From the publisher ... Several columns seem to be lost in cyberspace, or perhaps the U. S. mail this time. Hence, only 20 pages. Better luck next issue? Dave Schmidt is in the process of moving to take a different job, so until he gets settled in, please send your Musings to the publisher in Topeka.

We received a bagged DXN, #23, with the bottom third (including all of the address) torn off, leaving only the bar code and the due date of 11-15-98. The yellow sticker read, "Damaged in handling in the postal service" and "Returned for Better Address". Indeed. And why some postal weenie would decide NOT to indicate the city from which it was returned, so that I could immediately send out a replacement, I know not. Perhaps you've already requested a replacement (several have for #23, but if you'd like the upper 2/3 of your DXN, or better yet a complete copy, let me know.

Thanks to all who continue to send in clippings of radio happenings. Here are a few guidelines: DON'T write inside the copy area of the clipping; write only in the margin; be sure to include your name and the name of the publication; if you photocopy, copy at 100%, and make sure that the copy has a clean white background; double-check to make sure that if the article jumps to an inside page that you include that page, too. Articles which chronicle status changes in stations should go to Jerry Starr for use in "AM Switch" (and eventually in the Log), not to the publisher, as most articles which see print in DXN concern changes in the AM broadcast industry, rather than changes that affect just one station (so as a general rule, we don't use FM nor shortwave articles; send these to the appropriate clubs for their use). I ask for the name of the publication so that we can give fair credit to the source, especially of syndicated articles which may be copyrighted. Shorter articles have a much better chance of fitting available space in DXN, but I have been able to get business class students at Topeka High to type up longer articles (they maintain state accreditations, we get quality copy), although it may be six months from now before they have time again.

A reminder to both column editors and potential article and publication contributors: please request and study the "NRC Contributor's Guide", available either at the NRC website for downloading or directly from the publisher either in electronic form or in hard copy. The editors and I are

wasting a lot of time dealing with submissions that just as easily could have been done "correctly"; that is, in a format that is commensurate with electronic publishing and NOT as done on a typewriter. It's just as easy for you to set margins and tabs as it is to type in spaces and hard returns (that I have to delete, one-by-one; yes, I still have several submitters who are using hard returns at the end of every line!). A few minutes spent in reformatting your submissions will save all of us needless time and effort.

Tom Bryant has retired from WSM, but he has volunteered to continue to sign verifies, promising a maximum lag time of eight weeks until requestors receive verifies from WSM. Our thanks to Tom again for forwarding to the NRC potential members' names from those who have written to WSM.

Called city of Oak Lawn on 3/31 . . . no one heard of station. Then called village of Riverdale, site of the transmitter, and woman told me she thinks the tower is on West 138th Street. This is strange. Ex: Valparaiso. (KO-IL)

(CR-IL) [The FCC database still shows this as a CP, but the new transmitter location is at N41-38-36 W87-38-35 for those of you who keep track. Yikes! Another Mapbook change - Ed.]
- 1090 (WGLC) IL Mendota - 3/31 - Noted off the air since at least 3/23. Nothing audible here since in the daytime. (KO-IL)

- 620 WHEN NY Syracuse - 4/4 - Adds Cigar Connoisseur Radio Network's Saturday program "Smoke This!" per show today. Host "The General" Cigar Dave mentioned he attended Syracuse University. Station slogan is "*The Sports Monster*." (DP-HI)
- 680 WCBM MD Baltimore - Changed nets from ABC to CBS news, believe 3/1. Also some programming changes, Dr. Laura moves from 0900-1200. (JEK-MD)

- 740 CBL ON Toronto** - 4/5 1100-1200 - Noted testing on 99.1 with medley of classical music, no announcements and not // 740. Move to 99.1 happens on 4/19, with simulcasting to continue on 740 for 6 months. (MB ON)

- KRPL** + 3/21 0143 - Now simulcasting "T-104" with a CHR format. My guess is that it's 104.3 WOCT Baltimore with a format change. Ads for a DJ club in DC with phone 751-8300 and Future Honda in Laurel, legal ID 0151 as "WXTR-AM Frederick." Top of hour ID garbled. In shifting mix with four others. (SK-PA)
- 850 WIOL TN Knoxville** - 3/21 - Adds "Smoke This!" per program today, ex- WIVK? Station slogan in "Total Information Radio." (DP-HI)
- 1360 WPTT PA McKeesport** - 3/23 2000 - Confirmed with new calls, ID as "Sports Radio 1360 WPTT McKeesport-Pittsburgh." Probably bought by WPTT, which is Channel 22 in Pittsburgh. (SK-PA)
- WIPG PA McKeesport** - 4/6 - Adds Premiere Radio Network's "Michael Reagan Show" per program today. Format change from all-sports? (DP-HI)
- 1500 WTOP DC Washington** - 4/5 - Per "Online Today with David Lawrence," station is dropping this and all other talk shows as of today, to go all-news and Orioles baseball. (DP-HI)
- 1520 WTRI MD Brunswick** - 3/22 - Still silent. (JEK-MD)
- 1600 WOHz WV Wheeling** - 3/25 - New address: 1015 Main Street, Wheeling 26003. (SK-PA)

- 560 WGAI NC Elizabeth City** - 3/15 0100-0130 - *Heard* with code ID's a-plenty. Suspect they were on the daytime kilowatt. (SF-TN) *Heard* with code ID's at 4 different times 0104-0117, when WQAM took over. Poor, no voice. (DT-JAM)

The Phillies' flagship station had a typo; it is 1210 WPHT-PA. And the Angels' flagship station also had a typo, it is 1110 KRLA-CA.

Ken Onyschuk reports that the New York Mets have 98 games broadcast in Spanish on 1280 WADO-NY; the Arizona Diamondbacks have home games broadcast in Spanish on 1480 WPHX-AZ. Bob Karчевski reports that One-On-One Sports station 950 WIDB-IL will carry several Chicago White Sox games throughout the season. The broadcast will include pre-game coverage, live play-by-play and post game reports. I assume that these broadcasts will occur when the Chicago Bulls broadcasts are on 1000 WMVP-IL.

I have more names of announcers; these are listed below with the network lists. I have checked the flagship list with that in the March 30, 1998 issue of "Broadcasting and Cable". There was no mention in that magazine of CBS Radio broadcasting MLB games, and the CBS web site has an old network list.


