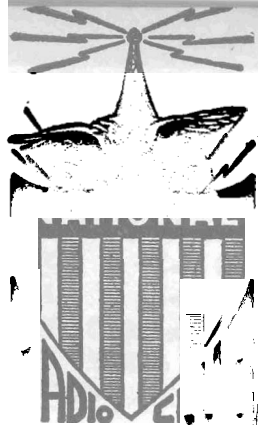

This seems to be the only time to get this elusive station since semi-local WJLK s/on 8am SM. Very convenient! 3/23 netted WBOS-1600 @ 6:407pm & later for another catch. At one station I talked to an announcer/engineer recently from SA, who explained one of the top NRCers a while back kept sending him letters in EE & after a while included IRC cards. Although he did not understand the letters, he signed one of the cards just to stop what he called "disparate" (nonsense). If that's a verie, so's a brick stamped "made in Japan/near NHK studios." I will send v/s & new government info to ~~DDX~~ soon. By the way, in Mexico, the government permits one person to own more than one station in each city, e/g/: XEAR XEJP XEAI XELZ & XERC are all of some owner. Remember XEN on 695? It wasn't a mistake- the government has authorized "testing" on 685 & 695 to avoid XEMP QRM (XEMP isn't always on 710 either). XEN was just sold to Radiopolis for 3,000,000 pesos (\$230,000) because previous owner was electrocuted inside the XR, shorting out a transformer too. I recently have completed a study on the effects of physical changes on radio reception & was selected to show my display in the SD County Science Fair. I came in second in my department, showing DXing is still good for something, hi! In case you are wondering about my study, I used 12 clear channels, KNBR WSB WJR WBEM WFAA WCCO WHAS KOA WCBS KDKA WHO & KSL, recorded their signal strengths from day to day, & related this to physical changes as sunspots, temperature, pressure, WX & moon phase. My results were rather amazing. Sunspots showed up as the #1 cause of static & inferior radio reception (as more of us know). Next came temperature. I found, in general, when an extreme low temperature prevailed, say -150, the station was not heard. Despite many claims, pressure had very little to do with the radio waves in my six-month project. No consistency existed; high, low, or similar pressure didn't correlate with similar signal strengths. The same results were found with WX & moon phase. If any of you are interested in my studies, please write me, & I'll fill you in! Local KGB is now leaning heavily toward rr, & expect them to have a survey soon. They are now on till 4:30 am except MM, I believe. At the rate SD is going every station will soon be AN - only KOGO isn't on later than 1am (when they s/off). KGB is now rr - just announced "Silver Dollar Survey" & pick of week. KHJ in LA is joining them soon. DX: 3/25- WYOU-1550 poor signal because of an immense amount of QRN. Said only verie with PP. 3/30 waste-KRCC-690 in Ore. testing till 3:40 with SS/FF mx, & EE IDs. Veries, poorer than ever, eight veries all in March - 35 reports sent! Radio Station WHOT has been authorized by the F.C.C. to expand its broadcasting day to 24 hours on a newly-assigned frequency of 1330 kc/s. The station will make the switch from 1570 to 1330 kc/s. at 1 pm Monday (4/ 5/63) & will use two transmitting sites, its present XR at 401 N. Blaine Ave. just N of Campbell, & a new XR location on Calla Road, S of Poland. WHOT said it first requested authorization for the change early in 1960 & was given approval in 1962. Construction of the new XR & erection of five towers has taken more than a year. The station had been operating since 1955 on a sunrise to sunset schedule. The Blaine Ave. XR will be used for the RS sunrise to sunset time period & the Calla Rd. site for the rest of the 24-hour period. The station had to abandon its end-of-the-dial 1570 position as operation during the night hours is prohibited by international treaty." The newspaper says "WHOT is the originator of personality radio in this area & has brought to the local scene an enthusiastic sound which has been widely imitated but not equaled. The WHOT personalities that will be continued at their regular times are Johnny Kay, George Barry, Dick Thompson & Boots Bell. At 7pm Dick Clark will host his own two-hour show. This will be followed by a new personality Don Evans until midnight. At this time Al Knight will carry the chatter until dawn. The WHOT execs explain there will be a great increase in the station's NX & sports activities." I tried getting a report from the station when they were on 1570 but had no luck. At one time the station had FM on 101.1 but I was unable to receive a veri for that. I believe the FM is still at the same spot. 73s to all.

Thus the voting was Unanimous, thus there can be no doubt as to the result.


Now I am coming to you for a decision as to the publishing of the Proposal and the Results in DX News. I will abide by your will.

Cooper and our Foreign DX Digest Editor, Peter V. Taylor;

Gentlemen;

This date I received your Second News-Letter and as usual its filled with many distorted facts or you did not bother to do any checking before making your statements.

However I am sending this to all of you asking WHY I have not as yet received an answer to my letter addressed to Maurice Nittler under the date of February 25 1963 giving the results of the votes on the proposal you gentlemen made in regard to taking over the publishing etc of the NRC as of Sept 1 1963.
