The deal will give Clear Channel presence in New York, Dallas, and Miami, and up their holdings in Chicago.

It will handle all aspects of the production, distribution and national advertising sales for a series of live, national, Monday through Friday talk programs. The programs will feature talkers Alan Colmes, Barry Farber and Victoria Jones. A fourth program titled "Left to Right" pits the conservative viewpoints of Barry Farber against the liberal perspective of Alan Colmes.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

EEO violations have cost five stations a total of \$42,000. Great Empire's WOW-AM & FM, Omaha will have to fork over \$12,000 (down from \$25,000) for "willful and repeated violations" of the EEO rules. Clint Formby's KSAM-AM & FM, Huntsville, TX must pay \$15,000 (down from \$31,500). Poor recruitment and self-assessment were cited in the forfeiture orders. Resort Broadcasting's WGMD, Rehoboth Beach, DE in the Salisbury/Ocean City market will spend \$15,000 because of poor recruitment and self-assessment.

The FCC has put procedures in place to help silent stations get preferred processing so that they have a better shot of keeping their licenses. The 1996 Telecommunications Act mandates a silent station must forfeit its license after one year of remaining silent. Several stations in recent months have fallen victim to the new rule, most of them being AM's or Educational FM's.

In order to take advantage of expedited processing, a licensee should submit a letter prominently labeled "REQUEST TO EXPEDITE APPLICATION OF SILENT STATION." Each letter should include the station's call sign, city and state of license, type of application, and a brief explanation of why action on the application is necessary to return to the air and the date the station's license will expire if it remains off the air. A copy of the letter must be delivered to the appropriate branch of the commission dealing with that station's type of service. All requests to expedite must be sent to James Crutchfield at the address given for Glenn Griesman above. The fax number is the same, as well. Once the station is back on the air, the station must notify the Commission immediately.

The Commission has denied PDB Corporation's application for review of a staff action dismissing PDB's application for reinstatement of its expired construction permit for WUMI, State College, MS.

ELSEWHERE

American Radio Systems is buying a second AM in Baltimore. For \$2.775 million, it will pick up Mortenson Broadcasting's black gospel WBGR. ARS owns religion WBMD, Baltimore and oldies WQSR, Catonsville.

Jeff Trumper's adding a combo in Albuquerque, upping his holdings there to six stations--two AM's and four FM's. He's buying River City's rock combo of KZSS and KZRR-FM, Albuquerque, as well as classic rocker KLSK, Santa Fe. He currently owns classic hits KHTZ, children's KDZZ, and new rock KTEG, all Albuquerque. Terms of the deal weren't disclosed.

Arbitron will begin mailing complimentary copies of the Winter 1996 First Preference Report to radio station programmers and radio consultants on June 10. The First Preference Report provides its users with estimates of First Preference cume listeners for Persons 12+, Persons 18-34, Persons 25-34 and Persons 35-64, Monday-Sunday, 6 am-Midnight in all 94 Winter markets.

The Radio industry experienced its 44th consecutive month of revenue gains in April 1996, as combined local and national spot advertising revenue increased 6% vs the same month in 1995. Year-to-date combined revenues gained 6% through April 1996; national year-to-date revenues were up 2%, and local dollars through April were up 7% compared with the first four months of 1995. WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

The Commission has renewed the license of Prettyman Broadcasting's WXCY, Havre de Grace, MD in the Wilmington, DE market subject to reporting conditions and denied a petition to deny the station's license renewal by Charles W. Adams. Adams complained about the station's EEO policies. The Commission found the station did not adequately self-assess its policies.

The Commission has reduced the forfeiture of Buckley Broadcasting Corp.'s WFBL and WSEN-FM, Baldwinsville, NY from \$25,000 to \$7,000 for EEO recruiting deficiencies and poor self-assessment. The NAACP had filed a petition for reconsideration of the order, which was denied.

KTEM Radio's KTEM and KPLE, Temple, TX had its fine reduced from \$25,000 to \$15,000 for EEO violations. It's also subject to reporting conditions and was hit with a short-term renewal.

Edward W. Hosken, Jr. has been named Counsel to the Inspector General of the FCC as well as Director of Investigations. He joined the Commission in May from the Committee on Standards of Official Conduct of the U.S. House of Representatives.

Cynthia Ward Jeffries has been named Director of the FCC's "1-888 Call Center" located in Gettysburg, PA. Jeffries will head the day-to-day operation of the new toll-free center, which is run by the Compliance and Information Bureau. The new call center will handle complaints or questions about phone charges, long distance carriers, obtaining licenses or forms, and radio and television programming. The phone number is (888) 322-8255.

ELSEWHERE

Dame Media is buying into the Utica/Rome market in a big way with the purchase of three combos in two separate transactions. The \$3 million package includes Bendat Communications standards WUTQ and rocker WOUR, both Utica; Adirondack Broadcasting's sports WADR and soft AC WUUU, both Remsen, NY; and Promedia Communications' sports WRNY and CHR WSKS, both Rome, NY. The Promedia stations are currently owned by Adirondack. Closing is expected within 90 days.

ELSEWHERE (cont'd)

Roger Dodson's Radio One Broadcasting Group is cashing out. Three Eagles Communications, headed by Rolland Johnson, is buying all ten stations, plus another station in Illinois owned by TKO Broadcasting in separate transactions for a total of \$10.2 million. Radio One's stations include standards KQAD and country KLQL, Luverne, MN in the Sioux Falls market; oldies/talk KTTT and country KKOT, Columbus, NE; standards KMEM and classic rock KNET-FM, Lincoln, NE; standards KBRK and AC KBRK-FM, Brookings, SD; and standards KIJV and country KZNC, Huron, SD. TKO's station is country WCCQ, Crest Hill, IL which serves part of the Chicago market. LMA's with all the properties begin immediately. Three Eagles is based in Monument, CO.

Terry Shockley's Shockley Communications Corp. is picking up two more combos in the Duluth/Superior market, bringing its total owned stations there to six. It will buy WDSM/KZIO, Inc.'s talk/sports WDSM and CHR-new rock KZIO, Superior, WI and Head of Lakes Broadcasting Company's standards KXTP, Superior and country KTCO, Duluth, MN. All four stations are owned by Patricia McNulty and Ken Buehler. Price for both combos is \$3.8 million. Shockley owns full service soft AC KDAL and soft AC KDAL-FM, both Duluth.

Statistical Research has announced Radio PC 2001 which will provide powerful desktop data access for network radio planning as part of the RADAR service. The RADAR PC package includes RADAR Planner, a reach/frequency program, PC/SCAN which contains digitized versions of RADAR reports, and the new PC/TARGETS, a spreadsheet program for handling RADAR data to build schedules. The routines are windows-based with pull-down menus, context specific help screens and built-in graphics. For more info, call (908) 654-4000.

Westinghouse is considering separating its broadcasting businesses from its industrial divisions. Chairman Michael Jordan recommended to the Board of Directors split the two divisions to "create the appropriate balance sheet and tax structure for each major sector of our business."

With the switch of CBS' KRQR, San Francisco to modern rock, the station changed its slogan to "Alice." Frank Wood, president of Secret Communications found the name strikingly similar to his station in the Denver market, KALC, which began using the moniker a couple of years ago. Frank penned a letter to KRQR's GM, Stephen DiNardo, stating his concerns about the consequences of KRQR picking up the name:

"While imitation is the sincerest form of flattery, we feel that your actions are quite likely to cause: 1. Confusion among the thousands of female listeners who regularly commute between Denver and San Francisco; 2. Dismay to women named "Alice" because across the nation they had all finally found the one station which represented their identity and now they will become subjected to a schizophrenic reaction (or in radio parlance, "personality stereoshock"); 3. Terrible anxiety among the hordes of male listeners who had latched onto the Denver "Alice" in a shameless attempt to seduce the aforementioned female listeners; they now realize their girlfriends will be unresponsive since schizophrenia severely inhibits the libido; 4. Further gender confusion in San Francisco."

In order to avoid a lawsuit because of "these clearly predictable results [that] will cause immense economic damage to Secret Communications as well as stress to its thin-skinned officers," Wood has asked CBS to send one large case of mushrooms from the Bay area, "the type whereby eating one side makes one large, the other side small."

BIG. . . \$3.9 Billion will bring the two largest U.S. radio companies together as one. Westinghouse and Infinity Broadcasting will merge using Westinghouse common stock to create the nation's largest radio group--with a company estimated value of \$18 billion. Mel Karmazin will run the combined operation and own approximately two percent of Westinghouse. Infinity shareholders will receive Westinghouse shares at a rate of 1.71 to one Infinity share. Westinghouse will issue approximately 205 million shares for Infinity's 120 million. The combined group will hold 83 radio stations, 69 of which are in the top 10 markets. Infinity also brings its recently-acquired Shadow Broadcast Services into the mix. Infinity-managed Westwood One Radio Networks is not a part of the deal, although it must surely be a factor. The deal has to pass muster with the FCC, the FTC, and shareholders of both companies, although Karmazin and other key Infinity shareholders, who collectively own 51% of Infinity, have already agreed to vote for the merger. The new ownership rules will allow the deal in all top 10 markets except Chicago (10 stations, 1 FM over limit) and Dallas (10 stations, 3 FM's over limit).

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

The Commission is proposing the eliminating or streamlining the procedures to modify grandfathered short-spaced FM stations. Grandfathered stations are those that were authorized before November 16, 1964 that did not meet the separation distances required by Section 73.207 of the Rules, which was adopted later. The Rulemaking proposal suggests changing three key aspects of the current procedures. First, stations would use a predicted interference area analysis based on field strength protection ratios instead of the current ambiguous limitation based on the relative locations of the 60 dBu service contour. Second, the second- and third-adjacent-channel protection criteria would be eliminated. Third, the provision for agreements between grandfathered stations would be eliminated.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK (cont'd)

The proposal comes as a result of a joint petition filed in 1991 asking the FCC to permit stations which are short-spaced to second- or third-adjacent-channel stations to change location without regard to further short-spacing. The petition also proposed to permit stations which are short-spaced to co-channel or first-adjacent-channel stations to apply for maximum-permitted facilities for its class, as long as the resulting signal doesn't extend any further into the protected short-spaced station's 60 dBu contour. It also proposed that a 40 dBu contour be used for predicting co-channel interference and a 54 dBu for first-adjacents. A compromise of opposing comments filed at the time, coupled with the ability of computers to do a lot of engineering work have prompted the three-pronged approach of the new Rulemaking Proposal. Comments are due July 22, 1996. Replies are due August 5, 1996.

The Pittsburgh market was hit hard with fines and reporting conditions for EEO violations. Renda Broadcasting's standards WJAS and soft AC WSHH, Pittsburgh were nailed for \$16,500. WHJB, Inc.'s talk/AC WHJB and AC WSSZ, both Greensburg, PA will spend \$15,000 as will Farr Broadcasting's talk/CHR WESA (AM) and CHR WESA-FM, both Charleroi, PA. Although no discrimination was found, reporting and recruitment problems caught the stations.

The Commission has reduced forfeitures resulting from EEO problems for Waller Broadcasting's KEBE and KOOI, Jacksonville, TX, which went from \$31,250 to \$12,000. First Greenville Corporation's KGVL and KIKT, Greenville, TX, will only have to spend \$6,000 instead of \$37,500. Historic Hudson Valley Radio's WGHQ and WBPM cut their \$25,000 fine back to \$8,000. The University of Southern California's KUSC, Los Angeles will spend \$17,500 in fines after it was unsuccessful in having its forfeiture reduced.

The Commission has reduced the fine for Colfax Communication's WTEM, Bethesda, MD to \$4,000 for violating sponsorship ID rules. The fine had been \$6,000. The forfeiture was reduced based on the station's compliance history.

The license of Family Broadcasting's WSTX-FM, Christiansted, VI has been designated for hearing. The station's been silent for almost two years. The station claims Hurricane Marilyn, which swept through the region in September, 1995, damaged the studio building and equipment.

Clarence Jones' WMNY, Elloree, SC has had its operating authority terminated since its been silent for more than two years. Its renewal was denied and call letters deleted.

Licensees for AM, FM, and FM translator stations in Iowa and Missouri, as well as FM translators only in Nevada, are coming up for renewal soon. The Commission is mailing its license renewal booklets in mid-July for these stations. To make sure that your station's mailing address is updated at the Commission, call Claudia Patterson at (202) 418-2784.

The FCC has released the 1995 Broadcast and Cable Employment Report, which trends minority and female employment from 1991 through 1995. Total broadcast employment for stations having five or more full-time employees was up from 1994. Full-time female employment was up 0.8% to 40.7%. Minority full-time employment was up 1.5 points to 19.7%. Of full-timers in the upper four job categories (officials and managers, professionals, technicians, and sales workers), women increased from 33.2% to 34.2% and minorities increased from 16.3% to 17.5%. The data is compiled from the Annual Employment reports that broadcasters and cable operators file, showing composition of their staffs by gender, race, and/or national origin.

ELSEWHERE

Evergreen Media and Greater Media will swap stations in a deal that will give Evergreen two AM/FM combos in Washington, DC and adds an FM to Greater Media's Boston group. Greater Media picks up country WKLB-FM, Boston in exchange for AC WEBR, Washington. Evergreen will also purchase WEBR's sister, talker WWRC for \$22.5 million. Evergreen owns news WTOP and AC WASH. In Boston, Greater Media has country WBCS, Spanish WMEX, and AC WMJX. LMA's for each of the stations begin immediately.

Salem Communications is picking up Colfax Communication's recently-purchased oldies KOOL (AM), Phoenix, AZ for \$6.5 million. Salem will most likely flip the station to religious programming. Colfax retains a right of first refusal to buy back the station if Salem ever puts it up for sale.

ELSEWHERE (cont'd)

Beasley Broadcasting is broadening its holdings in the Greenville-New Bern, NC market with the purchase of urban AC WIKS, New Bern, NC and AC WMGV, Newport, NC from Stephen Taylor's WIKS-FM, Inc. Price on the combo is \$14 million. Beasley is also buying WIKS/WMGV LMA partner new rocker WXNR, Grifton NC for \$2 million from Taylor Communications Corp. The company recently purchased standards WNCT (AM) and oldies WNCT-FM, Greenville, NC from Park Broadcasting to combo with rocker WSFL, Bridgeton, NC in that market giving them five FM's there.

Children's Broadcasting Corp. is picking up another major market AM station to add to its collection carrying Radio AAHS programming. It will buy Lloyd Roach's WPWA, Chester, PA for \$1.3 million to cover the tough-to-crack Philadelphia market. WPWA covers the southern portion of the Philadelphia market and most of the Wilmington, DE market. Closing is planned for October.

Both SW Network's Smoothfm and its classical format will no longer require network inventory for the 24-hour formats. The move comes after a struggle to clear the necessary inventory in enough markets of size to give its ratings national value.

Jones Satellite Network is being spun to another subsidiary of its parent company Jones Intercable, Inc. The \$17.2 million deal includes Superaudio, Jones' cable radio service offering the Jones formats to its cable subscribers. Jones Global Group will now oversee the operation of Jones Galactic Radio, which owns JSN and Superaudio. The purchase was financed with shares of Bell Cablemedia plc, the U.K.'s third largest cable system, of which Jones now owns 7.2 million shares.

The Canadian Broadcasting Company will use the Digital Courier International Network to distribute CBS Radio Sports' Olympic programming to a select group of 40 Canadian radio stations from the site of the 1996 Summer Games in Atlanta. This marks the first time Canada's public broadcaster has made Olympic programming available to private radio stations. CBS Radio Sports has scheduled five daily Olympic feeds for the duration of the games to be distributed over the DCI Network, in addition to timely reports following high-profile events. The games run from July 19 to August 4.

Beginning July 19, NPR's Performance Today and Weekend Performance Today will air a special series of four live broadcasts from Atlanta in celebration of the cultural and musical events taking place in conjunction with the 1996 Olympic Games. For more info, call (202) 414-2300.

SW Networks announced the HardDrive, a two hour rock program hosted by Lou Brutus of Chicago's WRCX-FM, which will debut July fourth weekend. The show will feature the music of acts such as SoundGarden, Alice In Chains and Pearl Jam as well as exclusive interviews and live performances by the biggest names in rock. A two-hour, music intensive radio special celebrating 25 years of Soul Train award winners as a salute to Black Music Month will air June 27, 28, 29 or 30. For more info, call (212) 833-5400.

American View Radio Network announced the national debut of The Garden of Eden with nationally renowned author, newspaper columnist, and radio host Jack Eden. The two-hour call in show runs from 8-10 am ET on Saturdays and is available on a barter basis. For more info, call (800) 292-5881.

The Salem Radio Network announced that Janet Parshall's America will expand to three hours daily, Monday-Friday 2-5 pm ET. For more info, call (214) 831-1920.

ABC Radio Networks named Rafael Eli Managing Director, International Business Development. Eli will be responsible for international sales, including the development of new and existing business. ABC also named John Buckley Director of Market-Development. He'll be responsible for developing new business at advertising agencies and corporations in the Southwest region. Jeff Steele has been promoted to Advertising Sales Manager for the Southwest Region for ABC. Steele will be responsible for managing the advertising sales staff in Dallas and developing new business in the Southwest Region.

Dave Nicholson has been named General Manager of the Real Country Network. Nicholson joined the Network as Operations Manager in May of 1993. He previously was Operations Manager at WNOE AM/FM in New Orleans.

ARS is buying KSTE from Fuller-Jeffrey Broadcasting while Chancellor is purchasing the West Palm Beach stations from OmniAmerica. The transaction is expected to close early next year.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

Bahakel Communications' AM in Lynchburg, VA, silent since 1991, will remain silent forever. The license of WWOD (AM) was not renewed.

The Commission has denied an NAACP petition for reconsideration of a decision to fine the stations \$6,250 and impose reporting conditions for EEO self-assessment violations. The NAACP wanted a license renewal hearing, which was denied as the Commission found the NAACP had not demonstrated that the original decision contained a material error or omission.

It's a heck of a way to get out of paying a fine, but Diamond Broadcasting of California won't have to pay its \$25,000 forfeiture for EEO violations. Diamond was the licensee of KKIS-AM & FM, Pittsburg/Walnut Creek, CA (San Francisco) (now KATD and KZWC, respectively), which were in bankruptcy under the control of Randolph E. George. George successfully argued to the Commission that the fine would only hurt innocent creditors. The combo owed lenders more than \$3 million before the stations were sold. People's Network now owns KATD. Z-Spanish Network owns KZWC.

The Commission announced plans to open a proceeding to allow electronic filing of formal comments in rulemaking proceedings and online access to those comments. In February of this year, the Commission issued a notice of inquiry as to how it could utilize computer technology and the Internet to improve procedures. This is the first planned proceeding to come from those comments. No dates were released on when the proposal would be formally issued.

The Commission has released an updated edition of the Communications Act of 1934 as amended by the Telecommunications Act of 1996. The cost is \$13 and can be ordered from the GPO at (202) 512-1800. The stock number for ordering is 0-16-052372-9.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK (cont'd)

The NAB Radio Board met this past week in Arlington, VA. NewCity Communications' Dick Ferguson was reelected as Board Chairman. Howard Anderson was reelected Vice Chair. The NAB Joint Board of Directors has also voted to re-elected Phil Jones Chairman of the Board, Eddie Fritts, President/CEO and Ken Almgren as Treasurer. The Board approved development of two initiatives - one to help provide information useful to the planning and positioning of the industry and the other to help raise public understanding and approval of the benefits broadcasters provide to their communities and the nation.

The Radio Board unanimously reconfirmed its support of in-band on-channel Digital Audio Broadcasting. The Board is looking toward USA Digital's system as having "great promise." USA Digital is a joint venture between Gannett and Westinghouse/CBS. The USA system will not participate in the Electronics Industries' Association's testing of other systems later this summer in San Francisco because USA couldn't agree with EIA on testing procedures.

The Board is also wrestling with re-writing the schedule for radio membership dues. Deregulation has forced the NAB to restructure its membership categories, adding several categories above the \$5 million annual revenue mark, including a category for those above \$200 million. There are no changes for "already-existing rate categories."

ELSEWHERE

Westwood One and CNN have signed a new multi-year deal that expands the two companies' partnership. Westwood will continue to market CNNRadio and CNN Headline News. CNNRadio will expand its coverage by enhancing overnight and weekend news programming, increasing special reports and feature coverage, and installing a breaking news alert system. CNNRadio will also launch a customized report service for "key" affiliates which will include coverage of breaking news and interviews with newsmakers.

Reuter's reports several Infinity Broadcasting shareholders have filed suit in a Delaware court to block the company's planned merger with Westinghouse/CBS. The three lawsuits allege Infinity's board didn't maximize the per-share value of Infinity stock and breached their fiduciary responsibility by doing so.

According to the June edition of the Radio Television News Directors Associations' "Communicator" magazine, job opportunities for electronic journalists are on the rise and should stay that way for a while. Radio news staffing is beginning to stabilize. The research showed that radio stations adding staff outnumbered those reducing staff by nearly two-to-one, indicating an end to the large staff cutbacks of recent years. Many of the staff increases were part-time positions. Nearly two out of every three TV newsrooms added staff last year due to affiliation changes and increased news coverage, and only six percent reported staff cutbacks. In addition, more than half of the stations surveyed plan to add even more news coverage next year. The research was conducted by Bob Papper, associate professor of telecommunications at Ball State University, with Assistant Professors Andrew Sharma and Michael Gerhard.

Interep Research announced the release of its new study entitled "Like a Rock-The Changing Faces of Rock Radio." The report presents three broad categories of rock radio - defined as AOR, Classic Rock and Alternative, which when added together are second only to news/talk in overall listening. AOR continues to stay young by evolving--older artists are less of a staple on today's AOR station. AOR and Classic Rock stations both skew male, while alternative is more balanced between male and female. It's interesting to note that even though the three formats share some similarities, each has a distinct appeal. Classic rock only shares 17% of its audience with alternative and 31% with AOR. AOR shares only 19% with alternative, 23% with class rock. Alternative has the highest amount of sharing: up to 36% with AOR. The study also shows the number of Classic Rock stations has grown 15% over the past year, the number of Alternative/Modern Rock stations has grown by 50%. AOR stations have remained steady. Interep Research released it's 1996 profile of the Urban Radio Listener. Some highlights include 44% of listeners have attended or graduated college and 90% of the adult listeners are 18-49 years old, with equal distribution in all major age segments within this demo. A new Katz Radio Group study concludes the number of adults 25-54 who tune in to local AM news/information radio stations markedly increases when there is an emergency of breaking news story in the area. The study was based on Arbitron diary winter survey ratings in nineteen Northeast markets during the "Blizzard of '96". The study documents that during the winter of 1996, there was a 7.2 percent increase in the number of listeners aged 25-54 listening to this format.
