K O R A - 1240

This station will be on the air with a special DX Test broadcast from 2:30 to 3:00 a.m. EST (1:30-2:00 CST). This is a tough channel, but with a special effort NRCers should hear them for quite a distance as 1240 is not too crowded at this time. W R Y T - 950

Formerly WORL, this station will be on the air with a special TEST broadcast on 12/26, from 4:00 to 4:30 a.m., EST. There may be some slight interference from Stations WPEP & the CBC all-night station still unID, but Westward, the frequency is expected to be clear after the s/off of KIMN around 4:03 a.m., so many DXers should hear WRYT's TEST. We do not know what they'll be doing during this half hour, nor do we have the mailing address for veries, but send your reports to the Chief Engineer, whom we thank.

K B A B - 1490

We start the Nes Year right with a DX TEST from a rare DX catch, KBAB-1490, which will be on from 2:00 to 2:30 CST, or 3:00-3:30 EST. A few all-night stations on 1490 may limit their coverage on this TEST, but then it seems that some of the all-nighters on 1490 have dropped off on Monday mornings, so be sure to try real hard. VENEZUELA. YVOA, LV del Tachira, San Cristobal. S/on heard 12/5 at 0501 with NA. (Seaver, Calif.)
- 1005 NO. KOREA. Pyongyang outlet heard best ever 12/5 at 0417. (Seaver, Calif.)
- 1010 JAPAN. JONR, Osaka. Another one I've been after for some time! Call sign ID at 0400 in the clear, 12/2, with only CFRB every few minutes. (Scrimgeour, Calif.)
MEXICO. XEHL, Guadalajara, Jal. heard with very strong signal 11/30 around 2300. (Miller, Fla.)
MEXICO. XEEB, Esperanza, Son. was in at its 0305 s/off on 12/2. (Scrimgeour, Calif.)
- 1015 EL SALVADOR. YSC, San Salvador, heard 11/29 with Yeh-Esse-Seh ID plus time given in between each record. Heard from 2250 to 2300 with great signal. (Winsor, Ind.)
- 1020 DOM. REP. HIPJ, R. Commercial, Santo Domingo, heard here with good signal around 2240. Announces they are the most modern and powerful station in the country. (Sounds like the management has been studying US promotion methods.) (Miller, Fla.)
- 1025 COSTA RICA. TIAC, R. Fides, San Jose. S/off 2305 12/4. No anthem, but call clearly given. (Miller, Wash.)
UNID. SS Signal playing soft piano music 11/25, music came in well, but ID very soft, impossible to hear. Modulation must be low. Assume HJER unless otherwise proven wrong. (Winsor, Ind.) How about above? (Ed.)
- 1100 VENEZUELA. YVKE, R. Cultura, Caracas. Level WKYC on loop 12/5 1930. Latin vocals. (Wood, Ind.)
- 1120 COLOMBIA. HJKG, R. Tunja, Tunja. ID by san 1800 12/1, then into news. (Wood, Ind.)
GUATEMALA. TGRR, R. Reloj, Guatemala. Heard over KMCX with R. Reloj ID; usual SS-type music on 11/29. ID heard 2139 very clearly. (Winsor, Ind.) S/off nightly 0100 with a strong signal. Gives call letters, station address (which I couldn't catch) KR location, power as 10 kW, and requests reports. No anthem is played, but they put on some really weird and beautiful Indian music. Usually a simple matter to loop out KMCX here. TGRR is undoubtedly the easiest Guatemalan station for me. (Miller, Fla.)
- 1125 COSTA RICA. TISRH, R. Popular, San Jose. Easily separable on ID 2143 followed by soft recorded music. In for about 20 minutes. (Winsor, Ind.)
- 1130 JAPAN. JOOR, Tokyo, heard 12/5 at 0427 good under CKWX. (Seaver, Calif.)
- +1140 PANAMA. HOP49, R. Universal, Panama, with ID and ranchero music at 0640 12/3. Mentions station in Colon not listed here. (Silvera, Jamaica)
- 1150.5 MEXICO. XERM, Mexicali, B.C.N. ID'd as station with basketball at 0110 12/8. (Freeman, Calif.)
- 1160 SO. KOREA. HLKU, Pusan. Heard with "MBC, HLKU" ID 12/5 at 0500. (Seaver, Calif.)
- +1180 DOM. REP. HIBE, R. Mil, Sto. Domingo, now back here from 1190. (Silvera, Jamaica)
ID S.S. My Radio X disappeared from here at the same time as local SS WENX-1380 quit AMing. I wonder why. Hi. (Cooper, N.Y.)
- +1190 HONDURAS. HRVW, San Pedro Sula, now here from 1185. Poor signal, hard to dig out from WCWO/HJCT. (Miller)
- 1205 UNID. S.S. Again loops S.A. Mixed LA and NA music and ID on the hour just happened to come in a fade, or I could have had this one. S9+ signals but many deep fades. (Conrad, Ky.)
- 1210 COLOMBIA. HJPF, LV Amiga, Pereira. ID 0154, over CMHK. No trace of LV3. (Wood, Ind.)
JAPAN. JOOR, Tokyo... whoops, Osaka ... call sign ID 0300 12/5. (Scrimgeour, Calif. Strong w/ US Christmas music 12/5 at 0437-0450. ID given was not "Mainichi Hoso", however, I couldn't grab the first word. (Seaver)
- 1214 ALBANIA. R. Tirana. heard with excellent S-9 signals on MM 11/7 0000-0100, plays the "Internationale" around 0057. Report sent. (Cooper, N.Y.)
- 1220 JAPAN. HNK-2 network heard weak on 12/5 at 0410. (Seaver, Calif.) They'll CSL as JOOC. (Ed)
UNID. S.S. AN SS heard here MM 12/5 while looking in vain for KZYM's TEST. (Cooper, N.Y.)

- 1304 ALGERIA. Oran has nitely EE Nx at 1700, followed by 20 minutes of dance music. Very good here. (Bugaj, Mor.)
- 1325 NETH. ANT. PJ10, The Voice of Aruba, Cranjestad. Heard s/off on Monday 11/14 at 2302 in EE. Report sent, but they didn't verify a report of last winter. (Cooper, N.Y.)
- +1330 PANAMA. HON92, Canal 13, Panama. With Instrumental music and frequent IDs at 1830 12/1. (Silvera, Jamaica)
- 1340 BERMUDA. ZBM2, Hamilton. Dominating the frequency 0413 11/28. (Rugg, Que.)
- +1348 COLC BIA. HJ??, La Voz de Chicamocha, (Chicamocha?), Dept. de Santander, heard with good signals at 1859 12/1, ranchero music, and announces 1330 kHz. Must be new. Not listed. (Silvera, Jamaica)
- 1370 UNID. S.S. Heard here MM 12/5, 0115-0200 and on, with Strauss waltzes - does this fit the programming of HJKX? I sort of doubt it. (Cooper, N.Y.) You're like the Top 40 fan who doubts "Music Til Dawn" exists. This DOES fit HJKX' format. This a confusing MM freq., because NHK II, CBC AN, and HJKX all play similar music. (Ed.)
- 1376 AS. RUSSIA. Vladivostok heard weak 12/5 at 0423 and on. (Seaver, Calif.)
- FRANCE. Lille I - heard Sat. AM 12/3 0140-0220 w/WBNX-1380 off; reported. (Cooper, N.Y.)
- 1457 ENGLAND. BBC Clevedon. Still audible at good level 0414 11/28. (Rugg, Que.)
- 1460 COLOMBIA. HJAL, R. Sincelajo, Sincelajo. Poor level 0309-0327 11/28. Too weak for a report. Did hear several IDs, and a "R. Centro" was apparently mentioned. (Rugg, Que.)
- +1490 COLOMBIA. HJAY, LV de la Cordialidad, Galapa, Atlantico, now here from 1480, as I suspected. Permanent move, as they now announce "nueva frecuencia." (Silvera, Jamaica)
- +1501V PANAMA. HON, R. Aeropuerto, Colon, heard here MM's 11/21 and 11/28, but not heard MM 12/5 AN. (Cooper, N.Y.) Unid. SS in L & C all evening long, I think s/off 0030. Is this HON? I've been listening a lot to this one, but no ID seems to be clearly given, but then my SS is much to be desired. (Winsor, Ind.)
- 1530 U.F.O. Seemed Oriental here 12/5 at 0428. Jap? (Seaver, Calif.)
- 1535V U.F.O. Whhops. UNID S.S. heard weakly MM 12/5 at 0536-0545. No ID's heard, but I think it's likely HON-R. Aeropuerto. (Seaver, Calif.) Note, not on 1501 that date! (Ed.)
- 1538 W. GERMANY. Deutschlandfunk, Mainflingen, must be one here w/classical and semi-classical selections 0110-0145 12/4. Not a word spoken in narration. Tentative report sent. (Silvera, Jamaica)
- 1560 MEXICO. XEVIP, Mexico, D.F. Seems to be AN only on Sat. and Sun., in EE. Does anyone have an address for this one? (Cooper, N.Y.)
- 1575 CHINA. New one for me, logged on 11/28 at 0510 with Mandarin, march music at 0514, and then a Central People's Broadcasting Station ID at 0515. (I think that all Chinese radios - including transmitters - have been misaligned by 5 kc., just to fool FBIS, Hi.) (Scrimgeour, Calif.) NOT to mention PAL. (Ed.)
- 1586 W. GERMANY. W.D.R., Langenburg. Heard and reported on reception of MM 11/28. They have an IS from 0152 tune-in to 0155, then a lady in German came on, mentioning many numerals, not in order, and then NX at 0200. Seems like a rather late s/on for Germany??? (Cooper, N.Y.)
- 1590 JAPAN. NHK-II outlet heard 12/2 at 0400, perhaps unneeded JQGB. A good morning for Japan. JCKD was atop U.S. DRM for a few minutes, too, a rarity for midweek reception! (Scrimgeour, Calif.)
