There are three special tests this week, from KUXL-1570, KHOK-1560 and KYNG-1420.

KUXL, 11/3, 3:15-3:45 EST. "The Excel (XL) Station of the Twin Cities) has this special test period coming up, and they would like to hear from the DXers who might be able to hear them. They've been on since January '62. Only interference is expected from CKLM, Montreal.

KHOK, 11/5, 3:01-4:30 EST. This will be a Proof of Performance test, beginning with Irving V. Schmidtke, GM, CE. 15 minutes of music, and ending the same way. They are Gates equipped throughout, 150' tower quarter-wave, 135 radials. The channel is expected to be completely clear for this period, giving all a fine chance of logging.

KYNG, 11/5, 3:30-4:00 EST. KYNG (King) is affiliated with KQEN-1240 in Roseburg, Ore. Mr. Sundry Rhucles. (Queen). This will be a test period, and they will use recorded music, we believe, and will be interested in seeing how far they can be heard at this time. They've been in business since 12/7/56. Frequency should be clear. (All the above information was received from Len Kruse.)
