DX Time Machine

From the pages of *DX News*:

50 years ago ... from the December 15, 1945 DXN: Clarence Burnham, Gloucester, MA; Al Bartholomew, Corning, NY; Al Maley, Highland Falls, NY; and Stan Morss, Bradford, MA, reported excellent TA reception during the first week of December ... Editor Ray Edge suggested that members experiencing slow mail delivery avail themselves of First Class mailing of *DX News* for 75¢ per year extra.

25 years ago ... from the Nov. 12, 1970 DXN: Appearing in this issue was Gordon Nelson's article, "Loop Distortion - Why Get Skewed?"

10 years ago ... from the December 9, 1985 DXN: Bob Hoffman, Ocean City, NJ was selling a Martens loop for \$85 as "new, unused, the last Martens loop imported by Paul Swearingen".

HCJB test info, from Rich McVicar ... HCJB is airing MONTHLY DX tests on 690 kHz for the next year. Each test will be 15 minutes in length and will include plenty of Morse Code and other unique items. All tests have to be aired sometime between 0504 UTC and 0820 UTC, when there is no regular programming going out on 690 kHz.

I've tried to time the tests so that each one corresponds with a sunrise or sunset either in Europe, the South Pacific, Japan, or eastern Canada. In most cases, I just let the terminator take its natural seasonal course and left the time alone. The tests will take place UTC Sunday in order to give DXers a chance to set up a longwire on Saturday.

Correct reports for these tests are verified with a special 690 kHz QSL card. In order that your QSL will be truly valuable, I'm being really fussy and unreasonable about details. If you hear code, you need to report exactly when you heard it and what characters you heard. Tape recordings are welcome but tapes can not be returned.

1485 ENGLAND BBC R. Humberside, NOV 23 2007-2011 - Discussion of local issues, people introduced from that part of the UK, one "BBC Humberside" ID noted; the QRM was mainly another BBC station with a jazz program; SIO 322 [Burnell-NF]

1485 UNID, NOV 23 2035 - Very briefly and weakly with considerable QRM: seemed like really hideous heavy metal music -- NRK on 1314 was playing garbage by Napalm Death at the time, but the 1485 signal was too fractured to establish a // [Burnell-NF]

1503 ENGLAND BBC R. Stoke on Trent, NOV 23 1918-1931 - Clas music program, publicity for local concert events, ID as "BBC Radio Stoke"; QRM from an UNID station in AA and rock music from likely Poland; SIO 322. [Burnell-NF]

1512 BELGIUM, RVI/Belgische Radio, Wolvtertem, NOV 23 2320-2330 -Flemish or GG talk, then pop female vocal; in tough slop from WNRB-1510 (50 kW at 9 miles / 15 km). [Connelly-MA]

1521 SAUDI ARABIA, Duba, NOV 23 2315 - AA chanting, dominant. [Jeziorski-FL] NOV 25 0338 - stern-sounding AA talk by man (probably preaching). [Connelly*H-MA] NOV 26 0431 - AA song equal to KB slop. [Braun-DE] No date 2226 - Strong het yields stringed instrumental music, then five pips into talk by man at 2230. Couldn't make out the language due to WWKB slop. Could this have been Saudi Arabia? [Reed-MA] (One of the furthest TAs normally heard, and one of the easiest, except near Buffalo! - Jim)

1530t ENGLAND BBC R. Essex, Southend, NOV 23 1931 - Jingle and hype for "Jukebox", short clips of 4 oldies, then DJ asked listeners to phone 03(or 2)45-445512 to vote for one of them; faded away shortly afterwards; SIO 322. I can't find what the British 0345 city code is, but 0245 corresponds to R. Essex. The other two British stations on 1530 would have telephone numbers that do not match at all. [Burnell-NF]

1530 ICELAND Navy Broadcasting Svc., Keflavik, NOV 23, 2018-2031 - US- accented announcers with many PSA's, some for military programs, C&W music program; mix of stations here with Vaticana and this dominant; SIO 322 [Burnell-NF]

1530 VATICAN, Vatican R., NOV 23 2328 - classical music over/under WSAI. [Connelly-MA] NOV 24 0030 - Tchaikovsky's "Sleeping Beauty Waltz"; atop WSAI and a low growl presumably from Latin American stations. [Connelly*H-MA]

1620 NETHERLANDS, Scheveningen, NOV 18 2200 - Fair signals with Morse Code identifier of the Aero/Marine Beacon. [DX-MB] (Shawn reports this one on 1619.7 kHz - Jim) NOV 23 0554 - "PCH" in Morse code; strong, trashing co- channel Connecticut Department of Transportation TIS station. [Connelly-MA]

Dave T Astifies: "I find it amazing how different DX is at this new QTH, only seven miles from the old one. While Latin American DX is superb here, I'm hearing NOTHING from across the pond except a powerful Norway on 1314 most nights, and the occasional audio from the Saudi on 1521. Otherwise, zip. I'm happy to get just a carrier on 684, whereas last winter I heard Spain there virtually daily. What causes such differences in reception patterns?"


Mark T Astifies: "I did quite a bit of DXing from Cape Cod during family visits this weekend (US Thanksgiving). Unfortunately, being sociable shut out activities around the especially-productive sunset period. After all, this was not a DXpedition. Many Euro's in, Africa and Latin America so-so (did get Brazil on 860 and 1040). You inland guys take note that Norway 1314 is hanging in to an absurdly late time. I checked at 0800 UTC and it was still there! I suspect that by Christmas / Winter Solstice, it will be audible at 1000 UTC. That's the latest I ever heard a TA in the Boston area (UK on 1214 heard in 1966)."

Bruce T Astifies: "This is my first-ever audio on a TA frequency in over 15 years of DXing from Oklahoma. I know Norway-1314 is almost a "pest" in ECNA but this logging is a real highlight for me. TAs in the central US are certainly a rarity but I'll keep at it, hoping for a solid ID. Carriers noted on the following TA frequencies from 0501-0530 NOV 26 as well: 1332, 1305, 1296, 1278, 1269, 1251, 1215 with snatches of vocal mx noted at 0506, 1188, 1134, 1125, 1107, 1098, 1071, 1062, 1053, and 1017.

- 1431 unID, NOV 24 0557 - het, bits of talk in slop. Probably too late for Ukraine, so Portugal is more likely. This is a tough channel because of 4 strong stations (MA/NJ/NY/ON) on 1430. [Connelly-MA]

- 1467 FRANCE, TWR Roumoules, NOV 23 2318 - good with British-accented preacher reading from Luke "This day you will be with me in paradise." [Connelly-MA] NOV 25 2312 - Presumed with religious talk in EE, instrumental "How Great Thou Art" at 2319, gone at 2320. NOV 26 2327 - Fair with address for "Hour of Decision": Box 506, London. [Jeziorski-FL]
- 1476 UNID - NOV 27 0216 & 0250 - Orchestra with classical music. Lviv, Ukraine a possibility as other Ukrainians were coming in while very little from Spain which is another possibility here. [Dangerfield-PA]
