From the Publisher ... John Malicky continues to work on planning for Pittsburgh 2008, the 75th anniversary convention. One important change: Please send registrations directly to him at 995 Shadycrest Rd - Pittsburgh, PA 15216 (checks/MO's made out to "National Radio Club"), or access www.nrcdxas.org to make a PayPal payment.

On page 15 is an announcement from the NRC Board of Directors, via Wayne Heinen, Chairman, concerning the publisher's replacement(s). A number of you have sent in multiple-year subscription renewals, the ultimate act of faith in believing that the NRC will continue with barely a burp after I end my tenure as publisher in June, and this announcement will confirm your faith, although there's still one important part of the puzzle left to be filled. As Wayne indicates, I sent a several-page "job description" of my duties to him, and "like Topsy, it grew", to quote a literary figure. The BoD has managed to cover all my duties except for the most important, that of the publisher, the person who lays out the magazine 30 times a year and posts it to e-DXN and the printer. The mailing duties will now be handled by the printer, so now the commitment by the person handling DXN publishing will average between 2-8 hours a week. Specifically, the publisher will set publication deadlines; gather and edit submissions by our current fine staff of editors and others; lay out the magazine in 12, 16, 24, 36, 40, or 48-page increments (72 pages? It happened three times, anyway.); develop new columns; transmit the finished product (probably via PDF's) to the printer, to e-DXN forums, and to Wayne for placement of the PDF on e-DXN and to other clubs now receiving exchanges electronically; and in general serve as the manager of what is really a small business. Currently I use Adobe InDesign CS2 (CS3 is now available) for DTP software and MacLink Plus to translate several columns to RTF versions so

that they can be placed in DXN; however, other platforms and software could be used, although probably not as effectively, considering that when I would send the new publisher templates and such that the styles and all artwork would be in place already.

So the new publisher would not have to fool with printing labels, maintaining membership databases, prepping DXN for mail and delivering it to the post office, nor even editing DDXA or IDXA which I plan to continue to do. Prospective publishers: kindly apply via e-mail to Wayne via the e-mail address on the back of DXN.

On hold are two Musings; look for them in the next issue of DXN in May.

Unfilled positions ... We're still in need of volunteers for the following positions: one or more persons to edit future NRC publications; a "DX Targets" editor; a DXN publisher, by June 2008, starting with the July 2008 DXN.



570	KQNG	HI	Lihue. Noted off the air the afternoon of 3/23 and for the whole week. Per station manager in phone call 3/28, the power supply to the transmitter was disrupted and they were waiting for new parts from the Mainland, hoping to return 3/31. Still off 3/31 but noted back on 4/2. (DP-HI)
620	KIPA	HI	Hilo (and synchros in Kalaoa and Naalehu). Noted with strong carrier but no programming the evening of 3/23. Also noted in the daytime that week, sometimes with very weak music. Per station manager Dan in phone call 3/28, they planned to return to the air within two weeks, with a "non-political" talk format. Noted back on 3/31 0500 EDT with oldies from '60s and '70s and announcements about a "Classic Hits Weekend" but no IDs. So remove from the "Silent" list. (DP-HI)
790	KBRV	ID	Soda Springs. 3/25 0906. Sports, weather, trivia questions, call letter IDs; phone number 547-2400 was mentioned a couple of times; at 0914, guy says "Thanks for listening to the new AM 790 KBRV Soda Springs," followed by music. Fair signal, mixing with KXXX; still there at 0945. Have not noted KBRV for a long time; wonder if they've been silent? The reference to the "new" 790 might be a clue. Also wonder if the CP to move to 800 is still alive-- FCC database says it is. (JW-CO)
930	KBAI	WA	Bellingham. Adds Air America Radio's "Thom Hartmann Program" per show 3/31. (DP-HI)
950	KKFN	CO	Denver. Thanks to Dale Park who forwarded an article from the online <i>Rocky Mountain News</i> of 3/6, we learned that the "Fan" Fox sports talk format on KKFN moved to 104.3 FM (with new calls KKFN-FM ex-KJCD) effective that day. According to the article, the two stations were to simulcast until 3/31, after which the ESPN sports talk format of KEPN 1600 Lakewood CO was to move to 950. However, John Wilkins informs me that as of 4/2 the two KKFNs are still simulcasting and KEPN is still ESPN. (Ed.-WI)
1010	KXPS	CA	Thousand Palms. Added Fox Sports Radio's "The Drive on Fox with Chris Myers and Sean Farnham" 3/10 per a Premiere Radio Networks news release, airing only the first three hours at 1506-1800. (DP-HI)
1050	WDZ	IL	Decatur. Per Premiere Radio Networks news release, the <i>Decatur Herald and Review</i> , and AllAccess.com, station will switch from urban AC "Magic 10-50" ("old school R&B") to "Fox Sports Talk 10-50 the Fan" on 3/31. Fox Sports Radio will air all day weekdays except 0900-1500, all day Saturdays and all day Sundays except 0700-1300. Station also adds Jim Rome live 1207-1500 plus some local talk. Ironically, WDZ just added Premiere's "Steve Harvey Morning Show" on 2/18. Owned by Tom Joyner, the station has received protests from the local NAACP chapter. (DP-HI)
1080	KFXX	OR	Portland. Per message board at pdxradio.com, station dropped Jim Rome 3/3, replacing him with live Mike Tirico from ESPN Radio 1307-1500 and newcomer Dan Patrick until 1800. (DP-HI)
1120	KPNW	OR	Eugene. Station adds Michael Savage live weekdays at 1506-1800 per message board at pdxradio.com, replacing local sports talk. "The Savage Nation" was last heard in Eugene on KUGN-590. (DP-HI)
1150	KXMG	OR	Portland. Per message board at pdxradio.com, station switched from SS AC

"Magia" format 2/2 to regional Mexican "Ke Buena," similar to 1210 KTBK WA and 1600 KTUB UT. **(DP-HI)**

- 1240 KRJY CA **Sacramento.** Per *Sacramento Bee*, KSAC 1240 flipped from liberal talk 3/31 to what the station manager calls "hip-hop gospel." She said the "nasty, dirty and contentious" tone of the shows combined with lack of advertising from Democratic organizations led to the switch. **(DP-HI)** (As pointed out in this issue's AMS, calls were also changed, from KSAC to KRJY. **Ed.-WI)**
- 1310 KZRG MO **Joplin.** Will add "The Kim Komando Show" 4/26 per station website, airing Saturdays 1007-1300. Station airs Fox Newsradio and conservative talk and is relayed on KSYN-FM 92.5's HD-3 channel. **(DP-HI)**
- 1340 KPTR CA **Cathedral City.** Per a *Palm Springs Desert Sun* article written by the stations' new owners, the easy listening format of KWLY 98.5 FM will move back to 1340 in the next few months. KPTR and its liberal talk ("The Valley's Progressive Voice") will then shift from 1340 to 1450, displacing KGAM's mostly conservative talk, which was similar to co-owned KPSI 920's format. No mention as to whether Alan Colmes and/or play-by-play will remain on 1450. **(DP-HI)**
- 1400 KQDJ ND **Jamestown.** Added Fox Sports Radio 3/3 per Premiere Radio Networks news release. Wikipedia says station is an ESPN Radio affiliate so FSR is either an addition or replacement. **(DP-HI)**
- 1450 KGAM CA **Palm Springs.** See 1340 KPTR above. **(Ed.-WI)**
- 1470 KELA WA **Centralia-Chehalis.** Per station website, the station was displaced by a recent flood. Quoting here, "Our business office is located in the temporary trailer facing Gold Street and the studios are located in the temporary trailer facing our regular building." Website gives address as 1635 South Gold Street, Centralia 98531. **(DP-HI)**
- 1560 WMBH MO **Joplin.** Frequently silent station has been off the air for a month. Owner is trying to find a buyer. **(JRT-MO)**
- 1670 KNRO CA **Redding.** This station will drop ESPN sports on 4/18, becoming a // of KPIG-FM 107.5 Freedom CA (plus others including KPIG AM 1510 Piedmont CA). KPIG's format is Americana (recall the Denver market's KCUV 1510 a few years back). One result of the change-- KNRO will not carry Giants' baseball this year and will end carrying Sacramento Kings' basketball. Thanks to **Dave White** for forwarding an article from redding.com regarding this situation. **(Ed.-WI)**
- 1680 KGED CA **Fresno.** 3/23 0755. Poor signals under WDSS with Adult Standards music and ID. Now with this format ex-Radio Disney and these calls ex-KAVT. **NEW (SA-MB)**

- 570 KLAC CA **Los Angeles.** 3/28 0556. Ads for Long Beach Grand Prix race, HD TV dealer, Boston Medical Group (for male sexual problems), ID "AM 5-70 KLAC Los Angeles..."; into Fox National Sports Report. KQNG HI still off. Poor. **(DP-HI)**
- 580 KMJ CA **Fresno.** 3/29. While driving around the evening of 3/28, I noted KLAC 570 coming in very distorted, even though I was far away from QRM sources like power lines and cellular antennae. However, KMJ was booming in, which

leads me to think that KMJ's HD carrier is powerful enough to mangle an adjacent channel 2500 miles away! **(DP-HI)**

- 590 KFNS IL Wood River. 3/6 1838. "Fan 590" ID and reference to "sports in Saint Louis." Good signal. **(GH-IL)**

- 700 KHSE TX Wylie. 3/11 2008. Heard under a strong WLW signal with Indian music and ID "Fun Asia Radio 700 AM." **(RNA-OK)**
- 710 KIRO WA Seattle. 3/15 0757. News from the NRC Board of Directors

Since the first of the year, your Board of Directors has been busy addressing the impending retirement of Paul Swearingen as the Publisher of *DX News* magazine and Administrator of our e-dxn.com on line site. Paul has been interested in having a smooth and successful transition and has provided the Board of Directors with plenty of documentation delineating the duties that he has performed.

Tantamount in our effort was the smooth transition to a new Publisher. A brief summary of the duties follows; these are not intended to be the full description that Paul supplied to the Board! These duties are basically two-fold: the first part is working with the editors and compiling their columns into a document ready for the printer, and creating each issue of *DX News* in Adobe Acrobat format that is posted to www.e-dxn.com; second, coordinating with the printer and hired help to have *DX News* printed, prepared, and delivered to the post office for mailing.

The second portion has been taken care of by Board Member Ken Chatterton. He has arranged (through a competitive bid) with Benjamin Printing of Watertown, New York that not only allows us to continue to have *DX News* printed at a fair price, but the majority of the preparation and mailing is included in the bid. Ken has volunteered to be our local liaison with Benjamin Printing and will, in addition, be handling the mailing of *DX News* to subscribers outside the United States. You will see the request for a desktop publishing position is now posted on the front page of this issue.

Another duty that Paul has performed is maintaining the *DX News* mailing database and collection of monies at his PO Box for renewals. These functions will both be moving to headquarters in Aurora, Colorado. More on this transfer as we get closer to Paul's retirement date.

Paul, along with Fred Vobbe of the DX Audio Service, was a driving force in the creation of www.e-dxn.com and all that it entails. After e-DXN began, the duties of membership tracking and the administrative management of the e-DXN became Paul's territory. As you can see, Paul has been a VERY BUSY volunteer. Recently, Dave White volunteered to help with the software management of e-DXN. He has jumped in with both feet to apply his expertise to keep it running while making needed software changes to improve its functions. The Board approached Dave and he has graciously agreed to add the management and membership aspects of e-DXN to his duties. Paul has volunteered to remain active in monitoring e-DXN forums and the [NRC-AM] listserv, as these can be done from "anywhere in the world". Paul has indicated that he will still be an active member of the NRC and the DX Community and will continue to edit DDXA and IDXA.

All of this has been so positive, that now I have to broach the subject of an impending dues increase. We are looking at an increase in the cost of *DX News*, primarily because of the additional services being provided by Benjamin Printing. Even if the Board had been approached by any volunteers that were willing to take on the entire printing and mailing job, we still would have been looking at some form of dues increase this year.

The dues for a one-year subscription to *DX News* were \$22 prior to an increase to \$28 in October of 2001. That was seven years ago! We have been able to absorb both postage and printing increases since that time. As many of you are probably aware, this will be the last *DX News* mailed at the current forty-one cent rate. Beginning May 10th, the rate for First-class postage is being raised another penny, and who knows where it will go from there!

The Board will be finishing its research and forecasts and will hopefully be able to arrive at the new dues increase to be included in the May *DX News*.

We would like to commend those who have volunteered in recent years to help keep the NRC going and make it the kind of club that we are all proud to be members of.

I would like to ask that anyone that may have computer skills to consider volunteering to take over the last unfilled task on the list, that of Publisher, with duties as outlined above.


