Greetings from Little Cuba. Although my DXing has been curtailed by a bum tuner in the S-120 & a two-week fishing trip at Leesburg, there is still some interesting info worth musing about. Some random noted about Central-North Florida stations: WBIL-1410 announces 5kw, not 1kw. as in White's. They use a single tower located at Howey-in-the-Hills which provides coverage over a large area. I visited the studios of WLBE-790. LBE means Leesburg-Eustis, their primary coverage area. They have a double tower array located between both towns & are directional to protect WFUN. Power is 5kw. daytime, 1kw. at night. They are on till midnight EST nightly & programming is from light classical to pops. Also in Eustis is WLCO-1240. LCO is for Lake County & the station calls itself "Radio Wulco." In nearby Mt. Dora is WVGT-1580, the Voice of the Golden Triangle, a station which features A-1 programming except for a semiliterate morning newsmen. (The secretary there tells me the DJs are a bunch of wolves, hi!) WLOF-950 (stands for We Love Orlando, Fla.) is on till midnight nightly, but antenna change causes abrupt disappearance of their signal at SSS in Leesburg. Their DJ Tommy Gunn had a continuous marathon show, lasted 58 hours, & claims a new world's record. WGTO-540 in Cypress Gardens is a local in Orlando. WHOO-990 with 10kw. puts in a weaker signal than many equally distant 250 watters. WMOP-900 announces new power of 5kw., perhaps a bit unusual for that frequency. WAPE-690 announces they are now AN but they are inaudible in Leesburg after SSS. Some local notes: WFUN-790 has moved to new "million dollar studios" in South Miami, which should now be listed as their correct location, instead of Miami Beach. Most of you know what amazing reception a 6" ferrite antenna can give with a transistor radio. But just think of the possibilities with a ferrite rod 16" to 30" long matched to a sensitive communications receiver! I am in the process of investigating the possibilities of ultra-sensitive ferrite antennae. I have talked to one of the RCA Ferrite engineers who thought it looked very promising. Nothing of this kind of experimentation has ever been done as far as I know, so there is no information to be had - just experimentation. I think it possible to develop an antenna with the sensitivity of a longwire & much better directivity than a loop. It is also possible that the noise level could be cut considerably with a ferrite antenna. In many cases power line noise could be nulled to a minimum, along with static, etc. You could also take it with you anywhere you take your receiver. I have been in touch with Indiana General Corp., who makes the best ferrite antenna rod available. I would like to have comments from all interested. If the experiments are successful, antennae could be had for as little as \$3.00. The price of the rod decreases considerably with greater quantity. Perhaps this could be the answer to many of the problems of the modern day DXer. Perhaps the apartment DXer could attain the results of the country DXer. If you are interested, I urge you to send me your comments.

Here's the way the band looks, using the Grundig with SWL7 antenna strung about 20' above ground: here are only two XRs within 20 miles of my permanent location; KWYZ-1230 & KRKO-1380, unfortunately both NSP, but neither emitting any spurious signals that I have caught so far. In the 21-40 mile range, there are 13 XRs, i.e.: KGDN-630 KETO-1590 KBRC-1430 KAPS-1470 KAGT-1340 KNBX-1050 KFKF-1330 KIXI-910 KXA-770 KAYO-1150 KOL-1300 KJR-950 KTW-1250. Five of these are daytime only, & five AN, a couple probably NSP, & none over 5kw. In the 41-100 mile range are found the big 50kws. of Seattle & Vancouver, i.e., KING-1090 KIRO-710 KOMO-1000 CKWX-1130. There are, I believe, 37 stations in this range, eight AN at least part-time, with CKWX probably NSP. Surprisingly some of these within 100 miles are not at listenable level; KAPS-1470 in Mt. Vernon, only 28 miles distant, is covered by KELA Centralia, some 105 miles distant; KAPY-1290 in Port Angeles, some 50 miles is almost non-audible, with null in this direction, while KOMP-1450 in same city is covered by KPUY in Puyallup, some 63 miles away. CHQM-1320 in Vancouver very null this direction, is inaudible under strong KXRO in Aberdeen, 108 miles. In fact, the signals from Aberdeen/Hoquiam area come in here surprisingly strong. Portland area stations are only fair here, with KGON-1520 best. Only KPQ-560 is audible here of all the Wenatchee stations, although only 96 miles away. In case the Railroads go on strike July 29th it is suggested that each NRC Member getting his DX News 3rd class mail, send in a 10¢ stamp so his August 17th issue can be mailed FIRST CLASS. REASON is that it has been published that in case of a STRIKE ONLY FIRST CLASS AND AIR-MAIL will be moving, ALL OTHER CLASSES will just stand still. PLEASE DO NOT SEND in any stamp UNLESS THE RAILROADS GO ON STRIKE.

#### POSTAL "ZIP" NUMBERS


Again we have a change in the method of mail delivery. I am sure that all have heard of the new ZIP numbering system.

Thus I am asking every NRC Member to send in his-her Postal "ZIP" number as soon as possible. Please include a fee of .10¢ in US or Canadian stamps or the same amount in coin. I have contacted the Addressograph Corp and they will add the ZIP number to your address plate. They will take the plates as they are, take out the metal part, add the ZIP number and re-insert the metal part. The total cost will depend on the number of plates involved, thus to be sure I am asking for the 10¢ FEE. In case the cost per plate is lower, those remitting the .10¢ FEE will be re-embursed the difference. BUT LETS HAVE THOSE "ZIP" NUMBERS as soon as possible, along with either .10¢ in coin or stamps. Further the Postal Authorities state that by using the ZIP number system will speed up all classes of mail, so it looks as if its worth a try. TO Bill Roney and the member in Mass who have already send in their FEE can ignore the above, as it will be taken care of, also Ken Butterfield.

A couple lines here that can be filled in reminds me that when you note in Ernie Coopers Station Data that on 1400 KC CJFP Riviere du Loup, Quebec is listed for 5,000 watts DAYS, plus on 1490 KC CKCR in Kitchener, Ont for 10,000 Watts days and 5,000 watts Nights is not an Error. Info from the Dept of Transport in Ottawa assures me that this is a fact and in accordance with Radio agreements with the US.
