DUKE STREET TARGETS JANE SIBERRY

A full-scale 50-date North American tour has been mapped out for singer/songwriter Jane Siberry in support of her new Duke Street album, *The Speckless Sky*, an album which was more than a year in the making. She is collaborating with Alain Lortie, designer for Montreal performer Michel Lemieux, to create a staging and lighting design for her tour. The WEA-distributed Duke Street label has drawn up a major marketing campaign to launch her new album - her third such release and the second for Duke Street.

One More Colour has been shipped as the first single from Siberry's new album. A video is currently in the works, being developed by Deborah Samuel.

Siberry's first album, a self-titled project released on the Street Record label, drew moderate response. However, it was her first Duke Street album, *No Borders Here*, which raised the eyebrows of the critics across Canada. This was further fuelled by the hit single *Mimi On The Beach*.

A coast-to-coast tour established Siberry as one of the most promising recording acts, which led her into her *Speckless Sky* album. Recently, Will Ackerman, President of the San Francisco-based Windham Hill label, heard *No Borders Here* and was so impressed with the material that he signed Siberry to a U.S. record deal. In view of the signing, *No Borders Here* is still active in the U.S.

The Speckless Sky was co-produced by Siberry and her long-time musical partner John Switzer, with engineering chores by John Naslen.

Siberry looks on *The Speckless Sky* as an extension of her previous album. The 3 tracks: *The Empty City*, *Map Of The World (Part II)*, and *Seven Steps To The Wall* were written shortly after completing *No Borders Here*. She also performed these songs during her national tour, which gave her audiences a further insight into the potential talent of this young artist. Siberry does have some comparisons between the 2 LPs.

"I think my singing is better now", she explains. "and I used the Fairlight more

often. I believe the new album has more feel, but I balanced it with the warmth and human side."

Siberry admitted that she was apprehensive about the way her previous album



had been received. "I was a bit surprised that the album did so well commercially," she said. "I was pleased to see an LP that wasn't written for the public do so well. The instrumentation is fairly the same on the new album, and song-wise, it stretches from simple pop songs to a collage like *Vladimir, Vladimir*."

Siberry describes her unique sound as "modern, but high in energy as well as laid



Heavy metal releases being set by Attic

With the current renewed interest in hard rock and heavy metal recordings, Attic has set a heavy schedule of releases over the next 2 months via their associated labels, Viper, Road Runner and Mausoleum.

Picture, a Dutch band, will release *Trader* (Sept. 9) their 2nd LP for the Viper label. Blacklace, a U.S. metal band, will be on release with their *Mausoleum LP, Get It While It's Hot* (16). Canadian tour dates are possible for this group; and from the same label, *Second Attack*, an LP from Crossfire, a European metal band.

The Attic label itself will release *Evil Invaders*, the 2nd LP from *Razor*, a Guelph, Ont. metal unit. This LP was produced in Toronto by Walter Zwol. A video of the title track, directed by Chris Terry, will be released shortly. Tour dates are being set for October.

Another Canadian group, *Blind Vengeance*, a metal quartet from Oshawa, Ont., recently signed to the Viper label, will have their album re-issued, but with remixing by Zwol at the Metalworks. The band had originally released the *Bob Gallo* production themselves. The re-release will feature album jacket artwork by *Dimo Safari*. Oct. 7 has been set as the release date.

Toronto metal band *Jade*, recently inked to the Road Runner label, are set for the release of their *Vendetta LP* (Oct. 7). A video of *I'm Not Yours*, directed by *Bob Connolly*, is set for release. Local dates are being scheduled for the band.

Signed to the Viper label this past sum-

mer, Montreal hard rock group *Dagger* will have their LP shipped Oct. 28. *Geoff Hughes* produced.

With the growing popularity of compact discs, Attic will be one of the leaders in the release of heavy metal CDs. They have scheduled the release of 5 of their past metal LPs on the CD format, leading with the self-titled *Lee Aaron LP* and *Metal Queen*, followed by the *Anvil LPs*, *Metal On Metal*, *Forged In Fire* and *Hard & Heavy*.

Palo Alto and A&M pact licensing deal

A&M Records, Canada, has signed a licensing agreement with the California-based Palo Alto label, which specializes in jazz and big band releases. The label features over 80 albums in their catalogue, with half a dozen of these titles currently charting in the U.S. trades.

Says *Albert Evers*, Director of Business Affairs for Palo Alto, "We are very aware of A&M's strength in the Canadian marketplace and look forward to an opportunity to work together," adding, "We wanted to be in the best place in the business we could be."

"Palo Alto will compliment our existing jazz catalogue very highly," says A&M Canada President *Gerry Lacoursiere*, continuing with "Palo Alto is a fine label, dedicated to artists both new and established, and committed to quality. We look forward to working with Palo Alto artists on tour and on disc."

Upcoming releases include *Moe Mistletoe Magic*, a Christmas album of both traditional and original material by such artists as *Phil Woods*, *Rare Silk* and *McCoy Tyner*; *Bossanova Eyes* by *Richie Cole*, featuring *Manhattan Transfer* vocalist *Janice Siegel*, and *Century 22* by *George Shaw*.

OMD's autograph session attracts A&M's Friesen

After a recent concert appearance in Toronto, *Andy McCluskey* and *Paul Humphreys* of *Orchestral Manoeuvres in The Dark*, took time out for an in-store autograph session at *Records On Wheels*, which is situated on *Yonge Street*, in the downtown core. Among the more than 500 fans who lined the street as early as 7 am was *Gil Friesen*, President of A&M Records (OMD's U.S. label and Canadian distributor), who made a surprise visit.

The 2½ hour session was the culmination of a locally held *CRUSH* contest, run by *Wheels* and *Virgin Records*. As well as concert tickets, *Crush* drinks and album giveaways, the grand prize winner took home a pedal car - similar to the one appearing on *OMD's Crush* album jacket.

Virgin's National Promotion and Publicity Director, *Laura Bartlett*, says, "It was originally slated to last an hour, but the excitement just grew and grew. *Andy* and *Paul* were thrilled with the success of the in-store as well as the surprise visit by *Gil Friesen*." *OMD* are currently represented on the *RPM 100* with their *Crush* album, which has already enjoyed 10 weeks of charting.

Alien Shores hit Double Platinum in four weeks

Following quickly on the heels of their highly successful *Crying Over You* single, *Platinum Blonde* have slated a mid-October release date for *Situation Critical* their second video, directed by *Robert Quartly* and *Deborah Samuels* of *Champagne Limited*. Their current album *Alien Shores* has sold over 200,000 units in the first four weeks of release. "This is beyond the realm of ridiculous; just great," expresses *Kim Zayac* of *CBS Records*.

Platinum Blonde wound up the Eastern leg of their tour with near riots on East Coast beaches and "torrid reception in the hotels" according to *Bruce Burrow*, the band's manager. Not only did the *Platinum Blonde* tour bus have a smashed window but they needed a police cordon to leave the *Hotel Newfoundland* when fans mobbed the front gate and prevented their escape to the bus.

While in *Newfoundland*, lead vocalist *Mark Holmes* established the *Platinum Blonde World Cup National Soccer Series*, a fund raiser in aid of *OXFAM*. Of the planned series, that will be staged throughout their tour, the *Blonde* won their first outing 6-0 against the local celebrities, and raised over \$1000 for the cause. According to *Zayac*, *Platinum Blonde* will be releasing *Crying Over You*, in the U.S., the first week of October, this will be coupled with an *AOR* sampler, which should answer lack of action in U.S. trades.

Can-Aid put on hold until agreement made

The proposed super-concert of 1985 has been put on hold. The decision was made by officials of the *Ready Foundation*, after a series of meetings and discussions with the managers of Canada's leading performers and artists. They have requested that the concert be re-scheduled to a new date next summer.

According to a spokesman for the *Can-Aid* project: "The concert organizers felt that Canadian talent should have the opportunity to make a contribution to charity in the *Live-Aid* event and had proceeded to stage a concert with the support of many top artists." However, a number of these artists were not available for the *September 29* date and their participation is obviously paramount, therefore a change was necessary.

Although the production crew had obtained the same stage used at the *Wembley Live-Aid* show, and the same sound/light equipment that was used in the *Philadelphia Live-Aid* show, it is assured that a similar setup will be available when the concert is held next summer.

Now that the committee of top industry people have been assembled, everyone has agreed to meet during the *Juno* awards and work out a date that will be most suitable for the top names.

CBC never intended to televise

Okay! Here's the whole scoop. Finally the inside word on why the CBC never intended to televise the ACME Awards. This from Brian Ferriman, Director and Awards Committee Member, The Academy of Country Music Entertainment (EC: I'm impressed) "First of all, the CBC never intended to televise our awards show, but rather a one-hour Super Special featuring our Canadian Country Music Award winners in performance. Moreover, the telecast fell through simply because Telefilm Canada refused at the eleventh hour to participate in funding the

project. I say eleventh hour because Telefilm delayed in making any decision re: funding until the last moment, and then passed, despite the fact the independents producing the show already had a written guarantee of telecast in hand from the CBC, and after the CBC had already slotted a prime time September telecast date for the show and sold over 75 percent of the available advertising. Does this sound like lack of CBC support to you, Walt? It certainly doesn't to me. I don't mind pot shots at all - just aim your gun in the right direction, please." CKOC retires pocket chart

From the time CKOC Hamilton, Ontario moved to a Top 40 music format in 1960, the station (Canada's second oldest radio station) began compiling a music chart on a weekly basis. They made their "pocket" charts available to listeners through record dealers ever since, even when major Top 40 stations across North America cut out this very expensive service some 10 years ago.

"Now, at last", says CKOC Program Director Nevin Grant, "soaring paper, printing and postal costs have prompted CKOC to retire the weekly pocket charts in favour of a larger, improved 'blow-up' chart for the retailers to post in their stores."

CKOC will continue to research the weekly sales of 19 major record retailers, which is combined with request patterns and rack and trade paper statistics to compile their music survey on singles and albums. The Advance Listings will continue to be supplied to those interested.

Siberry set to break nationally.....

This week sees the media release of The Speckless Sky, Jane Siberry's second album for Duke Street. In the 18 months since the release of No Borders Here Jane has been dubbed as Canada's most critically acclaimed new artist, has won a CASBY Award for Best Female Artist, and was the only Canadian artist to consistently grace the most prestigious Best Ten lists of '84.

With The Speckless Sky Jane delivers a more melodic, more rhythmic and definitely more accessible album and shows she has the maturity to progress from creator of an underground hit (Mimi) to a beloved major talent. Initial evidence of this is reflected by the first single One More Colour.

This tune with its pop rhythms and hooks is a natural for CHR, AOR and A/C as evidenced by the out-of-the-box adds in the Toronto market - CFNY, CHUM-FM, 1050 CHUM and CKFM. So for those who thought that Mimi At The Beach was a bit weird, maybe a fraction too long, or whatever, check out One More Colour

because I guarantee it will surprise you - it is a hit. (LP DSR 31019; single DSR 71019).

Jane will be supporting her new release with a 50-city North American Tour from September through November. The twenty date Canadian leg from Fredricton to Victoria will be co-presented nationally by MuchMusic in conjunction with a radio station in each city. Duke Street and WEA will support the release and tour with a two-week national TV campaign, extensive co-op ads and a major national promotion on MuchMusic. Also, watch for the first video (One More Colour) produced by Champagne Pictures and directed by Deborah Samuel. It is released this week.

Also on tour this fall are 2 Juno nominees. Vally (Country Male Vocal) and Hagood Hardy (Instrumental Artist) both set out on the road in mid-October. Vally, whose latest single, Sonny's Dream (video out next week), is charting nationally on country charts, will be supporting his album, Notes From Places (DSR 31010) with a 30-plus date coast to coast tour. Meanwhile, Hagood hits Western Canada in support of his latest album, Night Magic (DSR 31014) and is the centre of a major promotion in

New Wonder LP receives first class treatment

Stevie Wonder's long-awaited new album In Square Circle, will be receiving first class service with a four-colour laminated gatefold cover, plus an eight-page booklet insert.

The album was written, produced and arranged by Wonder with associate production by Gary Olazabal and was digitally recorded in his Wonderland Studios. The album is set for release Sept. 23.

The album jacket has been double embossed and round double-sided posters are also to be utilized in the campaign. Bio booklets are available as well.

In Square Circle is the first full studio LP from the singer-songwriter in five years, the last being Hotter Than July released in 1980. The single shipped gold.

As well as his own successes Wonder has made several guest appearances over the years with a variety of different artists, his latest appearance is on the Eurythmics latest single, There Must Be An Angel, in which Wonder adds his classic harmonica stylings.

back." She pointed out that her first album did garner some positive response, but on a smaller level.

"The first album was more acoustic," she says. "It did get some good reviews on an underground level. I've grown from one LP to another. I played keyboards and guitar on the new album, as well as arranging the Fairlight."

Giving an instrumental assist on the Speckless Sky album were keyboardists Anne Bourne and Rob Yale, guitarist Ken Myhre, bassist John Switzer (co-producer), and drummer Al Cross, all of whom are in Siberry's band with the exception of Yale.

"I've left the concept for my video in Deborah's (Samuels) hands. I worked on my first videos, but I didn't think they were any more successful. I wanted to see if it was because there were 2 cooks, so to speak. What I want to do eventually is write and direct my own videos."

Siberry also believes that one of the pleasures of working with an independent record company is their flexibility and willingness to work closely with the artist.

"Producing my own albums is important because I can sustain the coherence of my own ideas from inception to completion." She concludes with "Quite often my songs begin as an image or idea rather than a lyric or melody."

In addition to full point-of-purchase material plus the tour, her new LP is getting the added boost of a 2-week ad campaign on the national music video station MuchMusic. This campaign will run from Sept. 23 through Oct. 6. While MuchMusic will be co-presenting the tour, radio stations across Canada will also be sponsoring.

Confirmed Canadian dates include Fredericton (Oct. 10-12), Halifax (15), Ottawa (17-18), Kingston (21), Guelph (22-24), Toronto (25), London (28), Sudbury (29), Thunder Bay (31), Winnipeg (Nov. 1), Saskatoon (2), Regina (3), Calgary (5-6), Vancouver (8), and Vancouver (9).




