At 4:00 (5:00, E.D.S.T.) the second hour will be a part of WMHI's regular sked featuring news, weather, the "Sound of Music" show, and a few sports and public service announcements. ~~wiki~~ WMHI has some beautiful QSL cards, which right now are very low. They have been reordered, however, so please be patient if yours doesn't arrive immediately after the show. Mr. PRYOR E. NEUBER Jr., who OKed this program, says he is a BCB DXer himself, and he would very much appreciate it if you would send your reports to him IN DUPLICATE so he may have one for the WMHI files, and one for his own. WMHI signs on Tuesdays through Saturdays at 5:00 a.m., LT, and at 7:15 on Sundays, and at 4:45 a.m. all Mondays except the first Monday of the month when they open up for DXers at 4:04 a.m. (EDT ends 10/28). So this will be a monthly DX from 4:04-5:00, starting with 11/5. That 4:45-5:00 a.m. period other Mondays will also be for DXers. During the TEST portion of this program, 3:04-4:00 on 10/22 (with EDT still in effect there will also be short periods of 1,000 cycle tone and singing IDs - so everyone ought to have a golden opportunity of logging WMHI! Be sure to send those reports (remember, in duplicate, please) to Mr. Pryor E. Neuber, Jr., WMHI, A.T.D., Route 5, Frederick, Maryland. (Station is of course actually in Braddock Heights). A light homework load means I'll send in a Musing and add a suggestion to the rules for writing CPC letters. When writing for a DX, be sure to stress that tone and code IDs, several two-minute-long periods of code IDs with five-second tone intervals in between, emitted on DXes will penetrate the QRM very well and get the station much better coverage. This should be a necessity for DXing graveyarders as the coverage is much better. You can make out a weak TT but never the weak vocal announcement, right? But with code IDs the call can be made out. So you don't copy code. Few DXers do. But you can at least write down the often repeated didahs and figure them out after they have been put on paper and checked. Kindly take the hint. Canadian CPCers can make 400 cps square wave tone and code IDs available (thanks to a member at CFTO-TV) to any Canadian DXing station so this should help those Maple Leafs on congested frequencies. Regarding postage rates as outlined on Page 3 of the International DX Digest section, it is now a fact that as of January 7 1963 there will be increases in at least domestic postal rates as follows;-

FIRST CLASS MAIL will be increased from .04¢ per ounce to .05¢ per Oz
POST CARDS will be increased from .03¢ each to .04¢ each.

AIR-MAIL will be increased from .07¢ per ounce to .08¢ per ounce
AIR-MAIL POST CARDS will be increased from .05¢ each to .06¢ each

3rd CLASS MAIL, such as your DX News is sent will be increased from .03¢ for the 1st 2 ozs to .04¢ the 1st 2 ozs which means beginning Jan 7 1963 another .34¢ will have to be added to each members mailing costs

Thus from each \$4.00 membership dues, \$1.36 must be used to mail the 34 issues of DX News, thus leaving \$2.64 to purchase mimeo paper-mimeo ink-bulletin envelopes-stencils and the other operating costs of the club.
