It is gratifying to know that they have had a change of heart of late. Reception CX have suffered somewhat since the holidays out in this area. It is my understanding that CX will become definitely better between 1/10 & 1/20. Replaced my tap & lead-in wires of my inverted L antenna last week & found signals to be stronger than before the change. My tap wire was "scaly" & quite corroded. Also happy to follow with the logging of a TEST from WHAG-1410, Hagerstown, Md. on 1/13 from 4:30-5am, the final five minutes found WING on with its RS to interfere. The third logging on 1/13 was Station WXKW-1600, Troy, N.Y. with its RS from 4:30-5am, with some of the usual QRM, mianly ANer KLAK. On 1/14 Station WAAC-1300 Terre Haute, Ind. was logged on f/c-TT from 1:17-1:30am, with some KVOR QRM. Then in late afternoon on 1/14 Station KDFN-1500 Doniphan, Mo. was heard on RS for the first time from 5-6:15pm, when they soff. Above KEHR-883 logging prompts me to take a few lines to review DX of the "pearut whistle" stations I've heard here in Western Washington. I classify these in several catagories, i.e. (a) the CBC relay stations, ranging in power from 20-40w. (such as CBXI-610) of which quite a few have been verified on basis of assuming reception is from closest of the relays, if more than two on a given channel. Most distant verified to date is CBRF-730, Fernie, B.C. somewhere around 365 miles I believe. (b) Remots of BCB stations operating in area of 1605-1610 kc/s. Will detail those verified in this sector some other time - these do constitute an interesting phase of our hobby. (c) Carrier current operations of colleges, churches, etc. Only two logged here, and perhaps these should be considered the same station. First logged was a station on 657 kc/s. using no call, but IDing as "Voice of the Philadelphia Church" which is located in Ballard area of Seattle, Wash. some 15 miles from my then DX location. They verified as a carrier-current operation, 10w. output to power lines. A very recent logging in this catagory is same "Voice of the Philadelphia Church" from my Marysville location, probably 30 miles distance, now using call of KFPE (or KXPC?) & on 662 kc/s. They have not answered my report and tape of this reception. Probably would not want to acknowledge reception at this distance! (d) Clandestine operations. Above KEHR is most recent; very obvious semi-juvenile record "hop" with live audience. Only other was a "Cool Radio" KOOL, approximately 1605 kc/s. announcing as 1610, very juvenile, high school or younger operator. Never did pin down this "KOOL! baby, but have good tape that's fun to listen to. 73.
