Well, boys, so far this is shaping up as one heck of a season. Rarely heard stations are being heard frequently, and new loggings are rampant, so if you don't get some good DX this season, you never will. Hurricane Hilaa saw many Gulf Coast stations on AN, and the following were logged: WACY-1460 Moss Point, Miss., WXXX-1310, Hattiesburg, KABE-1540 Westwego, WBGS-1560 Slidell, La., KXKW-1520 Lafayette, and KJEL-1290. Other loggings: Enisoras Vargas-1070, La Guiara, thanks to a tip from Mr. Schatz. Report out. Mystery stations from Dominacan Republic include 873 kc/s., and 1510.5 kc/s., the latter located outside of Santo Domingo and a relay of Radio Universal-650.
