



1961 Big Year For Canadian Association of Broadcasters

AMILESTONE of 1960 was the Board of Broadcast Governors' blessing of the first privately-owned television network to be allowed in Canada. The license was granted to S. W. Caldwell Limited Toronto who was unopposed in his application to the Board.

Perhaps more attention was paid to research this year than in any other year in broadcasting's history. The most ambitious project is the Communications Research project being undertaken for Canadian broadcasting at the University of British Columbia. This project was initiated as a memorial to four broadcasting pioneers—Harold Carson; F. H. Elphicke, A. A. Murphy and Harry Sedgwick.

The C.A.B. has donated \$20,000 to this project, and a total of \$300,000 is expected for the fund in toto so that the Communications project can be financed in perpetuity.

The Communications project will be designed to find out what impact radio and TV programs have on people, and why; to what extent these reactions are predictable because of what the people are, rather than what the programs are; basic audience composition, etc.

Another research project which was launched this year was the special study on the French language market, which was undertaken in co-operation with the French language regional association.

Another research project was the complete survey of the buying and selling methods actually or potentially employed in the broadcasting industry. This survey was undertaken by the firm Woods, Gordon of Toronto for the C.A.B.

The C.A.B. also had a committee under

the Chairmanship of Mr. Leo Thompson investigate talent and personnel training. In addition, there were many liaison committees such as the CAB/CAA/CAB Liaison Committee consisting of Mr. R. T. Snelgrove, Mr. K. D. Soble, Mr. J. A. Dupont, Mr. D. A. Gourd and Mr. A. Waters.

The C.A.B. presented four important briefs during 1960. One was presented to the Ministers of Finance and National Revenue asking that broadcasting stations be exempt from application of sales tax. Another brief, dealing with political broadcasting, was submitted to the House of Commons Standing Committee on Elections and Privileges. A brief was also submitted to the House of Commons Committee on Broadcasting, and to the Board of Broadcast Governors concerning radio regulations.

The Code of Ethics approved by the C.A.B. has now been printed and copies suitable for framing will be sent out to stations who have applied for adherence.

On the annual meeting front, in addition to regional annual meetings, there was the C.A.B. annual meeting held in Quebec City in March. Another highlight of the year was the meeting of the Radio-Television News Directors Association which met in Canada for the first time in 1960.

Radio week was held again this year to inform the public of the informative and entertaining qualities of radio. Promotion kits were sent out from the C.A.B. Toronto office featuring spots; idea books; fact sheets, etc. The Television Section of C.A.B. held its Fourth Annual Television Seminar in Toronto in April.

The total membership of The Canadian Association of Broadcasters is now 163 radio and 49 television members, plus 66 associates.

Canadian Television Continues Its Growth

TELEVISION has swept Canada by storm. This is more strongly emphasized than ever this year as new privately owned stations have either begun or are getting ready to begin operations in Canada's largest cities heretofore served solely by the Canadian Broadcasting Corporation stations.

Television programs can now be received by over 93 percent of all Canadian homes which are being served by a total of 74 stations, at latest count, not including a number of satellite outlets.

The number of stations has grown from only two, back in September, 1952, to 74 (17 CBC-owned stations and 57 privately owned stations); the number of Canadian homes with TV receivers has increased from 4 percent of all homes in 1952 to 80 percent, according to the last official report. As of January 1 this year, it is estimated that TV homes in Canada have attained 83 percent coverage.

Within a few years, according to some sources connected with the industry, ownership of TV sets should reach close to the 100 percent mark.

In brief, television set ownership in Canada has leaped from 4 percent of total households in 1952, to 84 percent of total households as of March 31, 1960. The number of TV stations in operation in the same period has grown from 2 to 74, and sales of TV receivers have increased from 140,000 to 3,931,000.

The two provinces leading in set ownership are the richest and most heavily populated—Ontario and Quebec, with the former enjoying a slight lead. In Ontario, 88 percent of the total number of households are provided with 1,405,000 sets. In Quebec, 98 percent of the total number of households own 1,000,000 sets.

The smallest number of sets are on Prince

Edward Island (15,000), covering 62 percent of total households. Next is Newfoundland, with a total of 50,000 sets, representing 56 percent of the total number of households.

Meanwhile, radio broadcasting has continued to flourish. According to industry sources, revenues of radio stations continued at a high level during 1960, despite strong competition for the advertisers' dollars from television. Sales of radio sets, compared to sales of TV receivers, have improved, although showing a decline for 1960, compared to the previous year. Sales of transistor radios were high, as well as those of automobile sets.

For 1961, there will be keen competition for the approximately fifty million advertising dollars available for television, and the broadcasters will also be competing for the viewers' time.

The six recently-licensed English language independent stations, as well as the second French-language station in Montreal, will begin operations in the major cities, competing with existing CBC outlets. Formerly, the CBC enjoyed a monopoly in the rich markets of Montreal, Toronto, Vancouver, Winnipeg, Ottawa and Halifax.

In a seventh city, Edmonton (Alberta), the CBC has been granted license to compete with a privately-owned station in operation for several years. And in an eighth center, Calgary, a second private outlet has been approved. These two new stations will also start operations this year.

Also highly possible for 1961, is a second English television network. The CBC at present operates two networks, one French and the other English. Spencer Caldwell of Toronto, has obtained initial permission from the Board of Broadcast Governors to operate such a network, which may be finalized at a second appearance before the BBG.
