That's the new QTH up there; this DX NEWS should be the first one received there, only about three miles S of here; almost ten miles by highway. That CPC is really going to town this season - what an array of really great DXes they have set up via co-operation with stations who would be on anyway with TEST periods. These tests add calls to the log just as well as special DXes would! New here, KUXL via TEST of 11/3, hard to read back of CKLM's plus S-9 signal. KHOK-1560 a real surprise, just about 100% readable from 3:07 up to WRSJ's s/on @ 4:35 during their TEST of 11/5. On same date KYNG's TEST 3:30-4:00 ran into serious LA QRM on 1420 but was fairly readable at times. Both these WCs ran the meter up to S-9 most of the time. On 11/7 I finally found TILX-725 @ 11 pm, quite clear at times. 11/10, found KVPH-1550 topping the channel all the way during their r/c @ 1:15 am, mx and V. 11/12, found KPOR's 1370 TEST 100% readable although the signal never got over S-8 here, very faint signal on 1370 with them, no idea who.
