JACK SEARLE asks how, if not all Bandwatch contributions are published, a member can comply with the Best-of-Month rule that the entry must have been reported in the DX Times. This BOM rule is to ensure that any good DX catch is publicised at time of reception for the benefit of all members and not submitted 'out of the blue' as a QSL or competition entry, when conditions no longer permit the opportunity of reception. A 'disputed' logging can be considered within weeks of 'reception', but not so easily six months later when a 'QSL' is entered. On the other hand, to include every Bandwatch contribution would add up to 1½ pages to the present 4, but our budget and the time available to Magcom staff currently limits output to 16 and 20 page issues. So, the BOM rule should really read, under the current set-up: "Month reported to the DX Times". No entry would be disqualified because the report had not been published, and any disqualification will be the subject of correspondence between Adcom, the contributor and Magcom. Hope this clarifies the situation for all SW contributors.

In Pacific Asian Report - full details of 2YM and also the maintenance silent periods for the NZBC National network. 1XX Murupara relay will shortly move from 1110 to synchronised operation on 1240. 1XX Chief Engineer Graham Bryce apologises for the delay in verifying reports recently, and promises all will be acknowledged eventually. "Each transmitter will normally close down once each month between 2300 and 0600 NZ time the following morning or earlier if the work has been completed. The programme will continue uninterupted if it is not intended to carry out maintenance on the scheduled night. Part of the maintenance period will be used for carrying out performance tests on the transmitter and the carrier is not likely to be off during the whole of the maintenance period.

"Stations will close down at the 11pm time release or following sports results if any. An announcement will be made at this time giving the station call sign, the reason for the close-down (e.g. maintenance), the approximate duration of the closure and alternative stations to which listeners may tune.

"Details of scheduled close downs which began Sunday 24 November are as follows:

"Additional close-downs for urgent maintenance may be necessary from time to time.

NZBC Chief Engineer comments: I hope that this information will enable your members to listen for overseas stations on these frequencies during closedown periods. NZBC Public Relations Officer comments: There is little extra cost involved in running the transmitters for the extra time. As they are remotely controlled, this does not involve extra staff hours and power costs for the hours involved are not high. Transmitter reliability is better if transmitters are left running. Most faults occur switching on equipment.

2YM Palmerston North 1410kHz began transmissions on 20/12 using temporary facilities in the form of a 1kw Toshiba transmitter located in a caravan and dual coupled into the existing 2ZA aerial. A new building is to house the 2ZA transmitter together with the pemanent 2M 2kw transmitter which is coming from Dunedin, is nearing completion and installation of equipment should take place during February, after which the caravan transmitter will be withdrawn.

STATION OF THE MONTH

The Qatar Broadcasting Service broad-casts from Doha, capital of the state of Qatar, known in Arabic as al-Dauha. Identification is "Idhaot ul-Qatar min al Dauha". The station is staffed with Arab announcers trained in the BBC Arabic service. A schedule for this station to operate with 100 and 250 kw transmitters, has been registered with the International Telecommunications Union in Geneva, and is:

6135 khz 0400-0500; 1000-1600 GMT 7160 0400-0500 7200 1200-1600 9570 0300-0700 1000-2100 11730 0500-0700 15315 1000-1600

It is not known at this stage whether the full schedule is being used, but the 100kw transmission on 9570 has been observed here on 9570 from 0501 to after 0530. Programming is in Arabic and includes the time signal and news at 0530. The station should not be confused with Sana in the Yemen Arabic republic operating with a frequency of 9575 khz.

SHORTWAVE BANDWATCH

*ORTF, the familiar name of the French Broadcasting System in Paris, was replaced with the new "Radio France" on 1 January 1975.

*Following the cyclone devastation of Darwin on Christmas Day, local station 8DR was resurected by sending programmes down to Radio Australia at Shepparton, Victoria by microwave over a distance



Shepparton, Victoria by microwave over a distance of 8000km. The programming was then retransmitted on shortwave, picked up off the air at the 8DR transmitter and rebroadcast on medium wave. This round -about routing was made necessary by the loss of the communication link of only 16km between the 8DR studio and it's transmitter. Colin Campbell and David Ricquish supplied the following schedule for the 8DR relay from Shepp-arton: 1900-0020 GMT on 11810Khz, 0030-1000 on 17715, 1010-1900 on 9550kHz. The SW operation is still effective as at 10/1. For the time being, the Darwin Relay station of Radio Australia is off-air due cyclone damage. *An excellent list of African stations is reported by Tony Marr and Bryan Clark while on holiday at Whangaparaoa, near Auckland.

*News Flash: The BBC Monitoring Service reports hearing Spanish Sahara on the unannounced frequency of 11805kHz from 0810 to fade-out 1800GMT in SS and AA.

ARTHUR CUSHEN'S SHORTWAVE REVIEW 15

1975 we trust will be a better year for reception than the past one has been with severe disturbance being experienced over many months. Reception of signals from Europe on new frequencies have been observed, while over the New Year period many stations were on extended schedules. My programme 'DX World' must be on the biggest network of stations in the world as it is now carried on the 21 station NZBC National network on the second Thursday of each month at 11.45.p.m. NZT.

All times are GMT - add 13 hours for N.Z. Summer Time. All frequencies KHZ.

AUSTRIA; Vienna has recently made three frequency changes: From 0600-0900 to East Asia 11865 has replaced 21675 although there is some interference from 0600-0620 from Deutsche Welle. From2000-2200 to Europe 9615 has replaced 9710. and from 2100-0000 to South America 11895 has replaced 15210.

Brazil: Radio Nacional at Brasilia has changed from 11780 to 9605 and is heard in English from 2100-2200 but at poor strength. Portuguese is heard at 1900 and German at 2000 on the same frequency.

CANADA: Radio Canada is testing on 9445 from 0600-0800 in place of 9480. English is noted at 0640, and French at 0700. 9445 is also used 1800-2230.

Dominican Republic: Radio Norte Santiago now operates 24 hours a day on 4806 and is best around 0730 but suffers from CW QRM. It relays its medium wave outlet on 720.

Finland: Helsinki has changed from 9550 to 9720 for its North American trans--mission 0300-0400. English is broadcast at 0300 and Finnish at 0330.

Holland: Hilversum made some frequency changes on 3 December. 0930-1050 15110 replaces 9640 in English

1100-1220 15110 and 21745 are new frequencies

15185 has programmes in Dutch; 1700-1820 11960 has programmes in Arabic. 1830 - 1950 11955 in Arabic: 2000-2120 11745 in French.

Indomesia: RPDK station on 2920 at Jawa Tengah has been heard from 1200 - 1500. On 3205 RPDK Kendal, at Jawa Tengah relays news from Jakarta at 1300, according to Craig Tyson in Perth.

Lebanon: Beirut is on 9570 from 2300-0100 to South America and causes inter--ference to the BBC FES. Beirut is also noted on 9525 in English 0230-0300.

Liberia: VOA Monrovia 11890 carries programmes in Spanish until closing at 0330at very good strength.

Malta: The CBC programmes relayed by DW-Malta to Europe are now on 7290 and 6100. The transmission to Africa from Daventry is now 11720 9625 and 7155.

Romania: Bucharest is heard on the new frequency of 11790 in English from 0400 -0427. Also announce frequencies of 5990 6150 6190 9570 11940.
