They will remain at low power until the exact moment before their 12 am legal ID plays. (It has run as late as 12:03 am). To QSL, send a self-addressed envelope with at least 2 stamps to Paul Walker, Jr. - P.O. Box 340 - Marion, IL 62959, and include your location, radio used, when/what you heard. If you send a CD, do NOT send the entire test, just a few relevant clips. If you send a cassette tape, cue it up to the start of the test. WGGH's Internet streaming will be disabled during this test. Also, please be aware that the mailbox at the post office is checked only twice a week, so you may not get an imemdiate reply. Thanks to Paul Walker and NRC/IRCA test manager Saul Chernos for arranging this test.

From the "lost" entries ... December 20, 1958: A letter from Ross Harp, Jr. informed us that many stations across the nation would test the Conelrad Alert System between 0200 and 0500 EST on 640 and 1240 kc/s, with 3 or 4 stations transmitting sequentially for 6 seconds each with a continuous message.

25 years ago ... from the November 26, 1984 DXN: Volunteers to put DX News onto tape were being sought, due to numerous requests.

10 years ago ... from the November 22, 1999 DXN: Mike Hardester, Jacksonville, NC noted that WSMO-1580 Camp Lejeune was changing its call letters in a "tribute" to WSM, Nashville ... several DX'ers (Robert C.
