"PROSZE MI POMOC?": How many times have you wandered across the bands only to encounter an unfamiliar tongue which causes you to shout "nie rozumieu" and then plead "bonvolu paroli pli malrapide"? Nevertheless, be of good cheer because "aole ia he mea e hilahila ai". One of the problems faced by most shortwave broadcast enthusiasts, especially those who are new to DXing, is the confusion of so many different languages on the shortwave bands. Not being able to understand the language in question is only part of the problem. Half of the difficulty is being able to simply recognize the language being heard...much less being on top of the content of these programs. For those of us who must say "mi parlas nur Angle" help may, indeed, be on the way. When one is able to determine the language it is then a comparatively simple matter to combine that knowledge with time and frequency of the transmission and then use a reference book to find out where the station is located, or at least narrow the possibilities down quite a bit. In response to cries of "tafadhali nionyesne njia", or "vaer sa snild a hjelpe meg", or,occasionally, "lutten bana yardim edin", the Radio Canada Shortwave Club will be starting a new series commencing March 2nd which should be of interest to DXers everywhere and one which will go a long way towards helping DXers to solve that problem of "what language am I hearing". This series will feature spoken examples of over fifty different foreign languages, the ones you're most likely to hear on the various shortwave broadcast bands. Undoubtedly at a given point in these sessions you may well exclaim "gizack badanta, wami djagwanc wigowag, ni-ya-yo" and further conclude that "cred ca nu e greu de loc". RCI will also be telling you the names of the various countries where these languages are spoken. Thus, while you may not come away with an understanding of the absolute urgency of the request "kiko wapi choo cha wanaume" nor share the discreet embarassment of "tafadhali badilisha zipu", chances are excellent that you will be able to identify more readily the language employed, if not the country of origin. This program will be an especially valuable series for those who are able to tape record it keeping it for future reference. I feel certain that when this programming has been terminated you will feel "bardzo mi bylo przyjemnie" and will want to express your gratitude to Radio Canada Inter-Radio Canada Shortwave Club can be heard at 1200 GMT on 15315, 11825, and 5970 with repeat transmissions at 0100 GMT on 11945, 9755, and 6085, and again at both 0400 and 0500 GMT on 9655 and 6135. And so, my friends, "downdzenia" and "lykke til"...or failing that, at least accept a hardy "selamat mendengar lagi" ...

Just as though you needed another reminder that the brief respite granted us in January by the cost of living council is over, those reception reports to the Maldives, Tristan da Cumha, Rarotonga, and Reyk javik posted after March 1st will cost you five cents more resulting in another USPS record of twenty six cents per one-half ounce. Those airmail postcard reports to keep up your Radio Australia Listeners' Club requirements will now require you to shell out three cents more for a new bite of eighteen cents; as you

simultaneously exchange a like amount for that international aerogram rate needed for services rendered toward NHK's report form. That precious Peruvian report gets a break, though...a hike of but a single cent ally in an accurate manner. Another eighteen cent rate seems to have been assigned to the international first class surface charge...used by American DXers solely to mail congratu-

TECHNICAL TOPICS

PADIO NEDERLANDS Radio Components Course will start on March 7th, Tune in and learn a little more about what makes your receiver tick. No charge, of course (boo). Enroll by writing RN, Box 222, Hilversum, Holland.

Reccomended reading: the Jan. 1974 issue of "Radio-Electronics" has a very good 7 page article on 'Modern Receiver Circuits'. Look for it on your newstand.

Per don Johnson "Conserve Energy, DX in the dark." Seriously, with many of us facing possible power blackouts during the next year, give much thought to being able to use a receiver on batterys. The SFR-4, SX-190, HRO-500, and Barlow-Wadley would all be nice to have for that time. They all can be connected to run from external power very easily. You'll need both news and entertainment during the blackout, and it's the best possible time to DX with all your local sources of QRM shut down.

I have a number of lightning arresters available free. Write.

Jim Whitehead is using a folded dipole (two parallel conductors), and is having trouble with the wires twisting at the ends. Most people use T-V lead in for the two wires, which is convenently held apart. The twists themselves don't matter to the radio waves, as the voltage induced in the wire is not dependant on which wire is on top or bottom. However, with open wire and spreaders, there is the chance that the two wires will short out to each other, degrading the performance of the antenna. The easyist way to avoid this is to use a standard dipole, instead of folded. Spacers should be every 4 to 8 inches for a FD, a swivel at each end should help some.

Mahlon Hale is using a audio filter following his receiver to help remove QRM, and wants to know wheather Telex communications headphones would do a better job than H1-F1 types. I don't have a schematic of the audio filter in question, but in general, filters are not designed to drive low impedance loads such as speakers or H1-F1 type headphones. Telex, and other communications type, including most surplus, headsets would be 600 to 2,000 ohm, and would present a much better match to the filter. If the filter is doing it's job at all, the headset would not improve it's restricted frequency response very much.

From the conversion at the recent SCADs meeting, (you should have been there) it seems like everyone has questions about antennas. THE PURPOSE OF THE ANTENNA IS TO DELIVER A SIGNAL TO THE RECEIVER STRONG ENOUGH TO OVERCOME THE NOISE GENERATED WITHIN THE RADIO ITSELF. If it does that, it's done it's share. It's the job of the receiver to amplify that signal enough to rattle the headphones. Tune your receiver to a clear spot on the dial, and note the volume of the static. Now disconnect your antenna. If the noise level goes down markedly, your antenna is adequate for the conditions at that time and freq. Notice also that receiver noise is a smoother hiss than static. The antenna cannot tell the diference between static and the desired station, except by the direction of arrival. If your receiver has a high internal noise level, a antenna tuner or preamp will help, but a antenna tuner or preamp will not pull a weak signal out of static and interference picked up along with the desired signal. The only help for that is a antenna with directional characteristics favoring the direction of the station you want. Most modern receivers have enough gain, and low internal noise-sets that don't quite possibly are defective and can be brought up to like new condition with tube replacement and proper alignment. Second test: if your antenna is OK by the above defination, you should never have to turn the volume control all the way up. If so, the receiver doesn't have mnough gain. If your receiver has a low noise front end, and high gain, a external preamp or antenna tuner will not help much. While a preamp between the antenna and receiver will cause the S meter too read S-9 instead of S-3 on some particular station, you just end up turning down the volume control; you have the same mixture of desired station and static, and can't understand the audio one bit better. A preamp is most likely going to hurt, by causing the receiver to overload on the strong stations. Can you hear Yankee Doodle in the background faintly, whenever you are tuned within 50 kHz of a VoA station? VoA doesn't splatter- that's cross modulation in your receiver, one of the lesser known receiver faults. Where this is most noticable is when you are tuned to a ham band and a guy a couple of blocks away goes on the air on the same meter band. With a bad case of overload, your receiver might go completely dead. Enough heresy for one month, see you in April.

INDEPENDENCE! This is a special day for HAP. As reported last month, HAP is no longer a part of SPEEDXTRAS. Instead, we are now a seperate department within SPEEDX. Our changes being the following:

- 1. Our official printed "voice" will remain in SPEEDX. This is our main tie with this club.
- 2. HAP, as most of you know, was founded by SPEEDX. In all future reference to SPEEDX we will list them as "SPEEDX(parent club)". This will identify them as our founder.
- 3. In the past the SPEEDXTRAS/SPEEDX Treasury has subsidized our operation. Over \$320 was needed last year, 90% of which you & they provided, with 10% from other clubs. Because the Xmas Tree Fund Drive was so successful (\$168.50) and an add'l \$66 was raised, I have asked SPEEDX not to support HAP financially as of 12-73. Instead we are depending on every club in North America, and every SWL/DXer. Our hope is that all concerned will purchase some HAP items offered over the years, or make a donation. By having the hobby support us we hope to serve every club equally.
- 4. I want all SWLs, DXers, club editors, BODs and broadcasters to consider HAP as an INTER-CLUB ORGANIZATION. As soon as possible we will serve not only SW clubs but, BCB, FM, TV, Utility clubs, etc. We call on clubs specializing in areas outside SW to help us.
- 5. Our project is now completely run by a HAP BOD. It consists of Bill Paschke, Vice Chairman, Ted F. Poling, PALS Chairman, and myself. We have a revised HAP Operations Leaflet which guides us. This leaflet is available for a #10 SASE from: Bill Paschke, 855 Elm St., Beloit, WI 53511.
- 6. As reported last month HAP has its own bank account. All checks, MOs, etc, should be made payable to: HANDICAPPED AID PROGRAM when making donations or purchasing HAP items. But don't worry, we're not going to hound you for donations, Hi. If we have to do that, HAP becomes a "drag" for you and a "pain" for us. HAP is providing a useful and badly needed service. When the SWL/DXer supports HAP he is in fact sponsoring a HAPee, paying for an antenna, shipment of equipment, etc. So, you are very important to us. We don't exist without the SWL. There's nothing wrong with being an advanced DXer. We need them too. But the so-called 'Little Guy' is important to HAP. We must have your help.



Ciao! A very special thanks to the 61 reporters to Europe/Africa this month, making it the biggest since SPEEDX's start. Let's try for 75! And of course, a special welcome to new reporter Dave Browne, Dave Butler, Shaun Carrick, Ken Earhart, Mark Eckman, Craig Hannan, David Romani, Mike Savu, and last but not least, Evelyn Turner. Hope you all will become regular contributers.

We've got a back log of mail piled up here and hope to start digging into it as soon as possible. But, if you do have any questions or comments do not hesitate to ask or write.

Also, let me thank Jon Fay for the great job he did for January, ran out of space in last month's column and didn't have a chance to thank him. Jon is our DPH, and a good one at that.

On to the news then, a reminder that all $\omega d \text{DAC}$ items appear with their permission.

U.S.S.R. goes DA: Gus Liller sends word: "Radio Loseow has a good DA program. The announcer starts the show by saying 'Mello there, Hams'. Some of the topics covered are the frequencies of domestic Soviet Stations, when and how to hear them, DA news from various DX Clubs, and answers to listener's questions. The DA program is broadcast Thursdays, at 0015 GMT as well as at other times during the daily feature program."

International waters - A new entry: "In March or April a new station is expected to operate from a vessel which comes from France. The station will have the name Radio Victoria or Radio Skylab. Already on board the vessel is a shortwave transmitter of 100-200 watts, a medium wave transmitter and an FM transmitter.

Belgium - ORU: Jim Whitehead sends this item in: "According to Sweden Calling DX'ers, ORU is about to begin testing two (2) new 250 kw transmitters. The transmitter installation is complete but the antenna switching mechanism is not yet in operation. It is anticipated that full scale operational testing will begin soon. ORU is presently using 6055 and 11855 to North America."

Jamming - Greece and U.S.S.R.: "According to the political daily newspaper The Guardian, Deutsche Welle's and the BBC's broadcasts in Greek to Greece are being jammed, though it does not specifically come out and say the Greek Military Junta is behind it."

"... construction is progressing but it will be well into this year before anything goes on the air. In fact I suspect it might be next year before it goes on. I haven't seen any 'Pert' charts for the Swaziland station but they are having some unusual problems. Parts aquisition is one, and weather is another. We caw some pictures of the guys trying to work in mud up to their knees. Swaziland is having its rainy season right now. You can imagine the difficulties that that causes."

Algeria - Radiodiffusion Television Algerienne: The RTVA has been observed with an English transmission at 1900-1930 on 15150, 17745 and 17825 kHz.

Chad - Radiodiffusion Nationale Tchadienne: "This station does indeed seem to have a new transmitter with a power of 100 kw or so (listed 30 kw) on 4904.5 with excellent reception in Europe."

During the period in question a different question will be asked each day in the foreign language programs as well as the German Service. Entries should be posted by March 31st 1974. Prizes include trips to Vienna, radios, cameras, binoculars, books, records, and (even) a rubber dinghy."



SPRING 1974

Following a somewhat mediocre winter DX season we wish we could be the bearer of glad tidings in the form of a prediction for better overall conditions going into the spring.....unfortunately, the odds are rather against it at this point. In the meantime DXers concentrating on long hauls should devote their attention to the highest frequency bands open into a desired region...oarticularly during the late afternoon/early evening period. For at least the first half of the coming spring, this is where the most consistant action will be located. Based on what could be considered as normal for a given band and time, should it appear that a "good" day may be at hand (and the odds also say an "excellent" or two may be in the offing), the opportunity to grab a rare bird on frequencies approaching the lower reaches of the predicted range would be well worth exploring. (See the accompanying forecast charts and legend).


For those (ute DXers in particular) who might be in the mood for some "off-beat" fare between mid-March and late April, try taking a quick pass across a band that is perhaps five to eight megahertz higher than the maximum indicated on the forecast chart. Some really unusual reception patterns could be observed if the band is producing. However, this is a chancy prospect, and while worth investigating occasionally, certainly not deserving of any great expenditure of time...a few moments of fast scanning should be all that is necessary to determine the probable course of events.

Through the years we have received many requests for information about propagation reference material. In responding, we have usually attempted to determine the extent of math or general science background possessed by the writer since there is very little material available between the categories of "overly simple" and "highly technical". However, an SWL now wishing to begin compiling some data in order to prepare his own general forecasts has the material at hand to do it for the next few years,....if he gets started right about now.

As most know, the ll year sun spot cycle is now heading toward its low...where it will remain for maybe 5 or 6 years. If a very accurate log or journal is begun that will include such details as date, GMT, transmitter site, SINPO etc; then when that same date rolls around the following year, it may be expected that the general reception patterns will once again be duplicated. A few moments taken each time the headset is applied to note the quality of even those stations which are considered regulars can provide an extremely useful tool twelve months hence....and increase its value in twenty-four or forty-eight if regularly maintained. If such a record is developed, there will be little need for concern in five or six years when the sun spot curve begins to ascend again, because by that time you will probably have acquired sufficient first-hand practical knowledge to cope with the situation as it unfolds.

The forecast chart is arranged in three vertical columns. The one on the left consists of five graphs depicting anticipated reception for Western North America (MST & PST time zones). Similarly, on the right is another set of five graphs representing Eastern North America (EST & CST time zones). Down the center is a series of notations indicating the world regions from which a radio signal might originate.

Each individual graph is indexed with GMT on its horizontal axis (the "00" following the hour has been deleted), and Frequency (in megahertz) on its vertical axis.

There are actually two curves plotted on each graph...one representing the maximum useable frequency, and another representing an estimated lowest useable frequency. Therefore, the darkened area between these curves (called an "envelope") illustrates the frequency range most likely to produce reception at the given hour.

As an example, let's consider an SWL in Western North America wishing to tune to Central Asia around the hour of 2200 GMT. Selecting the fourth graph from the top (Central Asia/Far East) in the left column (Western North America), and then reading across the horizontal axis to "22" (2200 GMT with the "00" deleted), the predicted frequency range would be between 11.0 and 17.0 megahertz.

Long distance radio reception is noted for its almost daily variations in quality, but as a very general rule, frequencies appearing in the upper 20 to 25% of the envelope will provide the most stable and reliable signals for the path at the given hour. For the Western North America/Central Asia example above, this would mean that frequencies between 15.5 and 17.0 megahertz would be the the most productive. Overall reception quality may be expected to decrease quite sharply as the lower limits of the envelope are approached.

If desired, the reader may remove this entire section from the magazine and fold the charts vertically to show only the reception graphs for his region. This may then be placed near the receiver for a handy reference at all times.




