


THE WAVE'S MUSIC NOTES






JEFF LORBER

As a keyboardist and producer, Jeff Lorber's impact on the world of jazz fusion has been immeasurable. The early eighties proved to be a prolific period for his group, The Jeff Lorber Fusion. They released six albums in five years. The band toured constantly, and Jeff was voted Best Session Player for two consecutive years by Keyboard Magazine's Annual Reader's Poll. In 1986 the Jeff Lorber Fusion effectively disbanded. Since then he has hardly been resting.

Using his own JHL studio as a home base, Jeff Lorber re-focused his attention to producing and scouting talent. Artists that he has produced, worked with, or remixed make up a veritable Who's-Who of today's music: Kenny G, Bruce Hornsby, Chaka Khan, Michael Franks, Luther Vandross, Dave Koz, Art Porter, Eric Marienthal, Manhattan Transfer, U2, Prince, Diana Ross, Paula Abdul, Duran Duran, Aerosmith, Hammer and the Rolling Stones to name a few. In the years he has spent behind the scenes, quietly influencing a broad spectrum of music, Jeff has rediscovered his own musical style and his compositional voice. It was time to make another recording of his own. He called on the talents of some of the people he has worked with on their projects. Dave Koz, Bruce Hornsby, Janis Siegel, Lee Ritenour, Paul Jackson, Jr. and Art Porter all came to contribute to the album that so many

have been waiting for. Lorber's new release, appropriately titled "Worth Waiting For," comes seven years after the last "Jeff Lorber Fusion" album. The challenge of the new album was not in coming up with material; he has been writing all along. The challenge was to remain objective while producing his own music. He had to avoid the temptation to over-analyze his own work. He wanted to stay true to emotions and keep the sound spontaneous. That spontaneity can be felt in the energy and optimism of the album.

So many artists in the field of contemporary jazz have been influenced, if not discovered, by Lorber. It only seems fair for him to get his name back out there for a whole new audience to discover.
