**CHARLOTTE SHUFFLE.** . . . Evergreen, EZ Communications, and SFX are in a three way swap this week in Philadelphia and Charlotte. In the first part of the deal, Evergreen is giving up its two FM's in Philadelphia, dance WIOQ and oldies WUSL in exchange for \$10 million cash and all of EZ's Charlotte holdings: urban oldies WBAV (AM), CHR WNKS, and Sports WFNZ (AM), all Charlotte; urban WPEG, Concord; urban AC WBAV-FM, Gastonia; and rocker WRFX, Kannapolis. The deal will give Evergreen the magic number of five FM's in Philadelphia. It owns jazz WJZZ, hot AC WYXR, and will soon close on Secret's classical WFLN-FM. The purchase puts EZ over the FM limit in Charlotte, since it already owns country WSOC-FM and 70's oldies WSSS. So, in the second part of the deal, EZ will give up WRFX, WNKS, and WSSS to SFX in exchange for \$64.8 million and SFX's country WTDR, Statesville. The deal will leave SFX with four FM's there as it owns soft AC WLYT, Hickory. EZ will have four, as well. By the way, EZ is soon to be sold to American Radio Systems, which has no holdings in Charlotte. LMA's begin mid-September. Peter Handy of Star Media Group handled the transaction.

**THEY PAID HOW MUCH?** In Baltimore, American Radio Systems is spending approximately \$90 million for two more FM's. It's buying Capitol Broadcasting Company's hot AC WWMX for \$60 million and 70's oldies WOCT for \$30 million. ARS will own three FM's and an AM when the deal is finished. It owns religion WBMD and oldies WQSR, Catonsville, MD there. The LMA begins October 1.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

Mario Loredo may not have his construction permit in Liberal, KS much longer. The Commission has begun proceedings into whether he is fit to be a licensee because he was a citizen of Mexico when he filed the application. On the application, dated August 24, 1993, Loredo indicated he complied with the foreign ownership provisions, which require licensees to be U.S. citizens.

When Loredo filed for an extension of time in May, 1995, he "inadvertently" indicated he was not a U.S. citizen. Loredo now argues that the alien ownership rules do not apply to licensees of unbuilt stations and that he would not have put the station on the air until his U.S. citizenship was finalized. The Commission is focusing on the misrepresentation on the initial application and could pull the permit and fine Loredo up to \$250,000.

Word of Faith Fellowship, Inc., licensee of WEMG, Knoxville, TN has allowed the station's license to expire. The station has been silent since 1989. The Commission has pulled the license and deleted the call letters.

Three stations are up for revocation as per the new silent station rules. Two are silent. They are Missouri Valley Productions' KLEH, Anamosa, IA and Concord Area Broadcasting's KRHT, Concord, CA. One other station, Evergreen Media's KNFL, Tremonton, UT, has been included in a proceeding, but just came back on the air doing news, talk, and sports serving the Logan, UT market.

The Commission inadvertently accepted for filing the application of Foothills Broadcasting for 88.3 MHz in Maynardville, TN. The application has been returned to pending status.

ELSEWHERE

Nationwide Communications is picking up another combo in the San Diego market. It's buying Tri-Cities Broadcasting's news/talk KCEO, Vista, CA, and progressive KUPR, Carlsbad for \$32 million. Nationwide owns classical KFSD-FM and LMA's standards KPOP (AM) and classic rocker KGB-FM from Brown Broadcasting in that market. The LMA begins immediately.

Tsunami Communications will spend \$31 million to buy the Dalton Group's oldies WGRR, Cincinnati. Dalton has owned the station since 1988. What makes the deal interesting is that Tsunami's combo in the Denver/Ft. Collins market, progressive KTCL, Ft. Collins, and standards KIIX, Wellington, CO, is in a 30% maximum SMA with Jacor's Denver group. Jacor owns or controls seven stations in Cincinnati.

Engles Enterprises is doubling up in its home market, Santa Barbara, purchasing crosstown oldies KIST and AC KMGQ, Goleta, CA from Channel Islands Broadcasting for an undisclosed amount. The LMA began last week. Engles owns new rock KHTY and news/talk/sports KTMS, both Santa Barbara. Robert J. Maccini of Media Services Group brokered the deal.

According to the RAB, the radio industry had its 47th consecutive month of revenue gains in July 1996. Combined local and national spot advertising revenue increased 7% vs. the same month in 1995, while local revenue increased 7% and national spot revenue posted a 8% gain. These figures are based on the RAB's Radio revenue index of more than 100 markets.

The Arbitron Company began its mailing of complimentary copies of the Spring 1996 First Preference Report to radio station programmers and consultants. The report includes estimates of First Preference cume listeners for Persons 12+, 18-34, 25-34 and 35-64 for Monday - Sunday 6AM-MID in all 262 Spring markets. First Preference is defined as those listeners who spend more time with that station in a one week period that any other station they listened to. Users can compare the performance of a station in one market to that of others in the same format in a similar size market.

Jeff Katz, DJ at KSTE-AM, Sacramento, CA was fired for suggesting that drivers be awarded a sombrero bumper sticker for hitting illegal immigrants trying to cross into the U.S. from Mexico. Katz added, during his morning talk show, for every 10 bumper stickers collected, a motorist would earn a free drink or meal at Taco Bell. Los Angeles-based National Hispanic Media Coalition claimed credit for the dismissal but parent company Chancellor Broadcasting says the firing resulted strictly from an internal investigation.

Interp's research department put in lots of overtime this week. The U.S. Hispanic Market study reveals that an average of 96.1% of Hispanics 12+ are reached by radio every week and almost half are heavy listeners. **WASHINGTON THIS WEEK**

The Commission has assessed a \$2,500 forfeiture against Southern Broadcasting Companies, Inc., former licensee of Station WSTT (AM), Thomasville, GA for violation of the Commission's Rules which require special temporary authority for a station to limit or discontinue operation beyond a 30 day period. Southern Broadcasting did obtain the requisite permission to go silent but failed to obtain an extension when that authorization expired. The Commission originally set the forfeiture at \$5,000 and denied a petition to rescind or reduce it based on financial hardship but took into consideration "the nature, circumstances, extent, and gravity of the violation" and reduced the forfeiture to \$2,500.

Liggett Broadcasting's WALM, Albion, MI has lost its license after the Commission chose not to renew the station. It has been silent since 1995.

Consumers in Delaware, Nebraska & Wyoming can now reach the FCC's National Call Center by calling (888) 225-5322. Florida, Maine, Virginia, Vermont, Kansas and Montana were introduced to the service earlier this year. Full nationwide coverage is planned by early 1997.

**ELSEWHERE**

Heritage Media is buying a third FM in Kansas City, spending an undisclosed amount on Ingram Media's classical KXTR and children's KCAZ, Mission, KS. Inside Radio reports the deal includes a monthly business magazine--one of the many magazines Ingram publishes. KCAZ is presently in an LMA with Chris Dahl's Children's Radio Group.



**ELSEWHERE (cont'd)**

Cox Broadcasting is adding two stations to its collection in Tulsa with the purchase of George Kravis' standards KGTO and hot AC KRAV. The price was not disclosed. Cox is buying all of the NewCity stations, which own country KWEN, news/talk KRMG, and classic rock KJSR there. Peter Handy of Star Media Group brokered the transaction.

Benchmark is buying up four stations in the Jackson, MS market. CLG Media of Jackson is selling urban oldies WKXI, urban AC WKXI-FM, urban WJMI, and black gospel WOAD for a total just shy of \$15 million. This transaction marks the stations' third sale in as many years. Jackson is Benchmark's ninth radio market in the Southeast.

Sheridan Broadcasting's Chairman is buying his own AM in the Richmond, VA market. Ronald Davenport is planning to buy Fletcher Communications' standards WSTK, Colonial Heights, CA for \$550,00. The purchase price includes real estate. Davenport will own the station under the name MCL/MCM, Inc. Sheridan owns stations in Pittsburgh and Buffalo.

Mid-West Family is loading up in the Appleton-Oshkosh, WI market. ODon Communications will sell its standards outlet WNAM, Neenah and country WUSW, Oshkosh for cash and stock valued at \$5.2 million. Mid-West already has news/talk WOSH, Oshkosh and oldies twins WVBO, Winneconne and WOGB, Kaukauna. The two groups are already in an LMA.

Maine-based Bay Communications is letting one of its FM's go. Jerry Evans' Moon Song Communications will buy talker WSNV, Howland, ME in the Bangor market for \$350,000. The purchase will give Moon Song group status, as it owns hot AC KQMO, Springfield, MO. Bay keeps Portland, ME classic rock combo WCME, Booth Bay Harbor and WXGL, Topsham; and urban-oldies WAAW, Williston, SC.

A change may be in the works in Los Angeles. Inside Radio reports several GM's in the Los Angeles metro have asked Arbitron to redefine the L.A. market to include fourteen townships in Ventura and San Bernardino counties. The cities will come from the East Ventura and the West Outer San Bernardino splits. Arbitron is expected to review the request as well as requests by other markets by the end of the year.

The just released RADAR 53 (Spring, 1996) shows that ABC's share of audience increased from 47.8 to 48.5 among Persons 12+, CBS dipped from 15.7 to 15.3 and Westwood One went from 36.5 to 36.3. Compared to a year ago, ABC's share is up 3.7%, CBS is up 2.6% and Westwood One is down 6.9%. The American Urban Network showed little change from the previous survey. ABC holds 9 of the top 10 programs and Paul Harvey continues to be the #1 ranked personality in network radio. In the Adult 25-54 demographic, CBS Spectrum Radio posted a 12% audience gain and the CBS Radio Network increased 2% in this demo. ABC's Genesis Network was up 9% and their Prime Network increase by 3%. Westwood One's six networks also showed audience gains in this demo, with Variety up 16% and Young Adult up 15%, having the largest gains of all the fourteen networks measured in this demo.

Strategic Radio Research has changed its company name to Strategic Media Research immediately and plans to announce three new management-level hires in its Sales and Client Service departments within the next two weeks. The moves come on the heels of a multi-million-dollar investment in the company earlier this year from Chartwell Capital Investors, a Florida-based venture capital firm.

**CANADA THIS WEEK**

In Canada, Telemedia is buying adult contemporary CFMG, Saint Albert, ON in the Edmonton market. The purchase will be Telemedia's 25th station in Canada.

The CHUM Group is buying up the four stations owned by St. Lawrence Broadcasting. St. Lawrence's properties are in southern Ontario where its two FM's get into the Watertown, NY market. The stations are soft AC CFLY (FM) and hot AC CKLC (AM), both Kingston, ON; and AC CFJR (AM) and classic rocker CHXL (FM), both Brockville, ON. The deal will bring CHUM Group's total to 24 stations.

The Canadian Radio & Television Commission is increasing the number of hours stations can simulcast. The new regulation allows co-owned, co-located AM/FM combos to simulcast up to 42 hours per week in addition to the simulcasting that is already permitted between midnight and 6am. The new ruling was made August 23.

**PREMIERE. IT KEEPS ON GROWING AND GROWING AND. . .** Premiere announced its intent to acquire Philadelphia Music Works, Inc. (PMW). PMW produces and distributes jingle services directly to advertisers for cash and to affiliated radio stations in exchange for commercial air time. The purchase price is \$635,000 cash at closing and contingent payments aggregating up to \$700,000 based on audience levels delivered by PMW over the next 3 years. Any contingent payments would be in cash or stock at Premiere's option. Closing is subject to approval by Premiere's Board of Directors.

**UNITY ON CLOUD NINE. . .** Unity Broadcasting has announced it will buy Cloud 9 Broadcasting's gold-based AC WERA, Plainfield, NJ for \$1 million. Unity owns gospel and talk-formatted WWRL, New York, which is at 1600 kHz. It has a construction permit to increase to 25,000 watts days but is precluded from doing that because it has to protect WERA on 1590 kHz. WERA will probably be shut down after the purchase. The new daytime coverage of WWRL would pick up an additional 1.8 million potential listeners within its 5 mv/m contour.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

The NAB has filed comments with the FCC regarding the revision of Section 73.3526(d) of the Rules regarding the location of stations' public files. The NAB's arguments largely cite Salem Communication's response to the proposed rulemaking, which would require licensees to keep the public file at the main studio, regardless of whether the studio is located in the city of license. The NAB favors the proposal because it believes it's obvious the public would find the file from where the station primarily operates. It believes locating the files at the main studio would lessen the chance that the file will be incomplete due to relocating files to a place other than the main studio. The NAB is asking that the provision should also extend to stations that are in an LMA.

The NAB disagrees with proposals that would require licensees to accommodate people who are unwilling to visit the main studio. The Commission has proposed requiring licensees to either deliver the public file to the individual or provide round-trip transportation to the station, as well as forcing the station to respond to all telephone or mail requests regarding the public file. The NAB argues that the vast majority of studios are easily accessible, and that transporting a public file, which may take up an entire file cabinet, is unreasonable.

The Commission is looking into the silent status of Lamoille Broadcasting and Communications' WSJR (AM), Madawaska, ME and WLVC (AM), Fort Kent, ME. WSJR and WLVC have been silent since March 7, 1994 and the special temporary authority permitting the stations to remain silent expired September 1, 1995. Lamoille filed a response in March of this year requesting extension of silence authority and stating that it was in the process of selling the stations on or about March 15 and anticipated filing a status report regarding the outcome prior to April 1. FCC records reveal that neither an application for the assignment or transfer of control of either station's license, nor a status report has been filed. The stations have 30 days to file a written appearance to show cause why the licenses should not be revoked.

Charles Moss's KRKE (AM), Aspen, CO's silent status is also under investigation by the Commission. KRKE has been off the air since May 25, 1993 and the special temporary authority permitting the station to remain silent expired June 5, 1995. The licensee has been attempting to donate the station's facilities to the Aspen School District for use as a teaching tool for the community's students but failed to request an extension of the station's silent authorization since it's expiration. Moss has 30 days to file written appearance to "show cause why" the license should not be revoked.

Up for renewal is WMTD (AM), Hinton, WV who suspended operations on January 27, 1993 when the owner of the station's transmitting antenna site ordered Bluestone Broadcasters, Inc. to remove its facilities from the property. The special temporary authorization permitting the station to remain silent expired February 24, 1996. Bluestone filed a further request for extension on February 21. The Commission records reveal that attempts to secure an acceptable site have not been successful. Bluestone has 20 days to present evidence of it's intent to expeditiously resume broadcast operations and that renewal of the license would serve the public interest.

The Commission granted Prism Radio Partners' WWKY-AM, WVEZ-FM and WTFX-FM, Louisville, KY, license renewals but fined them \$16,000 based on EEO violations. The violations include Prism's failure to recruit minorities for 23 of the 60 full-time vacancies between June, 1993 and March, 1996 and failure to self-assess the effectiveness of it's EEO efforts. The Commission also imposed reporting conditions to monitor the stations' prospective EEO performance.

License renewal was granted for WCMS Radio Norfolk, Inc.'s WCMS-AM & FM, Norfolk, VA who also received a \$14,000 forfeiture for inadequate minority recruitment and self-assessment of it's EEO efforts. The Commission also imposed reporting conditions to monitor future EEO performance at the station.

The Commission announced that the filing fee for renewal applications for commercial AM/FM/TV broadcast stations has been increased from \$115 to \$125 effective September 12, 1996. The filing fee for renewal applications for commercial FM/TV translator and LPTV stations remains unchanged, as does the filing fee for ownership reports for commercial AM/FM/TV stations.



WASHINGTON THIS WEEK (cont'd)

The Commission denied application for reinstatement and extension of the construction permit for Deltaville Communications' unbuilt station WLUD-FM in Deltaville, VA. At the time of the permit's expiration, the Commission had not received either an application for extension of time to construct or an application for license to cover the permit. Deltaville claims that its original extension request had been timely filed but thereafter had been lost by the Commission. Deltaville's plans were to modify the facility and was awaiting Commission action on a modification filed by WMYK, Moyock, NC which would alleviate the potential for short-spacing and allow them to operate from a different site. The Commission further stated that Deltaville has not made "substantial progress" toward construction.

The Commission granted an application for assignment of license KXGO, Arcata, CA, from Westar Broadcasting Group, Ltd. to Miller Broadcasting Company, Inc. and the related request for waiver of the one-to-a-market rule, which restricts common radio and television station ownership in the same market. Miller convinced the Commission that joint operation of the stations will result in significant cost savings as well as the potential for enhanced programming and service benefits to the community. The Commission further stated that the market will continue to be served by other media "voices" and that the proposed combination will not create any undue concentration of ownership or control of broadcast media. The application was unopposed.

ELSEWHERE

With the blessing of the Justice Department, the Commission has granted the transfer applications for the Jacor/Citicasters merger. Jacor wasted no time closing the deal, which creates the fourth largest radio group with 66 U.S. stations. Jacor paid \$29.50 per share plus one warrant per diluted share for the company. In order to accommodate Citicasters senior management, Randy Michaels has been named CEO. Citicasters' Robert Lawrence is the group's new President/COO while David Crowl is the President of the newly formed "Radio Division." This week, Jacor also closed on its three station purchase in Lexington, KY from Trumper Communications, as well.

On the other hand, The Justice Department has told Jacor it can't back the purchase of oldies WGRR, Hamilton, OH (Cincinnati) by Tsunami Communications. Jacor had planned to provide financing to Tsunami for the \$31 million purchase from The Dalton Group. Jacor's deal with Citicasters requires the divestiture of CHR WKRQ, Cincinnati, a Citicasters station. The DOJ said the backing of Tsunami would have "nullified" the divestiture.

In the story we ran in our September 4, issue regarding the EZ/Evergreen swap of stations in Charlotte and Philadelphia, we incorrectly stated that WIOQ and WUSL were owned by Evergreen. They are owned by EZ Communications and are in an LMA with Evergreen.

Salem Communications continues its expansion with the purchase of contemporary Christian WHLO, Akron and southern gospel WTLO-FM, Canton for \$8 million from Mortenson Broadcasting. The stations are the first purchase for Salem in the Akron/Canton area. Salem recently bought WHK, Cleveland. When closed, Salem will own 38 stations.

The owners of Caribou Broadcasting, which owns rocker KATT-FM, hot AC KYIS, and jazz KTNT-FM, Edmond (Oklahoma City), will have a long way to travel for its most recent acquisition. Caribou is buying modern KPOI, Honolulu for \$2,125 million from Charles Cotton. It's Caribou's first purchase outside its home market. Kalil & Co. was the broker.

Premiere Radio Networks has signed a Letter of Intent to become the exclusive sales representative for network radio advertising for AudioNet. AudioNet broadcasts the live audio of radio and television stations and networks, the live play-by-play of professional and college sports, live concerts and corporate and special events, such as annual meetings, trade shows, press conferences and quarterly earnings calls to users of the World Wide Web. Premiere will itself invest \$4 million in AudioNet along with other strategic investors, including Motorola.

ELSEWHERE (cont'd)

Premiere has also signed an agreement to become the exclusive network radio sales rep for The One-On-One Sports Radio Network. Chicago-based One-On-One has more than 360 station affiliates, including 45 in the top 50 markets.

Shadow now competing with radio? Shadow Broadcast Services has announced a partnership with America Online Digital City Los Angeles to provide traffic information through regional graphic maps and textual reports. The main focus will be Sigalerts, major accidents, heavy congestion, alternative routes and natural or emergency closures. Currently Shadow provides real-time traffic information for AOL Digital Cities in Philadelphia, San Diego, San Francisco and Washington, DC.

Interep Research released a new report on the CHR format. Highlights are that CHR listeners are heavy consumers of fast-food, beer, movies, as well as PCs and cellular phones. According to the report, CHR tends to have a slight female skew - 55% of the audience are women. For more info, call (212) 916-0700.

M STREET BAZAAR. . . PEOPLE, PRODUCTS, AND PROGRAMMING

The CBS Radio Networks began broadcasting a new 60-second program entitled "The Forbes Report." The program will air Monday-Friday and will be reported once a week by Steve Forbes, Editor-in-Chief and President of Forbes Magazine. The show can be heard nationally on The Mary Matalin Show and CBS Radio's post-season Major League Baseball and regular-season NFL football broadcasts. For more info, call (212) 975-3774.

New Radio Star introduced Radio Star Radio, a radio station whose target audience is people in the radio and record industries, as well as people who love the business. The radio station plays 24-hours-a-day, seven days a week on the Internet. Radio Star Radio Live has industry news, plays new music with new artists, interviews and features such as "Hollywood Report from Hollystar," "News N Stuff," the "This Morning Prep Sheet" and "Superstar." The rest of the day is taken up by overnighted tapes of the previous day's show from various personality shows around the U.S., Canada and New Zealand. Premiere Radio Networks and Huntsman Entertainment, Inc. announced that they have formed an association in which Huntsman will develop and produce a series of country radio specials for Premiere, along with interviews for Premier's "Country Plain Wrap Countdown" program. The company's first venture will be the production of the "Martina McBride and Friends Special Live from Nashville" which will air in October during country music month.

The NAB announced that the 1996 NAB Radio Show, to be held October 9-12 in Los Angeles, will be the last held in conjunction with conferences produced by Radio-Television News Directors Association (RTNDA), Society of Broadcast Engineers (SBE) and Society of Motion Picture and Television Engineers (SMPTE) under the World Media Expo umbrella to allow greater flexibility in scheduling and locating future Radio Shows. The 1997 NAB Radio Show will be held September 17-20 in New Orleans.

ABC Radio Networks has named Nancy Wetmore Account Executive for the Advertising Sales Department in Dallas. Wetmore will be responsible for developing new business and servicing existing accounts in the Southwest region.

**BIG . . .** Evergreen Media spent a ton of cash this week. It's picking up a combo in Philadelphia and a duopoly in San Francisco for \$218 million. The Brown Organization will sell children's KDFC, classical KDFC-FM, and jazz KKSF for \$115 million. The company adds these to urban KMEL, hot AC KIOI, and dance KYLD, San Mateo to max out the ownership limit in that market. Beasley Broadcast Group will get \$103 million for WDAS and WDAS-FM. An immediate LMA was announced for San Francisco, but nothing was mentioned for Philly. Probably because Evergreen already owns two FM's there (hot AC WYXR and jazz WJJZ) and has an LMA-to-purchase three others (classical WFLN-FM from Secret and urban WUSL/dance WIOQ from EZ). Buying WDAS-FM will put them over the FM ownership cap of five FM's. Peter Handy of Star Media Group brokered the deal.

**BIGGER . . .** Jacor's Randy Michaels is adding to his collection this week. Reaffirming his commitment to radio, he is swapping Jacor's television station in Tampa, WTSP (CBS), for six of Gannett's eleven stations. Jacor will pick up CHR combo KIIS-AM & FM, Los Angeles; news/talk KSDO and soft AC KKBH, San Diego; and hot AC simulcast WDAE and WUSA, Tampa. The value or terms of the deal weren't disclosed. The group will have its full complement of five FM's in Tampa with easy listening WDUV, Bradenton; CHR WFLZ, classic rock WTBT, New Port Richey; and rocker WXTB Clearwater along with AM talker WFLA. The company currently owns only one FM in San Diego, dance KHTS, El Cajon, CA and LMA's sports XETRA and new rock XETRA-FM, Tijuana. It's Jacor's first shot at L.A. Gannett keeps country simulcast KKBQ, Houston and KKBQ-FM, Pasadena; CHR KHKS, Denton, TX (Dallas); and urban-oldies WGCI and urban WGCI-FM, Chicago. No LMA's were announced.

**WASHINGTON THIS WEEK**

Two more DAB manufacturers have pulled out of testing of the in-band on-channel system because no acceptable testing facility is available. AT&T/Lucent Technologies and Amati Communications Corp. informed the Consumer Electronics Manufacturers Association (CEMA) that they pulled out because no station in San Francisco would volunteer for the experiments. USA Digital Radio pulled out for the same reasons last May. The concept of in-band on-channel DAB has been wrought with problems because of poor performance in the lab. CEMA President, Gary Shapiro, questions the future of IBOC stating that future redesigns, "must be skeptically weighed against broadcasters' interest in delaying digital radio and the realities of present-day physics." Three systems are still undergoing tests, none of which are IBOC. NAB President Eddie Fritts has written to all three IBOC developers stating it will again "offer its services to facilitate a fair and impartial IBOC testing program" once the technology is "appropriately developed."

The commission held a hearing regarding license renewal for Hometown Media, Inc.'s WAYB(AM), Waynesboro, VA to determine whether they have the capability and intent to expeditiously resume broadcast operations, whether they violated Commission Rules to remain silent, and if the grant of renewal application would serve the public interest. Hometown proved plans for the sale of the station to Valley Communications and arrangements for the necessary equipment to allow WAYB to return to the air. Valley plans to LMA the station until FCC approval of the transfer. As to the silent status of the station, in March 1995, before going silent, Hometown filed a request for Special Temporary Authority to remain silent which expired February 16, 1996. No further request to remain silent was filed. Hometown admits this violation but the FCC found "it was inadvertent and of short duration and not a deliberate flouting of the Commission's rules." The renewal was granted conditioned on the expeditious resumption of operations on or before January 15, 1997.

Consumers in Illinois, Minnesota, Michigan, Oklahoma, South Carolina and Georgia are now able to reach the FCC's National Call Center by calling 1-888-CALL-FCC. The Center will respond to inquiries of telecommunications issues and will provide information on obtaining a license or form and how to file a complaint. Full nationwide coverage is planned by early 1997.

Jac-Vin Religious Broadcasters, Inc.'s religion/southern gospel WJTD, McArthur, OH has applied to change from non-commercial to commercial status. The class A station is licensed on 98.7 MHz with 6000 watts at 328 feet.

In Dallas, CBS is swapping classic rock KRRW and rock KTXQ, Ft. Worth for SFX Broadcasting's new rock WHFS, Annapolis, MD serving the Baltimore and Washington, DC markets. The deal is a tax-free "like-kind" exchange that will give CBS an FM-FM combo in Washington as it owns classic rocker WARW, Bethesda, MD. The trade is on the heels of a previously announced swap of SFX-owned talker KRLD, Dallas and the Texas State Networks for CBS' classic rocker KKRW, Houston. Paul Leonard of Star Media brokered the deal. CBS' pending merger with Infinity Broadcasting will put the new group over the FM limit by three in Dallas--they'll have to spin one more to be legal.

Spanish Broadcasting System is buying two more FM stations in the Miami/Ft. Lauderdale market, bringing its totals there to an AM and three FM's. New Age Broadcasting will get \$110 million for Spanish hits WXDJ, Homestead and Spanish AC WRMA, Ft. Lauderdale. SBS will combo the two FM's with Spanish talk WCMQ Miami Springs and Spanish soft AC WCMQ-FM, Hialeah. New Age President, Russ Oasis, will stay on with SBS as Exec. VP/COO.

Benchmark Communications is buying a third FM in the Columbia, SC market. It will spend \$4.1 million on Congaree Broadcasters' standards WSCQ. The purchase will up its station count in that market to five as it owns news/talk WVOC, sports WCOS, and country WCOS-FM, all Columbia; and country WHKZ, Cayce, SC.

E.D. Rivers Group is selling off its Savannah, GA properties for \$3.75 million. Eddie Esserman and Leon Perlis of Ogeechee Broadcasting are buying sports WEAS and urban WEAS-FM. The purchase will make Ogeechee a group, as it owns talk/sports WMWR and oldies WAYS, Macon, GA.

Nashville-based Morningstar's High Country format will be discontinued as of October 25, according to Christian Research Report. This comes after the recently announced purchase by Salem Radio Networks of the High Country format and its contemporary Christian counterpart, Today's Christian Music. Salem has also recently purchased The Word In Music, the contemporary Christian network based in Colorado Springs, CO.

ABC Radio is retiring its Z-Rock format at the end of the year. Over the past 10 years, Z-Rock's musical focus has moved from metal to hard rock and then to alternative. ABC plans to focus its rock efforts on its Classic "AOR" and MR-35 formats.

The Utica-Rome Spring 1996 Arbitron Market Report has been reissued. Listener estimates for WKLL(FM), Frankfort, NY based on an assignment of diary credit that did not appropriately reflect all listening in Oneida County which was credited to out-of-market station WKRL-FM, North Syracuse. Listener estimates for other stations in the report are not affected. Arbitron has mailed revised tapes.

The Arbitron Company is mailing Radio Advisory Council eligibility forms to its station clients. This is the first step of the election process for five format/market size representatives. First time members will be elected for AOR and news/talk formats. Arbitron subscribers who hold the title of GM or higher and are involved in the day-to-day operation of a radio station may indicate their desire to run by returning the forms. Names will be placed on the election ballot to be chosen by their peers from stations in their formats and market size. For more info, call (410) 312-8239.

At the NAB Radio Show, here are some things you won't want to miss. ABC Radio Networks is holding a reception and party on Oct. 9 at the Wells Fargo Building (across from the Biltmore Hotel) and serving up hospitality in Suite #1170 at the Biltmore Hotel. Demonstrations will be held of the audio server and ABC NewsWire in booth #2059 at the Convention Center. ABC News will sponsor the RTNDA Luncheon on Friday with speaker Sam Donaldson. CBS will sponsor the NAB Radio Luncheon Oct. 11 with a keynote address by Dolly Parton. In addition, CBS will feature 16 panels covering topics ranging from formats to websites to digital studios. Brian Setzer and his Orchestra will be the entertainment at the "Friday Night Party", sponsored by SW Networks and R&R. The reception will take place at the Biltmore Hotel in the Tiffany and Crystal Ballrooms beginning at 6pm.

ESPN Radio Network is set to provide live national broadcasts of the 1996-97 NBA season with "The NBA On ESPN Radio." The show will debut on Jan. 19. Coverage will include 15 regular season games, select First Round playoffs, Semi-Final Playoffs, '97 Conference Finals, NBA Finals, the All-Star Game, two All-Star Weekend Specials and The NBA draft. For more info, call (972) 991-9200.

The Los Angeles Times reports that the Fox network is under fire for it's "promos on its weekend radio countdown show. It claims the promos, ads and assorted host chitchat bleed into each other that it's sometimes hard for an adult -- no less a child -- to tell which is which. Fox claims the "Fox Kids Countdown" is heard on more than 180 stations representing almost 90% of the country. The FCC rules, adopted in 1974, prohibit the host of a children's TV show from using his special bond to push products on them and require broadcasters to maintain "an adequate separation between programming and advertising." But the story says the rules do not apply to radio. Jeff Chester, Executive Director of the Washington-based Center for Media Education, will ask it's attorneys "to investigate, file [a complaint] and ask the FCC to come up with new rules" to address the children's radio market which wasn't in existence when the FCC guidelines for TV were created. Fox claims their countdown show is not even carrying the amount of commercials they could under the guidelines and the show is family-oriented, not just for kids.
