**WASHINGTON THIS WEEK**

In a recent docket case, the FCC upheld the grant of Daniel S. Stratmeyer's application for a construction permit for a new FM station in Mt. Vernon, IL, while dismissing the petition of Saga Communications of Illinois, Inc. Saga requested reconsideration of the FCC's previous denial of its application on the grounds that the board did not "meaningfully discuss" its exceptions to Saga's original petition.

The FCC has announced the appointment of David Siddall as Chief of the Frequency Allocation Branch in the Office of Engineering and Technology. Siddall, an attorney with the FCC since 1985, has been instrumental in formulating the Commission's policies on new technologies such as high definition television (HDTV) and was involved in several mass media rulemakings including the 1990 FCC report to the U.S. Court of appeals on broadcast decency.

Docket 88-375 marches on; on April 24, 1989 the FCC created a new class of FM stations (class C3) in zone II. On August 25, 1989 the FCC increased the maximum ERP for commercial class A stations to 6,000 watts. As part of this process some stations were subject to reclassification if minimum requirements were not met by June 3, 1990. This week the FCC released a public notice listing the stations that have been reclassified. If you would like a copy of the notice please send \$3.00 to M Street Corp. Gospel Opportunities, Inc has applied with the FCC to modify the license of WHWL-95.7 in Marquette, MI from a commercial broadcast license to a non-commercial educational license. WHWL presently airs religious teaching programs.

FCC pirate busters in Los Angeles shut down an unlicensed FM station operation on 89.7 MHz in Simi Valley, CA. Derek Lloyd Underhill was fined \$1,000 for unlicensed operation. The pirate station identified as "KDUL", a call sign not currently used--despite the proliferation of twelve-in-a-row formats.

**ELSEWHERE**

More trouble for Emmis as Washington WAVA's "Morning Zoo" team of Don Geronimo and Mike O'Meara snag a \$15 million lawsuit. In a recent broadcast, they are said to have slandered Carol Sewell, a PR executive representing actor Leslie Nielsen, because Sewell was unable to produce Nielsen for an on-air interview. According to the Washington Post, the team's antics included calling Sewell a "bitch," "a liar" and a "cat woman" as well as telling their listeners to go to Sewell's hotel room and "gouge her eyes out." According to the lawsuit, Sewell received over 45 harassing telephone calls which, among other things, caused emotional distress and invaded Sewell's privacy.

Greater Media's KLSX Los Angeles is adding Howard Stern for mornings in late July. Stern's controversial brand of comedy and talk has garnered him frequent attention from the FCC, which has deemed parts of his program obscene. With the addition of KLSX, Stern will be broadcast on a total of four stations including WXRK-FM, New York, from which it originates; WYSP-FM, Philadelphia; and WJFK, Washington, D.C. Stern will be broadcast live 3 to 5am and replayed on tape 5 to 10am. Upon his newest signing, Stern said, "Los Angeles is filled with homosexuals, deviants and child molesters. I should do very well."

ELSEWHERE (Cont'd)

Infinity's trouble of the week comes from their own KROQ Los Angeles. The Foothill Leader reports that KROQ erected a billboard in La Crescenta showing Moses carrying the Ten Commandments before his disciples. The cartoon bubble above the people reads "No Thanks, we listen to Jed the Fish." Vandals response to the ad was to paint fish symbols and the phrase "Jesus will Judge" over the billboard. Local churches are not to happy with the billboard, but do not condone the graffiti and the police are looking for a suspect. M Street wonders yet again if radio must put down people and their beliefs to make a share and a sale.

New York based National Black Network has shut down its hourly news operation resulting in the layoff of about 20 staff members. According to NBN president Jack Bryant, the network will become like other commercial-only networks and will concentrate on its nighttime talk programming. The change effects approximately 100 NBN affiliates. This leaves Sheridan Broadcasting Network as the only provider of black-oriented hourly newscasts.

The Winners News Network based at WWNN Pompano Beach, FL has ended its satellite network. WNN provided a 24 hour format of motivational seminar excerpts. The format never caught on nationally and WNN never reached ten affiliates. WNN plans to continue the network via tape. Of the affiliates we contacted all planned to find other programming. WWNN will continue with the format locally.

If you can't kill the competition sell it. Starting July 1, Nashville rock rivals WKDF (AOR) and WGFX (Classic Rock) will share the same sales staff. Citing economic reasons, officials of the two stations say the newly combined sales force will operate out of WKDF's offices, while continuing to compete for audience. This makes a total of 10 Nashville stations involved in some form of program, staff or format sharing.

The Radio Advertising Bureau (RAB) is cautioning stations to carefully inspect language regarding payment terms in advertising agency contracts because of a recent statement from the American Association of Advertising Agencies (AAAA) advocating limits on an agency's liability to pay for orders they place. The AAAA wants agencies to abandon traditional contracts with media and advertisers in which agencies are liable for advertising orders. According to the RAB, the new policy will make it more difficult for stations to collect on such orders. RAB Chairman Rick Buckley said, "Our concern is that, by approving contracts with the so-called 'sequential liability' provision, stations will unknowingly be bargaining away an important contractual element and incurring financial risk without receiving any concessions in return."

In other advertising news, the NAB is providing revised political ad contracts for radio and TV, reflecting recent FCC policy changes regarding political ad rates. The NAB said any prior versions of the form are obsolete and should not be used. The forms are available in pads of 100 for \$10, and can be ordered from NAB Services, 202-429-5373.

In an agreement with background music supplier Audio Environments, Inc. (AEI), radio programming syndicator Broadcast Programming is releasing custom "cover" instrumentals aimed at easy listening stations. Each CD contains a minimum of 15 custom cuts and will be released on a bi-monthly basis. For information on the new CDs, contact Edith Hilliard or Tom Casey at Broadcast Programming, 800-426-9802.

**WASHINGTON THIS WEEK**

The FCC was closed Thursday, July 4th.

The Commission has overturned a Review Board order remanding to the administrative Law Judge the proceeding involving five mutually exclusive applications for a new FM station on 96.1 MHz. class A at Huron, OH. The Commission also vacated an order by the ALJ dismissing of Luipold Broadcasting, Inc. In addition to Luipold the applicants are Great Lakes Broadcasting, Inc., Huron Communications Co. LP, Thomas W. Roberts and NCB Enterprises, Inc.

Other actions at the FCC last week included: The Commission upheld the grant of Daniel S. Stratemeyer's application for a new class B1 FM Station on 102.1 in Mt. Vernon, IL; and dismissed the petition of Saga Communications of Illinois, Inc. for reconsideration of the Commission's previous denial of its application. KWEL, Inc. was notified by the Commission of an apparent liability for a forfeiture of \$10,000 for willful and repeated violations of Commission rules on station KBAT, Midland, TX. Salem Broadcasting, Inc. was notified of an apparent liability for a forfeiture of \$10,000 violations of unauthorized transfer of control and failing to maintain a meaningful management and staff presence at the

main studio at WOBG-FM, Salem WV. WOBG-FM is "leased" to WOBG(AM)

Radio Vision Christiana Management applied to the FCC to change WWRV-1330KHz, New York, NY from a commercial station to a non-commercial educational station. WWRV programs a variety of ethnic Christian programs.

The National Association of Broadcasters is asking the FCC to reconsider a recent decision that would automatically award a "pioneer preference" to innovators of new communications services seeking radio spectrum. Proposing new changes, the NAB said it could live with a pioneer policy that would provide clear guidance for would-be applicants, and make the preference, "at best, a weighted--not decisive--factor in the licensing process."

Roy Stewart, mass media bureau chief of the FCC, will headline a panel of experts discussing "Programming, Ownership and Financial Strategies for Survival and Success" at Radio 1991. The NAB convention session will cover the FCC's clarification of its main studio rule and its new proceeding on radio ownership rules, the limits of time brokerage arrangements and agreements relating to joint sales and combo rates.

NAB Radio Montreux picked-up steam this week as six more media organizations became supporting members. Radio Television News Directors Association, Radio Network Association, Broadcast Education Association, International Radio and Television Society, National Public Radio, and the North American National Broadcasters Association have endorsed the international convention to be held in Montreux, Switzerland, June 10-13, 1992.

**Canada This Week**

As part of the CRTC's reviewing of procedures, regulations and policies in light of the new Broadcasting Act effective June 4th, 1991 the CRTC has changed the definition of major types of broadcast undertakings. The old types were: broadcast transmitting undertakings, broadcast receiving undertakings and networks. The new definitions read: program undertaking, distribution undertaking and network. Broadcast transmitting undertakings will be categorized as follows: 1) Radio (AM & FM) - originating programs, 2) Radio (AM & FM) - rebroadcasting only, 3) Television - originating programs, 4) Television - rebroadcasting only, 5) Multi-channel - rebroadcasting only several radio and/or TV signals, 6) Subscription TV, 7) Distribution, including multipoint distribution systems. Network operations are as follows: 1) AM & FM programs, 2) Television programs, 3) Cable Community programs, 4) Cable Microwave, 5) Satellite - retransmitting, 6) Satellite - programming, 7) Pay-Television, 8) Specialty programs. Should any of the changes effect the classification of a licensee the change will be effective with the licensee's renewal.

U.S. stations can be glad they do not need to deal with the CRTC. MusiquePlus, Inc. of Montreal went before the CRTC to change two conditions of its licence, namely numbers 4 and 14. The proposed changes redefined the "broadcast week" as "seven consecutive broadcast days beginning of Friday" and redefined "broadcast day" as a "24 hour period beginning at 00:00:01 hour". MusiquePlus is haggling over the small print as to allow it to better achieve its required percent of Canadian content. Canadian content is a set percent of the music played on a station that must be produced or recorded by Canadian artists. MusiquePlus stated in its application that under the percent definition of "Broadcast week" it has to prepare playlists 5 days before new releases are ready for distribution. Playing the hits is never a small matter to Canadian stations.

ELSEWHERE

The American Hispanic Owned Radio Association (AHORA) has taken the first steps towards incorporation as a non-profit trade association. At its Board of Directors meeting in Las Vegas the Board formed committees to carry out initial projects in: membership, finance, new business, government relations, music industry and ratings/research. For more information contact AHORA at (805) 324-4411.

This weeks "Local Marketing Agreement" comes to us from Atlanta where Great American's WKLS(FM) has announced it will represent all local and national sales for Ring Radio's WCNN(AM) and WALR(FM). Time will be sold on all three as "The Atlanta Trombo" or can be purchased individually on each station. WKLS is a rock station, WCNN programs all news and WALR is an urban AC station. The press release states that "This is the most exciting event Atlanta radio has ever seen." While this may be good business we will let you judge how exciting it may be.

The first two of King Broadcasting's six radio stations have found a buyer and it's in the family. Making good on a promise to keep classical music in Seattle the daughters of the late King founder Dorothy Stimson Bullitt have made an offer to buy KING AM and FM. Patsy Collins and Harriet Bullitt intend to keep KING-FM's successful classical format and to keep KING(AM) news/talk. The sisters hope to continue using the KING call letters, KING-TV has been sold along with the other King TV stations to The Providence Journal Company. Still to be sold are KYAFM/KSFO San Francisco and KINK(FM)/KGW Portland, OR.

The SUN Radio Network of Clearwater, FL may be for sale according to an article in the Milwaukee Journal. The Journal reports that Liberty Lobby one of the backers of SUN is shopping the network along with flagship station WEND for 8.5 million dollars. Since its inception SUN has been through a series of problems and bankruptcy. SUN and its sister network North America One provide 24 hour talk programming to radio stations on a barter basis.

The United Kingdom has awarded the first national FM licence to First National Radio. FNR will operate under the name "The Showtime Station". FNR beat out three other applicants for the eight year commercial licence. The licence carries with it a fee of 1.75 million pounds (approximately 2.92 million dollars) per year. FNR will program show music from stage, screen and concerts and plans on drawing audience away from BBC Radio 2 and 4. The new service expects to begin operations in the summer of 1992. Still to be awarded are two national AM licenses for the U.K.

"Classical Countdown" debuts on KCSN-FM in Los Angeles this week and is the latest entry in weekly countdown field. This one has a twist as it counts down the top classical recordings of the week. Based on top-40 countdown shows "Classical Countdown" will offer new releases, artist interviews and a little bit of fun. The program is being made available to public stations nationwide. The program is produced by Rich Capparella.

The Commission has ordered a non-public investigation of Infinity's KROQ-FM Pasadena, CA. The inquiry concerns KROQ's broadcast of a hoax murder confession, as well as "additional information developed in an ongoing staff investigation." The Commission has directed the Chief ALJ "to require by subpoena the production of books, papers, correspondence, memoranda and other records deemed relevant to this inquiry; and to require witnesses to testify and produce evidence in Section 409 of the Communications act of 1934." The results of the inquiry are to be sent to the Commission for appropriate action.

The Commission has denied the request of Southern California Broadcasting Company for a reduction of a \$10,000 fine at KIEV for sponsorship identification violations. KIEV argued for mitigation of the fine claiming that the violations were inadvertent. The Commission stated that inadvertence is ignorance of the law, which the Commission does not consider a mitigating circumstance.

The Commission waived the one-to-a-market rule and granted the assignment of WBJU-TV to International Broadcasting Corporation. International is the licensee of WVOZ(FM) Carolina, PR. The waiver was granted because the TV station's bankruptcy meet the "failed station" criteria.

In a separate one-to-a-market case the Commission denied the Committee for Community Access (CCA) reconsideration of its decision granting a waiver to WHDH(AM) and WHDH-TV, Boston. CCA based its request in part on the absence of a full-time station in Boston with a format that serves the needs of the city's minority community demonstrated that the city lacked the diversity of media outlets sufficient to justify a waiver. The Commission stated that CCA presented no evidence to support its allegation that it would be adversely affected by the FCC's grant of a waiver. Although CCA suggested that any concentration in control of ownership of media outlets in the Boston market would inhibit the development of a full-time "minority format" station, CCA submitted no evidence to support this conclusion. The Commission said that even assuming that the Boston market lacks a full-time radio station with a format that could be characterized as "minority-oriented," a substantial factual question has not been presented. Even when considered alone, the absence of such a station does not demonstrate the failure of the marketplace to serve the listening needs of the minority community. the Commission concluded that CCA had failed to show that those needs are not being met by other radio stations licensed in that market.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK (Cont'd)

Several Philadelphia groups have petitioned the FCC to deny the renewals of WEAZ AM/FM, WEGX, WIOQ, WIP, WPEN/WMGK, WMMR, WOGL AM/FM, WUSL, WXTU and WYSP. The petition was filed by the National Organization for Women, ACT-UP, Aspira, Black & White Men Together, Custody Action for Lesbian Mothers and the Philadelphia Lesbian & Gay Task Force. The petitioners claim the stations failed to broadcast sufficient programming on issues of concern to them. Earlier the FCC rejected similar claims filed against renewals of several Philadelphia TV stations.

In two separate actions the Commission has denied requests for tax certificates. Both request from S/G Communications and from Radio Radio, Inc. were based on atypical procedures used in the RKO settlement proceeding. Denying the request, the Commission said that it was unable to find a change in policy or the adoption of a new policy of the type contemplated by the Internal Revenue Code. To the contrary, through the RKO settlements, the Commission sought to achieve a specific remedy based on particular facts in order to terminate a complex adjudication.

The Society of Broadcast Engineers Chapter 28 Newsletter reports that the FCC is inspecting stations by mail. Lucky broadcasters receive a 30 page questionnaire by registered mail. The detailed survey which requires copies of logs to support answers must be returned within 15 day.

The Commission commends broadcasters for their use of EBS to disseminate emergency information. The FCC has been receiving reports of EBS activations at a record rate. Since February 15, 1991 122 stations have activated the EBS 634 times.

In other FCC actions: The commission dismissed a petition for reconsideration from Edens Broadcasting, Inc., WRBQ-FM Tampa, FL, regarding a denied short-spaced tower site. Upheld a ruling by the Mass Media Bureau returning as unacceptable a application from KIQI, San Francisco for 30,000 watts day/ 1,000 watts night. Upheld a Review Board decision which dismissed as untimely, an appeal by Opal Chadwell. Afforded an extension of time to Maricopa County Community College District and Arizona Board of Regents for Arizona State University until October 1, 1991 within which to file a plan for joint operation (share time) of a proposed new noncommercial FM on 89.5 in Phoenix. Designated for hearing the mutually exclusive applications of Center for Study and Application of Black Economic Development to renew the license of KUCB-FM and the applications of Iowa Acorn Broadcasting Corporation and Minority Communications, Inc. for 89.3 MHz in Des Moines, IA.

CANADA THIS WEEK

The CRTC has issued the results of public comment on public notice (1990-86). In September, 1990 the CRTC asked for comments regarding a proposal to eliminate the distinction between beer, wine, cider, coolers and spirits from the Television Broadcast Regulations, 1987, the Radio Regulations, 1986 and the Specialty Services Regulations, 1990. Under the proposed amendments the advertising of spirits would be subject to the same rules as alcoholic beverages with 7% or less of distilled spirits. The CRTC received a total of 582 comments as follows. Most comments (79%) were from individuals. Less than 1% of individuals favored permitting broadcast advertising if spirits; 35% favored retaining the status quo, and the majority (64%) wanted all alcoholic beverages to be banned without exception, from broadcast advertising. Government responses primarily supported the idea of a ban, interest group responses were close to those of individuals and broadcast industry responses were all in support of allowing the advertising. At the present time The Association of Canadian Distillers is putting up a challenge to the constitutional validity of the CRTC's prohibition against the advertising of spirits. The CRTC has decided that in light of the legal challenge and that few comments supporting a change were received they would not alter the regulations.

The CBC has surrendered to the CRTC its broadcasting licences for CBPX and CBPY Yoho National Park. The Canadian Parks Service has advised the CBC that the transmitters will not be going on air.

ELSEWHERE

Last week we ran a report from the Milwaukee Journal that the Sun Radio Network might be for sale, this week Larry Wyman, President of Kayla Satellite Broadcasting Network, Inc., owner of Sun responds "Sun is not for sale." Larry says Sun is alive and well, he also would like to set the record straight that while Liberty Lobby is a stock holder in Kayla it does not control the operations of the network.

ELSEWHERE (Cont'd)

The latest (May) RAB sales figures for radio show year-to-date revenue down 3.7% vs. a 5.2% decline in the first quarter of 1991. Revenue for the month of May was down 2.9% over the same period in 1990. Local revenue was down 3.1% following a 5.2% increase in April. National revenue was down 2.3%, after an April decrease of 0.6%. The accounting firms of Miller Kaplan Arase & Co. and Hungerford Aldrin Nichols & Carter provide the figures on more than 100 markets RAB uses to calculate its revenue index.

More hoax news this week as Steve White, talk host on WALE Providence, RI, loses his job over an incident where by White had an engineer at the station announce that White had been shot outside the stations studios. Listeners were let in on the hoax about 10 minutes later with the news that it had been a "dramatization."

The ABC Radio Networks will convert their satellite transmissions to SEDAT (Spectrum Efficient Digital Audio Technology) on Monday, July 29th at 3:30pm. SEDAT provides ABC the ability to feed programming over a greater number of channels (from 19 to 57) with a higher audio quality. ABC is providing equipment to affiliates free of charge. Look for more innovative services from ABC in the future, with the added capacity ABC is free to try new ideas without disrupting their primary network services.

Unistar's "Super Gold" Saturday night oldies show is moving from Los Angeles to Disney-MGM Studios in Orlando, FL on July 27th. "Super Gold" becomes the first full time tenant at the Disney-MGM radio studios. "Super Gold" is on 275 stations, if you would like to be one of them give Unistar a call at (719) 576-3438.

The European Broadcasting Union, in cooperation with the NAB, will hold an international symposium on DAB in Montreux immediately preceding the NAB Radio Montreux show in June 1992. The symposium will evaluate the situation for DAB after the World Administrative Radio Conference in March 1992 and assess the possibilities for the introduction of DAB in various parts of the world.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

The Commission has renewed the licences of WIBZ-FM, Wedgefield, SC and WDXY, Sumter, SC unconditionally over the objections and petitions filed by the NAACP and the National Black Media Coalition. A short term license renewal for WAVF-FM, Hanahan, SC was also granted. After review the FCC found that improvement was needed in WDXY and WIBZ's record keeping but the stations did engage in recruitment efforts that resulted in referrals and hires. The Commission found WAVF to be out of compliance with EEO rules and issued a notice of apparent liability for \$13,000.

The NAB is asking federal regulators to assert their authority and remove arbitrary local barriers that impose the best placement of broadcast towers and consumer antennas. The NAB feels the FCC has the authority to supersede local and state zoning laws. The NAB cites as proof the long, established constitutional powers of the federal government to centralize the regulation of interstate and foreign communications.

More news on the FCC's self inspection survey. The self inspection by mail reported on last week was a test document sent to nine California stations (more than nine require full paperwork disclosure with the appropriate government agencies.) According to the FCC stations will not be penalized for problems reported, as long as they are corrected. If the test is deemed a success the survey may be sent to all stations as soon as early 1992. Items on the list include EEO records, EBS tests, the public file, Chief operator inspection reports, operator licences and information on antennas, antenna lighting and paint jobs.

Short wave news: The application of Weiner Broadcasting Company for a construction permit for a new international broadcast station at Monticello, ME was denied. Eternal Word Television Network, Inc. filed an application for a construction permit for a 500,000 watt international station at Birmingham, AL.

The Commission has overturned a Review Board order remanding to the ALJ the proceeding involving five mutually exclusive applications for a new class A FM station on 96.1 MHz at Huron, OH. It also vacated an order by the ALJ dismissing the application of Luipold Broadcasting, Inc.

A Review Board decision granting the application Beach Broadcasting Limited Partnership for a new FM on 94.5 at Long Beach, MS was upheld by the Commission. The Review Board had granted the application to Beach Broadcasting because of its clear advantage in duration of local residency and slightly superior civic participation of its principal. The Commission was not persuaded by competing applicant Manuel Lima's arguments concerning Beach's financial qualifications, stating that they were based on speculation unsupported by specific allegations raising a substantial and material question of fact.

In other docket actions the Commission upheld a Review Board decision granting the application of James River Communications Corporation for a new FM on 101.1 MHz at Richmond, VA; upheld the grant of Shore Media Inc.'s application for a new FM on 103.1 at Bay Shore, NY; denied Julia S. Zozaya reconsideration of its order which upheld a Review Board decision granting the application of Flagstaff Broadcasting Partnership for a new FM station in Flagstaff, AZ and denying the competing applications of Zozaya and Flagstaff Broadcasting Foundation.

CANADA THIS WEEK

The CRTC has released a special Tete-A-Tete reporting the comments received from Canadian's about their broadcasting and telecommunications systems. The CRTC received more than 40,000 phone calls and 7,000 letters last year alone. The report contains global and detailed information and statistics on a variety of topics of public interest. Copies of the report are available by contacting the CRTC Information Service or any CRTC Regional Office.

Bad news for CKRA Edmonton as the CRTC grants only a two year licence renewal. The CRTC found CKRA broadcast commercials in excess of the daily maximum and failed to meet its foreground program commitment.

CANADA THIS WEEK (Cont'd)

Worse news for CHRC Quebec City as they receive their third one year renewal. The CRTC found no significant improvement since the last short term renewal. The primary problem is with morning talk host Andre Arthur and comments he has made. Along with the renewal comes six conditions; 1) CHRC must retain logger tapes of all broadcasts for six months. 2) They must inform the CRTC of any judgments of settlements regarding defamation actions taken against is/or its host Andre Arthur, as a consequence of on-air remarks by Andre Arthur during CHRC broadcasts. 3) Adhere strictly to requirements of a CRTC letter. 4) Inform their audience of the existence of the guidelines daily immediately before the Open Line program. 5) Adhere to the CAB Sex-Role Portrayal Code. 6) Adhere to the CAB Broadcast Code for Advertising to Children.

ELSEWHERE

CBS will buy WCCO from Midwest Communications, Inc. According to a CBS announcement they will pay 200 million dollars for WCCO(AM), WLTE(FM), WCCO-TV all in Minneapolis, WFRV-TV in Green Bay, as well as Midwest Cable & Satellite and Midwest Sports Channel a regional sports cable channel. The transaction marks a return of WCCO(AM) to the CBS family as it was owned by CBS from 1931 to 1952. CBS plans to ask for a FCC waiver of its "one to a market" rule and in an industry first will request a waiver of the "12-12-12" rule, CBS already owns 12 FM stations. CBS is asking for the waiver pending outcome of the FCC's current proceeding to review its radio ownership limits.

So you want more info on DAB and digital audio (you gluten you) the NAB will give us a whole day on DAB at Radio 1991 in San Francisco. A day long seminar on starting Friday morning September 13th will offer presentations on equipment and software for digital audio storage and distribution. WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

The House Energy and Commerce Committee has approved the idea of a class based user fee for broadcasters. Under the latest version of the plan Class C & B FM's along with Class I AM's will pay \$500 a year all other stations would pay \$100 a year. From here it is on to the full House. The NAB through Edward Fritts attacked the tax as "unrelated to the services provided" and "a double hit, since broadcasters already pay their share of a substantial cost of regulation."

The National Black Media Coalition has found another target in Salem Communications. The Coalition has challenged the transfer of WAVA(FM) Washington, DC from Emmis to Salem. The Coalitions usual charges of a bad record in minority hiring are being filed.

The Commission has upheld the Mass Media Bureau's dismissal of the application of Rita A. Capobianchi for a new class A FM station on 94.5 MHz at Murrells Inlet, SC, for failure to respond to Commission requests for documentary proof of her financial qualifications. In seeking reconsideration, Capobianchi did not address the reason for her dismissal, instead, she argued for the first time that the selection of her application for random verification of her financial certification violated the administrative due process principle that similarly situated applicants be treated similarly. The Commission denied her application because it was undisputed that she failed to prosecute her application by knowingly ignoring the Commission's official written request for information.

**WASHINGTON THIS WEEK (Cont'd)**

Southern Virginia Broadcasting Corp., former licensee of WSVS AM and FM at Crewe, VA, failed to respond to the Notice of Apparent Liability for inadequate EEO efforts. Therefore the Commission ordered the company to forfeit the sum of \$15,000 to the U.S. Government.

The Commission has upheld the Review Board's decision to grant Horace Perkins application for a new class A FM station on 107.5 MHz in Columbus, OH, and dismissed the petition for reconsideration filed by Mid-Ohio Radio Limited. The Commission noted that Mid-Ohio's petition was procedurally deficient and repetitious since it repeated arguments already considered and rejected by the Commission.

Ethnic Radio of Las Banos's application for an experimental synchronous AM station at San Jose, CA to operate simultaneously with primary station KLBS, Los Banos on the same frequency 1330KHz but with 20 watts directional was dismissed.

In other actions the Commission: upheld a Review Board decision granting the application of Beach Broadcasting Limited Partnership for a new class A FM station on 94.5 MHz at Long Beach, MS, and denying the competing application of Manuel Lima; upheld a Review Board decision granting the application of James River Communications Corporation for a new class A FM station on 101.1 MHz in Richmond, VA; denied the petition to rescind or revoke filed by Spitzer Communications, Co. against the substitution of 104.1 C1 for 104.1 C at Rapid City, SD; upheld a Review Board dismissal of Sharron Annette Haley's application for a new class A FM station on 94.7 MHz at Sumter, SC, for her failure to demonstrate that she was financially qualified to construct and operate the proposed station.

**WASHINGTON THIS DECADE**

The FCC has released a Public Notice reminding us of a few basic radio rules for licensed and unlicensed broadcast stations. For unlicensed AM stations the power is restricted to 0.05 watts (100mW to the final RF stage, unlimited power is allowed on a college or university campus as long as the field strength does not exceed 24000/F(KHz) uV/meter at 30 meters outside of the campus. Approximate maximum coverage 200 feet. Unlicensed FM stations have a 0.01 microwatts limit and have an approximate coverage of 200 feet. There are no restrictions on content or operating hours for unlicensed stations operating under part 15. Unlicensed TV broadcasting is not allowed in the TV bands.

On the Licensed side of the world; The power minimum for AM is 250 watts and for FM its 100 watts. Commercial stations must operate at least 2/3 of total hours authorized between 6am and 6pm and between 6pm and 12mid. Non-commercial AM stations have no minimum operating hours, however actual hours of operation are taken into account in renewal applications. FM stations must operate a minimum of 5 hours per day 6 days a week and at least 36 hours per week. FM stations licensed to educational institutions must operate a minimum of 5 hours per day Monday - Friday, and at least 36 hours per week, except for official school holidays. FM translators have a maximum power of 250 watts and no minimum operating hours. FM boosters have maximum power of 20% of the primary stations power and have no minimum operating hours.

Gannett's Chicago urban FM WGCI has been hit with its second employment discrimination suite. Shannon Dell receives \$48,000 a year for her mid-day air shift. The men on the air before and after her reportedly make more than \$600,000. Dell has filed a sex bias suit against Gannett in Federal court. This comes after overnight personality Irene Mojica filed a suite charging sex discrimination and harassment. Mojica has worked for WGCI for 12 years and receives \$30,000 for her overnight shift. M Street - Just because radio is "Show Biz" does not release it from laws governing the employment of people. With several cases now in the courts, play it safe and check your stations employment policies.

ELSEWHERE (Cont' d)

Baseball adds a major market FM next year as the Atlanta Braves move from WSB to Jacor Broadcasting's WPCH(FM) and WGST(AM). Night games will be played on both stations, day games will only air on the AM. Football has had some success on the FM side but this is the first time a major market FM has carried more than a few games out of a season. The Braves have signed a three year deal with Jacor. WGST will also air the Atlanta Hawks. M Street - the thing to watch here is WPCH's success in adding males to the FM, will it be at the expense of female numbers?
