However at 2:15 caught r/c s/off of KCTX-1510, very clear, giving Texas temperature as 33°. Also finally got KENO-1460 s/off @ 2:57. KGVO DX impossible as 1290 covered by WICE/KOIL & later unnn CFAM & finally 4am s/on of WHKY: CFAM quite readable, but no trace of CHSM-1250 DX, only noisy WRYT heard, although something from the SW seemed to be in back. Next fry on 1/5 & found TA CX the best I have ever heard here! At 12:30am ORTF-1554 Nice was very clear. I checked 1586 & found German was fully readable w/volume control at minimum! Hets & occasional audio at most TA frequencies near upper end of dial. I never got far enough to check the low end, hi. Extremely loud s/on at 1am on 1578 sounded like Spain and looped more easterly than other TAs. Some may wonder why IDX uses 24-hour time and Musings use AM/PM. Most of the Musings reports are bunched together chronologically by individual's activity, and thus there is no confusion when, say, the time "4:29" is given. Personally, all my logging is done by the 24-hour clock, because I find it easier to convert CST to EST and either to GMT ... or to JST or NZST ... which a foreign DX'er must continuously do to send out an acceptable report. And, too, 1627 takes less space than 4:27 p.m. It doesn't make that much difference in Musings, where the time is obvious, per context.
