I did get a few of the NRC DXes using Admiral five-tube portable during coffee break; WWSF-1400 NRC, KCCL-1460-TEST. WVMT-620 NRC but no reply. WSNE-1410 TEST. WFRE-560 TEST, WTOL-1230 NRC. WFAW-940 TEST but no reply. KXIW-1320 TEST. Other veries in are WWGO-1450 WYNN-540 WSEM-F00 WVON-1450 WHRY-1600 WFLS-1350 WWYN-1260 WTOT-980 and WMSG/WCEF-1050. And WVOB-1520 who was heard on RS, thus a nice personal letter instead of the usual v/f, one like Roger Winsor would like to have. I have so many reports out - some on the second and third try. On fourth try, WERZ-1590 netted a nice QSL, two reports on RS and two back about five years ago on DX. Looking for some of those easy ones for some but hard for me after a few reports like WYAL-1280 WANS-1280 WDAX-1410 WEAS-900 WOWE-1580 WJES/WAFS-1570, WYCL-1580 WYNR-1390 WSKT-1580 etc. The past two seasons I netted 100 & 105 veries. I have 43 s far this year so it dooks like I'll get half way there. I guess my best catch was CEN -640 a real rough one in WFAW-940, wish they'd verify. Two others who failed me, KMIS-1050 after nice catch, & WABD-B70. We both reported them, Ernie, on the same AM, like last year WKMK-1370. Guess I'll hang in there for the summer. 73.

Hal Robie - 351 South Street - Medfield, Massachusetts - 02052 Not much here for news right now. Wost interesting is a letter from Radio Woscow in answer to a letter I sent referring to the situation on the evenings of 1/27-28 when the USSR interval signal faded in over Radio Andorra-998 at 5:56rm and lasted until 6. Nothing else could be clearly IDed, although a man's voice could be heard briefly but indistinctly. (The announcer on Radio Andorra at this time was a woman). No list here shows Kishinyov on at that hour, so I wrote asking about their hours of broadcast and stated what I had heard. Reply says, Thank you for your letter of 3/23 and the reception report on Mishinyov, Moldavian Soviet Socialist Republic. According to info received from our technical department, we found our that the call signal you heard from 22:56 to 23:00 GMT belongs to Radio Kishinyov. At this hour this station closes down and the language was Moldavian. Unfortunately, we do not verify reception reports from local stations. Do you listen to Radio Moscow's North American Service?" Etc/etc. This may not be an official verification, but it states in black and white that the signal I heard belongs to Radio Kishinyov and I personally consider it to confirm my reception, brief as it was on those two occasions. I was unable to pick up the signal again, although I tried nightly for some time. One of the nice things about this hobby is its flexibility within the limits of one's own conscience. My log includes only those stations I know I've heard. There are no tentatives unless subsequently verified, and tentatives aren't reported unless it is pretty certain theirs is the station heard. Even on these rare occasions I usually request a verie only if they can be certain beyond a dubt. On those stations positively IDed I'm willing to accept a most loosely worded statement as long as it is an apparant attempt to confirm. When time permitted I was more or less a purist, going back for clarification of statements, sending PP for signature specifying exact frequency if verie listed more than one, etc. It's easy to go overboard, but I wonder if it's necessary in most cases. Lately I've taken to filing a copy of my $\phi \phi$ riginal report with any verie that requires clarification on a minor point. For my own purpose I find this is a fairly satisfactory solution.
