Called 1949-50 DX season finis April 16th and have kept putting off sending in final report ever since. Inasmuch as next bulletin starts another DX season this report is sorta a resume of past season, also a report for balance of season from my last report on March 20th. A few new catches were added after date of March 20th, namely KIND KGNB & KMOD in March. Monday morn, April 3rd, one of best DX morns of season here which gave me KICO KAVR & KATO & KPRK all on f/cs. All were very welcome. On 7th, added KENM, 9th, KSWO on Easter morn pagaent, then no DX till morn of 14th, found 1YZ on 800 kc/s. breaking through for a report. On 16th, closed DX season by adding KEYY on f/c. During season reported to 142 new stations, of which at present time all are verified with exception of KSPA & KVON in Clifornia, KSWO in Oklahoma, & KENM KIPA KGIB KIHO KOSE KDEC KOPO WFEC WPCF & WWWV. Just today, 8/19, am again following up KENM KSWO KVON & KSPA. Balance will try to log again sometime. Confined past season mostly to K calls. A few W calls were reported and now verified, namely WSPC WATM WTOR WROD WIKC WIBR WMTW WTXL WFUR WRJW WNAI WKOZ WAFI WABG WUSJ WPRO. Not too many new Canadians but all were very welcome. All now verified there were CHFA CJDC CKOY & CJNB. Only foreign veries outside of Puerto Rico was 1YZ. Sent my report airmail and enclosed IRC. Came back in just a month. Pleased to get it as made an even 10 verified in New Zealand. Balance of veries were K calls, all verified which I am listing by states. Ariz. - KRUX KYCA KTYL KCKY KIFN. Of the K states, only N.D. and Wyoming failed to give me a new one. Next best frequency was 1340 kc/s. even with the usual interference. It gave me 12. 1240 gave me 8, 1400 only 4, 1450 3rd with 10. Leaving 1230 kc/s. You guessed it - nary a one. Started last season needing 56 active calls in Cal., now the list is down to 31, which includes KSPA and KVON, still out. Best veries of season to my mind were CJDC in Dawson Creek on 1350 kc/s., heard only twice and usually completely blotted out by Mexican. Next, 1YZ, followed by KSON KRUX KCKY KVRH KEYY KATO KBOG KMON KAVR KBOW KPRK KBYM KBUC KAFP & KWIK, all heard through interference on their respedtive channels. Other favorite veries were KTED KSMA KBLF KPMO KBRO KBRC KSEM KRKL KXRN KICO KBKR KERG KPDQ KTBI & KRCO. As ever.
