## Changes in programming status; reported by listeners

Boston Radio...as noted on a recent trip to Beantown, WADN-1120 is still broadcasting its outstanding folk music format. I did hear an epic blooper on the part of the Saturday PM announcer who, after a cluster of folk songs, intoned " I am speaking, and you are listening to Walden Radio. MADN - 1120, Concord. You are fortunate to be listening." (Usually, it is "Thank you for joining us!") It prompted a laugh from a rather unlikely source. And on 740 is "Earth Radio". On Saturday, WWEA runs a "Vintage Rock and Reil Party" until 2:00am, and after sunset, WWEA does run on very low power. At sunset, the announcer airs a long message to the effect that listeners in the outer suburbs will lose the signal, but people in Boston and the inner towns and cities will continue to hear the signal (which does come into Everett). WWEA ID's for Cambridge - Boston, and not for Needham, a suburb about 12 miles southwest of Boston Common.

Also in Boston, WRCA - 1330 is still "Showbiz Radio", carrying show music and features...was reported to go to brokered ethnic programs. And WBIV-1960 is still serving up its Spanish format to thousands of fascinated listeners in Concord, Wellesley, Wayland, Weston, and little of its very directional signal gets into Boston and Chelsea, where most of the Hispanics reside. And what little gets into Boston is clobbered by WBZ on most radios.

Ed Janusz writes from Brick township, NJ, that the area has lost its two country music stations. WTTM-920, Trenton has dropped CWM for News and Information, and, according to a news clip sent by Al Holtz, BRN Business Naws. And WOBM-1160, Lakewood, now airs Music of Your Life, a format also heard on WMID, WBUD, WNEW, WPEN, and many other audible stations here. However, CWM is heard only on 250 watt WKMB-1070, 60 miles away in Stirling, and WYNY-103.5, both of which are catches of DX quality. The WOBM switch gives the station all of the emotional impact of seeing Jerry Vale asleep in the back of a borrowed pickup truck, according to Ed.

Another oddity... The M Street Journal notes in its 12/02 issue that KYNG-1300, Fresno has gone to an all Christmas music format, as has WODZ-680, Memphis, whose format is "Christmas, trucker" which is an interesting combination. On 12/24, in the PM (and all day on 12/25), most AM and FM stations emulated this format, but only temporarily. I wonder when those two stations will change formats again....there is something to be said about listening to "Frosty the Snowman" or "Silent Night" on Labor Day Weekend ....

# Target DX

DX'ing 'smart', with shared tips and requests by NRC members

So you've been DXing for a year or two now, and you've logged some 400 stations, and perhaps you've even veried half of them. As you randomly scan across the dial, you realize that its getting more difficult to catch new loggings. Welcome to Target DX (TDX), the column that tries to answer the question, "Where do I go from here?"

### TARGET LISTS

As former TDX editor Jim Renfrew used to say, its important that you do your homework. The whole idea behind target DXing is to develop a game plan -- to focus your energy. This requires some research. The best sources of information are back issues of DX News and the IRCA's DX Monitor. The NRC AM Radio Log and the World Radio and TV Handbook are also invaluable. Once you've gathered all your sources of info, its time to think

about some general goals. Perhaps you live on the east coast and want to hear Arizona, or you live in the west and want to hear Delaware. Or do you want to concentrate on international DXing? My goal for the season is to work on loggings and veries from Latin America.

I started to develop a preliminary Latin American target list by reviewing back issues of DX News. I looked for loggings that were listed in IDXD by DXers from the Northeastern US and Canada. Using the WRTH as a cross-reference, I selected those which I believed would be fairly easy to log. (Don't make your first target list too difficult -- as you gain experience, the difficulty factor can increase. Start easy, so you don't become disappointed and lose interest).
