WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

The FCC has made some changes in their one to a market multiple ownership rules. They will now entertain waivers on a case by case basis. The FCC will look favorably towards the granting of waiver applications if they involve radio and television stations in the top-25 markets with at least 30 separately owned stations remaining after the combination is approved. Other requests will be considered on a case by case basis.

New rules have been adopted concerning the broadcast of indecent or obscene material. The new rules will be enforce 24 hours a day, prior to the changes the broadcast of indecent programming was only prohibited when there was a reasonable risk that children might be in the audience. The Commission noted it would continue to enforce its generic definition of indecency, which has been upheld by

the courts. Under the definition, broadcast indecency is language or material that, in context, depicts or describes, in terms patently offensive as measured by contemporary community standards for the broadcast medium, sexual or excretory activities or organs. The new rules will become effective 30 days after its publication in the Federal Register.

Also adopted by the FCC were new rules permitting limited short-spacing of FM station assignments though the use of directional antennas. The FCC believes that these changes are needed to accommodate problems with site location due to FAA clearance, government ownership, restrictions on desirable sites, environmental and economic concerns as well as coverage considerations. Short-spacing will be limited temporarily to five miles.

The FCC has upheld the Mass Media Bureau returning of a Domega Broadcasting Corp. application for a new FM at Las Cruces, NM. The Commission rejected Domega's method of calculating compliance with the U.S./Mexican Treaty. The Commission stated that although Domega found the engineering requirements of the Treaty unnecessarily rigid and restrictive, they are nonetheless straightforward. The FCC concluded that applications that fail to comply with international agreements must be returned.

On remand, the Commission has granted the application of Union City Radio for a new AM station on 1030 KHz at Union City, IN. This reverses the FCC previous grant of Land O'Lakes Broadcasting Corp. application to move WTRJ, Troy, OH to 1030 KHz.

The FCC has accepted a joint settlement agreement for 98.1 MHz in San Diego, CA. A CP has been granted to KIFM Broadcasting, LP, a newly formed entity resulting from the settlement agreement. All other applications are dismissed.

A federal appellate court has upheld the FCC decision approving the assignment of WNIK AM/FM, Arecibo, PR, from Hato Abajo Development Corp. to Kelly Broadcasting System Corp. Former owners of the station citing complicated family and business relationships, alleged the transfer would violate the FCC's duopoly restrictions.

Ruling that the right of free speech does not include the right to broadcast without a license, District Court Judge John J. McNaught of Boston has granted judgment to the government in a case seeking injunction against the operators of "Radio New York International" a ship board radio station. RNI had announced plans in August 1988 to resume broadcasting prompting the government filed suit to enjoin them from doing so.

Two strange applications were reported by the FCC this past week. One is by WSMS 91.7 in Memphis, TN. They are asking to construct an experimental broadcast station on their frequency with 25000 w at 403 ft, directional. The second is also to construct an experimental station by WKNO-FM 91.1 in Memphis, TN. They are asking for 100000(h) watts and 66700(v) watts on 91.1 with no height given.

The Commission has affirmed the substitution of channel 295 C instead of 257 A to Atlanta, TX, and denied the request for review by Radio U.S.A., licensee of KCOZ, channel 261 A, Shreveport, LA.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

The FCC has ordered Great American Radio Corp., licensee of KCKO, Spokane, WA, to show cause why the station's license should not be revoked. KCKO had requested permission to remain silent until August 15th, 1985. In a visit to the station the FCC could find no evidence of a transmitter building or antenna towers.

WRPZ, Paris, KY, has also been ordered to show cause why it should not loose its license. Mega Broadcasting licensee of WRPZ never notified the FCC it was off the air or requested permission to remain off the air. A Field Operations Bureau investigation found the station to be have been silent since November of 1987.

The FCC has eliminated the rulemaking process when considering a request to downgrade the class of an FM allotment.

The U.S. Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia has remanded for notice and comment the rulemaking on the so-called interim rules governing counterproposals for substituted FM channels. The court also vacated and remanded the allotting of 106.7 MHz at Semora, NC.

The Commission has granted Golden West Broadcasting's request for reconsideration and tentatively approved its proposal to increase KMPC-FM's service to Glendale, CA, by increasing its ERP to a level exceeding the maximum allowed. Final action is pending a notice from Mexico that is has no objection to the proposed power increase.

The application of Dean-Thomas Communications for a new FM station at Bridgewater, VA, on 105.1 MHz has been granted to the successor applicant WRDJ, Inc.

The request of Metro Broadcasting, Inc. for reconsideration of the Commission's action returning its petition for Rulemaking and Order to Show Cause in the amending of the FM Table at Terrell and Dangerfield, TX, has been denied.

The hours for counter and phone service at the Mass Media Bureau and Dockets Reference Room at the FCC have been changed to 10:00 am to 4:30 pm.
