


THIS FINDS EXPRESSION THROUGH APPROPRIATE ARTICLES IN THE CLUB JOURNAL; THROUGH THE COMPILATION AND CATALOGING OF DATA BY THE OFFICIAL CLUB HISTORIAN AND BY THE FREQUENT PUBLICATION OF THE LOCATIONS OF HISTORICAL LIBRARIES AND MUSEUMS.

5. TO ENCOURAGE FRIENDLY AND MATERIAL ASSISTANCE TO AFFLICTED AND HANDICAPPED ASSOCIATES

THIS FINDS EXPRESSION IN OFFICIAL CLUB PROJECTS ORGANIZED FOR THE PURPOSE; IN THE ACTIVITIES OF INDIVIDUAL MEMBERS AND THE PUBLICATION THEREOF, ALTHO NOT NECESSARILY REVEALING THE BENEFACTOR'S IDENTITY; AND IN THE REVELATION OF IDEAS WHICH WILL IN FACT PROVIDE BENEFITS NOT BESTOWED IN THE PAST.

6. TO ASSIST IN SETTING UP COMMUNICATION CHANNELS BETWEEN FAMILY MEMBERS WIDELY SEPARATED AND ISOLATED BY DISTANCE AND INADEQUATE FACILITIES

THIS FINDS EXPRESSION IN THE DX AND PHONE-PATCH ACTIVITIES OF INDIVIDUAL MEMBERS AND THE MEANS FOR SYSTEMATICALLY REPORTING THESE ACTIVITIES IN THE CLUB JOURNAL SO THAT MORE MEMBERS WILL BE ENCOURAGED TO PARTICIPATE.

7. TO ACCUMULATE, RESTORE AND EXHIBIT RELICS OF THE WIRELESS AND RADIO PAST AND ENCOURAGE AND SUPPORT THE ESTABLISHMENT OF MUSEUMS FOR THE PURPOSE

THIS FINDS EXPRESSION IN THE TABULATION AND CATALOGING OF ALL SIGNIFICANT RELICS IN THIS CATEGORY INCLUDING (A) COLLECTIONS WITHIN THE CLUB JURISDICTION AND (B) SIMILAR COLLECTIONS ESTABLISHED BY OTHERS. ALSO, IN THE TABULA—TION OF ALL RELICS AVAILABLE FOR POTENTIAL TRANSFER TO OTHERS BY INDIVIDUAL MEMBERS THROUGH THEIR FAMILY, EXECUTORS OR TRUSTEES. ALSO IN THE PERIODIC DISPLAY OF TRAVELING OR PORTABLE EXHIBITS AT RADIO CONVENTIONS AND SIMILAR ASSEMBLIES. AND FINALLY, IN THE ESTABLISHMENT OF PLANS AND PROCEDURES WHICH WILL INSURE THE INTEGRITY, PRESERVATION AND ADMINISTRATION OF THOSE RELICS INTO FUTURE YEARS.

TO ANSWER ALL THESE PEOPLE WE PRINT THIS MONTH ON THE INSIDE FRONT COVER THE INTERPRETA-TION MENTIONED ABOVE. NO MEMBER CAN READ THIS WITHOUT FINDING HIS PLACE IN THE FRAMEWORK. SOME, IN THEIR ACTIVI-TIES WILL BE LIMITED TO ITEMS 1, 3 AND 6. OTHERS WILL BE MOTIVATED BY ITEMS 2, 4 AND 5. STILL OTHERS, ENTIRELY UNNOTICED, WILL BE ACTIVE WITHIN THE SCOPE OF ITEM 5.

RUNNING IN ALL DIRECTIONS


ON PAGE 26 ALEC TRAUN ACCUSES US OF RUN NING IN ALL DIRECTIONS AT ONCE. TO SAY THAT WE 'RUN' IS MOST GENEROUS. IN MOST OF ITS PROJECTS OOTC MOVES WITH THE SPEED OF A GLACIER. IF ONLY WE COULD MOVE AHEAD WITH ALL DELIBERATE SPEED IN THOSE SEV-ERAL DIRECTIONS PRESCIBED BY OUR CONSTI-TUTION AND BY-LAWS!

AS THE SUBJECT OF 'RUNNING' HAS COME UP LET ME SAY THIS: IT MAY BE A SURPRISE BUT THIS CLUB IS BEING RUN BY A HANDFUL OF WELL-INTENTIONED AUTOCRATS, ME INCLUDED. THE DIRECTORS PARTICIPATE BY TELEPATHY. AS A GUIDE WE HAVE A HALF-FINISHED "RULE BOOK" WHICH SAYS ONE THING ON, ONE PAGE AND JUST THE OPPOSITE ON ANOTHER.

BASICALLY, OUR "RULE BOOK" IS FLEXIBLE. IT INCLUDES A PROCEDURE FOR MAKING AL-MOST ANY CHANGE YOU COULD POSSIBLY WANT. IF YOU WANT 50 DIRECTORS, OR 2, YOU CAN HAVE THEM. IF YOU WANT AN ADVISORY COM-MITTEE IN EVERY DISTRICT YOU CAN HAVE IT. ALMOST ANYTHING THE MEMBERS WANT THEY CAN HAVE. EXCEPTION: ONE THING YOU CAN'T HAVE IS A GUARANTEE THAT WHATEVER YOU VOTE FOR WILL WORK.

IT ISN'T THAT WE DON'T HAVE TALENT, EX-PERIENCE, WISDOM, MATURITY IN THE RANKS OF THE AUTOCRATS. THOSE QUALITIES A-BOUND ABOVE AVERAGE. YET OUR SYSTEM DOES NOT WORK. WHY? IF YOU REALLY WANT TO KNOW BOYS, IT IS FEAR. WE OFFICIALS FEAR THAT WE WILL SEEM TOO AGGRESSIVE. FEAR THAT ACTION WILL LEAD TO CRITICISM. THE RESULT IS STAGNATION IN THE APPLICA-TION OF CORRECTIVES. OR PROGRESS, AT THE SPEED OF A GLACIER.

THERE'S NO HOPE FOR IMPROVEMENT, BOYS UNTIL YOU WRITE THESE SELF-EFFACING AUTO-CRATS AND TELL THEM IN NO UNCERTAIN TERMS THAT YOU WANT ALL THE RULES TO WORK. NOT MUCH SENSE IN CHANGING ANY RULES UNTIL THERE'S ALSO A WILL TO MAKE WHATEVER RULES WE HAVE WORK.




AUGUST SPARK GAP TIMES WILL REPORT THE RESULTS OF THE PURCHASING POWER SURVEY. INDICATIONS NOW SUGGEST THE PROJECT WILL NOT QUITE MAKE THE GRADE. TANGIBLE PUR-CHASES, PER REPORTEE, WAY EXCEEDED EX-PECTATIONS. SOME APOLOGIZED FOR BUYING AS LITTLE AS \$500. IT WOULD SEEM THAT MOST OF YOU THOUGHT IT NOT WORTHWHILE TO REPORT UNLESS YOU HAD LAID OUT \$1000 OR MORE. TOTAL RETURNS MAY NOT QUITE REACH 200. Too MANY MEMBERS RELUCTANT TO RE-PORT EVEN THO WE CLOTHED THEIR DATA IN ANONYMINITY. OUR SUBSCRIBERS REPRESENT A VERY FERTILE MARKET BUT WE CAN'T PROVE IT. AT LEAST NOT YET.

AUGUST SPARK GAP TIMES WILL ALSO TABULATE THOSE MEMBERS WHO HAVE BEEN PAID WIRELESS OPERATORS, MEMBERS OF OOTC AND CURRENTLY SUBSCRIBING TO SGT. THESE RETURNS ARE POURING IN AS WE GO TO PRESS. THE TOTAL WILL INDICATE THE APPROXIMATE PROPORTION IN THAT CATEGORY AND THEREBY GUIDE FUTURE EDITORS IN CHOOSING MATERIAL TO GO INTO SGT. AT THE 68TH MEETING ON MARCH 23RD MRS.


DEGNA MARCONI PARESCE, A DAUGHTER OF SENATORE GUGLIELMO MARCONI SPOKE TO US THRU

INTERVENED AND W1NQ SUBSTITUTED.

AT THIS SAME MEETING THE 3RD HONORARY MEMBER, GENERAL IVAN L. FARMAN (1912) USAF DEPUTY DIRECTOR OF COMMUNICATIONS, WASH INGTON, D.C. WAS INDUCTED.

DURING 1950 THE FOLLOWING OFFICERS WERE IN COMMAND: PRESIDENT, W1ZE. VICE-PRESIDENT, W1ANA. SECRETARY, W1NQ. TREASURER, W1TK.

ARE WE KEEPING SPARK GAP TIMES AFLOAT?

WE ARE BY NO MEANS SURE THAT THE USE OF XX ON ENVELOPES WILL BE ENOUGH OF A PROD TO KEEP READERS RENEWING SUBSCRIPTIONS.

IN APRIL, 56 ENVELOPES WERE SO MARKED. THE RATIO TO THE TOTAL OF 571 MAGAZINES MAILED WAS THUS ABOUT 10%. THE HIGHEST RATIO OF IMMINENT LAPSES WAS 25% AMONG THE ASSOCIATE MEMBERS, THE LOWEST WAS 0% IN THE 9TH DISTRICT.

However the ratio of Already Lapsed Subscribers to total members rose sharply to 20% - 147 to be exact. A number of these members were lapses who had reported purchasing thousands of dollars worth of tangible items in 1966. So Poverty could not be the only reason for failure to renew.

THE PRELIMINARY WARNING "X"; THE ACTION SIGNAL "XX", POSSIBLY ARE NOT WORKING. ONE READER GOT THE EDITOR ON THE AIR TO ASK WHAT THE TWO X'S MEANT! TO SEND A SEPARATE BILL TO EACH SUBSCRIBER WILL INCREASE BOTH TIME AND COSTS.

THERE WILL BE THOSE WHO, HAVING NO RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE SOUNDNESS OF OUR
FINANCES, WILL URGE THAT NO IMMEDIATE
ACTION BE TAKEN TO AVOID A DEFICIT.
THEY WILL POINT TO OUR CURRENT FINANCIAL
SURPLUS AND ASK, "WHY WORRY?".

THIS ATTITUDE IS OPPOSITE TO THOSE WHO ARE CARRYING WITHOUT COMPENSATION THE BULK OF THE WORK LOAD. THESE FEW COUNSEL CAUTION, KNOWING THAT OUR CONTINGENT LIABILITIES AND OBLIGATIONS COULD BE SUBSTANTIAL. SUPPOSE, FOR LACK OF AN EDITOR, PUBLICATION OF SGT CEASED. THE CLUB WOULD BE OBLIGATED TO REFUND SUBSCRIPTION MONEY PAID AHEAD AND THIS COULD AMOUNT TO OVER \$1000.

PAPER PRICES HAVE CONTINUED RISING, IN-CREASING ENVELOPE COST. POSTAGE WILL GO UP, AND SOON. THIRD CLASS MAIL DELIVERY HAS SO DETERIORATED THAT FIRST CLASS MAIL MAY BE NECESSARY TO KEEP OUR SUB-SCRIBERS HAPPY. THIS WILL LIFT POSTAGE COSTS 100 TO 200%.

THOSE RESPONSIBLE FOR SOUND FISCAL ACTION ALSO KNOW THAT SGT CANNOT BE GOT OUT INDEFINITELY BELOW PUBLISHING COSTS. IF WE LOST OUR MEMBER PUBLISHER, WHO NOW CONTRIBUTES BOTH TIME AND MONEY, PRINTING COST COULD RISE AT LEAST 35%. ONLY A HANDFUL OF MEMBERS APPRECIATE THE EFFORT INVOLVED GETTING THE MAGAZINE INTO THE BLACK AND IMPROVING IT AT THE SAME TIME. IT IS EASY, AND THOUGHTLESS, FOR THOSE ON THE NON-WORKING SIDE-LINES TO VOTE DISSIPATION OF HARD-EARNED RESOURCES.

EVEN MORE IMPORTANT THAN THE FINANCIAL PROBLEM IS THE FACT THAT 147 OF OUR MEMBERS ARE NOT NOW RECEIVING SGT, WHICH MEANS THAT THEY ARE OUT OF TOUCH WITH CLUB AFFAIRS. OUR SUBSCRIBING MEMBERS COULD DO SOMETHING ABOUT THIS. IF WE PUBLISHED THE CALL SIGNS OF THE NON-PAYING MEMBERS, AND IF EACH READER HAD A REMINDER QSO WITH JUST ONE OF THOSE WHO HAD NEGLECTED TO RENEW, QUICK ACTION FROM MOST OF THESE LAPSEES WOULD BE INEVITABLE. SOME WHO LAPSED A LONG TIME AGO WOULD NOW SUBSCRIBE. AND THAT 20% FRINGE NOW PREVAILING WOULD SHRINK DOWN TO A LIVABLE 10 OR 12%.

AS HAS BEEN SAID BEFORE, NO MEMBER IS UNDER ANY OBLIGATION TO SUBSCRIBE. AND CERTAINLY SGT CAN NEVER PLEASE EVERY-BODY. SO THE PUBLICATION OF THESE CALL SIGNS WOULD NOT HAVE THE INTENT OF STIG-MATIZING THOSE WHO DO NOT CARE FOR THE MAGAZINE. IT IS PLAIN THAT A GREAT MA-JORITY OF MEMBERS WANT TO KEEP THEIR SUBSCRIPTIONS CURRENT, AND WOULD DO SO IF REMINDED OFTEN ENOUGH. PRINTING 100 OR SO CALL SIGNS TAKES VERY LITTLE SPACE, BUT BEFORE DOING THIS, AT THE RISK OF OFFENDING A MINORITY, SEND THE EDITOR A BRIEF STATEMENT OF YOUR VIEWS. THE ATTITUDE THEN SEEMING TO PREVAIL WILL THEN BE PUBLICIZED BEFORE ANY AC-TION IS TAKEN. USE A QSL CARD IF CON-VENIENT. A SIMPLE "YES" OR "MO" WILL MAKE THE PROBLEM EASIER TO RESOLVE.

A HIGHER PRICE FOR SGT DOES NOT SOLVE THE PROBLEM OF LAPSED SUBSCRIPTIONS.

EVEREY EFFORT HAS BEEN MADE TO PERSUADE THOSE STILL LIVING TO SEND A BRIEF REPORT OF THEIR CURRENT STATUS AND IF POSSIBLE A PICTURE. 

EACH TAPE, WHEN READY, IS PRECEDED BY A RADIO MESSAGE TO THE SERVICE MAN CONCERNED, TO ALERT HIM REGARDING THE INCOMING TAPE. THESE MESSAGES ARE DISPATCHED THROUGH MARS OR APPROPRIATE CIVILIAN NETS. SOME OPERATORS, SUCH AS KENNETH KROTH SHOWN ABOVE HAVE DISPATCHED UP TO 100 MESSAGES A DAY.

THE COST OF TAPES, SPOOLS, POSTAGE, TELE-PHONE SERVICE AND SPACE FOR THE RECORDING OPERATORS IS ABSORBED BY DAVE'S WHOLESALE COMPANY AND CONTRIBUTING ORGANIZATIONS.

CO-OPERATING ORGANIZATIONS FURNISHING VOLUNTEERS ARE ALMOST WITHOUT LIMIT.

SERVICE MEN, WHERE THEY HAVE FACILITIES AVAILABLE, OFTEN SEND REPLY MESSAGES BACK ON THE UNUSED EDGE OF THE TAPE.

HUNDREDS OF APPRECIATIVE LETTERS HAVE COME IN TO DAVE FROM ALL OVER.

AS YOU MAY HAVE GUESSED BY NOW, THIS IS A SERVICE WHICH CAN EVEN BE OPERATED BY ONE MAN IN A WHEEL CHAIR AT ANY TIME OF YEAR OR IT CAN BE EXPANDED INTO A TREMENDOUS ANNUAL DRIVE INVOLVING HUNDREDS OF WORKERS AND THOUSANDS OF TAPED MSGS.

HERE IS JUST THE THING JOE UHALT WAS GROPING FOR BACK THERE IN DECEMBER. IN HIS WORDS: "I FEEL NO ORGANIZATION CAN GET VERY FAR UNLESS IT HAS SOME MOTIVE, SOME PROJECT, SOME PURPOSE FROM A MATERIAL SENSE."


HERE IS AN ACTIVITY THAT JUST ONE MEMBER WITH A RECORDER AND TELEPHONE, EVEN IN A SMALL TOWN, CAN START TOMORROW. OR A MEMBER GROUP IN A METROPOLITAN AREA CAN GO INTO IT ON AN ORGANIZED BASIS WITH PUBLICITY, MEETINGS AND ALL THE TRAPPINGS. NO NEED TO WAIT FOR CHRISTMAS. THE BOYS ARE IN THE BATTLEFIED ALL YEAR.

HOW DO WE START? IT COULD BE THIS SIMPLE: SUPPOSE JOE DOAK HAS A RECORDER, TELEPHONE AND KNOW-HOW SUFFICIENT TO GET AN INCOMING MESSAGE ON TO TAPE. HE CAN PHONE OR WRITE THE LOCAL PAPER EDITOR THAT BETWEEN THE HOURS OF SUCH AND SUCH HE WILL ACCEPT A MESSAGE FROM ANY FAMILY WITH A SERVICE MAN OVERSEAS, TO BE RECORDED AND SENT WITHOUT COST. THEN, WHEN YOU TAKE A MESSAGE OR TWO INFORM THE EXECUTIVE SECRETARY WHAT YOU HAVE DONE. IF HE GETS THREE OR FOUR SUCH REPORTS HE WILL PASS THEM ALONG TO THE DIRECTORS WHO WILL DECIDE WHETHER THIS SHOULD BE AN OFFICIAL CLUB PROJECT TO BE SUPPORTED WITH CLUB FUNDS AT LEAST TO THE EXTENT OF DEFRAYING COST OF SPOOLS, TAPE AND POSTAGE SO THAT NO MEMBER NEED BE OUT OF POCKET. IF THE DIRECTORS GO THAT FAR THEN A GOODWILL AMBASSADOR SHOULD BE AP-POINTED TO MANAGE AND CO-ORDINATE ALL THE ACTIVITY. THE CLUB MIGHT EVEN APPROPRI-ATE FUNDS FOR RECORDERS FOR UNEOUIPPED MEMBERS. RECORDERS ARE CHEAP.

THAT'S HOW IT COULD START. BY SOME FEW TAKING THE INITIATIVE TO DO SOMETHING TANGIBLE. ONLY GENUINE ACTIVITY CAN PROVE THE WORTH OF THE PROJECT. ADOPTION OF OPERATION GOODWILL AS AN OFFICIAL CLUB PROJECT COULD COME LATER.





WE KNOW EXACTLY HOW THE OPERATOR OF A SKI RESORT MUST FEEL AFTER PREPARING FOR A CAPACITY WASHINGTON'S BIRTHDAY WEEK-END ONLY TO HAVE A DRENCHING RAIN. NOBODY COMES. AND THERE HE IS, UP THE CREEK.

WE GOT ALL 'SET' PAGE-WISE FOR A BIG RUSH OF LISTINGS, NOT MANY NEW ONES PERHAPS, BUT A FLOOD OF CORRECTIONS. WITH THE ADVENT OF DAYLIGHT SAVING, COMING FOR THE FIRST TIME IN ABOUT TWENTY STATES, MANY OF OUR LISTEES WILL FIND THEIR HABITUAL SCHEDULES SHIFTED IN RESPECT TO GMT. HENCE IN THE LISTENING POST SECTIONS PUBLISHED IN DEC. FEB. AND APR. SGT WE ESTIMATE THAT UP TO 30% OF THOSE TIMES COULD NOW BE INCORRECT.


IN THE CLOCK WATCHERS GUIDE FOR APRIL WE ATTEMPTED TO ADJUST FOR DAYLIGHT TIME BY MOVING MOST OF THE GMTS ONE HOUR NEARER GREENWICH. So, WE ESTIMATED THE TIMES SHOWN IN APRIL MIGHT BE 90% CORRECT.

THE ONLY WAY TO INSURE A CORRECT LISTING IS TO STATE THE GMTs AS THEY WILL APPLY IN YOUR OWN CASE FOR BOTH SUMMER (S) AND WINTER (W). JUST TAKE A POST CARD AND LAY IT DOWN UNDER ONE OF THE LISTENING POST HEADINGS AND WRITE DOWN YOUR APPLICABLE DATA. IF WE GET YOU CORRECTLY LISTED IN THE LISTENING POST YOU WILL AUTOMATICALLY BE CORRECTLY LISTED IN THE CLOCK WATCHERS GUIDE. IF YOU SUBMITTED INFORMATION AND FAILED TO FIND YOUR CALL SIGN PUBLISHED, YOU PROBABLY OMITTED ESSENTIAL INFORMATION SUCH AS FREQUENCY, DAY OR TIME. WE HAVE OVER 60 SUCH CARDS.

MANY MEMBERS TAKE THE POSITION THAT THEIR ONE LITTLE STATION DOESN'T COUNT, SO THEY DON'T REPORT. IF ALL TOOK THIS POSITION THE LISTENING POST WOULD SIMPLY FOLD UP.

GET SOME LETTERS READING LIKE THIS: "OLD
OLD TIMERS HAVE A 40 METER NET MORNINGS
AND I HEAR THEM QUITE REGULARLY." HAD A

THEN THERE'S THE PROBLEM OF TIME IN TERMS OF GMT. IT APPEARS THAT ONLY ABOUT 10% OF OUR MEMBERS USE GMT EVEN AS A REFERENCE. PERHAPS ONLY 2% USE GMT IN THEIR LOGS. YET WE MUST USE GMT IN THESE SGT TABULATIONS. MOST OF YOU IN NETS HAVE ALREADY DISCOVERED THE FURTHER COMPLICATION INTRODUCED WITH THE ADOPTION OF DAYLIGHT SAVING TIME. THEREFOR EVERYONE REPORTING NET DATA SHOULD SHOW THE EFFECTIVE GMT IN SUMMER AND THE EFFECTIVE GMT IN WINTER. TO INDICATE USE (S) OR (W).

WE ARE PLEASED TO ANNOUNCE THE START OF A SECOND OLD OLD TIMERS ROUND TABLE TO BE KNOWN AS THE MID-WEST SECTION AS DISTINGUISHED FROM THE NORTH-EAST SECTION. 

THE ABOVE PHO-TO TAKEN IN 1962 SHOWS BOTH GAP AND ORIGINATOR IN AN EXCELLENT STATE OF PRESERVATION. THE LOCALE WAS FLORIDA WHERE LES OPERATES AS W4BZ WHILE HIS MISSOURI FRIENDS WRESTLE WITH SNOW AND WINTER GALES.

TO ADVERTISE ITS WARES THE BENWOOD COMPANY WENT INTO BROADCASTING AS STATION WEB, OPERATING FROM THE CHASE HOTEL IN ST. LOUIS. LATER, REMOVING TO THE MELBOURNE HOTEL IT WAS RELICENSED AS WIL. STILL LATER LES ESTABLISHED STATION WWIL IN FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA AND SOLD OUT BOTH OF THEM WHEN HE RETIRED IN 1957.

IN THE TWENTIES THERE MUST HAVE BEEN A "RADIO ROW" ON OLIVE ST, ST. LOUIS. THE BENWOOD COMPANY AND THE LINZE ELECTRICAL SUPPLY COMPANY, WHO CLAIMED OPERATION SINCE 1887, COULD PRACTICALLY GLOWER AT EACH OTHER FROM ACROSS THE STREET. THEY CARRIED BOTH DUPLICATE AND COMPETING LINES. HOWEVER THIS SITUATION DEVELOPED INTO AN UNDERCOVER COURTSHIP AND LES, AS THE POTENTIAL GROOM, SOLD OUT TO LINZE. THE MARRIAGE ESTABLISHED THE NAME BENWOOD-LINZE. HAROLD J. WRAPE, WHO OWNED LINZE, WAS THE BRIDE APPARENT.

NOT TO BE DISTRACTED BY THIS BUDDING COM-MERCIAL ROMANCE LES ESTABLISHED RAPPORT WITH THE LOCAL POLICE. LES, NOT QUITE SO CONFIDENT, HIS CROSSED FINGERS HIDDEN, IS LOOKING DOWN AT THE EQUIPMENT IN AN ATTITUDE OF PRAYER HOPING NOTHING GOES PFSST. NOTHING DID.

THE TRANSMITTER WAS RATED 10 WATTS AND GOT THE "BUZZER" PART OF NAME FROM THE AUDIBLE ABILITIES OF ITS VIBRATOR POWER SUPPLY. THE RECEIVER USED A MULTI-WAVE TUNER WITH HONEYCOMB COILS AND A DEFOREST ULTRA-AUDION DETECTOR WITH ONE-STAGE AMPLIFIER, ALL PRODUCED IN 1949-20 ERA.

THE VINTAGE OF THE PACKARD IS SUPPORTED BY ITS 36" TIRES, THE KLAXON, THE SPEED-OMETER ON STEERING COLUMN, THE FOLDING TOP, THE COBBLE-PAVED STREET AND EVEN THE MILLINERY WORN BY THE CHAUFFEUR.






IN THE CURB-SIDE PHOTO THE EQUIPMENT HAS BEEN LOWERED TO THE FLOOR OF THE TONNEAU.

- 3. THE CHAIRMAN SHALL SUMMARIZE IN ONE COMMUNICATION THE VIEWS OF EACH OF THE DIRECTORS ON ANY SUBJECT UNDER CONSIDERATION, AND THREE WEEKS BEFORE THE TAKING OF ANY VOTE, SHALL DISTRIBUTE IT TO:
  - A. EACH AND ALL THE DIRECTORS
