WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

The FCC has approved two cross ownership waivers this week. River City Television Partners, LP will be allowed to own KDNT-TV 30 in St. Louis and KSTZ(FM) Ste. Genevieve, MO. South Central Communications and John Engelbrecht were granted a permanent waiver to allow them to keep their interest in Knoxville Channel 8, LP owners of WKXT-TV. SCCC and Engelbrecht have a controlling interest in WEZK(FM) also in Knoxville, TN. The FCC had previously granted an 18 month waiver to allow SCCC and Engelbrecht time to divest their interest in WEZK. As a condition of the permanent waiver Engelbrecht may not increase his equity or involvement with WKXT-TV.

The Commission has affirmed the ALJ's dismissal of Juan Galiano's application for a new FM at Hormigueros, PR. Galiano's application was dismissed for failure to file his notice of appearance and to pay the hearing fee. Galiano had contended hurricane Hugo disrupted mail service and that he had received his notice late. Competing parties filed documents showing that there had been no disruption of mail service in Hormigueros.

The FCC has once again supported its own and has upheld a Review Board decision granting the application of Flagstaff Broadcasting Partnership for a new FM in Flagstaff, AZ, and denying the competing application of Julia S. Zozaya and Flagstaff Broadcasting Foundation.

More pirates shut down: "The Muddy Sound of KMUD" is no more as the FCC San Francisco office shut down Stephen McGreevy's station on 7435 KHz and fined him \$1,000. George P. Hopp, Jr. was fined \$1,000 and had his station "XERK" also on 7435 KHz in Donna, TX shut down. 7435 KHz is in the International Fixed Public Service band.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

The FCC this week released two decisions with major impacts on the FM band.

In the first, the Commission made several significant amendments to rules governing FM translator stations. The changes were designed to, in the FCC's words, create "rules [more] consistent with its intended purpose of providing a supplementary service to areas in which direct reception...is unsatisfactory..."

Under the amended rules, coverage contours of a translator providing fill-in service will be defined congruent with that of the primary station for respective station classes. An FM translator's protected contour will be defined at 1 mV/m. Translators may be owned by either the commercial FM station being rebroadcast or by an independent entity, provided the translator's contour is encompassed by the primary station's coverage contour. Commercial translators providing fill-in service may use any terrestrial means to obtain the primary station's signals, while also using intercity relay frequencies on a secondary basis. Financial support arrangements are left to the affected parties.

FM translators may not be licensed to a commercial FM station if the translator's contour extends beyond the primary station's coverage contour. Commercial primary stations may provide no financial support beyond technical assistance to such FM translators. Noncommercial FM stations are not subject to any ownership or financial support restrictions.

For "white areas" outside the protected contours of any full-time service, the FCC stated it would be favorably disposed toward waiver requests to permit commercial primary station ownership and financial support of translators, signal relay by any terrestrial means, and waivers of limitations on power and/or antenna height. For noncommercial stations "white areas" will be considered as any areas lacking a full-service noncommercial station. For all translators, announcements not to exceed a total of 30 seconds per hour are permitted in order to acknowledge and solicit funds. Emergency warnings of imminent danger remain allowable. The FCC continues to bar any other translator-originated programming.

The Commission adopted procedures for resolving mutually exclusive applications; said that translators would remain exempt from multiple ownership rules; continued to prohibit AM-FM cross-service translators or the use of translators solely to relay signals of a primary station to more distant translator facilities; and clarified that licensees may operate translators within the same area in order to provide a satisfactory signal quality.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK (Cont'd)

Finally, the FCC made a number of important technical changes in translator rules. The maximum ERP proposed standard has been reduced from 1,000 to 250 watts. The Commission also established power and antenna height combinations for translators operating beyond a primary station's coverage contour, yielding new contour distances of 7 kilometers for areas east of the Mississippi River and for Southern California, 13 kilometers elsewhere. Translators may operate on any of the 80 non-reserved commercial channels, with the 20 noncommercial channels reserved for noncommercial FM translator use.

Translators already in existence will be grandfathered from compliance with the new technical rules until they have interference problems, at which time compliance will be required. Existing stations must comply with the new service rules within three years. The Commission will consider waiver requests for extended grandfathering periods for stations who show that service to the public would be unduly lost as a result of compliance with the revised rules.

The FCC also this week clarified its procedures for authorizations for new communities of license. The clarifications came in response to several petitions for reconsideration of new FCC rules adopted in April 1989 enabling FM and TV licensees to modify their authorizations to specify new communities of license.

The FCC clarification contains five major points relevant to radio:

- 1) The Commission reiterated factors limiting a migration of stations from rural to urban areas. The proposed relocation of a station "may implicate policies which would weigh against the move despite a claimed first local service preference" for a community in a more urbanized area.
- 2) The FCC pointed out its right to waive, under limited circumstances where the general public would clearly benefit, its prohibition on moves that would deprive a community of its only existing service. However, the Commission did state that it would not accept a petition for a change in community of license during the first year of station operation if the licensee or permittee had received a decisionally significant preference in a comparative hearing which would not have been granted had the comparative contest been for a station in the new community.
- 3) Where two licensees in a community each file a petition for rulemaking seeking to remove their station from the community, each citing the other as a remaining station, the petitions will be treated in the same manner as any set of conflicting allotment petitions.
- 4) Where AM and FM licensees in the same community request a change in community of license, and the public interest may be best served by the retention of one of the stations in the community, the request of the AM licensee would generally be preferred over that of the FM licensee.
- 5) In examining proposals to change community of license, video and audio broadcast services will be treated as two distinct services. Because AM and FM stations have traditionally been considered joint components of a single aural medium, the Commission also determined it will examine the availability of AM and FM stations in a community, including both commercial and noncommercial stations.

M Street comments: at some unseen future point, the FCC's maintenance of a structure whereby licensee fitness is determined by the licensee's service to a community of license must either quietly be dropped or will collide headfirst with the commodification of radio. Recent trends such as AM and FM "superstations," time leasing on non-co-owned stations, and station moves of 100 miles or more have been an inevitable result of years of cynical manipulation - by broadcasters and by a deregulation-oriented FCC - of this structure. It's time to make the concept of public service real, or scrap it completely. The farce that broadcasters and the general public must currently endure serves nobody but the lawyers.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

Civil rights organizations have filed challenges to the license renewals of 32 California stations, alleging discrimination and failure to hire sufficient numbers of minority employees. Stations targeted by the NAACP and the National Hispanic Media Coalition include six in the Los Angeles area (KIEV-870, KFWB-980, KCRW-89.9, KMPC-710, KLIT-101.9, and KBIG-104.3) and three in San Diego. Ironically, one of the stations targeted, KCRW Santa Monica, has one of the best records of any major public radio station in the country for airing and distributing Hispanic-produced programming; however, the sole measure used in these license challenges is hiring practices among paid staff. Representatives of the groups were quoted in a Los Angeles newspaper as citing improvements in hiring practices following recent complaints and license filings against stations in Texas, Florida, and the Carolinas.

The Commission this week granted in part a request by Key West Broadcasting Co. for review of the dismissal of its application for a new FM in Key West FL, but upheld

the ALJ's dismissal of the application itself. The FCC agreed that neither the Review Board nor the ALJ had the authority to rule on Key West's request for a fee deferral, but upheld the dismissal since an authorized ruling would have had the same outcome. In other rulings, the FCC upheld the grant of Advanced Broadcast Technologies, Inc.'s application for a new FM in State College, PA; denied a request by Craig L. Fox for reconsideration of a staff action returning his petitions for rulemaking in Del Mar and San Clemente, CA; upheld the renewal of license for KWOD in Sacramento CA; and upheld the grant to Progressive Communications, Inc. for a new FM station in Temple, TX.

The FCC has announced that it is revising its current version of the FCC telephone directory, last published in March 1990. The new directory is being made available by Fair Press Services at the price of \$5.00 for the first copy and \$2.50 for each additional copy. ELSEWHERE

United Press International will remain in business for at least an additional 90 days. Members of the Newspaper Guild accepted a 35% pay cut in voting this week in order to keep themselves in business. UPI claimed it needed the pay cut in order to continue operations while it searches for someone to buy the wire service. UPI is now on its third owner in the last ten years, and is suffering from the additional financial problems of its parent company, Infotech. Infotech is presently under investigation by the Securities and Exchange Commission.

Satellite Music Network has announced their expected replacement for "The Wave" new age format, canceled last month. The new format is "Classic Rock," and will be under the direction of Lee Abrams. Abrams will continue to oversee SMN's "Z-Rock" heavy metal format but will pass responsibility for CHR "The Heat" to an as yet unnamed player.

Mexico has adopted Motorola C-QUAM AM stereo as its national broadcast standard. Mexico joins Canada, Australia and Brazil in choosing C-QUAM. Japan and Great Britain are now testing C-QUAM and are expected to adopt the Motorola system as well. If the Japanese select C-QUAM it may help AM Stereo growth in the U.S. as more receivers and cars will come already equipped for AM stereo.

MTV has announced a winner for its contest (featured previously in M Street) to give away the license to an AM radio station. The winner, one Chris McCarron, is reported by Radio Business Report to be seriously considering moving to Thomasville GA to run the station, country formatted WSTT-730. In doing so, she would be passing up the approximately \$100,000 cash made available by MTV as a substitute prize. Incidentally, the station will probably drop its country format at least long enough for the Billy Idol guest DJ appearance and MTV promos that will accompany the award.

The National Association of Broadcasters has filed comments with the FCC urging establishing a land-based (rather than satellite distributed) digital audio broadcasting (DAB) technology. The NAB's comments underscored its calls for preference to be given to existing station operators, rather than new broadcasters, and for DAB technology to be licensed as an enhancement, not as an alternative, to current service.

The Board of Directors of Country Radio Broadcasters, Inc., has elected Larry Daniels of KNIX Phoenix to become their new President. Daniels assumes the post following the resignation of previous president Paul Wilensky, who recently left country-formatted WMZQ Washington to take a position with non-country stations KDBK/KDBQ in San Francisco. This year's Country Radio Seminar, organized by CRB, is scheduled for March 6-9, 1991 at Nashville's Opryland Hotel and Convention Center. Registration information will be mailed shortly.

BFM CALENDAR NOTES

By December 1, radio stations in Connecticut, Maine, Massachusetts, New Hampshire, Rhode Island and Vermont must file renewal applications (FCC Form 303-S, with EEO statements on FCC Form 396); renewal applications must be filed for FM translator stations in Minnesota and South Dakota on FCC Form 348; and annual ownership reports must be filed on FCC Form 323 for stations in Alabama, Georgia, Minnesota, North Dakota, South Dakota, Montana, Colorado, Connecticut, New Hampshire, Vermont, Maine, Massachusetts and Rhode Island.
