
NOTES &c FROM NJPC

Judging from the number of reports this time some people have finally done some DXing. So without further comment, here's whats been heard.

- 539 -HUNGARY/UNID Budapest noted on top w/some patchy audio, male talking at 2153 2/10 during fair opening; someone else causing SAH, no audio from latter stn; unscientific method of counting S-meter beats shows about 6 Hz difference between the two. (Taylor)
- 570 -MEXICO XENZ Culliacan, Sin. 2/21 0157-0201 w/SS rock and "Musica de Pegue" ID's. Dropped out at 0201, which must have been power cut time. XE stns are now subject to a rather big fine for failing to hold to legal power, and most seem to be conforming now. (Gleason)
- VENEZUELA YVLX R. Rumbos excellent sig topping channel, 0015 2/12. (Hagan)
- 580 -PUERTO RICO WKAQ R. El Mundo, San Juan all alone w/WMCA & WSYR nowhere to be heard, on 2/12. NRC Log says WKAQ on 580; I received it on 570. Is this possible? ID heard as "W-Ka-ah-Koo", a musical ID. (Peterson) WKAQ definitely on 580 and well heard here at times. Most often reported SSers on 570 are the YV and HI. (ED)
- 593 -MOROCCO/WEST GERMANY Oujda/Frankfurt mixed, but the Moroccan on top w/easy listening Western mx 2215 2/10. The GG poor underneath w/talking; neither very often heard. (Taylor)
- 600 -COLOMBIA HJHJ R. Libertad, Barranquilla fair at 0330 on 2/8 w/CFGF/CMKV. CMKV was on top w/S-4. (Peterson)
- CUBA CMKV R. Rebelde, San German at 0045 2/12 w/HJHJ, S-4. (Peterson, next)
- 640 -VENEZUELA YVQO Ondas Portenas, Puerto la Cruz fair w/CBN on 2/3 at 0500.
- 650 -COLOMBIA HJXJ Emisoras Monserrate, Bogota heard intermittently between 0729-0800 2/25 w/several ID's. At 0729 the ID was "TODELAR ... somos professional ... somos Emisoras Monserrate". (Rugg)
- 660.5 -NICARAGUA YNAM presumed, 2/18 0817 w/CDT TC for 3:16, ad. (Hauser)
- 670 -VENEZUELA YVLL R. Rumbos, Caracas. Very strong and alone on channel with several ID's 0035 2/12. (Falconer) * * On 2/4 at 0005 w/WMAQ on top. YVLL was very weak but heard ID "Radio Rumbos" Venezuela. (Peterson)
- 683 -SPAIN RNE Sevilla noted on 2/20 w/fair sig 0230+, readable circa 0250 as CEF-690 quieted down. Steady sig, still fair at recheck 0345. Better than Rome-845 and Cairo-818 also showing this morning. Hets/pips also on several other TA channels. (Sundstrom)
- UNID There is something very strange going on here of late ... low-pitched audible het noted on low side of RNE Sevilla at 2254 2/10, and nightly ever since. Preliminary DF seems to indicate about 100 degrees, or somewhere in Western Africa, although no recent data indicates a projected operation from this part of the world. No audio thus far. Help? (Taylor) * * Strange unid here 0330-0430 2/19 per PT tip. Several loop bearings yielded an average of about 108 degrees. Was most assuredly low of 683, and was apparently pretty much 560 Hz low, which would make it 682.440. Another het audible, this one about 375 Hz, but dunno placement of it - a Spectrum Analyser would help, hi, unless of course that 375 Hz one were a tone. Since nothing has been noted new for this channel, least of all on this bearing, we must surmise a very recent change. This bearing includes such potential exotica as Cape Verde Islands, South Africa, Southwest Africa and Lesotho, none of which seem likely. W/Spain and Yugoslavia audible on channel (683 even) only bearing pull likely would put actual bearing even further South, thereby leaving South Africa only, and they're supposedly phasing MW out in favor of FM. (Edmunds) *ERC suggests that this is a spur of some type from WOR as he is also noting it on 728. Does this sound reasonable? (ED)
- 690 -BRAZIL R. Drago do Mar heard w/weak signal 0230 2/1. (Trower)
- 719 -PORTUGAL Norte up w/male vocal, lite mx 2255 2/10, best audio and strength in a canine's age. Wonder who'll be first to come up w/London here? (Taylor)
- NRC NEEDS YOUR SUPPORT. REPORT YOUR DX REGULARLY AND OFTEN. ITS YOUR CLUB!!!!

- 720 -COLOMBIA HJAN Emisoras Unidas, Barranquilla 2/20 0135 w/clear ID by call letters, w/FM also mentioned. Was 100% readable and in the clear for 5 min w/local spots. This is the best I've ever heard an HJ. (Gleason) * * Weak w/Emisoras Unidas ID 0145 2/12. (Falconer)
- 730.7 -PANAMA Two "R. Alegre de Panama" IDs heard, TCs, 2/18 0847; listed WRTH 74 as HPQ, R. La Exitosa, 24 hours. (Hauser)
- 737 -ISRAEL Quadima heard w/usual Hebrew "chanting" (I realise this is a misnomer, but it conveys the message, hi) 0340 2/19. Now it seems that this one is accompanied by a jammer as well as by Spain. Good Mid-east opening. (Edmunds)
- 750 -COLOMBIA HJDK La Voz de Antioquia, Medellin 2/2 at 0245 w/WSB on top. HJDK was very weak, but heard ID as "La Voz de Antioquia". (Peterson)
- 760 -VENEZUELA YVQQ R. Puerto la Cruz 2/1 at 0315 w/WJR on top. ID as "Radio Puerto la Cruz". (Peterson)
- 775 -COSTA RICA TIW R. City, San Jose noted very strong w/ID 0525 2/8. (Falconer)
- 780 -BRITISH VIRGIN ISLANDS ZBVI finally heard very good at times w/WBEM. Had rock mx w/several ID's, 0100-0200 2/13. (Falconer) * * GSTQ noted u/WBEM 2/17 0412; this match ZBVI's s/off? (Hauser)
- 800 -NETHERLANDS ANTILLES PJB Bonaire in EE on 2/15 at 0245 w/religion and news at 0300. Fair level w/XEROK in background. (Zank)
- 810 -COLOMBIA HJCY R. Sutatenza, Bogota 2/18 0858 giving stn list w/locations, powers; SAH w/OC; 0900 beginning program about social progress. (Hauser)
- 825.3 -UNID Briefly good reception 2/20 0140 of station w/international style MoR, and soft voiced, poorly modulated announcer. Good SA/CA opening at time. Suspect TIOS, but is anyone else here? (Gleason) Sounds like TIOS. TGTO has been here in past, not sure where they are at the moment. (ED)
- 830 -MEXICO XELA Mexico DF "Buena Musica" in w/a fine signal 2/13 twixt 0446-0515. Cl mx, including a Mozart concert. Only slight WCCO QRM. (Krejny)
- VENEZUELA YVLT R. Sensacion, Los Teques fair through WCCO w/MoR mx, 0045-0100 2/12. (Falconer)
- 834 -BELIZE R. Belize in EE on 2/3 at 0230-0315 w/beautiful piano mx and news. Good level, but w/splatter from WCCO on 830. (Zank) * * 0400-0410 w/fantastic signal. No static/QRM. Dominating WCCO/WHAS w/BBC news and oldies RR and CW mx. Modulation low. Report sent. (Davenport)
- 836 -AZORES Emisora Regional, Ponta Delgada very weak sig, heard most nights, closing at 0100. (Trower)
- CANARY ISLANDS R. Popular de las Palmas heard to close 0002, generally last SS to s/off, leaving the Azores. (Trower)
- 844 -GILBERT & ELLICE ISLANDS Tarawa noted w/fair audio MM 2/18; 0712 YL talking; 0901 good carrier but WHAS splatter; 0923 YL talking again; seemed to go off before 0945. Condx made me wish NAWA's Cook Islands test had been on MW instead of SW, where Habana wiped it out. (Hauser)
- 850 -COLOMBIA "Manana de CARACOL" noted in passing 2/25 0701. (Hauser)
- NICARAGUA My "-al" station last time was likely R. Continental, noted this week 2/25 0648 thru KOA OC plugging its repetidoras (none listed in WRTH 74), which enable it to be heard "como emisora local" throughout Nicaragua; "Donde esta un nicaraguense, ahi esta la Continental". Very professional, w/M&W DJs alternating; 0654 yelling ads; plugging its 24h operation. (Hauser)
- URUGUAY Very tentative, as I wasn't taping, but thought I heard a TC at 0654 2/25 as "4 para las 4", i.e. GMT -3, mixing w/Nicaragua. (Hauser)
- UNID Strong overmodulated jingle 2/18 0813 for "Emisora _____al"; sure didn't sound like Nuevo Mundo. (Hauser)
- 855 -NETHERLANDS ANTILLES YL DD announcer noted w/mx, TCs 1030-1034 2/18, doubtless Qurom. (Hauser)
- 860 -MEXICO XEMO Tijuana, 2/18 good EE 0753 mentioning Community Radio for San Diego, representing XEMO. Community Radio is owned and operated by Curtis Mennifield and Larry De Rueshio, request line 291-0872. WRTH lists as 5 kw? (Vernon) * * In EE on 2/10 at 0815. IDing as if in San Diego. Very good level. (Zank) Is 5 kw as far as I know Brian. (ED)
- 880 -CUBA CMAF very strong o/WCBS w/mx program 0450-0500 2/13. (Falconer)
- 890 -COLOMBIA (tentative) several stns in WLS null; LV de Bogota usually dominates; one heard 2/25 0537 giving week's sked of carnival activities. (Hauser)
- PANAMA HOL81 David in very well w/romantic mx and dialogue 0624-45. QRM from HJCE but clearly dominant most of the time. (Krejny) 815 (ED)

- 900 -BARBADOS R. Barbados, poor, EE 2/9 or 10, Big Band mx at 0929 then s/on mentioning CBC, waited for my first WRTH to check this one, couldn't figure out CBC? Barbados mentioned a few times, also FM. Think religious program followed, much noise here at 0930, think 2/10, forgot date waiting for WRTH, hi. (Vernon) CBC=Caribbean Broadcasting Corporation. (ED)
- 930 -USA An und here, right near to you, heard 0430 2/17 w/discussion and requesting calls "If in the New York area, ring Area Code 212-985-9940". Presume this to be WPAT Paterson, N.J., new here. Comments pse. (Trower)
- 940 -COLOMBIA HJGB R. Eco, Cali good signal 0658 2/11. (Hagan)
- MEXICO XEQ Mexico, DF in SS on 2/14 at 0415-0430 w/La Hora de Mexico at a fair level. (Zank)
- 990 -MEXICO XET Monterrey in SS on 2/14 at 2330 alternating w/CBW near local sunset. Good level when it had its turn. (Zank)
- 1010 -MEXICO XEHL Guadalajara fair SS 2/19, 1004, male announcer w/TC, then femme announcer s/Love Story piano theme in background, mentioned "... la Fabulosa ..." in SS, many SS ballad songs. (Vernon)
- 1015 -EL SALVADOR YSC fair w/CFRB splash w/up tempo MoR mx. (Falconer)
- 1025 -UNID Most likely Costa Rica w/s/off 0400 2/12, very weak leaving another LA on frequency. (Falconer)
- 1030 -ARGENTINA LS10, Radio Del Plata, Buenos Aires logged w/news and sports 0733-0810. TCs were GMT -2 to confirm earlier observations. Good signal w/XEQR and und HJ QRM. (Krejny) * * Coming in quite well MM 2/18; 0744 OC off from US stn revealing 2 OM announcers alternating w/nx, o/SAHing XEQR; giving time as 5:44 (so at least Buenos Aires is on double-daylight time, GMT -2) meaning some other stns w/"late" s/ons may now be in a darkness path as they s/on an hour (or two?) earlier than sked in WRTH; 0748 cut-ons from US stn; 0750 1/2 another peak, all talk (must be same as noted last April by Martin 0830-0900), several more GMT -2 TCs; 0759 full ID mentioning FM outlet too, then "Freste Atencion", followed by military band and promo for ejercito nacional; XEQR still on but easily nulled. First Argentinian for me from this location.
- 1035 -HAITI 4VEF Cap Haitien w/good signals promising QSL's for correct/(Hauser) reports. Report sent (wrote down everything said the last min. (Davenport)
- PANAMA R. Union 2/25 0523 SS mentioning Puerto Rico, Panama and slogan ID in passing. (Hauser)
- 1055 -COLOMBIA HJFZ fair w/MoR mx 0405 2/12. (Falconer)
- 1060,5 -COLOMBIA (?) Mx hetting KNX 2/18 0657. Emisora Atlantica has been reported here, but recheck of its 2nd harmonic at 0710 w/tropical mx seemed, interpolating by eyeball, not to be a kHz below 2140. (Hauser)
- 1075 -COSTA RICA TIFC San Jose weak 0415-0430 2/12. Had religious program in EE very similar to 4VEC. WRTH says s/off 0400. (Falconer)
- 1080 -VENEZUELA YVNR R. Universal, Maracay among other stns jumbling here in KRLLD absence 2/25 0704, mentioning Estado Aragua and advertising ron. (Hauser)
- UNID The mysterious R. Libertad (cf FL-I: R. Libertad), 2/25 0626 ID, "sigue la musica", 0630 tropical mx; KRLLD on and off. (Hauser)
- 1088 -ENGLAND BBC FS very good level but lots of fast fade 0630-0700 2/11 in FF, then "This is London" in EE, mx, pips and into World Service mx. Have heard the same thing on Daventry-647 in December, but was in EE and was at 0600.
- 1100 -ANTIGUA ZDK St John's logged for the first time (thanks to 3WE)/(Foxworth) on 2/11 0504-0535 w/mixture of soul and calypso mx. Did not sound like a special program and since also heard later I believe they may be all night now. Good signal. (Krejny)
- GUATEMALA (Heard on 2nd harmonic, 2200) R. Superior is agn heard on 2200 kHz evenings mixing w/Nicaragua till it goes off; this stn is still missing from the WRTH. 2/13 0425 w/CDT TCs, 0430 ID several times, and "Viva la senal de Radio Superior"; 0445 same ID, "musica ligera", 0451, 0455, 0458 s/off: "...mejores deseos de su Radio Superior, ahora mas potente", freq as 1100 kHz, mentioning an FM freq, 0500:30 off abruptly during marimba mx. Also 2/17 0501 s/off. Believe to be TGRS, in Escuintla. (Hauser)
- NICARAGUA (Heard on 2nd harmonic of 2200) Still noted on 2200, mixing severely w/Guatemala, but this one goes off earlier. Noted 2/19 0219 w/CDT, "hora oficial de Nicaragua"; at this time it even had a slightly varying het w/Superior. Listened for some time but detected neither a Voz de la Victor nor a "Lider" ID. (Hauser)
- 1150 -UNID SS Good 2/10 1030+, many ID's as "Esta es la uba, el remme, radioama". (Excuse my SS) after each record. Believe CKX was off. (Vernon)
- 1151 -ENGLAND BRMB R. Birmingham now on RS. Lousy signal, swamped by Romania fm 1500-midnite and 0500-0800, also very often weaker than R. Clyde. (Trower)
- 1155 -EL SALVADOR (Heard on 2nd harmonic of 2310) Mx noted on 2310 at 0503 scan, presumed previously identified YSCF. (Hauser)
- 1171 -UNID 2/25 0505 seperable from KVOO OC w/SS birthday greetings show; mentioned "bandera de liberacion nacional"; anyone recognize this catch-phrase? RFS hypothesizes an Honduran drifts here. Either f/out or off 0508. (Hauser)
- 1180 -BRAZIL R. Globo excellent after HIBE s/off at 0600 2/10. 5 minute mx folo by musical program. (Hagan)
- DOMINICAN REPUBLIC HIBE R. Mil good after WHAM s/off at 0500 to s/off at 0600 2/10 w/Dominican National Anthem. (Hagan)
- 1196 -WEST GERMANY VOA Munich a block buster sig on 2/10 2223 w/commentary on European politics in EE; no Agadir, must have been off already. (Taylor)
- 1211,2 -VENEZUELA YVMN R. Coro s/on, mx, 2/18 1001, "siempre se escucha mas". (Hauser) * * Obliterating WCAU's hockey game w/ID at 0116, 2/25. (Rigg)
- 1214 -GREAT BRITAIN Best level so far this season at 0707 2/11, rock pgm. (Fox-
- 1220 -CUBA CMGY Perico (listed) on 2/25 0459:45-0500:15 w/musical inter-/worth lude that precedes the opening of all R. Havana, on SW xmsns. Surfaced atop for a few moments, no mistaking the tune. WGAR/CHSC/WKBEK and an und FF all on the air, w/WCAU nulled by necessity (50 kw at 3 air miles) New. (Sandstrom) * * None of the domestic tests heard 2/25 due to XEB and WGAR OC, but this came in 0439 w/light classics, EST TCs; 0458 "desde Matanzas ...CM...Radio 26..." then NA. CMGY Perico listed. (Hauser)
- 1225 -COSTA RICA TIBB San Jose w/BB ID's between mx. Fair w/WGAR splash. 0400 on 2/13. (Falconer)
- 1265 -ST KITTS R. Paradise 1000-1015 2/18. Very poor. 2/19 0000-0305 s/off. Poor to very good. (Davenport)
- 1277 -FRANCE ORTF Strasbourg noted in a rare appearance on 2/10 at 2225 w/modern serious orchestral mx (post-Debussy); another und signal underneath, but no discernable audio blows dreams on Moscow here, hi. (Taylor) According to info from GPN on phone the Russian is no longer here. (ED)
- 1286 -CZECHOSLOVAKIA Prague here in FS w/fantastic audio, easily listenable at 2204 w/the baby Lisbon stn behind; 2/10. Woman speaking in unrecognized language interspersed w/musical interludes; the one at 2205 was female vocal w/full orchestral accompaniment, very Slavic harmonies and near-modal melodies. (Taylor)
- 1295 -ENGLAND (I think) BBS FS pgms here // 1088 after 0700 2/11; tried for whatever else might have been there but was alone on frequency. (Foxworth)
- 1307 -CUBA CMHK Cruces, 2/16 w/all talk, fair signal at times o/noise level w/local WCAM-1310 off 0427-0445. - 1400 -BRAZIL R. Roquette Pinto, closing 0300 2/10, fair signal and also (Hauser) uses slogan "Voz oficial de Guanabara". (Trower) / (Hauser)
- 1403 -UNID 2/25 0606 carrier and hint of a het which could mean Conakry was one.
- 1410 -MEXICO (Heard on 2nd harmonic of 2820) XEAS R. Juventud noted for first time on a harmonic, 2820 kHz, 2/13 0504 w/mx in EE; 0522 f/up w/SS vocals, guitar trio, sung ID, TC as 11-25, said would continue "hasta las doce". Nuevo Laredo. Also 2/17 1228 w/6:30 TC, Laredo ads. (Hauser)
- 1421 -WEST GERMANY Saar excellent way over 1420 domestics w/clear speaking (Cont)

1460 -MEXICO (Heard on 2nd harmonic of 2920) Yes. R. Ysela is now going by Radio Variedades slogan, noted on 2nd harmonic of 2920 kHz, 2/26 0329 w/CST TC, ad in dolares, for Mercado Juarez; 0403 slogan ID, nx from Informex. (Hauser)

1466 -MONACO Monte Carlo (TWR) at terrific strength w/religion in EE 2227 2/10, a good bet at logging another TA country in EE. This is indeed the stn in RR daily between 0345-0400. OC comes on about 0430 daily prior to s/on 0445, exalting the RR stn here, when condx are particularly favourable to East Europeans. (Taylor) * * TWR first time this year. Fair to poor signal. 0637 2/11. This used to be one of the best TA's a few years ago, but doesn't seem to be anymore. (Hagan) * * R. Monte Carlo (studios in Monaco), fantastic signal way above all other TAs, presumably punching 1200 kw now; first noted 2/25 0552, earlier than sked in II; 0559 mx, 0600 jingle, into rapid wakeup DJ; peaked around 0610 (SRS?) about 1 S unit below 1460/1470 jumble, but almost gone by 0620. (Hauser)

1470 -GUATEMALA (Heard on 2nd harmonic of 2940) TGRY R. Rosa, Chiquimulilla, again on 2nd harmonic 2940 kHz 2/16 0345 w/instrumental mx, 0355 ammt, 0400 s/off message, 0402 off. (Hauser)

-MEXICO XECAV Durango, Dgo. 2/18 0230 using these calls, ex XEND. (Gleason)

1475 -AUSTRIA Wien hrd here testing w/tone and OC following s/off 2208 2/10 pinning meter; OC exalted audio on the little SS beasties underneath. (Taylor)

-NICARAGUA (?) Weak LA stn here w/talk in SS by man. 0105 2/13. YNAG listed in WRTH good possibility. (Falconer)

1502 -POLAND Very nice at s/on 0500 1/14 w/dramatic piano IS, man/woman, martial mx. A good S-7 signal but not noted as well since, just 1 or 2 times since w/much weaker signal. (Foxworth)

1505 -ANGUILLA Generally poor and hard to copy on DX MM 2/18. First half hour was wiped out by TTer on 1510 w/5 kHz tone test; CJRS splash brutal. Later a 1500 stn was also testing w/5 kHz TT !! Best reception was at 0710 and 0722 and heard at times to past 0830. Audio was very shallow. Very little voice detail was copied. Had lots of mx, could not identify, some calypso type selections. Report out, as I did hear several mentions of R. Anguilla. Freq checked maybe 10 Hz low, given accuracy of my FMS-3 which I set to WWV at 0620. Accuracy \pm 5 Hz or so, hi. (Foxworth) * * 2/18 on NNRC DX, bits of audio, mx, from tune in 0645. Some reasonably decent ID's taped 0710, again 0800 recheck. Frankly, signal was not worth attempting to follow w/severe sideband splash from CJRS-1510. Sig strength was fair at times, but low audio provided only good copy when CJRS announcer inhaled. Luckily, have this verified from 12/9/69. (Sundstrom) * * First noted at 0638 very weak audio playing Pretty Blue Eyes, first ID audible at 0645, then played Games People Play. Better ID at 0650, better still at 0654 when given three times. WDEE-1500 testing made things rough. Best ID's given at 0658, again at 0703 and then played Those Were The Days, followed by ID at 0707 and into By The Time I Get To Phoenix. Two more ID's at 0709 and my ears had it. Very weak audio and bad fade on signal didn't aid situation, also a low het as well. (Truax) * * NNRC test a smashing success here, w/R. Anguilla doing very well against KSTP and WIAC tests; extended an hour to 0630-0930; many ID's, NNRC plugs, variety of mx. 2/18 0632 carrier first noted (absent a few minutes before); 0637, 0641 ID's; 0659 stronger w/narrative calypso song, 0701 ID "This is Radio Anguilla, broadcasting from The Valley", twice, TC for 3:02 (usually 30 seconds fast); 0722 giving power as 500w, 0724 address, 0731 too, 0735 ID, TC as 24:4 ... "That's local time" ... " ... for the benefit of our listeners in the USA and Canada ... NNRC ..." 0820, KSTP 5 kHz TT made a 4.5 Hz SAH w/Anguilla, so one is off freq, hi; more of the same following hour; after 0835 some static crashes intruded; 0917 still on, mentioned "Special DX Test"; 0920 giving phone as 48. 0929 three (?) chimes, ID and off. Never had any identifiable audio from them before! Tnx, NNRC! (Hauser) * * Sounds like Anguilla was widely heard, best in Oklahoma. Not tried here, as not needed and sleep was, hi. (ED)

1525 -CHINA PEOPLES'S REPUBLIC Urumchi noted again on 2/10 2305 at good level, although not outstanding by previous standards, doing usual propaganda bit w/woman in high-pitched CC accented RR! The RR is good, but it ain't downtown Moscow variety, hi. Missed the usual ID, IS at 2300. (Taylor)

1529 -VATICAN Nice signal 2/11 0630 w/organ interlude followed by male announcer in II, at excellent strength; a good bet in this time slot on a MM w/WCKY off! Better get 'em soon, though, before sunrise in Rome makes this one "out" for another season. Also noted on 2/3 w/an ET, playing their IS over and over for 45 minutes between 0615-0700. New xmtr? (Taylor) * * Weak signal 0632 2/11 not positively IDed. First time I have heard this one from here. (Hagan) Looks like this one is now signing on earlier. This should make them much easier outside NE US. (ED)

1538 -WEST GERMANY DLF Mainflingen in at 2209 check 2/10 w/GG hymn and religion; excellent level, easily listenable, het was only proof of such a thing as 1540. Not heard like this for a long time (March 70). (Taylor) * * Some audio 2/25 0552, 0608 recognizably GG. (Hauser) * * Fair 0658 2/11. (Hagan)

1546 -ENGLAND BBC Local Radio copied w/EE voice 0710-0718 and later w/mx, wx. Bad QRM from domestic on 1550 - again w/5 kHz audio TT causing strong signal to appear on 1545! Was also hrd briefly at 0720 1/7 during good run of TA conditions. (Foxworth)

1554 -FRANCE Nice most likely the unid FF in strong (louder than CBE/WQXR!) w/mx 0148-0200 2/25. First time this one heard at this time. (Rugg) * * Excellent 0224 2/11. (Hagan) * * Nice second best to 1466, 2/25 0552, and powerfully FF 0608. (Hauser)

-FRANCE/USSR ORTF Nice playing accordion mx at 2210 check on 2/10; RR speaking by woman underneath, both stations could be readily understood. Louder than CBE-1550. (Taylor)

1562 -SWITZERLAND Beromunster w/light instrumental mx 2211 2/10 better than WQXR by 10 db. This has been an outstanding signal this season, in spite of pitiful condx for TA, both at SSS and late evenings, around 0500-0530. (Taylor) Excellent 0222 2/11 in GG w/typically Swiss mx. First time heard for me. Got good tape of this one. (Hagan)

1570 -SPAIN ECS12, R. Atalaya, Voz de Cordoba heard w/"Universidad para todo" to close at 2340 2/22. Location Cabra, new here. (Trower)

-UNID GG Re my report of unid GG stn here on 11/25/73, Rolf Bloedorn listened to my tape and still couldn't ID. Says its unlikely its DDR. Letters of inquiry out to several other stns. (ED)

1578 -UNID Had what seemed to be 2 audios, one w/mx and atop, likely Porto, and a woman speaking behind them likely Italy or Norway. Third stn had period of TT here, at 0610 1/7. Have on tape, but unable to ID language of speaker. (Foxworth)

1586 -WEST GERMANY Confirming Hauser's remarks, this station (and to a much lesser extent, Nice-1554) are totally anomalous as far as TA cx go. WDR is heard w/readable audio here on nights when nothing else from Europe is coming through, and when condx are good, I can get clear, listenable copy from WDR on unaided, unamplified table radio in bedroom. (Foxworth) * * Langenburg excellent 0615 2/11. Best in many weeks. Was in almost like a local. Mx program. (Hagan) * * Rather weaker than FF stns, 2/25 0552. (Hauser)

1594 -UNIDS SAH jumble peaking 2/25 0609; nothing ever surfaced. (Hauser)

1602 -WEST GERMANY Nurnberg excellent here on 2/10 at 2330, when caught ID by male announcer, followed by up-tempo instrumentals, common of so many GG stations. (Taylor) * * Munich good to excellent 0610 2/11 w/mx. This one not usually heard very well. Got good tape on it. (Hagan)

 close now, MM, @ 10am. 73.


DCN EGGERT - 2001 Reckcreek Drive - #15 D - Bowling Green, Kentucky - 52101


