NORTH ATLANTIC ICE PATROL DISCONTINUED.

The Ice Patrol and Ice Observation Service was discontinued on June 30, last. (From Hydrographic Bulletin, July 6, 1921.)

CHANGE IN TIME SIGNAL.

The time signal on Kaiser Quay, Hamburg, Germany, is now made at local mean noon, middle European time (15° E. lon.), corresponding to 23 hours Greenwich mean time. (From Hydrographic Bulletin, June 29, 1921.)

RADIO STATION AT MARACAIBO, VENEZUELA.

The work of erecting towers for the new radio station at Maracaibo has been completed and the apparatus is now being installed. It is expected that the installation will be completed the latter part of June, this year. The station is equipped with a 5-kilowatt set with a rotary synchronous spark system. The towers are 164 feet (50 meters) high and the normal sending radius by day w''. be about 800 miles and by night about 1,600 miles. This station will be open to commercial service.

The Venezuelan Government has already definitely arranged for 7 additional wireless stations to be situated at Maracay, Caracas, Puerto Cabello, La Guaira, San Cristobal, Ciudad Bolivar, and Margarita Island. After all the above-mentioned stations are completed there are to be 16 additional stations installed to provide service for the capital of every State in Venezuela. (From daily Commerce Reports, June 29, 1921.)
