- We welcome J.D. Stephens of Madison, Alabama to the NRC and DDXD-West family.
- Jonathan Helis, KB5IAV of Baton Rouge, Louisiana, USA reports: "Yesterday, I received a telephone call from Brian Wolshon, PH.D, PE, of Louisiana State University Department of Civil and Environmental Engineering in response to a reception report I sent to the LA Department of Transportation and Development Highway Advisory Radio Project. In both this call and a letter I received the same day, I was told that LA DOTD's HAR transmitters run at 10 watts, and there are 4 in the Baton Rouge area, on 670, 790, 820, and 1610 khz. He also informed me that LSU is helping develop an HAR system for the DOTD. Dr. Wolshon also mentioned that these frequencies may be changed because some suffer heavy interference in the evenings. I know from experience 820 suffers heavy QRM in the evenings from WBAP in Dallas, TX. If you want more information, or at least for now, to send a reception report, your best bet would be to Brian Wolshon, PH.D, P.E., Dept. Civil and Mechanical Engineering, Louisiana State University, Baton Rouge, LA 70803-6405. Patrick Griffith of Federal Heights, Colorado brings up the subject of which station has the most towers, and cites KOOO-1190 Dallas and WLQV-1500 Detroit each with 12. I think this would be an excellent discussion in Musings.
- Some Graveyard records are in from John Wilkins, Andy Rugg, and Morris Sorensen from some far-reaching locations. And one remains unaccounted for, as I have to locate Misery Box, Manitoulin Island, Ontario, Morris.

Much trouble with slop from local KLZ-560. Ex: News/talk format. (JW-CO) [Whoa, there. I spent the weekend of 1/31-2/1 in the San Antonio area and listened to KTSA quite extensively. Heard nothing but EE-language talk and news programming. Had San Antonio member Jim Boehm call them 2/2 and they stated "no foreign-language programs" from KTSA. Don't know what you heard, but it certainly wasn't KTSA - Ed.]

- 820 WYPA IL Chicago - New address is: 218 S. Wabash Chicago, IL 60604 and phone is: 312-922-6025. (BF-IL)
- 850 (KOA) CO Denver - 1/19 0845 - Totally off for 45 minutes (0845-0930); reason unknown. Bagged two new ones (KFUO and XEZF) as a result. (JW-CO)
- 930 WAUR IL Sandwich - 1/31 - Noted on RS at 1050 with SS, then came back at :59 with ID of WAUR Sandwich-Chicago only. Then back to pop-rock music. R. Aahs is history. Amen. (KO-IL)
- WAUR IL Sandwich - According to the Chicago Sun-Times [bet it was the Early Edition, hi -Ed.], the proposed sale of the 14 stations owned by the Childrens Broadcasting Corp. to Global Broadcasting Co. has collapsed. On 1/31 WAUR stopped broadcasting the Radio Aahs format. Since 2/2, I am hearing WAUR playing continuous rock music, with IDs on the hour as AM 930 WAUR Sandwich. Some ads and PSAs have also been heard. (CR-IL)
- 1360 KTOF IA Cedar Rapids - Is now // KWOE-850 with contemporary Christian music format. IDs as 850 and 1360, the Friendship Connection and Christian Hit Radio. (RD-IA)
- WCKY OH Cincinnati - 1/29 0640 - Now all-sports with Sports Fan Network programming. 0700 ID as WCK . . . Y Cincinnati, yet another sports station (guy in background shouting Because you can't hear the other two). All Sports 1360, then World of Racing program. Ex: WAZU. (LB-MO)
- KAHZ TX Fort Worth - 1/31 0600 - Heard with 70s "Classic" hits format throughout morning hours (all I could listen to, hi), then 2/1 1830 with gospel preaching, but at 1900 went to Adult Standards stuff (Frank, Barbra, etc). Called station. They said that "until the owner decides what to do, they are just pumping music down from the satellite" Have heard since with 1 hour sweeps of Beatles cuts, plus other uninterrupted periods of tunes. Sale of the network has been squashed, so who knows what evil lurks . . . ? [Ed.-TX]
- 1620 WPHG AL Atmore - 1/31 2142 - Testing, with REL music. Alone, with good signal. New. (JJR-WI)
- WPHG AL Atmore - 1/31 and on - Is a dusk-to-dawn regular here with a fairly good signal. REL/GOS programming. 2/3 0700 announcer was saying that just a couple of weeks ago their signal barely got of the county, but now they've heard from listeners "around the world". Gave map location of where Atmore is in southwest Alabama, "just north of the beautiful white sand beaches of Pensacola, Florida". Gave 1-800-495-9495 and local number to call. At 0648 on 2/4 heard them with what I thought was a newscast behind the same announcer (as if someone forgot to pot down a network/tape/whatever), then went away. But see Pete Taylor's 1620 unID logging. [Ed.-TX]
- WPHG AL Atmore - 2/1 2215-2250+ - Now on the air with regular programming of gospel music. Heard this evening with frequent IDs giving call sign, city, state, and slogan "We Proclaim His Glory". Lengthy station info announcement by President John Mathis giving lots of technical information, said they were 10,000 kilowatts nondirectional day and 1,000 kilowatts nondirectional at night. Announced E-mail address, web page of www.wphg.com (I tried it and it didn't work), as well as a local phone # and 1-800-495-9495. Also mentioned that WPHG-FM 90.9 would be on the air soon. Postal address announced as 805 North Main Street, Atmore, AL 36502, U.S.A. Several DXers have reported calling the station

and talking to someone who said they will be issuing a special *first day of operation* QSL letter. Although no one seemed to get a contact name, a good one to try would be Mr. Mathis, as he signed by QSL letter for sister station WGYJ-1590 (also in Atmore) a year or two ago. (JS-AL)

- WPHG AL Atmore - 2/1 0621 - Giving call letters and phone number as 1-800-495-9495. S-9 signal. (GJ-CA)
- WPHG AL Atmore - 2/1 2330 - Fair signal, with gospel and religious music. Man doing ID with southern accent. Mention of a future FM station. New. (SA-MB)
- WPHGt AL Atmore - 2/2 0100- Weak, with deep fades, with religious programing. Suspect this is who it is. (FA-ID)
- WPHG AL Atmore - 2/2 0800 - Heard here in the Denver area with a very solid signal with USA Radio news. (PG-CO)
- WPHG AL Atmore - 2/3 2019 - Thanks to e-mail tip from Patrick Martin. Found them testing with their 10 kW day power, which accounts for the HUGE signal here. Gospel music, devotional messages, as well as a 4-minute-long spiel by "Brother John Mathis," President of station operator Maranatha Ministries asking for donations ("love gifts") to support their ministry. But they also WANT RECEPTION REPORTS, whether by e-mail (johnyk@net1inc.com), fax (334-368-2713), phone (1-800-495-9495), or mail (805 N. Main St., Atmore AL 36502). Things are getting crowded in the X-band... (RS-MO)
- WPHG AL Atmore - Noted at weak and then fair levels 2/3 0059 and 2/4 0100. Called station and they moved here from 1590 at 5 AM CST 2/1 and have had calls from Ontario and Oregon. (PT-WA)
- WPHG AL Atmore - 2/4 0100 - Point of View REL program followed by AM 1620 WPHG, Atmore, Alabama, then into USA News. Excellent signal, sounded like a semi-local with very little fading. (SB-IL)
- 1640 WDIA CA Vallejo - 2/3 - KXBT appears to have changed call signs. They are in here tonight with a great signal IDing as 1640 DIA.. The FCC database confirms this call. (PG-CO) (KDIA? -pls)
- DIA. CA Vallejo - 2/4 0630 - Fair signal, with new call sign being used. Same old/soul music heard. NEW!! (SA-MB)
- 1660 WJDM NJ Elizabeth - Has gone to a '70s automated oldies format with no IDs after sitting through seven songs. Good way to build ratings, hi! This after Radio Aahs demise. (JJR-WI)
- 1660 WC2XZZ OH Cincinnati - This appears to be an experimental license, daytime only, with 10 kw. FCC database states it is for *Experimental Digital AM Broadcast Operation*. While it is licensed to Cincinnati, the coordinates appear to put the transmitter site just northeast of the suburb of Springdale. (PG-CO)

UNIDs and UNID HELP

- 730 UNID ?? -1/26 0255 - Running *The Lone Ranger* and old radio programs. Signal poor-to-fair at times, mixing with CKLG and KLVB. Faded at the station ID (naturally), but did hear... with 50,000 watts day and 25,000 watts night, went into *CN News*, then *Imagination Theater*. Checked the station list for *Imagination Theater*; nothing listed for 730. Nothing in the 18th edition of *AM Radio Log* matched either. Any ideas? (PR-OR)
- 1270 WWCA IN Gary - The LB-MO 12/18 0718 log of this in DX News No.13 mentioned hearing *Quad Cities WWCA*. The mention of *Quad Cities* points to WKBF Rock Island, IL which operates also on 1270 kHz. Rock Island is one of the Quad Cities. As far as WWCA is concerned, they have been silent for a while now, but I have seen reports recently that they came back on the air for brief periods of time, in order not to lose their licence. I have been trying for to confirm, but all I can hear is WKBF. (CR-IL)
- 1420 UNID MO - 2/4 0657 - Either KREL or KBTN, very poor, with mentions of St. Louis and what sounded like Macon County. Neither California nor Neosho is in or near St. Louis or Macon County, Missouri, but they may have been giving news. At 0600 *Your Information Leader*, K____, _____ Missouri and into a network's news. At 0602 the Mexican National Anthem from (probably) XEH loud and clear took over (oompa, oompa, oompa!). Either would be nice. [Ed.-TX]

- 1620 WPKX713 IL Chicago - BF-IL's log of the Chicago White Sox in Issue No. 14 mentions calls as KP414. The calls for this station are WPKX713, and the station is operated by the Illinois Sports Facility Authority, the authority that operates Chicago White Sox's Comiskey Park. (CR-IL)
- UNID ?? - Three hours after hearing WPHG at 0100 on 2/4, the channel was topped with a deep-fading SS station. Seemed to be preaching, with a Mahalia Jackson-like song at 0415. It looped east and was stronger than WJDM. A weak EE station was heard underneath. (PT-WA)
- 1630 WPGE863 IL - JR-MO's unID on 12/9 0735 in issue No. 13 is one of the METRA's WPGE863 stations. They do mention *morning rush hour* in their announcements. It is also GJ-CA's unID on 1/16 0600 from issue #16. (CR-IL)
- 1630 TIS MI - Reference the 1630 kHz logging in the your Feb 2 column's TIS section, Michigan Department of Transportation is putting in "Highway Advisory Radio" sites all over SE Michigan, as part of their intelligent transportation system project. There are SEVERAL of these stations on the air right now, including more than one that are using the WPJR342 call sign. They're not all repeating the same message, though. I can hear a jumble of 2 or 3 from my home, in downtown Detroit. The one that always comes in full-scale has finally started to give its location in the little tape loop! It is on I-96, near the Intersection of I-94 in Detroit. As I said, they're going to phase in many of these things -- I've driven by many that aren't on the air yet. The one in Auburn Hills that I homed in on is at the intersection of I-75 & I-96. Auburn Hills is about 25 miles NNE of Detroit. The Michigan DOT Intelligent Highway Control Center, where the HARs are controlled from, is about 1000' from my home. I'll try calling them or stopping by sometime to see if they can provide a list of the site locations, and if they'd QSL. (TT-MI)

- 670 WVNS+ VA Claremont - 2/1 0002 - Poor, in WMAQ null, but faded up to fair within seven minutes. Tuned in at 0002 on 2-1. Mentions of towers & where to send reports in between news format & weather on the 9's. New! (JJR-WI)
- WVNS+ VA Claremont - 2/1 0024 and 0117 - Good, under WMAQ at both of these times, with code IDs. Also heard a possible code ID at 0053. Good thing that the code came through loud and clear, cuz that's all I could hear during the two hours. Like many others probably did, I had tried for this the night before, but I learned of the correct date through E-mail from IRCA's Tim Noonan. (RD-IA)
- WVNS? VA Claremont - 1/30-31 - Not heard from 2305-0005, but did hear weak TTs in background of WMAQ weather cast at 2336. My QTH is approximately 29 miles south of WMAQ transmitter, so can barely get a weak signal from them. Otherwise, nothing in background heard during test time. (KO-IL)
- WVNS- VA Claremont - 2/1 0000-0200 - Nothing heard on DX Test under KBOI (nulled as best as possible). Did not expect to, either! (FA-ID) - 1/31 0000 and 02/01 0000 - Not heard either date only WMAQ, KBOI and unID Spanish station. (SA-MB) - 1/31 0000 - Not heard on scheduled DX test. Was able to null local KLTT, but heard only WMAQ. (JW-CO)

- 660 KCRO NE Omaha - 1/26 0714 - Good signal, with KTNN nulled, with 660 kHz begins its broadcasting day and as you make us a part of your day may God richly bless you. Then short REL song by group of women. Weather for east, northeast and southwest Iowa. *Stories of Great Christians* from The Moody Bible Institute of Chicago. (LB-MO)

- 690 WOKV FL Jacksonville - 1/23 0647 - Fair, on top of CB(?) in FF, with ID: *News talk 690 WOKV*, then weather with a *high of 70 degrees*. *Right now 60 at the beach*. *News talk 690 WOKV News*, then news and ad for *Shoney's*, TC, promo for CBS News, traffic report. CBS News at 0700. (LB-MO)
- 740 CBL ON Toronto - 1/19 0002 - CBC News, Toronto weather at 0004. At 0005 ID: *You're listening to CBC Radio One, 740 in Toronto*, then into program of classical music. Best ever here, dominating with loop E-W. (JW-CO)
- 790 WSGW MI Saginaw - 1/23 0720 - Weak signal, in and out. Over WWKY and others, with weather, ID as WSGW 790 24 hour news, and *Charles Osgood coming up*. (LB-MO)
- 860 WSON KY Henderson - 1/24 0715 - Weak signal, fading in and out, with NOS. Under FF (CJBC?). 0735 promo for Superbowl broadcast at 4:45 on *Sunday Brought to you by the All-Sports Club right here on WSON*. ??Stereo 86 WSON, *Henderson's radio station serving you for over 59 years*. (LB-MO)
- 880 KJOJ TX Conroe - 2/2 0755 - Preaching and call ID. Last heard briefly in Jan, 1996. (JR-OK)
- 900 WWLK KY Eddyville - 2/2 0749 - Church calender, REL music, call ID. New here. (JR-OK)
- 940 WMWR GA Macon - 1/27 0730 - Great signal, with news headlines and *Talk Radio 940* slogan. Weather, ID, news. (LB-MO)
- 1060 KGFX SD Pierre - 1/29 0659 - In QRM, with legal ID, ABC News. (JW-CO)
- 1190 KMYL AZ Tolleson - 1/29 0100-0130+ - Very surprised to hear this one, in semi-decent null of WOWO, with adult standards/music of your life programming. Low-key female announcer (satellite?) with announcements about songs and artists every 3rd song or so. Two IDs/slogans heard, both mentioning *The Music of Your Life - AM 1190 and 105.3 FM KMYL*. Peaked very well at times; almost equal to WOWO. Suspect still on day power/pattern. (JS-AL)
- 1210 WDAO OH Dayton - 1/5 0730 - Good, at possible sign-on, with 1210 WDAO ID, then straight into a black gospel broadcast. (RD-IA)
- 1240 KBIZ IA Ottumwa - 2/1 0300 - Poor, in mess, with KBIZ-KTWA (FM) ID into news. Unneeded. (JJR-WI)
- 1260 KTTS MO Springfield - 2/3 0717 - DJ chit-chat and local ads, then *The Ozarks' most dependable weather forecasts are on KTTS* into C&W. [Ed.-TX]
- 1270 KGNM MO St. Joseph - 2/2 0731 - Call ID and *Christian Radio*, then lost in QRM. New here. (JR-OK)
- 1660 WJDM NJ Elizabeth - 2/3 0720+ - Music // KAHZ-1360 off the satellite. First time heard here due to 1640/1680 splatter. Was even on DFW Airport when heard, too! [Ed.-TX]

0800 TO 1600 HOURS ELT

- 750 KOAL UT Price - 1/27 0819 - Farm prices, local news and sports with call ID. Good signal. (JR-OK)
- 800 CHAB SK Moose Jaw - (no date) 0823 - Lee Ann Rimes song, *Country 800* slogans, weather (-24 degrees), report on Punxsutawney Phil's activity and mentioned that they were waiting for Canada's version of Phil, Weirton (ON) Willie. (JW-CO)
- 850 WAIT IL Crystal Lake - 1/16 0815 - Fair, under KOA, with sign-on: *WAIT Crystal Lake-Chicago begins another ...* (RD-IA)

Your chance to log Argentina on 1620 is now much harder with WPHG-1620, Atmore AL on the air with religious programs during the first week of February. I never did hear anything that sounded like Argentina, as that Shenandoah TIS has been dominating the frequency.

TRANS-ATLANTIC DX

Mark speaks: "(On JAN 31) Northern Africans and Spaniards were strong; little was noted from northern Europe (UK, Norway, Germany, etc.) Burkina Faso-747 was quite good just after local sunset, Senegal-765 was like a local, numerous Moroccans and Algerians were very good, Mauritania-1349 was huge, bits of Angola-1088 made it in (stronger than anything on 1089), and I had likely Gambia on 648. There was also something Arabic-sounding (Libya or Saudi ?) blending in on 648. High-band stations (France-1467, Italy-1332, Saudi Arabia-1521, Algeria-1544) blasted in early (before 2300 UTC) but then became less numerous."

Ben speaks: "Morocco-171 does use both FF and AA at different times though the music played is usually Moroccan I can certainly tell the difference and I am sure of my log. Algeria-252 also has a lot of FF programs." (referring to my comment last week! - Jim)

- 640 CUBA R Reloj, Guanabacoa, Habana, FEB 5 0950-0954 - the Progreso outlet plugged into Reloj overnight this morning. Progreso programming at recheck 1030 (most Cubans that are not 24h have been signing on at 6 a.m. local, while those relaying Reloj overnight generally do so from either 12 or 1 a.m. local till 6 a.m.). Excellent. [Krueger-FL]
- 690 CUBA R. Progreso, FEB 1 0609 - noted in passing with male vocal // 640, weak under CBF. [Renfrew-NY]
- 780 MEXICO XESFT La Bronca Norteña, San Fernando, Tamaulipas FEB 5 1211-1218- over Chicago with norñaes, SP M ID. [Krueger-FL]
- 850 MEXICO XEM Chihuahua CHIH, JAN 19 1408 - Chihuahua ads, kids talking, roosters crowing, time checks, sounded like MST, which wouldn't be right, 10 degrees Centigrade temperature, milk PSA. Dominant with local KOA off for 45 minutes. [Wilkins-CO]
- 850 MEXICO XEZF Mexicali, JAN 19 1357 - Mexican NA, s/on by male announcer: "Está Ud. escuchando XEZF, sonido Banda, transmitiendo en 850 de su radio con mil wats de potencia efectivo en antena, en Pasaje Vallarta 1128-B en el Centro Cívico, Mexicali ...", then into gross tuba music, popular in western Mexico. A new one, thanks to local KOA being off for 45 minutes. XE #143, BCN #17. [Wilkins-CO]
- 1070 MEXICO XEOBS Cd. Obregón SON, JAN 24 0159 - Canned ID, largely unreadable, but call sign picked out, as well as "Radio Mexicana" slogans in KFI null. QRM from oldies station, presumably CHOK. [Wilkins-CO]
- 1130 MEXICO XEETCH Etchojoa SON, JAN 21 1334 - rustic fiddle music, call ID (still definitely sounds like 6 letters), then more indigenous tunes. Fair/poor in QRM. [Wilkins-CO]
- 1270 CUBA R Caribe, Nueva Gerona, Isla Juventud, FEB 5 1120-1150 and again 1829-2005 - big, overmod signal with screechy SS woman dj, mostly Cuban vocals, but one capitalist tune ("Say You, Say Me" Lionel Ritchie), carted male ID but too distorted to ID. Slowly overtaken by WRLZ, Eatonville, FL (Spanish format) co-channel. Recheck 1829, SS man, then vocal Cuban NA (recorded, though) into live baseball coverage. Pretty much overtaken again by WRLZ after 3 p.m. local. Note that Jay Novello heard R Caribe here a few weeks ago, while on a cruise. Suspect the culprit. [Krueger-FL] FEB 5 2243+ - yup, it's them. Signal back and strong and with the same overdriven mod of early this morning. Woman with "... la emisora de Juventud, Radio Caribe". Thanks to Novello's sleuthing. Need to check on the status of 1310 next (unheard on brief check with this log). [Krueger-FL] Regarding my R Caribe log, David Crawford adds more insight, probably worthy of tacking on for the complete story: "Actually been there a while, looked back through log and found an entry for 9/1/95 with Caribe here, logged on the Phillips 3405 microportable of all things. I vaguely remember being surprised to hear them there, were still listed on 1310 then. 1270 used to be Reloj, where I first heard them actually, think Nueva Gerona also, so guess they moved here when Reloj pulled plug on the freq. Caribe used to have a real [strong] signal when it was on 1040 way back when, an old favorite. When I heard them in 1995 they were

still running the same ID carts (with the brass bump music) as they did back in the 70's." [David Crawford-FL, in FEB 5 e-mail to Krueger-FL]

1290 CUBA R Taino, FEB 4 1740+ - note that the EE news segment remains here at approximately 12:50 p.m. Cuban time. From 1749-1754, EE news read by Langston Wright. The next EE segment was a reverbing woman at 1901, an entertainment segment on Madonna's baby, Michael Jackson's Polish theme park plans and a greetings to Prime Minister Tony Blair. Also ran a recorded promo for "R Taino Varadero" (referenced a couple of times) on FM, and I think a time, but I missed the details. Wonder if it's a program, FM breakaway segment or somesuch. [Krueger-FL]

Mark speaks: "During DXing from Cape Cod on Saturday 31 JAN, I noted a couple of off-channel stations. Both were Latin Americans. One was on 870.38 kHz and the other was on 941 kHz. Audio extracted from the 870.38 station seemed to have advertising in Spanish (so probably not a non-commercial Cuban)."

STATION NEWS

GERMANY: The schedule for SS programs on ARD, for Spanish immigrants in Germany daily 2100-2140 Central European Time. The principal frequencies (50 kW or more): 576 kHz SDR Stuttgart, 594 kHz HR Frankfurt, 801 kHz BR Munich, 936 kHz RB Bremen, 972 kHz NDR Hamburg, and with 5-20 kW on 567, 702, 711, 792 and 828 kHz. SPAIN: Radio Espana 954 Khz heard Sunday, JAN 18 between 0003 and 0006 with a program in English ... a collaboration between Radio Espana and the Voice of America. We have carefully monitored this station and we could hear news in English only on Sundays at 00:02, 01:02 and 02:02. These are two minutes English spots. ID aired in Spanish and English giving details on a shared agreement between Radio España and VOA. We phoned them to have further information and they couldn't confirm even the mere existence of that programmes!!! [Ignacio Sotomayor y Juan Antonio Arranz in *MediDX* e-mail]

FAT DX TUESDAY

Several stations all over the world use extended schedules for their Carnival Feasts (Fat Tuesday, Shrove Tuesday, the day before Ash Wednesday - Jim). In Brasil remember all those "Radio Marathon" easily IDed by "Salsa and Carnival music". Spain has extended schedules on 24th February and days before and after. Check stations in Spanish Towns like: Cádiz and Tenerife and also: Badajoz, Ciudad Real, Orense, San Sebastián, Sitges and Zaragoza. They will have local programmes all night long allowing to listen to them with local IDs, not mere synchronos. [*MediDX* e-mail]

MEXICANS MYSTIFY MIKA MAKELAINEN

During a recent DXpedition I logged quite a few interesting Mexicans, but unfortunately some remained unidentified. I would highly appreciate any help concerning the following mysteries:

780 AM - Nov. 29th 1997 at 1217-1227 UTC I heard a station with local Christian programming. A male host praising the Lord and playing Christian Mexican music. Several time checks placing it on the Central time zone, but no ID. This would be very interesting, as no Mexicans have ever been heard in Europe on this frequency. (XEFTT, San Fernando, has been a regular in Topeka -pls.)

1270 AM - Nov. 25th 1997 at 0803 UTC. I only got part of the slogan "... música, onda música ...", which doesn't fit to any station. Gave a Mexican PSA, so must be from Mexico anyway.

1470 AM - Nov. 29th at 1300 UTC. A brief time announcement "Las 6 en punto" followed by the National Anthem. I guess XEACE Mazatlan SN is the only possibility because I wasn't able to find other stations located in the Mountain time zone? Provided that XECU had already moved to 1450 by late November? Southeastern part of Mexico is anyhow excluded, because it was in daylight.

1590 AM - Nov. 25th at 0914-0924 UTC. A station identifying as "Clube 1590 La Ranchera", with the emphasis on "Ranchera" strangely on the last a. This could also be a Mexican-format station from the U.S., but still remains unresolved.
