Short Wave is the Short way to Permanent Peace:

JACK JONES, a born and bred Mississippian, and the 1982 SPEEDXer of the Year was first exposed to DXing back in 1923 when his dad got a 5-tube, breadboard layout Atwater-Kent radio set. At the age of seven, Jack sat quietly as his father sought out as many distant stations as he could tune in. One night, about five years later, his dad picked up a program relayed by KDKA-Pittsburgh from 5SW in Chelmsford, England. A few mornings later, they listened to WGY-Schenectady Eelaying a program from Anstralia. At that point, Jack was "hooked" and talked his father into getting him a one-tube $S W$ receiver. From that, he progressed to a two-tube job. He remained an active DXer until 1934 when his interest in aviation took top priority. He wound up, during World War II, as a glider pilot with the Troop Carrier Command of the U.S. Army Air Force and served in both North Africa and Europe. About seven years ago, on the spur of the moment, Jack picked up a Realistic DX-150 and found himself back in the DXing game. He doesn't say just when, but he obtained a Drake SPR-4 in time to earn a logging credit in the April 81 SPEEDX. Jack reports that he is 65 years old, a highway designer with the Mississippi Highway Dept, and expects to retire this April. He and his wife, Mary, have a daughter Nancy who gave them two grandsons, and a son who, by some quirk of fate, is named Jack. Congratulations, Jack Sr. \& 73 .

CEINA(REP.)...The Voice of Free China is now being heard well in North America due to an agreement between the station and American religious broadcaster WYFR. The two stations have traded transmitter time, giving each increased audibility in the other's area of the world. VOFC can be heard in English nightly from 0200-0300 GMT in the 25 meter band, and from 0300-0400 GMT in the 49 meter band (reportediy 5985 kHz ). It's a rather unique bituation, so tune in for a different perspective on the news.

Al1 SPEEDX Full and Associate members received a questionnaire stapled into the middle of their January 1982 issues. We felt that it would be only fair for us to do these things in cooperation with the membership. Thus, the questionnaire. IT IS THEREFORE VERY IMPORTANT INDEED FOR EVERY MEMBER, ASSOCIATE OR FULL, TO FTLL OUT THE QUESTIONNAIRE AND SURMIT IT TO THE BOARD !!!
For every questionnaire returned (with the member's name filled in, of course), the Board will give the member two membership credits toward Full Membership. The member will also have the satisfaction of knowing that he has participated in the future planning process of SPEEDX. If this questionnaire is successful, other surveys may be attempted at regular intervals.
