WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

The Commission did not issue broadcast applications or action for Friday, June 26, but was busy earlier this week as they canceled 49 various AM construction permits, and continues to do its housecleaning of unbuilt CP's. Last week, the Commission killed off 42 CP's, mostly FM's. A couple of the canceled CP's are for stations that are currently on the air, but may not have filed licenses to cover.

Two mutually exclusive applicants for 91.7 MHz in Austin, Texas have both been granted the frequency on an unusual time-sharing basis. The Texas Educational Broadcasting Cooperative, Inc. and the University of Texas at Austin will share the frequency based on an alternating-day schedule determined by ALJ Edward Luton in a decision last week. In 1990, the applicants met to try to work out an agreeable schedule for each entity, but failed after University play-by-play schedules conflicted with the Cooperative's proposal that stated it would have the frequency from 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Monday through Friday, and all hours Saturday and Sunday. Luton granted both applications stating that the Cooperative will broadcast Monday, Wednesday, Friday, and alternating Sundays, while the University will operate on Tuesday, Thursday, Saturday and alternating Sundays. If exceptions are not filed within 30 days and the Commission does not review the case on its own motion, the decision will become effective in 50 days.

Radio Moultrie, Inc., licensee of WMGA Moultrie, Georgia, got hit with a Notice of Apparent Liability of \$10,000 for a transfer of control without FCC consent. This past April, an assignment application was filed for a transfer that actually took place in 1990, when James Hardy, a 50 percent owner of the station sold his share of the station to James Charles Elder, Sr. Another illegal transfer took place in July 1990 after Elder transferred shares to G. Christopher Elder as a gift.

Another illegal transfer brought a \$10,000 fine to Mountain Signals, Inc., licensee of WETB Johnson City, Tenn. A transfer from Alpha-Omega Broadcasting, Inc. to Mountain Signals that took place in May, 1989 was not filed until October. Mountain Signals unsuccessfully argued that it really didn't take control of the station until October, and even if it did, it is not able to pay the fine.

The Commission granted a request by Jack A. Thompson, Jr., licensee of WORJ(AM), Oak Ridge TN, and cancelled the station's license. The station has been silent for some time.

Because of its previous clean record as a Commission licensee, Crista Ministries, Inc., licensee of KCIS/KCMS, Edmonds, Wash. had its fine reduced from \$7,500 to \$6,000 for not allowing access to its public inspection file. In September, 1991, an FCC field inspector's request to view the file was denied. The inspection was triggered after a citizen complained that the stations' operations manager denied access because "the stations were too busy."

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK (cont'd)

The NAB named its current VP/Broadcaster Congressional Relations John David to replace Lynn Christian as Senior VP/Radio. Tribune Broadcasting's Wayne Vriesman was elected NAB Radio Board chairman this week at the NAB joint board meeting in Washington. Bob Fox, owner of KVEN/KHAY Ventura, Calif. was named vice chairman.

NAB Radio membership was flat from one year ago. April 1 membership was 4,888 vs. 4,872 from a year ago. According to a release, 1990 commercial AM membership is 2,094, down from 2,134 in 1991. The NAB attributed the lack of growth to an aggressive dues collection program, causing more stations than normal to resign.

ELSEWHERE

Just change that first letter. Former NAB Senior/VP radio Lynn Christian has joined the Radio Advertising Bureau (RAB) as senior vice president/West Coast region. Christian will represent the RAB for all West Coast activities, but will continue to produce the Marconi Awards for the NAB at the fall radio show in New Orleans this fall. Christian replaces RAB VP/Stations J. Ray Padden, and will join the RAB on a full-time basis after the radio show.

National spot radio for May was up one percent over a year ago according to the Radio Advertising Bureau's radio revenue index. Local revenue posted its fifth straight monthly gain, up one percent, while the slide in national revenue continued, down six percent. However, this figure is slightly better than April's eight percent drop in national revenue. Overall, local and national spot radio was down one percent for the month of May. The accounting firms of Miller Kaplan Arase & Co. and Hungerford Aldrin Nichols & Carter provide the local and national spot revenue data. According to the Radio Network Association, network revenue was down 13 percent from a year ago for the period January through May.

Home Shopping Network founder Lowell "Bud" Paxson continued his Florida spending spree, announcing that he is buying Metroplex's WPRD Winter Park and WMGF Mount Dora (Orlando), FL, as well as Capitol Broadcasting's WVRI Cocoa Beach (Orlando), FL. Paxson is already in a LMA with WMGF. In Jacksonville, Paxson is purchasing Rowland First City Radio's WAIA St. Mary's, and Metroplex's WFYV Jacksonville. Paxson already owns WROO Jacksonville and is awaiting approval to acquire WNZS from Panamedia, Inc. In the Orlando market, he has WHVE Cocoa Beach and WWNZ Orlando, and will sell off WHVE when the purchase is completed.

In a surprise move, Associated Press Broadcast Services cut the term of its contracts from five years to two and started a new wire service catering to stations using AP services for drive times and bulletins only. The new service will cost between \$40 and \$325 per week and responds to the launch of competing services by CBS/Zapnews and ABC/Reuter's/Gannett.

Blaming soft sales and rights fees for sports, CBS laid-off 15 percent of its radio network staff this week. According to *Inside Radio*, 22 people were let go last Friday. The cutbacks will affect all departments, including programming, research, marketing, and sales.

Arson destroyed the studios of WSOS St. Augustine, FL (Jacksonville) last Tuesday night, June 23. At approximately 8:10 p.m., a neighbor spotted the blaze that took fire fighters approximately 30 minutes to put out. Investigators believe that the station's recent switch to a satellite adult contemporary format may have been the motive for the fire. According to *Inside Radio*, investigators would not comment on where the fire started or whether or not an accelerant was used. The station was back on the air from the transmitter site late Wednesday night.

Scott Simon, National Public Radio's host for *Weekend Edition* on Saturday, will take a year's leave of absence to become a co-host of the NBC television program "Weekend Today." Simon, who joined NPR in 1977 as chief of its Chicago bureau, has hosted *Weekend Edition* on Saturday since its debut in November, 1985. Simon is expected to continue to file periodic stories for NPR.

Ask WPKE in Pikesville KY to rattle off the "Who's on First" routine and you may get an answer you didn't expect. The station has created two LMA "networks," while running a stand-alone station, as well. Eastern Kentucky Radio Network, which owns country WDHR, Pikeville, has created two music networks also operated out of WDHR's studios. This first network, which is adult contemporary, is on WDHR's co-owned sister stations WPKE, Pikeville and WVKY, Louisa. The AC format is also on two stations the network has LMA'd--WBPA, Elkhorn City and WPRT Prestonsburg. The second network runs an oldies format and is on three stations the network has LMA'd--WLSI, Pikeville; WRAU, Elkhorn City; and WXXZ-FM, Prestonsburg. Both networks promote themselves as "Big Sandy Valley Radio."

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

Just in case there were any broadcasters buying into that stuff about an economic recovery, the Federal Communications Commission and the National Assn. of Broadcasters have both issued reports that will disabuse anybody of that notion.

The FCC's five year broadcast industry employment report -- covering the radio/TV and cable industries for the years 1987-91 -- finds that total broadcast employment for radio and TV was down from 158,779 jobs in 1990 to 155,311 in 1991. The numbers are much more startling when you look at the five year trend. In 1987-89, employment held steady at about 176,000 jobs before a dip from 175,599 in 1989 to 158,799 the following year as LMAs and other cost-cutting measures began to take hold. On the cable side, however, there were an extra 4,000 jobs created between 1990 and 1991 (102,656 to 106,771).

The NAB's 1992 Financial Report, meanwhile, finds that 58.6% of all radio stations lost money in 1991: 64.9% of all full-time AMs, 67.5% of all daytimers, 56% of all AM/FM combos, and 55.3% of all standalone FMs were thus affected. (Interestingly, there are no such numbers for post-LMA-era mutant combos.) More than half of the FMs lost more than \$10,000 last year; more than half the AMs lost over \$19,000. The NAB services department would like to sell you this report for \$125 (member stations) or \$225 (non-member stations.) Just hope those pesky employees of yours aren't hanging around demanding to be paid when the mailman delivers it.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK (cont'd)

From the "Blame It On Mexico" department: The FCC has upheld its denial of FM licenses to two applicants who did not "comply with power and antenna height limitations sent forth in a bilateral agreement between the U.S. and Mexico." Pike Family Broadcasting's application for an FM in Rancho Mirage, Calif., and Charles Morris, et al's application for a new FM in Central N.M. were both shot down pursuant to the FCC's "hard look" FM processing rules.

The Commission has denied Jemez Mountain Broadcasters review of a Mass Media Bureau decision which returned its application for a new FM station on 94.7 MHz at Santa Fe because it was unacceptable for filing because its short-spaced waiver request was deficient. Jemez's proposed transmitter site was short-spaced to KZRR-FM in Albuquerque.

The Commission also affirmed a Review Board decision which granted the application of Kevin Potter for a new FM station on 107.9 MHz at Gainesville, Texas, and denied the competing application of Mark Rodriguez, Jr. In seeking the review, Rodriguez contended that Potter deserved no integration credit and that his own credit for half-time integration outweighed Potter's diversification preference.

In the wake of the mass of canceled and expired CP's over the last two weeks, a few stations have reacted by filing for extensions and reinstatements. One in particular--KBFS-FM, Belle Fourche, SD, was granted a change in class from A to C2 AFTER its license was canceled. KHUA in Seward, Alaska, has filed a petition for reconsideration of its cancellation.

Six stations have been slapped with fines and conditional license renewals after EEO violations. The Michigan divisions of the NAACP and the National Black Media Coalition filed petitions to deny the renewals of WWJQ and WJQK, Zeeland; WMAX and WKLQ, Grand Rapids; and WGRD AM & FM, Grand Rapids charging that the stations' EEO programs were "unproductive and devoid of minority-specific sources" after interviewing quotas weren't met. WMAX was fined \$7,500. WGRD AM & FM were fined \$5,000. WKLQ was fined \$2,000. WWJQ/WJQK were not fined.

ELSEWHERE

For the third time in its four year history, the Business Radio Network has been sold, this time to an L.A.-based group headed by ex-Sports Entertainment Network principal Richard Grisar. Current owners Lester & Gary Loo and Richard Faulkner will maintain some BRN stock. Grisar becomes President/CEO. BRN's statement says its all-business/financial format "will be expanded to include greater sports programming."

A month after Dave Scott left TM Century, major stockholder Marjorie McIntyre has been named Chairman of the Board. Acting CEO Craig Turner is now president/CEO.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

About the time you read this, the Electronic Industries Assn., will be holding a July 16 meeting of its subcommittee on Digital Audio Broadcasting where it is expected to discuss "voting allocations" in the DAB standard selection process. That worries the National Assn. of Broadcasters which fears that the EIA will give "terrestrial" broadcasters only two votes out of a total of 12, as opposed to four for receiver manufacturers, two for radio networks, and four for other suppliers. At press time, NAB Sr. VP Michael Rau was trying to rally broadcasters to pack the EIA meeting to protest the group's proposal, lobbying instead to hold on to the group's previous "consensus process."

The Commission affirmed several station grants this week. Shore Media, Inc.'s grant for a new FM on 103.1 MHz at Bay Shore, NY was upheld after a set of appeals were filed by a competing applicant, Long Island Music Broadcasting Company. Weiss Broadcasting of Noblesville, Inc.'s grant of a new FM on 93.9 MHz at Noblesville, IN survived applications for review by Bible Broadcasting Network, Broadcast Communications, and Ben L. Umberger. Scottsdale Talking Machine and Wireless Co., Inc.'s grant of 105.9 MHz at Paradise Valley, AZ was upheld in response to applications for review by Hope Valley FM L.P., Paradise Valley Broadcasters, Gil L. Lyons, and American International Diversified.

A superior integration proposal by John Edward Ostland helped to uphold his grant of 99.3 MHz at Fresno, CA. Valley Radio sought the reconsideration in that case.

The Commission affirmed a review board decision granting Anne K. and William F. Wallace's CP for a new FM on 99.5 MHz at Rancho Mirage, Calif., after integration credit was contested Daniel P. Mitchell, a competing applicant.

Thomas W. Lawhorne kept his grant of 102.1 MHz at Sylvester, Georgia, after the Commission denied an application for review filed by CAM Broadcasting, the other applicant in the comparative proceeding. CAM was disqualified for failure to meet its burden under a tower site availability issue.

Kennelwood Broadcasting Company, Inc.'s grant of a new FM on 94.5 MHz at Waco, Texas was upheld after a petition for reconsideration filed by competing applicant Excelsior Communications was denied. Excelsior argued that the order granting Kennelwood's application was inconsistent with a recent review board decision in another case regarding integration credit. That case has not yet been considered by the Commission.

The Commission dismissed a joint application for review filed by Double D Broadcasting Company, permittee of KRAB, Green Acres, Calif., and Armando Garcia, permittee of a new station at Guadalupe, Calif. The application was filed a day late because of "a last minute failure of council's word processing system." The commission denied the request for acceptance, noting the parties should allow enough time to meet cut-off deadlines to account for such unanticipated delays.

Anchor Broadcasting, L.P.'s grant for a new FM on 99.3 MHz at Selbyville, Del. was upheld, pursuant to a remand from the court of appeals. The Commission rejected arguments by competing applicants Galaxy Communications and Susan M. Bechtel that the traditional integration criterion should not be used in this case.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK (cont'd)

The Commission revoked the license of WPSC(AM) in Pageland, SC, after repeated attempts to contact the licensee, Sandhill Broadcasting Company. The station has been silent since September 13, 1989.

The Indiana District of the Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod, Inc., license of non-commercial WLAB, Fort Wayne, got off with a slap on the wrist after promoting a products for a music store during a remote broadcast. The station was admonished, despite assurances that the station received no direct remuneration from the record store.

Not that anybody seemed to be taking a "wait and see" attitude anymore anyway, but *Inside Radio* reports that FCC Chairman Al Sikes told the crowd at the July 17 Upper Midwest Conclave meeting that the FCC's proposed new ownership rules could take place almost immediately after the commission's scheduled August 5 meeting to discuss the changes. *Inside Radio* says Sikes would then move with "no incubation period."

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK (cont'd)

Technically, we should have an "Ottawa This Week" section for this one, but it relates to the aforementioned. Canada gets its first U.S.-style LMA this week in Sault Ste. Marie, Ontario where rival operators Telemedia and Pelmorex have agreed to shut down their AMs and move their FMs in to one joint operation. Canada's industry trade, The Record, says country CFYN and top 40 CKCY will close their eyes forever on August 30, leaving the market to country CJQM and soft AC CHAS.

The National Assn. of Broadcasters has come out in favor of the FCC proposal that would allow institutional investors to increase their passive investment in a station from 10% to 20% without having the stations attributed to them vis-a-vis FCC ownership and reporting rules. NAB is also behind FCC proposals to revise the status of a limited partner and one that doubles the attribution rule for an active investor from five to 10%. The NAB says this will expand the financing available to potential station owners, but it still opposes the use of station licenses as collateral--something which some industry observers believe would open up even MORE pocketbooks.

If you're looking for a souvenir of the '92 election beyond that forlorn-looking Perot sticker, the NAB is now offering pads of 100 station/candidate spot buying contracts called "the agreement form for political broadcasters" that takes the new political time rules into account. Contact the NAB member service department at 800-368-5644.

Randy Odeneal's WLLR, Davenport IA number was up this week after the Commission fined the station \$12,500 for not being able to follow through on payments to a 1989 winner of Unidyne's Last Number Bonus Game, even though the station's agreement with the now-defunct promotion company specifies that the station is not responsible for the prize. The Commission said that even though Unidyne was responsible for the prize money, the contest was presented as a station-conducted contest. The base fine of \$6,250 was doubled because WLLR didn't make sure that the prize money was available.

Not two weeks after kicking several stations for failure to comply with them, the FCC has relaxed its "hard look" rules for station applications. The hard look rules, meant to force broadcasters to file cleaner, easier-to-digest Docket 80-90 applications, have been replaced by a three-step process in which stations will have 30 days after the close of a filing window to amend an application and another 30 days to correct any mistakes in the application pointed out by the commission. Not until the third stage of the process will stations have to make a "traditional showing of good cause" if they have problems with their filings, the FCC says.

ELSEWHERE

Think this explains why he was trying to redistribute so many stations to his kids? Group owner Bishop L.E. Willis has, according to R&R, pleaded guilty to a federal anti-money laundering violation. The 13 AM/14 FM owner faces a possible five year jail sentence on top of what could happen to Willis' ability to sell some of his stations to family members.

For months, affiliates of the fast-growing Sports Entertainment Network have complained about the fact that they were, in effect, taking a straight feed of SEN's flagship outlet, KVEG, Las Vegas. Rebroadcasting a Las Vegas station meant carrying ads for things that local outlets might not have wanted for themselves, i.e., sports betting parlors and 1-900 sex-phone services. Now, newly arrived SEN PD Jack Hayes says the network has finally installed the equipment that allows it to feed national spots to the rest of the country while KVEG is running its local ads. Hayes, last at San Diego's XETRA, will maintain his San Diego-based consultancy.

He's the No. 1 morning man in New York. He's within a point of KLOS, Los Angeles' Mark & Brian. But Howard Stern can't be entirely happy this week. Stern, who fancied himself one of the few morning hosts to successfully crack TV--remember Rick Dees' "Into The Night"?--has lost his weekly TV show. Stern's home-base, New York's WWOR, cites "budgetary concerns" and "an inability to distribute the show widely to other stations." Stern's agent, for his part, has told the trade press that Howard plans to concentrate on movies now, anyway.

The Clearwater, Fla.-based Independent Broadcasters Network has added the following talk-hosts: issue-oriented Ellen Rattner (11 a.m.-noon ET), headline-oriented veteran newsman Mort Crowley (1-3 p.m. ET), liberal v. conservative "Battleline" hosts Barry Lynn, Robert G. Grant, and Peter Flaherty (3-5 p.m. ET), and consumer host Sally Bowers (2-4 p.m. ET, Saturday). In other web news, for those of you who don't feel like shelling out for three channels of pay-per-view, North East Satellite Entertainment's Don Michael Gerrard will broadcast live from Barcelona, Spain July 22-26 as part of the Coca Cola Olympic Radio Network. And CBS News airs a multi-part series on the success of democracy called "The American Experiment" on July 25-26.

Does United Press International owe you money? UPI CFO David Moir, acting on behalf of the new owners, Worldwide News, Inc., has issued a notice to UPI vendors that Worldwide is only responsible for debts incurred after June 28. Anything before that must be collected through an administrative claim against the estate of the former UPI. Vaya con Dios.

In a new study of member stations, the Radio Advertising Bureau says that 56% of its respondents said a female salesperson was the top biller at their station, a percentage that increased to 64% in markets 26-50. Despite this, only 26% of the same stations had female GSMS, with the male dominance being more pronounced in smaller markets.

According to *Inside Radio*, the New York medical examiner's office now says that veteran programmer Rick Sklar, who went into the hospital June 22 for minor foot surgery and never came out, died of "ventilatory insufficiency"--or a lack of oxygen after receiving general anesthesia. The coroner's office has classified Sklar's death as a "therapeutic complication." Roosevelt Hospital, where Sklar died, says the matter is still under investigation.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

Several years ago, KMEL, San Francisco PD Keith Naftaly told an interviewer that one of the things he wanted his station to have was a "sexual" vibe on-air. Apparently, the Federal Communications Commission has picked up KMEL's vibes. On July 24, the FCC sent KMEL its "notice of apparent liability," fining former owner Century Broadcasting \$25,000 for "indecent material" broadcast by p.m. driver Rick Chase on various dates between Aug. 20 and Sept. 16. The ruling, announced shortly after Century's sale of KMEL to another recent FCC opponent, Evergreen Media, points out that the broadcasts "aired at times when there was a reasonable risk that children may have been in the audience."

Some of the material the FCC objected to includes this dialogue between Chase and a caller--"You had oral sex." "You can't say that on the radio." "I can say any damn thing I want. I can say vaginal"--and a parody song featuring the lyrics "blow me/you hardly even know me/just set yourself below me/and blow me" Then there was Chase berating a male caller for expecting to score on the first date, then adding: "Don't go out with Al. He's got a canker sore on Mister Winkie" and "put it back in your pants, or wash it or something." It should, however, be noted that, judging from the transcripts-- the FCC's cutting edge cultural types apparently confused the rap hit "Knockin' Boots" by Candyman with "The Candy Man" by Sammy Davis, Jr. Of course, this makes you wonder what would happen if somebody at the FCC had heard "Knockin' Boots," but then again, that record is two years old and it took the FCC three years to hear "Erotic City."

The FCC has announced a 10-step application and allotment process for the AM expanded band. If it's approved in the next few months, your shot at being one of the lucky stations at, say, 1640 AM, would go like this: The FCC will issue a public notice 30 days before the opening of a two week filing window. After a week or so to process the applicants, it will issue another public notice acknowledging them, rank the applicants for interference (or whether they'd improve the existing AM band by leaving), and issue another public notice with these rankings, followed by a brief comment period. There will then be a 60-90 day "calculation of allotments" period which is "completely computerized with no human intervention" followed by another public notice to announce the allotments and a 30 day comment period. Stations will then have 60 days to file FCC form 301. After this, petitions to deny can be filed against applicants, but no competing applications will be accepted. Then another filing window will be established for unused allotments. For more info, call the FCC's Jim Buttle at (202) 254-9570.

The National Assn. of Broadcasters has sent a letter to the Federal Election Commission in support of EZ Communications' suggestion that it offer political candidates free ad time this year instead of dealing with the maze of new political ad rules. EZ has asked that commission for an advisory opinion that such time would not be deemed a campaign contribution. The NAB, in the last week, has also issued statements declaring itself pleased with the decision of Satellite CD Radio, Inc., to withdraw its application for an experimental DAB system, and with the National Radio System Committee's development of a Radio Broadcast Data Systems standard that covers AM as well as FM. It did not, however, endorse RBDS' format scanning feature or its list of format codes. The RBDS standards committee's next move is to a vote by the full NRSC committee.

Ladies & Gentlemen, The Heat Goes Down: Satellite Music Network says its long-troubled top 40 format The Heat won't be officially retooled into a new, yet-unnamed "Hot AC/Adult CHR" network until September, but you can already hear signs of a change already. Several years after SMN recast its Rock'n'Hits format as an "MTV on radio," including jocks who spoke in Wayne's World-ese, the network already sounds only a notch or so edgier than WKQI, Detroit or WAEB-FM, Allentown, Pa., other client stations of the format's new consultant, Gary Berkowitz. WKQI, not incidentally, is owned by Barry Mayo, already part of the SMN camp as a consultant to its urban/AC format, The Touch.

Here's what the Heat already sounds like at 7:30 p.m. eastern time: Gloria Estefan, "Live For Loving You," Eddie Money, "Fall In Love Again," Modern English, "I Melt With You," Celine Dion, "If You Asked Me To," Natural Selection, "Do Anything," George Michael, "Too Funky," Fine Young Cannibals, "Good Thing," and Tag, "The Way I Feel."

In another sign of CHR's current turmoil, the NAB's fall radio show, scheduled for New Orleans on Sept. 9-12, will feature a session called "Top 40 Legends on the State of Contemporary Radio Today" featuring panelists Buzz Bennett, Mike Joseph, and Paul Drew. NAB is also promoting a Sept. 11 session with Joint Communications consultant John Parikhal called "Baby Boom Secrets: How To Win 25-54" which it says "will be the first time Parikhal has publicly presented his latest research." Parikhal will, however, also be on hand for the Michigan Assn. of Broadcasters annual convention held August 6-8 in Gaylord, Mich., at the Treetops Sylvan Resort. Parikhal's presentation there will be called "Narrowing In On The Baby Boom." Detroit Pistons star Isiah Thomas who will not, to our knowledge, be an NAB speaker, will also address the MAB.



In case you were still worrying about new Washington Redskins flagship WTEM-570 and its allegedly spotty nighttime signal, the all-sports station has announced that the Skins will now be simulcast on its sister station, classical WGMS-103.5. Wondering how classical and football will go together? So are we.

And if you're still stinging over WWOR-TV's cancellation of the Howard Stern show, Stern has made good on his threat to show up in the movies, announcing a deal with New Line Cinema--home of "Nightmare On Elm Street" and the "Teenage Mutant Ninja Turtles"--for a faux-documentary about Stern's radio show which, it says, will be similar to the heavy-metal parody film, "This Is Spinal Tap."
