

A CONVERSATION WITH ...



YANNI



At its best, the music you hear on The WAVE allows you to escape into a completely different world. It allows your mind to float, free of stress, without worry or interruption from the outside environment. Yanni's music does all that and more. The positive, benevolent feelings of his music are reflected in the man. Originally hailing from Greece, Yanni is now a resident of Los Angeles, a city which he feels is in a position of social and cultural leadership. The following exclusive conversation took place between Yanni and The WAVE's David Hirsch.

Q: What has The WAVE meant to you?

A: The WAVE put my name on the map. As an artist, it makes me feel absolutely wonderful. I can't tell you how great it feels when you're driving down Sunset Blvd. and your own song comes on the air.

Q: WAVE listeners feel your music is great as well. Does knowing that millions of people will hear your songs help your creativity?

A: No, I don't think so. I don't think it's very healthy to measure yourself in those terms. It does help your psychological makeup. It helps you feel good about yourself. It makes you feel appreciated. But I was just as excited about music and writing when no one knew me. Creating the music is the most important thing. If I never get played on the radio again, the music will still be there. I think that's a much healthier attitude to have.

Q: Do you have a philosophy behind your music?

A: Absolutely. I think you live life. You enjoy it. Then you talk about it. In order to have something to say you must feel joy and pain. Being Greek and having been raised in Greece, I tend to be a tad more emotional. In my music I "talk" about what happens to me,

or what I fantasize about, or what I miss, or whatever introspective observations I may have. I try to communicate my feelings just with melodies and sounds because I don't have lyrics.

Q: Do you have any New Year's resolutions you'd like to share with the readers of The WAVE MusicLetter?

A: When I came to California I quit everything - smoking, bad eating habits, everything but the hot tub! [laughs] Seriously, I should really take care of Yanni a little more. I haven't really lived a lot the last year. I have worked a lot. 1988 was the most creative year of my life. There are many opportunities just hanging there for me to take - movie scoring, a tour playing with various symphony orchestras, but in 1989 I'm going to really try to take it easy and enjoy life.

Q: You recorded your latest project "Chameleon Days" in your home studio. Most of the instrumentation you play yourself. Do you see yourself working with other musicians in the future?

A: Yes, I think it's time to open the doors a little more and as I grow as a composer I feel more comfortable working with other creative people. I also want to work with singers. There are a couple of singers I'd really like to work with. One is Bono from U2. I love the way he expresses himself. Peter Gabriel is another singer I would like to work with. It's not something I'm pursuing right now, but someday it would be nice to work with these people.

Q: This seems like an incredible time in your life.

A: It is an incredible time. It's hard to digest that all these good things are happening. It's hard not to get overwhelmed and maintain your sense of who you are and what you're all about. But I know who Yanni is and he's doing just fine.


