**WOWO TAKES A DIVE.** The applications are in, and are worse for WOWO than many expected. In order to make way for the WLIB application to add night service, Inner City Broadcasting Corp. has filed applications to modify the facilities of WOWO, Ft. Wayne, IN, to drop its night power from 50,000 watts down to 9,800 watts and change its directional pattern. Meanwhile, the application for WLIB, New York plans to add nighttime power of 30,000 watts, which will more than adequately cover the New York metro area. Both stations share the same 1190 kHz frequency.

**WASHINGTON THIS WEEK**

This year's mid-term elections cost Timothy D. Martz' stations in Sturgeon Bay and Norway, WI \$4,000 each after the Commission hit them for violating the lowest unit rate rules. In a response to a letter of inquiry, WFNL, Sturgeon Bay, and WZNL, Norway, said they did not maintain political advertising contracts in a political file, which resulted in overcharges to several candidates. The stations are refunding the overcharged amounts.

Pyramid Communications has asked the Commission for a waiver of the one-to-a-market rule after Leonard Lieberman, who serves on the board of Outlet Communications, was nominated to the Board of Directors of Pyramid. Pyramid owns WJMN (FM), Boston, while Outlet owns WJAR (TV), Providence, RI. WJAR's Grade A signal covers Boston entirely. Comments are due by December 14.

If you're in Washington, DC, on Tuesday, December 13, you'll want to stop by Room 856 at the FCC (1919 M Street NW) for the dog and pony show on the new Emergency Alert System (EAS). EAS is the system that replaces EBS. There will be a press conference about EAS, followed by a meeting of equipment manufacturers, FCC personnel, and technical experts from the National Weather Service and FEMA to review the system.

The National Association of Broadcasters names a new Radio Board Member: Eric Hauenstein, VP/GM Jones Satellite Network has been named to replace Mike Tyler in the network representative seat.

The NAB has scheduled its annual "Radio Group Head Fly-in" February 6-7 at the ANA Hotel in Washington, DC. The meeting will give radio group operators the opportunity to candidly discuss the changing world of radio ownership. The deadline for registration is January 16th. EZ buys into the Big Easy as it has announced plans to purchase adult standards WBYU, New Orleans from the Vanderbilt Corporation for \$1.1 million, pairing the station with EZ Communications' CHR WEZB.

If you're taking talk programming from the bird, beware of what you're airing. DeAngelis Tangibles has become intangible by filing Chapter 7 bankruptcy in Pennsylvania after several criminal and civil suits alleged fraud, criminal conspiracy, and deceptive business practices. The company, owned by brothers Timothy and James DeAngelis, advertised gold coins on a financial program hosted by Sonny Bloch on the Independent Broadcasters Network. Several published reports state the two brothers advertised the coins, that apparently did not exist, and took investors for about \$16 million. Both Bloch and the brothers have been accused of racketeering in a class-action suit filed in Pennsylvania. James DeAngelis faces 12 felony counts and is free on \$250,000 bond. Timothy faces 20 felony counts, and remains in jail on \$500,000 bond. Bloch has not been charged.

Following a shift in programming at all-sports WTEM, Bethesda, MD (Washington, DC), the Colfax Communications station has chosen not to bid on the broadcast rights to the Washington Redskins. According to the Washington Post, WTEM General Manager Bennett Zier said the decision was mostly a matter of cost, as estimates peg the price tag for the rights at between \$3.2 and \$3.5 million per year. Two other stations, Capital Cities/ABC's WMAL, and Infinity's WJFK-FM, have expressed interest in picking up the rights.

The Radio Advertising Bureau released the Radio Ad Revenue numbers for October and YTD. Radio advertising revenue climbed 15% over October 1993 levels. Local revenue was up 14%. National spot revenue for October jumped 21%.

**WASHINGTON THIS WEEK**

The big news from the Commission this week is a Notice of Proposed Rule Making allowing unattended operation of broadcast facilities. In the proposal, the FCC also seeks comment on eliminating the need for operators licenses for stations who choose to continue to use them.

The proposal would allow stations equipped with automatic transmission system (ATS) equipment to control the transmitter, as long as it could shut it off in case of emergency or extreme power fluctuations.

Also, if the transmitter malfunctions and begins to operate outside its licensed parameters, the station could continue to operate under Special Temporary Authority (STA) without immediate FCC approval, as long as the malfunction causes no interference to other stations. The Commission must be notified if the problem continues for more than ten days. If the problem does cause interference to other stations, the ATS equipment must fix the problem within three minutes or shut down the transmitter.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK (cont'd)

The Commission also wants to know if it should give this authority only to stations with ATS equipment, and whether AM directional stations without approved antenna sampling systems should be excluded.

The Commission is proposing to make the new rules effective with the implementation of the new Emergency Alert System. Comments are due January 20, replies due February 6.

ELSEWHERE

Gannett's Sky Radio, the four-year-old news service broadcast to airline passengers over in-flight audio channels, has been grounded for poor advertising sales. **M Street note:** Even though Gannett threw millions of dollars at a risky project, they still have trouble loosening the purse strings to program and promote their great AM facilities in several of the nation's largest markets.

Arbitron's decided (with the help of the Advisory Council) it's time to reset its priorities and focus on quality control. The company has gone through some pretty tough times as new software designed to streamline processing and catch problems before they get to the books failed several times during the last two books. The Advisory Council recommended and Arbitron agreed to delay the redesign of the Radio Market Report. Also, according to Inside Radio, the company may hold off on new projects in order to focus on quality control.

Speaking of holding off on new projects, it was revealed at Arbitron's Consultant Fly-In that the company's revolutionary people meter to measure radio listening won't be in operation till much later than expected. Although Arbitron continues to test the new technology, many issues still need to be resolved--including how use of the meters will be funded.

According to the New York Post, bidding for New York City-owned WNYC-FM will start this week. Infinity Broadcasting, which owns WZRC, WXRK, and WFAN in New York, has expressed an interest in the station. Analysts say the station could sell for \$55 to \$60 million. WNYC-FM is New York's primary NPR outlet.

OmniAmerica is purchasing three of the J.J. Taylor Company's stations, bringing OmniAmerica's total assets to be valued at approximately \$150 million. OmniAmerica will buy Taylor's three Florida stations: CHR WXXL, Leesburg (Orlando), and news WEAT (AM) and soft AC WEAT-FM, West Palm Beach. Terms were not disclosed. J.J. Taylor will serve on OmniAmerica's board of directors. Taylor will continue to operate his stations in Cape Cod: gold-based AC WCOD, Hyannis, MA; and country combo WFAL, Falmouth, MA, and WFXR, Harwich Port, MA.

HMW Communications has been busy this week as it announced it's buying WLYZ-FM, Greer, SC (Greenville-Spartanburg) and WWMO, Eden, NC (Greensboro) for \$1.3 million and \$1.2 million respectively. In Greenville, HMW was already operating WLYZ in an LMA with Greer Communications. HMW also owns urban WJMZ-FM, Anderson, SC, and new rock WLWZ-FM, Easley, SC. WLYZ is currently simulcasting WLWZ.

Salem is picking up another AM station, announcing it will buy KFIA, Sacramento, from Olympic Broadcasters for \$4.1 million. KFIA is a Christian-formatted full-timer on 710 KHz. The purchase brings Salem's total to 20 stations in 20 markets.

Tele-Media Broadcasting is doubling up in Allentown by buying easy listening WFMZ from Maranatha Broadcasting. Terms of the deal were not disclosed. Tele-Media already owns adult standards WEST, and adult contemporary WLEV, Easton, PA.

Radio Business Report reports that Williamsport, PA's, SabreCom has announced it will buy sports WFXX and rock WZXR, Williamsport for \$1 million from PAC Communications. SabreCom recently bought CHR WHTO, Muncie, which will give the new company a duopoly there.

In Puerto Rico, Zeta Communications and Prime Time Radio will put two FM stations together to cover the island. Zeta's Tropical WZNT, San Juan, and Prime Time's Spanish hits WOYE, Mayaguez will combine under a new company umbrella, Primedia Broadcast Group. The two station transaction is valued at \$15 million.

The Interep Radio Store announced it will launch the "Best Of Oldies Music" (BOOM!) Format Network during the first quarter of 1995. Consisting exclusively of Interep stations, BOOM! will be patterned after Interep's other format and demographic networks in presenting new opportunities for national advertisers to reach targeted demographics. The networks also serve as marketing vehicles to promote their respective formats and demographics. For more information call Interep at (212) 516-0700.

**WASHINGTON THIS WEEK**

The new Emergency Alert System was unveiled last week touting the ability to provide emergency information on many different consumer products. The new system works with radio, TV, cable, pagers, CD players, and other specially equipped electronic equipment--it will even turn them on for you in an emergency. It's designed to broadcast in languages other than English, and will automatically redistribute emergency information from the originating agency, like the National Weather Service. Broadcasters must install the new equipment and be in compliance with the new system in mid-1996.

The FCC won't let you get away with ignoring paid PSA's when figuring your lowest unit rate for political spots. The Commission has upheld a ruling treating paid PSA's in the same way as bonus spots because they hold more value than your normal PSA. The Commission also rejected the argument that the policy hurts non-profit organizations.

The next issue to be reviewed in the FCC's recent look inside may include easing up on the restrictions prohibiting the ownership of a television station and radio outlets in the same market. According to Inside Radio, the Commission may also consider eliminating the cap on the number of television stations a company can own nationally. It may even review the ability to own two television stations in the same market, depending on penetration within that market.

The Commission will also review its broadcast attribution rules, which specify how ownership of broadcast entities is determined. The review will focus on just what constitutes a "cognizable" interest for the purpose of applying the multiple ownership rules to specific situations.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK (cont'd)

The NAB has promoted two to VP level as DeDe Ferrell, director, House government relations moves to VP/Senate government relations. Kathleen Ramsey, director, broadcaster/congressional relations, moves up to president of that department.

Also, the NAB named a new head of their job-referral service, the Employment Clearinghouse. He's Michael McKinley, a former communications professor from Penn State University.

ELSEWHERE

After much speculation about just how Clear Channel Communications and Snowden Broadcasting were really related, Clear Channel is buying urban AC WYLD, New Orleans from Snowden. Terms weren't disclosed. This will give Clear Channel an official duopoly there, as they already own sports WQUE and urban WQUE-FM, and have been in an LMA with WYLD. According to Dow Jones, Clear Channel said Snowden is dissolving, and will withdraw its applications to buy three stations from Clear Channel: news-talker KAKC, Tulsa, and WQUE-AM & FM. No word on what will happen to Gospel WYLD (AM), New Orleans, or Snowden's station in the Louisville market--country WKJK, Salem, IN--which is currently in an SMA with Clear Channel's full service outlet WHAS and country WAMZ. **M Street speculation:** Since Clear Channel put up most of the money for Snowden's acquisition of WYLD, are they really just buying themselves out in this deal?

According to the Wall Street Journal, Fox wants a piece of SW Networks, the new syndicated programming venture between Sony Software and Time-Warner's Warner Music Group. Fox is trying to take "a substantial position" in the network, which will begin broadcasting short- and long-form music programming next month.

Interop has just concluded its third year of Customer Needs Assessment Panel (C-NAP) programs, which it claims are directly responsible for generating \$3 million in new radio business this year and \$10 million over the past three years. New advertisers include LA Gear, Paramount Pictures, and Western Union. The C-NAPs are panel discussions focusing on needs and concerns of advertisers. Advertisers, agencies, and station personnel discuss how radio can be more responsive to the needs of marketers. The ideas generated go into an "action plan" for the markets where the discussions are held. If you'd like more info, call (212) 916-0700.
