KSOL MORNING HOST SUSPENDED FROM BRIDGE: Notice how this is turning into the all-morning-show-suspensions-all-the-time item? KSOL San Francisco morning host Mancow Muller and sidekick Chewy Gomez were suspended, as of May 1, following the station's contention that it had no prior knowledge of the pair's intent to tie up Bay Bridge traffic for four hours last week. Mancow got a haircut on the bridge to parody Bill Clinton's now infamous haircut that tied up L.A. International Airport traffic. TOP 40 F.O.'S IN T.O.: Canada's dwindling AM top 40 format lost another key player on May 31 when longtime CHR outlet CFTR Toronto became "680 News." CFTR, which was reportedly trying to head off a rumored format change at rival CHOG (The Hog), had been top 40 since the early '70s and was generally regarded as the first "Q-format" top 40 in Canada at the time. Most of 'TR's staff is out with the format change. The rest of the week's format news follows.

SALES RESURGENCE CONTINUES: Combined national and local spot sales were up again for the month of April, although local revenue growth has slowed since its meteoric first quarter, this according to new figures from the Radio Advertising Bureau. Combined revenue is up 7%. Local revenue is up 6%, led by the southeast (10%) and southwest (13%). National revenue is up 10% paced by a 27% rise in the midwest. WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

Following a U.S. Court decision in April, the FCC has announced that it will allow broadcast advertising of casinos in Nevada. Local broadcasters say radio billing has picked up dramatically since the ban was lifted, with much of the new business allegedly coming at the expense of print advertising. It's also worth noting that Nationwide's tourist information AM KXNO was launched roughly at the same time the ban was lifted although the KXNO call letters had been secured some time earlier.

It was a light week for the Commission. For broadcast applications, grants and the like, it seems that not only was Monday a holiday, but Friday as well. No broadcast applications, actions, or texts were turned out on Friday. Wednesday was a light day, too. This issue of the journal reflects the easy week.

The Commission has dismissed an application filed by Edens Broadcasting, Inc. seeking review of the Mass Media Bureau's grant of Chapman S. Root Revocable Trust's application for a construction permit to modify the facilities of WEZY, Lakeland, FL. The permit allows WEZY to increase from 430 ft to 1050 ft. Edens' WRBQ-FM Tampa had filed an application to modify the facilities of the station. The application was short-spaced to WEZY's. The Commission had affirmed the Review Board's Decision denying Edens' application for modification of WRBQ-FM. Edens then asked the Commission to set aside the Bureau's grant of the Trust's application until the U.S. Court of Appeals for D.C. acts on Edens' appeal of the Commission's denial of its construction permit. Eden's appeal was denied, therefore, its request was dismissed as moot.

Lack of candor questions have led the Commission to designate for hearing the application to assign the construction permit of KCVI Blackfoot ID from Richard Bott II to Western Communications, Inc.

The mutually exclusive applications of Bott, Radio Representatives, Inc. and another applicant for the Blackfoot facility were designated for hearing in July, 1987. During the hearing, Bott received an integration preference based on his assertions that he would move to Blackfoot and serve as full-time General Manager. Bott's construction permit application was granted and that of RRI denied on the basis of the integration preference.

Nine months after the issuance of the construction permit, Bott entered into an agreement to assign his permit and filed an application with the Commission to implement the agreement. Bott represented that, throughout the comparative proceeding, he had always intended to operate with a commercial religious format but that the adoption of an identical format by another station in the market several months after the proceeding dramatically changed the market situation. However, the hearing record shows that Bott represented in that proceeding that his integration commitment was not contingent on the ability to implement a particular program format.

The Commission said there were substantial and material questions of fact concerning whether Bott, either in the course of the comparative license hearing or in the assignment proceeding, misled or lacked candor about his intention to act as a full-time General Manager. Therefore, the Commission has designated the application for hearing.

ELSEWHERE

Billboard magazine reports this week Group W plans to buy KBIS Little Rock--to shut it off. Even though the station is only 5000 watts at night and directional, they believe it interferes enough with 1010 WINS in New York to warrant the purchase. KBIS is currently news/talk/business and is owned by Signal Media.

Six months after abruptly shutting down, monitored airplay publication Monday Morning Replay is back in business. MMR will begin publishing a weekly data disc again on June 21 under previous publisher Rich Meyer. Unlike the previous editions of MMR, this one will be marketed primarily to radio programmers--not record labels. It will also feature national call-out info, something no other trade has attempted before. For more info, call 313-539-3363.

ELSEWHERE (cont'd)

Several weeks after Unistar announced the sales reorganization of its networks, Westwood One has reconfigured its networks also. The Westwood One News & Entertainment Network (WONE) has been "melded" into its existing NBC Radio Networks (WNBC) and Mutual Broadcasting System (WMBS). The Source (WSRC) remains untouched.

Four people, including KSOL San Mateo CA (San Francisco) morning host Mancow Muller, will go to court June 11 on charges stemming from Muller's Bay Bridge haircut stunt. Muller faces two misdemeanor counts; the others are just up on traffic charges.

The L.A. Daily News reports that former KPWR Los Angeles morning host and TV star Jay Thomas is suing KPWR for \$900,000 in breach of contract. KPWR fired Thomas last month. R&R reports that the station probably won't replace Thomas permanently until the matter is settled.

Rush Limbaugh has finally made it into the pages of what should be one of his favorite publications, Restaurant Business. The June RB reports that about 100-150 different eateries have "Rush Rooms," weekday lunchrooms where Rush's show is piped in for the like minded. Although one restaurant which closed its Rush Room was forced to reopen it after an on-air Limbaugh campaign, others have given up entirely, citing a lack of interest in menu items like H. Ross Perot shrimp and the "Feminist Sandwich," described on the menu as "braless chicken breast."

Beginning June 17, the Motor Sports Radio network will put its shows "Race Talk" and "Radio Road-Test" on Galaxy 6 satellite. For more info, call 607-770-9165. In other satellite news, AP has announced that it is moving its audio services from Galaxy 5 and SpaceNet III-R to GE's Satcom 5. It is also adopting Scientific Atlanta's SEDAT technology.

PRIDE GOETH BEFORE A DISPUTE: An Orlando-area 5,000 watter, once known as Pride AM, is off the air in a dispute between new owner Paxson Broadcasting and the people who had been leasing it pending a sale. WPRD Winter Haven--which was sold from Metroplex to Paxson--has been doing brokered talk under the auspices of RAMA Broadcasting. RAMA's Tom Holter says his group had a contract to buy the station which Paxson won't honor. RAMA has made an unsuccessful attempt at a restraining order to keep the station on the air. Paxson employees say the station went off the air to fix a "number of technical infractions" and rework its ground system. WPRD is set to return as all-sports outlet WWZN next month. Holter says RAMA has filed a breach of contract suit which will go to court in September. In other court news, WGAW Gardner, Mass., is off the air pending a bankruptcy court's approval of its reorganization plan that would allow it to return simulcasting WSRO Marlborough, Mass. This week's other news starts on page 7.

K.C. HAS A COW: WHB Kansas City, currently an oldies AM, will switch to a mix of country and farm news following its sale to Kanza, Inc. WHB, being spun off from the Malrite/Shamrock deal, will combine its own programming with that of soon-to-be-co-owned KMZU Carrollton, Mo. The station will be known as "Missouri's Farm Voice." KMZU GM Mike Carter says the station isn't expecting much in the 12+ department, but expects to make money with the station's low-end-of-the-dial coverage of surrounding counties. WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

Donna Searcy's name is familiar to anybody who's filed an FCC application since October, 1988, but now it's changing and so is she. Searcy, who will now be known by her married surname, Koehnke, is leaving to become secretary of the U.S. International Trade Commission. The FCC press release credits Searcy with eliminating the backlog at the FCC public reference room and helping to computerize the Commission.

The FCC has upheld an action by its Mass Media Bureau denying a complaint by Fairbanks' WVBF Framingham-Boston that Greater Media's WMJX was violating the blanketing interference rules and thus causing interference to WVBF. WMJX's sister station is WVBF's new country rival, WBCS. The commission pointed out that there hadn't been any actual listener complaints stemming from a modification of WMJX's license.

The Commission has upheld a staff action returning as unacceptable for filing the application of Sacramento Community Radio, Inc. for a new non-commercial educational FM at Sacramento. The application was ruled as untimely filed because of a "daisy chain," meaning it was mutually exclusive with another application governed by an earlier cut-off date.

The Commission has proposed relaxing its equipment authorization requirements to allow unapproved aural broadcast auxiliary transmitters to be used for backup purposes under limited circumstances. Beginning July 1, these auxiliary transmitters must be approved under the current equipment authorization program or removed from service. But, the Commission has proposed allowing any such transmitters removed from service to be retained for backup purposes up to 720 cumulative hours per year.

The Commission has affirmed the Mass Media Bureau's conditional grant of the application of Northern Illinois University and Rockford Educational Broadcasting Foundation for a new noncommercial station on 90.5 MHz at Rockford IL, and the return of the mutually exclusive application of Open Media Corp. for facilities in Chicago. Open Media sought review and reconsideration.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK (cont'd)

The NAB is initiating a study to develop "new techniques that will help radio and TV stations comply with proposed safety guidelines relating to electromagnetic fields caused by broadcast tower emissions." Interested parties should call the NAB's Kelly Williams at 202-775-4981 before the end of June. The NAB becomes the latest in a series of clients now represented to stations by the Colorado Springs-based Executive Broadcast Services. NAB is joined by the consultancy Teeson Media Services and MJM Research.

CANADA THIS WEEK

After years of prohibiting most religious broadcasting, the CRTC announced on June 3 that it would liberalize its 10-year-old policy and allow "individual faith group(s) to have a broadcasting service expressing [their] own point of view" as long as services are "balanced and provide diverse points of view on issues of public concern." There will also be new ethical guidelines for religious programs.

ELSEWHERE

Four years after Beasley Broadcasting caused a lot of oohing and aahing by buying KRTH-AM-FM Los Angeles for \$86.6 million, the FM has now been sold to Infinity for \$110 million giving the latter company an oldies/classic rock combo with its own KROQ. The press release calls the KRTH sale a world record, which is probably true, although the various transactions involved in the acquisition of WSKQ-FM New York came close to at least \$100 million.

Then again, if the folks at Infinity really think that \$40-million is small potatoes, maybe they aren't worried about the \$50-million lawsuit filed against the company as well as the GM and PD of WJFK Washington and p.m. drive team Don & Mike by WWMX Baltimore promotions director Dawn Tritaik who is charging invasion of privacy, defamation, and intentional infliction of emotional distress among other things. Tritaik says the duo announced on the air that she was a lesbian, something of which even her family was unaware, as well as claiming falsely that she was 300 pounds. This news comes about seven months after Don & Mike settled the \$15 million lawsuit by a D.C. P.R. woman who claimed she was attacked on-air.

R&R reports that a letter sent to an advertising agency by KIKI Honolulu GM Lee Coleman has caused a flap at the Office of Hawaiian Affairs. Coleman allegedly told the agency for an Accura dealer that his station's audience was "high income, white collar Caucasian and Japanese and not the Hawaiian or part-Hawaiian population," an apparent shot at Hawaiian-formatted KCCN-FM. The OHA chairman calls the statement "racist stereotyping" which Coleman denies.

Inside Radio says that Arbitron staffers will be carrying the new People Meter themselves this summer as a test of the new technology. Arbitron also says that there was an earlier "successful" test of the technology over Maryland Public TV earlier this year. Meanwhile, Canada's BBM has committed \$1-million to the new technology being developed by Martin Marietta Aero and Naval Systems.

Billboard also reports that California's Republican Party has filed a complaint with the state Fair Political Practices Commission against KFI Los Angeles, complaining that new Democratic Party chair Bill Press is hosting a show on the station. KFI's response is that Press has been a regular on the station for the last year and a half in advance of becoming the state chairman.

It's been a rough startup for Michael Bloomberg's WBBR New York-- no ratings to date despite an extensive (but dubiously targeted) ad campaign and an on-air product that only seems to be coming around now. But Bloomberg is already working on station #2 in an even larger market. Bloomberg is a partner in a four-person consortium that has filed for one of four AM licenses to be awarded by the U.K.'s Radio Authority.

ELSEWHERE (cont'd)

The Portland, Ore.-based Wieden & Kennedy agency was the \$100,000 winner at this year's Radio Creative Fund Mercury Awards for its Nike/"Hubble Telescope" spot. Another \$100,000 in prizes was divided between four \$20,000 Mercury gold and four \$5,000 Mercury silver winners. The best commercials M Street heard at the ceremony? The St. Louis Symphony Orchestra's "Beethoven" spot (a \$20,000 winner in the non-humor category) and a public service spot in which Stephen King describes the plight of the homeless in the style of one of his novels. Awards co-sponsor the Radio Advertising Bureau has also announced that it will offer inter-active correspondence training programs for radio salespeople and managers in cooperation with Chris Lytle & Associates.

KSOL San Francisco morning man Mancow Muller has gotten three years probation for his now-infamous Bay Bridge stunt. Muller will have to pay a total of \$1,000 and do 100 hours of community service. Whether KSOL will be allowed to have signage during said community service is not known.

In other morning-stunts-that-backfired news, former WNOR Norfolk owner Josephson has been fined \$45,000 by a Norfolk-area jury for a phone scam by morning host Henry Del Toro that took place eight years ago.

Ross Perot has been announced as the keynoter for this fall's NAB radio show in Dallas (Sept. 8-11); KIIS L.A. morning man Rick Dees will host the Marconi Radio Awards at the convention. If you're in Singapore on June 29, the NAB and the Pan Asia TV & Radio Industry Conference will be teaming up for a two hour seminar on emerging radio & TV technologies.

Following the sale and format change at WJZE Washington, D.C., now WBIG-FM, displaced PD Bob Linden has taken an ad in the local alternative paper promising to "knock... on the door of every radio station" until he finds a new home for the station's format and publishing his home number, 301-283-2076. Linden writes "If the fruits of my labor of love in presenting my special world of music to you sweetened your life with just a little more happiness, then I am filled with joy." Independent Broadcasters Network hosts Doug Stephan and Ellen Ratner will broadcast live from Russia and the Ukraine on June 22-25 as part of their coverage of a trip to Kiev and Moscow by USAID Administrator J. Brian Atwood.

Unistar will offer the three hour "Beach Boys Story" on the July 4th weekend hosted by WCBS-FM New York p.m. driver Bob Shannon. For more info, call 800-225-3270.

Finally, congrats to RAB director of research Jane Shapiro, who leaves for a similar post with the ABC Radio Networks. She'll be based out of New York.

Kelly Malone, formerly a political P.R. agent, is named marketing coordinator for the broadcast division of Associated Press ... Steve Peppard will head RCS' new radio traffic division; he was previously CBS' chief of radio MIS.

Digital Cable Radio has unveiled a new remote control, The Maestro, that will allow DCR subscribers to see song titles and artist names for songs on DCR's audio services.

IF AT FIRST YOU DON'T SUCCEED... After the attempted merger of Atlantic Radio and Pyramid went silent, Steve Dodge found a home his Boston trom-bo with the announcement this week that Atlantic will merge with Stoner Broadcasting System and Multi Market Communications creating American Radio Systems, Inc. The merger will put together Atlantic's WRKO, WHDH, and WBMX Boston MA with Stoner's WCMF, WCMF-FM, and WRMM Rochester NY; WMMX, WTUE, and WONE Dayton OH; WYRK Buffalo NY; KGGO-FM and WDMI Des Moines IA; WWSN and WDJX-FM Louisville KY; WNBF and WHWK Binghamton NY; and Multi Market's WZMX Hartford CT. Dodge will be CEO of the new group, Multi Market's Dave Perlman takes COO duties while Atlantic's Joe Winn will be CFO. Tom Stoner will chair the Executive Committee. The companies will pool their spending money to double up in markets where they're short.

BRANDS ON THE RUN: Taking its lead from Cincinnati's WLW and its new duopoly partner WLWA, WRVA Richmond is applying for the calls WRVH for its new second AM, WRNL. When owner Clear Channel completes the purchase of WRNL, that station will be known as 910-WRVA and will offer a more male-leaning talk format to compliment the original 1140-WRVA's full-service AC. Shows lined up for the new station thus far include G. Gordon Liddy, Larry King, and Jim Bohannon. Ironically, the station that started the recent "brand extension" trend is no longer here to enjoy it since WMAG Greensboro's experiment with the "Magic Lite" format on co-owned WMKG ended last year.

BACK IN THE NEW YORK GROOVE:

Roughly six months ago, WQHT (Hot 97) New York tried to do what had worked so well for WIOQ Philadelphia, among a number of others. In a market where both urban WRKS and WBLS were leaning heavily adult, WQHT made a decided run at those stations' younger demos. It didn't work, possibly because Hot 97--which has always gone to great lengths to avoid being called urban--held on to some non-urban dance product, something which WIOQ had jettisoned early on. Now WBLS, which had been on the cusp of urban AC, has brought in WIOQ's Jerry Clifton and is also skewing much younger. Hot 97, meanwhile, brings in Harry Lyles as its new consultant, although an R&R item on Lyles' hiring insists that this doesn't mean that Hot 97 will hurry up and finish a transition to urban in an attempt to head off WBLS.

All of this has some curious implications for New York radio. WRKS and WBLS have essentially traded places over the last five years. WBLS' legacy is as the widely-drawn adult urban outlet; WRKS is supposed to be the urban hits station. But for the last few years, Kiss has become the Anita Baker-leaning urban and now WBLS is playing "Whoomp! There It Is" and other rap records in middays. "Whoomp! There It Is," for those of you unfamiliar with it, is southern novelty rap of the sort that usually works great for most of the Clifton urban outlets, but which format observers have always thought wouldn't work in New York. If Clifton's WBLS works, it won't just change the balance of power here, it will redefine what New York listeners will accept.

WBLS has tightened up and played the hits before--it's usually ended up broadening again several months later. A family business with an extensive community heritage, it's the sort of operation which has ended up baffling more than one well-meaning outsider before. Having a consultant whose clients frequently deny any connection to the urban format is either a 180-degree move or, seen differently, a throwback to the late '70s/early '80s WBLS when then-PD Frankie Crocker was known for throwing in John Lennon, Barbra Streisand, Elvis Costello, or anything else he wanted in between R&B records. How Clifton will fare in the halls at WBLS is one variable. So is Hot 97. The Hispanic dance music that once defined the station has been all but purged since last fall. Even if Hot 97 wanted to reclaim that position, the music that fueled it has all but dried up in the absence of any airplay outlets. But young-end urban reaction records are no longer the station's exclusive franchise either.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

In Commission actions this week:

denied a petition filed by NCD Broadcasting Company seeking reconsideration of the allotment of 93.9 A to Boonville MO as that community's second service and the substitution of 102.3 A for 93.9 A (KNCD) at Columbia MO.

denied Dr. Sam Walters application for a review and motion to set aside the grant of Rochlis-Johnson Partnership's application for a new FM on 94.7 at Thousand Palms CA.

upheld a staff decision returning as unacceptable for filing the application of Sacramento Community Radio, Inc. for a new FM at Sacramento CA.

affirmed the Mass Media Bureau's conditional grant of the application of Northern Illinois University and Rockford Educational Broadcasting Foundation for a new non-commercial FM on 90.5 MHz at Rockford.

affirmed an action by the MMB which denied a complaint filed by Fairbanks Communications alleging that Greater Boston Radio (Greater Media), licensee of WMJX Boston MA, violated the blanketing interference rules when it modified the station's facilities.

Apparently, the legacy lives on. The Commission designated for hearing the application of the Petroleum V. Nasby Corp. for renewal of the license of WSWR Shelby OH and the application to transfer control of the station. Thrown in for good measure is a determination at the hearing whether or not to issue up to a \$250,000 forfeiture for unauthorized transfer of control. It seems that Nasby is a corporation pretty much wholly owned by former communications attorney Thomas Root and members of his family.

ELSEWHERE

Several months after its proposal to release a new ratings book every six weeks, Arbitron has revamped its game plan and now says it would issue a full 18-week rolling average report every 12-weeks--in other words, every three months as it does now. Less extensive Arbitrends would be released every six weeks instead, also based on an 18 week average.

A U.S. Tax Court ruling on whether radio licenses can be amortized as "franchises" under the tax code has been upheld by a federal appeals court. Jefferson Pilot can write its radio stations off as "franchises" for now; the IRS, which had opposed it, can still appeal to the Supreme Court.

Tribune Broadcasting's Wayne Vriesman is the new NAB Joint Board Chairman replacing Gary Chapman. Also, NAB's Radio Board--which now includes Taylor Communications' Paul Levesque--will vote on a new Radio Chairman by the time you read this.

R&R reports that the Cox duopoly purchase of WYAI Atlanta is now official. The deal, estimated by R&R at \$7 million, will pair the station with Cox's WSB-AM-FM-TV as well as both that town's daily newspapers. In other duopoly news, Broadcasting Partners, who recently picked up WYNY Lake Success NY (New York) is buying WCKZ-FM Gastonia NC for \$3 Million to double up with urban WPEG Concord NC giving them the lock on urban in Charlotte.

R&R also reports that KIKI Honolulu GM Lee Coleman--who allegedly tried to attract clients by pointing out that his audience was Caucasian and Japanese, not Hawaiian, has written a letter to the daily newspapers apologizing for his actions.

The next-in-a-series of satellite morning shows is WFAN New York's Don Imus who debuted on the Unistar Radio Network on WQYK Tampa. Unistar says he'll begin soon on WEEI Boston MA, WWRX-FM Westerly RI (Providence), and WINH Olyphant PA (Scranton).

When WTFX Louisville signed on with an all-Van Halen stunt several weeks ago, it didn't take much to intuit that the station was headed for a harder-edged AOR format. Just in case you're wondering, however, WTFX did adopt an 18-34 male leaning rock format. They've also hired Max Webster who was with rival WQMF and, referring to WQMF's longtime mascot, are now declaring "The Weasel is dead" on the air.

The Radio Advertising Bureau has announced that its annual managing sales conference will be known next year as "RAB '94." The convention will be held February 17-20 at Lowes Anatole, Dallas. Also, the RAB's Certified Radio Sales Manager program moves east to the Westfields Convention Center in Chantilly, Va., outside Washington D.C., on August 6-8. Call 800-722-7355 for info.

Despite all the talk about country fragmentation over the last several years, we still haven't seen many album-based country outlets. But consultant Steve Warren expects that to change; anticipating that "every market will have an album-oriented country station" by 1995, Warren has service-marked the term Album Country. Warren says he's up to his fourth such client now.

After years of speculation, former WEGX Philadelphia morning man John Lander has returned to San Diego for mornings on KFMB-FM (B100). Also, former KROQ L.A. jock and pioneering MTV VJ Mark Goodman goes to modern rocker WKQX Chicago for mornings.

Jim Higgins, who was named Sr. VP/national sales for Unistar six months ago, is upped to Sr. VP/sales for the network. Also, Amy Bolton has been named Director, Affiliate Relations for the fast growing MediaStar International. She'll head the station clearance service's new Baltimore office.

THE HUNDT FOR REED AS CHAIRMAN: Six months after taking office, President Clinton has named communications attorney Reed Hundt as his nominee for FCC Chairman. Hundt's nomination seemed to go over well with NAB chairman Eddie Fritts whose statement praised his "many outstanding credentials," and "will provide solid grounding for the many complex issues facing the FCC." The rest of this week's news begins on page 7.

MOODS FOR MODERNS: Lots of modern rock in this week's format news. WDRE Long Island has announced an LMA/simulcast with the forthcoming 98.5 FM licensed to Westhampton on Long Island's eastern end. That station should be up in August, using the same split-cart technology that WDRE's Philadelphia outlet WIBF utilizes. Meanwhile, San Diego gets its second modern FM as urban XHRM becomes "The Flash," running what it says is a more adult version of the format than border radio rival XETRA-FM (91X). Also, WWSN Louisville (a/k/a WDJX-AM) will spin off a separate modern program for nights. And WSKS Sparta GA, which had been simulcasting WCHZ Augusta's modern rock format plans to go local with their own format. Not all the modern rock news is good, however, CKST Vancouver--denied its application for an FM license--has fired the bulk of its airstaff. CKST hopes to have new owners and a new format in place by Labor Day although it will continue modern rock with a skeleton crew for now. This week's extra-thick format wrap-up follows:

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

The Supreme Court has ruled 7-2 against WMYK Moyock NC (Norfolk)'s right to accept lottery advertising for the state of Virginia despite the fact that lotteries are illegal in North Carolina. WMYK operates as a Norfolk station and despite its claims that 92% of its audience lives in Virginia, the high court overturned several lower court rulings to declare that gambling is not a constitutionally protected right and thus not a free speech issue. The two dissenting judges--Stevens and Blackmun--called the lottery ad ban "patently unconstitutional."

The Commission has initiated an inquiry into the policies and rules pertaining to the performance verification of directional antenna systems at AM stations.

The Commission dismissed a petition for rulemaking filed by Ozark Broadcasting Corp., licensee of WOAB Ozark AL, asking the Commission to permit commercial FM stations to operate with vertical polarization only.

The Commission has affirmed a Review Board order granting the application of Emission de Radio Balmeseda, Inc. for a new FM station on 106.5 A at Ponte Vedra Beach FL. An application for review of the grant filed by a competing applicant, Chameleon Broadcasting, Inc., was denied. Chameleon's app. was denied when the Review Board found it financially unqualified to be a licensee.

The Commission dismissed a request by the NAACP for review of an action which granted the applications for the assignment of licenses of WNDB/WVLV Daytona Beach and WLKF/WEZY Lakeland FL from Chapman S. Root Revocable Trust to Chapman S. Root Living Trust.

As today's issue goes to press, the FCC is conducting its first on-air test of the upgraded Emergency Broadcast System. The tests, which take place in Denver, will utilize government emergency operating centers, television, radio, cable, satellite, pagers, and other devices. The new tests replace an age-old system by shortening test tones, utilizing silent tests, and increased speed and reliability. A second test is scheduled in Baltimore later this summer.

The Commission ordered Radio Moultrie, Inc., licensee of WMGA Moultrie GA, to fork over \$1,000 for failing to receive prior consent to transfer control and filing annual ownership reports.

Assistant Secretary of the FCC William Caton is named acting secretary for the commission replacing the ITC-bound Donna Searcy.

The filing window for migration to the new expanded AM band closed this week. As soon as we have the information, we'll make it available. Watch this space for more information.

KVEN/KHEY Ventura CA, CEO Robert Fox is the new NAB Radio Board chairman replacing Wayne Vriesman who was voted NAB joint board head several days earlier. WKYS Washington DC, owner/GM Skip Finley is named vice chairman replacing Fox.

At the June 23 radio board meeting, the NAB called on broadcasters to move faster on the development of in-band AM and FM digital audio broadcasting and appropriated \$50,000 for testing of in-band systems. In what seems like wishful thinking given recent FCC signals on the matter, the board called for existing radio folks to get DAB "before satellite services are even considered."

ELSEWHERE

Several weeks after his foray into the satellite network business with the purchase of Superadio, Chris Devine is now selling his WWBZ Chicago to Evergreen, owner of rival WLUP-AM-FM, for \$28-million. Evergreen says WWBZ will remain hard rock, although R&R speculates that there will be some resulting changes--perhaps to all-talk--at WLUP-FM.

This week's episode of "Say The Wrong Thing" comes from former churban programmer turned voiceover king Mark Driscoll who shocked the CHR-targeted Bobby Poe Convention in Washington, D.C., last week by suggesting that churban stations should be more candid about actually being urban, then declaring, "you know what you are, a bunch of coon stations" to a chorus of gasps. Driscoll, whose CHR-reporting WIOQ Philadelphia sounded pretty urban itself, last we recall, spent most of the following Monday calling people who had been present to apologize. Inside Radio reports him as saying that the comment just "slipped out." Maybe that also explains the 1991 NAB Radio Show where Driscoll referred to female time buyers as "bitches." It definitely doesn't explain the stripper Driscoll planted at last year's Poe, which was clearly premeditated. And one Poe attendee this year reports that when Interscope's Billy Brill pointed out that rap records had to be selling to white listeners because "the brothers are stealing," people laughed, not gasped. While M Street normally has little sympathy for urban programmers who don't want to be associated publicly with their own format, incidents like this one go a long way toward explaining why, don't they?

This month's Radio Advertising Bureau national sales revenue figures put combined national and local revenue as up 8% for May over the same month in 1992. Local revenue is up 10% for the month, led by a 13% gain in the southeast. National revenue is up only 1% as revenue in the east drops 11%.

The Children's Satellite Network has spent \$2.9 million to acquire \$7.2 million of secured debt in Marsh Broadcasting, pending bankruptcy court approval. The move would give CSN new stations in two markets where it's currently represented--Twin Cities and Washington, D.C.--as well as Dallas, Houston, Kansas City, and Milwaukee. The network will LMA the stations until closing, although CSN's Chris Dahl says, in a press release, that some of the new AMs might keep their present format.

The Electronic Media Ratings Council has made good on its threat to suspend accreditation of the Atlanta spring Arbitron book because of the ratings agency's use of on-air survey announcements. That led Interep Exec. VP/Research Dir. Marla Pirner to issue a statement calling for more radio representation at the EMRC and pointing out that there are 11 members from TV on the EMRC and three from radio.

In the pre-KTWV Los Angeles years where jazz of any sort was rare on commercial radio, KJAZ San Francisco was one of the format's few standard bearers. Now it hopes to be so again with the launch of the KJAZ National Jazz Radio Network which will be offered to other stations and to cable systems. Funded by the station with George Wein's Festival Productions, United Video, the International Assn. of Jazz Educators, and "a number of jazz record industry interests," the network launched operations on June 30.

Rival Orlando stations WXXL and WDIZ have entered into a joint sales agreement for national ad buys only. WXXL's national sales director will sell for both stations; local sales will remain separate.

With the addition of WABC New York on July 5, Unistar host G. Gordon Liddy will be up to 100 affiliates, less than three months after his national debut. Liddy will add four other stations at the end of the month.
