



The Kingswood Music Theatre schedule of dates continues its roll with August shaping up to be one of the better months. One of the more critically-acclaimed dates for the month of July at the Canada Wonderland setting was Stevie Ray Vaughan who was coupled with Omar & The Howlers.

August kicks off with a coupling of Cutting Crew and Paul Janz (Aug 6). Cutting Crew have scored a couple of hit singles over the past few months, their latest being One For The Mockingbird, taken from their Breakfast LP, released by Virgin. Janz, a Vancouver-based A&M recording artist, is currently on release with his Electricity album.

Honeymoon Suite are back at Kingswood for 2 dates (8 & 9), followed by Siouxsie & The Banshees with Julian Cope (12), Kim Mitchell for 2 shows (14 & 15), Roger Waters (17), Crowded House (18), Al Jarreau with Chaka Khan (19), and Kenny Loggins (23).

Wagner single released prior to Toronto date

Jack Wagner, star of ABC-TV's General Hospital, will appear in the leading role of Jerome Robbins' musical, West Side Story, opening at Toronto's O'Keefe (Aug 4 thru 9). The popular musical is one of the Coors Light Spotlight On Theatre series.

WEA Music Canada moved quickly to release Wagner's single, Island Fever, which was taken from his Don't Give Up Your Day Job album. Wagner has never kicked into gear as a recording artist, but it's expected that because of his role as Tony in West Side Story, which will bring him into a live setting, he could catch with A/C programmers, in major cities where the musical will play.

Also starring are Lauri Landry as Maria, Valarie Pettiford (Anita), Rick Negron (Bernardo) and John Schiappa (Riff).

Haywire/Brighton Rock to tour Maritimes

Attic's Haywire and WEA's Brighton Rock are set for an extensive tour of the Maritimes. Brighton Rock, who are on release with a 12" non-commercial single of Change Of Heart, are just winding up their solo tour of Ontario, the last 3 dates being Penetanguishene (Aug 5), Barrie (6), and Sundridge (7). They join Haywire to kickoff their Maritime tour at the Bathurst Arena (9), followed by Woodstock (10), Campbellton (11), and wind up the New Brunswick leg of the August tour in Newcastle (15).

They leave the mainland for 5 dates in Newfoundland: Cornerbrook (18), Grand Falls (19), Mary's Town (20), St. John's (21), and Gander (22).

Back on the mainland they concentrate the rest of the month on Nova Scotia: New Glasgow (25), Truro (26), Kentville (27), Yarmouth (28), Bridgewater (29), and Sydney (31).

The popularity of these bands can be judged by the venues they are playing, which includes arenas, stadiums, civic and convention centres.

Haywire are currently making giant moves up the charts with Dance Desire, taken from their latest album, Don't Just Stand There. Their previous album, Bad Boys, went gold and is now approaching the 80,000 units sold mark.

The bands will continue their tour of the Maritimes into September with dates at the Metro Centre in Halifax (Sept 1), Moncton's Coliseum (2), Fredericton's Aitken Centre (3), Amherst's Stadium (4), the Forum in Charlottetown (5), and the Convention Centre in Saint John (6).

The tour is being coordinated by Saint John promoter Mark Lee and Haywire manager Bruce Hudson.

The Regina date will coincide with a couple of interesting events which the travelling group will take in: SRIA will hold an Executive Committee meeting on the 13th, and the following day the Gold Fever Festival Concert will be staged, featuring Glass Tiger and Tom Cochrane & Red Rider along with the winner of the province wide talent search.

Bon Jovi single available on special cassette pack

Bon Jovi have just completed the Canadian leg of their ongoing Slippery When Wet world tour, which resulted in several SRO dates. After the Montreal show the band was presented with octuple platinum awards in recognition of the more than 800,000 copies of Slippery When Wet sold in Canada in less than a year. Since their Montreal date the album, which was produced in Vancouver at Little Mountain Sound by Bruce Fairbairn, has sold in excess of 860,000 copies.

As an added bonus to Bon Jovi fans, Polydor has released a special cassette package featuring Wanted Dead Or Alive, the third single taken from the LP. The track

As well, the cassette includes I'd Die For You, which was also culled from the Slippery When Wet LP.



COVER STORY - by Graeme Boyce**The Pikes: no longer their own record company . . .**

Several years have now passed since Saskatchewan's Northern Pikes released Scene In North America, an EP that featured, among others, their current single, Teenland. The record served as their calling card to the Canadian music industry and heralded the beginning of a fast climb into prominence, culminating with their Virgin deal inked this past winter.

The band, known for their determination and constant touring, are unique; there is no other band signed to a major, sounding anything like them. Now that their new album, Big Blue Sky, is on the shelves across the country, the record-buying public can appreciate what those years of touring affords a band in Canada.

"I'm not pulling any East-West prejudice, but I think bands from out West have it harder," begins the Pikes' guitarist Bryan Potvin. "It's just a lesser populated area, and as a result you have to work twice as hard. In the last three and a half years there hasn't been a weekend gone by where we haven't played, because we've had these independent records out.

"It's like having a baby . . . there are loan payments that have to be made every month. I didn't even own an amp until about a year ago. I was renting the whole time," he confesses. "We weren't one of those groups that had a big p.a. system or light system, but we did have a school bus . . . 15 miles an hour at tops. It stunk . . . hot in the summer, cold in the winter."

Basically, it's a do-it-yourself trip until you're relatively close to signing that elusive deal. Touring a country 3,000 miles long (aside from attracting industry attention and helping promote your records) matures bandmembers, improves musicianship and strengthens personal bonds; and in essence, only the strong survive.

The Pikes Virgin debut was recorded at a

variety of studios by manager Fraser Hill and Rick Hutt, and the re-recording of previously released tracks didn't bother the band. Simply, they're songs that should be heard, boasts Potvin, adding there are only about 5,000 copies "floating around" the country in any case.

"This is a whole new ballgame for us," he enthuses. "It's funny . . . when we got signed, and it's something that you really think about, especially when you start doing your own material . . . you get your music out to as many people as you can. It's very difficult to do that when you're an independent. You're selling records from the stage. You're walking into record stores in towns where people don't know you, and you're hustling yourself. You are your own record company.

"There are no guarantees in this business. It's all one big crap shoot. You do your best and see what happens. If people pick up on it . . . great. But if they don't, well as long as we can lay in bed at night and be

able to sleep, thinking we gave it an honest shot . . . that's what's really important."

The debate will rage forever as to the reasons a musician records his work, as each artist's opinion differs anyway, but what distinguishes music arising from "the street" is precisely its honesty; yet some call it uncommercial.

"We have this attitude in the studio," Potvin relates, "of presenting the songs in a very naked form. The vocals are very dry, very upfront. It's presenting this attitude towards the listener, a take it or leave it type presentation. 'Here are the songs: this is what the guitars are doing, this is the vocal.' There is no reverb, echo or anything hiding or masking anything. It's a very obvious kind of production and that's what we were after."

Potvin believes it is an "honour" to have been offered the deal which allowed the recording of Big Blue Sky, as one of the privileged few in this industry. "There's a very small percentage of people on this earth who actually get to do what they want with their lives . . . to be able to do something like this," he concludes, "to have some guy upstairs signing over hundreds of thousands of dollars to record . . . we're pretty lucky."
