

SUN CITY - A MESSAGE OF IMPORTANCE

Steven Van Zandt's conceptual Sun City project has evolved into an album that will have a far-reaching impact on the global community. There were more than 50 performers/musicians, from all fields taking part - from rock to rap, from jazz to blues and from folk to reggae. They performed voluntarily at studios in New York, London, Boston and Los Angeles - and their royalties are being donated to the Africa Fund. The album and a video will be available shortly through the New York-based Manhattan label (distributed by Capitol). Last week RPM spoke with Van Zandt in New York. He wrote Sun City and co-produced the session with Arthur Baker.

"Putting the album together was a natural occurrence," says Van Zandt, "after a few weeks we had such a wealth of stuff, and a lot different than the single. Different songs just started forming, like the rap version and the jazz piece; they told their own story. They had to be included."

Originally, Van Zandt wrote the words and the music for Sun City intending to release only a single, however, the number of participating musicians and the variety of music grew so quickly that Van Zandt had enough material for an album. "The first sessions were about 4 months ago and the most recent were last Sunday (Oct 13)," he continues, "Bono (U2) recorded a country/blues song with Keith Richards and Ron Wood. We've already printed the album jacket though, so it's not listed and it'll be a nice surprise when people listen to the record for the first time."

The Africa Fund will distribute funds (artist royalties) to various groups aiding South Africa's political prisoners and exiles, Van Zandt adds: "Everybody who came in was very informed. At the time there was no record label - they didn't even know if it was going to be released but they kept coming forward and I just kept the lyrics flexible enough to allow for that much more emotion."

Van Zandt signed a deal with Manhattan Records including "more than the usual amount of money for promotion and marketing." Even though as Van Zandt ad-

mits: "I am a bit of a renegade and the lyrics are a bit controversial. They say that rock 'n' roll and politics don't mix - yes, we really had a fight with that one. But, sure, Manhattan and the record stores will make their profit

-that's only realistic and I really don't care, just as long as Sun City gets played. What's important is getting the message across."

The album, with its tentative release date of October 25, contains versions of the Sun City single, excerpts of speeches from Bishop Desmond Tutu and Nelson Mandela.

Roblan gears for busy fall season

Among the thousands upon thousands of records, tapes and CD's stacked high in the Toronto warehouse of Roblan, is the small congenial office of Jason Sniderman, who was more than willing to discuss the present state of the Canadian music business.

Besides the obvious trend towards stocking more CD's, Sniderman suggests that the current "decline in album sales will be offset by the increased sales of cassettes, which," he adds, "haven't even peaked yet."

Sniderman finds that 45's continue to sell: "there are still a lot of young people who buy the cases that hold singles."

When asked what he thought would happen to the domestic recording industry if the

Moffat purchases Toronto's Mutuelcom

Mutuelcom, the national radio representative company located in Toronto, has been purchased by the Moffat Communications Group. In making the announcement of purchase, Moffat Vice President James McLaughlin noted: "This move is the first in a series that will increase our Toronto presence in a way that is meaningful to our customers."

Mutuelcom President, Terence Williams commented: "The purchase will allow us to better serve our station clients as well as our agency and advertising customers, through expansion at our resource base in the research and promotion planning areas." He concluded with "We don't expect any change in our client list; and in fact, we hope to expand it."

Mutuelcom represents a broad group of stations throughout Canada.

RTA distribution rights for Bowie/Jagger video

Dancing In The Streets, a video by David Bowie and Mick Jagger is currently showing at Famous Players movie theatres across Canada before the feature film. The showing is sponsored by Kodak to benefit the Live Aid and provided by Reciprocal Trade Associates (RTA). Dale Baker, Executive Producer of RTA says "The response has been tremendous and it's a great vehicle for our clients to tap today's youth market."

Although the videos are sponsored by companies such as Kodak and Sony. "The main benefactors should be record companies" suggests Baker. "After all," he continues, "these videos will sell records."

RTA has a roster of ten videos and an exclusive agreement with the Famous Players. This roster includes Barbara Streisand, Carly Simon and Rick Springfield, among others. Baker also revealed, "We're working on getting the new a-ha video a follow-up to their Take On Me. Also, we're trying to tie up an agreement with Yoko Ono for the new John Lennon footage she found and is compiling but that probably won't be until after Christmas."

These videos, or music film shorts are, according to Baker, "taking over the spot once occupied by cartoons at the theatres and quite successfully."

CRTC dropped the 30 percent ruling, he replied, "If I were an artist, I'd like to think that I was being played, not because it was the law, but because I had a good album." He also wondered whether any Canadian group "would suffer - if indeed the ruling was dropped."

Finally, as we head towards the heavy holiday buying season, Sniderman was asked if he had any preference towards any particular artist or group. "We will front rack what we think will sell - whether it's American or Canadian," he replied, continuing with "It's a spontaneous decision. Given a choice between Bruce Springsteen or Bryan Adams - I'd pick Adams. I think he's got stronger legs." He concludes with "The Turner duet with Adams is the strongest track on the album."

Countdown to the Junos aired across Canada

Q-107's (Toronto) Bob Mackowycz is set to host a live 2-hr. phone-in radio special via satellite (Oct. 27) from 10 pm to 12 Midnight.

Special guests for the special include Bryan Adams (live from Japan), Corey Hart (live from Boston), Honeymoon Suite (live from Vancouver), Triumph (live from Toronto), and Lee Aaron (live from Toronto) plus surprise drop-ins.

Those stations firmed to participate at press time include Q-107 Toronto, CJCH Halifax, CFRA Ottawa, CKLC Kingston, Z99 Regina, K97 Edmonton, CITI Winnipeg, CKIK Calgary, CJBK London, CKPT, Peterborough, CJSD Thunder Bay, C95 Saskatoon, CFOX Vancouver, and CHIM Kelowna. Other cities are expected to join in.

The special is being produced by Doug Thompson in association with Telemedia Broadcast Systems.

Daltrey's solo album contains Cancon tracks

The recently released Atlantic solo album by Roger Daltrey contains 2 Cancon tracks, both written by the team of Bryan Adams and Jim Vallance. The tracks on the LP titled Under A Raging Moon, are Let Me Down Easy, and Rebel.

Although After The Fire has been taken as the first single, WEA expects FM rock radio in Canada will be airing the Adams/Vallance tracks, which may also be released as singles.

The title track of the LP was co-written by John Parr and is a tribute to the late Who drummer Keith Moon. After The Fire was penned by former Who guitarist Peter Dinklage. All royalties raised through the sales of this single are to be donated to the Band-Aid Trust.

Townshend is expected to be on release with his new solo album on the Atco label, distributed by WEA. Entitled White City, the album will be a soundtrack of original material.

ZZ Top ships platinum for Afterburner release

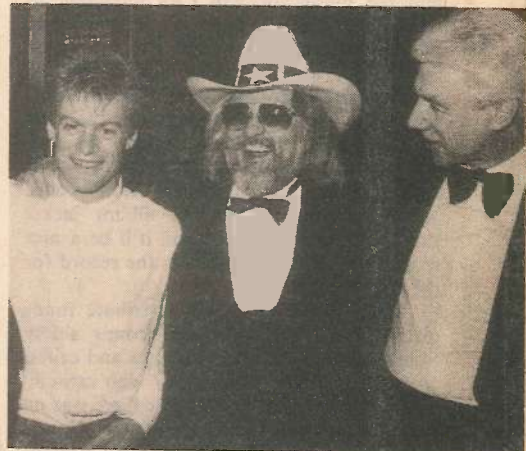
ZZ Top's Afterburner LP has shipped triple platinum (300,000 units) on release - the first time this year WEA has shipped an LP at this level.

Afterburner is the first LP from the Texas blues-rock trio in almost 2 years, and follows Eliminator, which surpassed the 800,000 units sold mark in Canada. The LP remained on the RPM 100 for more than 100 weeks.

WEA's Bill Johnston says, "Based on the single alone (Sleeping Bag), what ZZ Top has done on Afterburner is a continuation of Eliminator and retailers are confident that the new release will duplicate the success of Eliminator."

Johnston went on to explain, "There's nobody else recording who sound like ZZ Top and they've had no personnel changes in their 15 years. They don't change their sound radically, but deliver continuity and consistency. They're in a class themselves."

WEA expects to hit the million mark with Afterburner and is even expecting some cross-over action with the LP. There is no confirmation of a tour at press time.

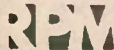
Excuse me!!!

It seems that every media reception I've been going to lately, the bearded ones resemble the Toronto Sun's Gary Dunford or Claire Hoy - not to mention the bearded ladies. However, the real Dunford was at the recent CBC Radio bash - one of those cheese and grape parties. Still with CBC radio . . . !!

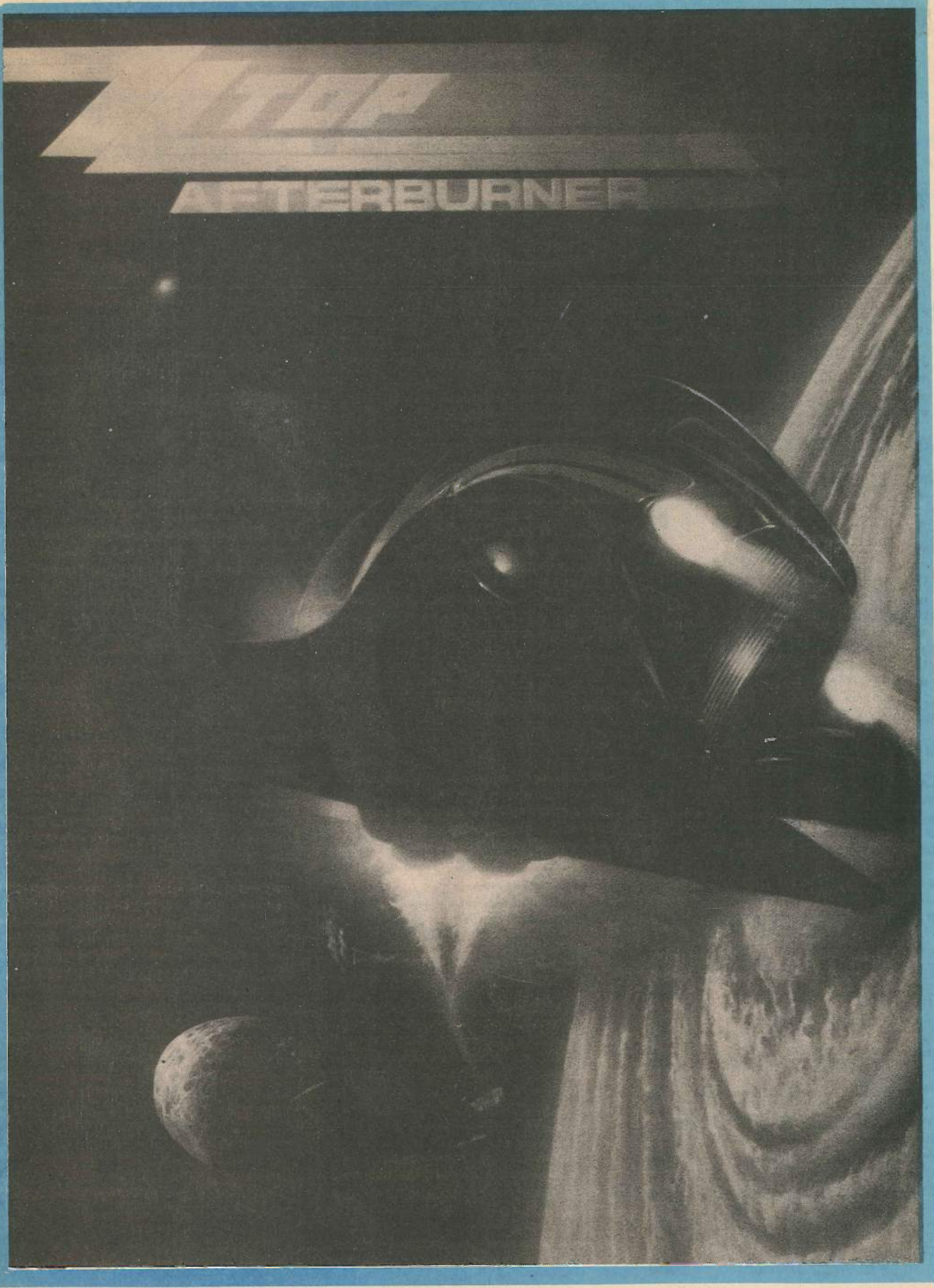

A very busy Christmas for Capitol

The pre-Christmas season is going to be a very busy, profitable, and 'winning' time of the year for us at Capitol-EMI. One of the projects that we're really excited about is Helix. The band has never neglected to tour

Canada but right now they are planning their first national tour, starting

November 1st in St Johns (Nfld.), and carrying through until December when they'll be in B.C. They'll be playing over 20 cities. Their current single (and video) The Kids Are All Shakin from Long

Way To Heaven continues to gain momentum. David Wilcox will be heading to Western Canada in support of his latest release, The Best Of David Wilcox.

On the topic of Canadian acts, we feel that Rational Youth's Bang On single is extremely commercial/accessible and is tailor made for radio. We've just released Running Away by Strange Advance (who will have Western dates in the near future), and Miles

In My Mind by Bamboo. Frank Mills is also planning to tour Canada with dates in the Maritimes confirmed. More will follow. Luba is now en route to Japan as a finalist in the World Popular Song Festival.

New releases by our U.K. acts are doing very well. The Hounds Of Love album by Kate Bush turned gold within 4 weeks of release and the single Running Up That Hill is going strong at both CHR and AOR radio. We're really happy about the CHR play to date, and hope to close in on some of the Western markets in the near future. The debut single Election Day by Arcadia was an immediate add to most stations right out of the box. The album So Red The Rose will be released in November. Both of these acts are being supported by strong marketing campaigns. Sheena Easton's latest titled Do You was produced by Nile Rodgers. The single will be Do It For Love.

Hearts' latest single Never follows the Top 10 success of the gold single What About Love. The Heart album has just closed in on platinum and continues to sell well. A live date for Toronto marked on Nov. 12 has just been announced. The Motels are currently on tour in Canada as Special Guests to Supertramp. We've just released Shock, the second single. It should do well at not only radio, but dance clubs too. Tina Turner's latest One Of The Living from Mad Max III Soundtrack is another hit right out of the box. It's expected that she'll be making an appearance at the

Juno Award show.

Three heavier sounding acts that we're currently working are Phantom, Rocker & Slick, Wasp, and Iron Maiden. P,R&S are Slim Jim Phantom, Lee Rocker (both from Stray Cats), and Early Slick. The first single from their debut album is called Men Without Shame. As well as Slick's extraordinary guitar work, the record also features Keith Richards. Wasp's second album The Last Command includes the track Blind In Texas. An incredible, and humorous video has been done to support this song. We're hoping for a Canadian tour in February. Live After Death is the new double-live album by Iron Maiden. This record, featuring 18 live tracks recorded on their '84/85 World Slavery Tour, comes complete with an 8 page colour booklet.

Robotman is a children's project that we're really excited about. Conceived and produced by Peter Shelly, Robotman is already a syndicated cartoon, and television show.

The surprise of the season could be Tarkan Boy from a newcomer, Baltimore. This song has already made it to the Top 5 in all major European territories, and is now poised to take North America by storm. A definite hit! There's also Little Steven's Sun City (Artists United Against Apartheid) that should do extremely well.

From our distribution labels, Anthem has just released Power Windows by Rush. This album, which features the single Big Money is already roaring up the charts in the U.S. Ian Thomas is continuing to make gains with his latest Add Water album which includes the single Harmony. Aquarius has just released Love Has Remembered, the latest single from April Wine's Walking Thru Fire album. Corey Hart's Boy In The Box single hit the Top 10 on stations right across the country, and in some cases, again achieved the Number One position.

Also included is the Bono track as well as an improvisation of Peter Gabriel. Says Van Zandt: "Peter just sang a few tracks against an African log drum, then we put the music to it, certainly capturing his emotion...it's a fantastic song."

Through the Sun City release Van Zandt hopes to accomplish 3 things "We're trying to educate the musicians, the sports people, the actors - those who would consider going to Sun City - and putting to rest the ignorance about it." He continues, "It's a suggestion of solidarity for South Africa's blacks. They don't get much support, especially from our governments. And we want to re-focus on racism in general by writing about South Africa with their exaggerated form of racism."

When asked about the toughest part of the project, Van Zandt replied, "The remixing took quite a bit of work...yes, finding out who sang what line the best was the hardest thing to do." And what has been the initial response from radio? "It's receiving across the board acceptance. I think they feel it stretches their format without going against what they normally play because we're speaking to a wide and varied group of listeners out there."

Always one to attempt firsts, Donn scored another as the world's fastest yodeller, when in 1984 he let go all 5 tones in 1.9 seconds.
