According to the 1600 station's time line on the FCC database, their renewal request was denied in January 2005 (we have no details). Now, the CP for U1 5000/11 has been dismissed, probably due to the fact that the license is supposed to be deleted. In addition to inaction on the part of the licensee, and the fact that the 1700 X-bander is (over) 5-years-old. The licensee owns three stations in the area: 1190 in Moulton, Alabama and the 1600 and 1700 stations in Huntsville. But according the FCC, WHIY is still **licensed for U2 5000/500**. Stay tuned . . .

NEWS TO YOUSE

- 860 KTRB CA Modesto - Is SILENT to facilitate the move to San Francisco, expected to be completed in 2007. The Modesto facility will eventually return to the air as KMPH on 840 kHz, using the former KTRB studios and 860 transmitter site. Interesting note: The KTRB San Francisco installation will have two sites. The nighttime site is located where no commercial power is available so it will be powered 100% by diesel generators.
- 870 KHNR HI Honolulu - Still no official word on their move to 880 kHz, although we have seen two reports (in other publications) of hearing them testing on the new frequency. Whether or not that info is true, we can't say. But a Hawaiian DXer says he has heard nothing on 880. Their application says the present tower is located on the island of Molokai, 67 km east of Honolulu. They have proposed to move the transmitter to the site of the tower which houses KORL-690, KGI-760, KRUD-1130 and KZOO-1210, so possibly all these signals into one stick is causing some engineering difficulties. We'll keep you posted.
- 920 WBAA IN West Lafayette - Noted last issue as having their license cancelled (due to license lapse), has been issued an Special Temporary Authority to continue broadcasting as they claim they did file for renewal in 2004, as scheduled. It should be all sorted out in 'government time'. We heard from no less than five readers who noted this Purdue University station on the air after the DX News arrived with the item.
- 1110 WSLV TN Ardmore - The FCC has accepted their application for renewal after declaring their facility as deleted due to the fact they did not file for renewal on time. No doubt others will follow.



Per various Internet reports, 1314 Norway has gone dark, signing off without fanfare on July 1. There's no mention of the historic 1314 sign-off on the NRK website either. NRK Norway is still on the air at 153 and 630 kilohertz with 100 kW, on 675 kHz with 20 kW, and on 1485 kHz with only 1 kW. Coverage maps and a thumbnail tower site photo can be found at www.nrk.no/informasjon/nrk_i_utlandet/3694632.html. Needless to say, DX reception of Norway will be difficult in the absence of the 1.2 megawatt 1314 kHz flamethrower of the Arctic.


