

Seen nightly as the guitarist in The Posse, the studio band for Arsenio Hall, this is Peter's first solo release. "Warm Sound In A Gray Field" features Mark Isham and Patrick O'Hearn. Peter's a very talented musician that has toured with everyone from Bobby McFerrin, and the Pointer Sisters to Wang Chung.



DAVE STEWART & BARBARA GASKIN

No, he's not the guy from the Eurythmics. He's the other Dave Stewart, one of Britain's most respected keyboardists. This is the second release for the English duo. The album's called "The Big Idea" and the song "Grey Skies" is very popular here at **The WAVE**.
