EMI leading the way in digital downloads

LONDON — EMI has joined forces with computer software giant Microsoft to sell "the largest single release of digital music on the web by a record label" in a deal initially with US



web retailers before moving to those in Europe.

Although the deal does have its

critics (one described it as a "mere drop in the ocean"), it does make available for sale more than 100 albums and singles by high-profile artists. It also shows that, after having offered music fans selected free downloadable tracks for promotional purposes, the major

record companies are now positioning secure digital delivery as a seri-

Breathless Corrs keep up the pace

LONDON — The Corrs are racing towards the chequered flag in sales and airplay across Europe with the aptly-named *Breathless*, setting new lap times all the way.

The lead track from their 143/Lava/Atlantic album *In Blue*, released Europe-wide on July 17, has already beaten the Irish family group's previous best time in roaring to number one in the UK with

blanket airplay and first-week sales of over 60,000. That triggered a number six debut on M&M's Eurochart Hot 100 Singles, where this week *Breathless* stands at number seven. The track also tops the European Radio Top 50 airplay chart, as the group prepare to add to their tally of some 10 million albums sold in Europe alone since *Forgiven, Not Forgotten* took its first tentative steps in the UK

Sony jobs to go in Europe?

NEW YORK — Sony Music Entertainment has laid off approximately 500 of its 13,500-strong workforce worldwide, as part of a restructuring programme.

While around 100 workers were let go in the US and 400 in the international division, it is unclear how just many will be laid off in Europe. Some observers have conjectured that Europe will make a "contribution" over a period of time to the overall

also point out that Sony's corporate statement, issued on July 14, read: "Approximately 500 employees may be leaving the company."

The losses are across the board, including in distribution, administration, finance and publishing in a move described by Sony as "an ongoing effort to maximise organisational effectiveness."

A top regional executive reckons the layoffs have to do with Sony's difficulties globally: "It's not a secret that we're a bit cold at the moment," he says.

Sony Music's affiliates in Canada and in Australia are said to be among those most affected by the staff cuts, with 35 and 10 layoffs respectively. Asia should lose some 25 jobs, while Latin America could lose up to 150 people, according to sources.

In Europe, immediate cutbacks were less obvious, with none of the Sony affiliates prepared to comment on the situation. A spokesman for Sony Music Europe declined to discuss the issue and no timetable for redundancies has





Upfront

If there was a defining moment during the third IFPI Platinum Europe Awards show last week, it was when Neil Kinnock blushed on stage while being hugged by the Corrs. "Nobody told me I would get to be kissed by the most beautiful women in Europe," quipped the vice president of the European Commission in an unscripted moment.

Well, that moment just about summed up the whole thing. The show attracted top European politicians with the artists doing what they do best—being stars.

Paul Russell, who is one of the founding fathers of the Awards, got it right when he said before the show: "We have to use our artists to speak on behalf of the industry."

The IFPI Platinum Awards confirmed that the music industry's message is probably better delivered if it is imbued with the charisma of some of the best-selling artists on the continent.

And indeed, there was a lot of that kind of charm

on stage on July 13.

Overall, the show was a success. Phil Collins proved to be a well-seasoned host (he could always pursue a career in talk shows if his records ever stop selling). Kinnock delivered a speech where he alternated a message to the industry with a few jokes, and gracefully took the stage to present the awards to the artists. Jean-Michel Jarre suggested sending music downloaders Napster a virus called "I hate you," and handed his baton of Artist Spokesman to The Corrs. The artists thanked their record companies—perhaps there should have been a special award for the Cardinals' lead singer Nina Persson, who rather humorously thanked "PolyGram—no, Universal. Ummm...Seagram—or...whoever bought us the last time!"

There was also some good music to listen to.

Now, only time will tell if the industry will get more out of Brussels than it has to date on issues such as the Copyright Directive. But it is through events like the Platinum Awards that the industry can get its message spelled out in the most eloquent manner by its best ambassadors—the artists.

Positive reaction to Platinum Europe Awards

BRUSSELS — The early departure of European Commission President Romano Prodi from the third IFPI Platinum Europe Awards on July 13 did little to detract from an occasion, hailed by all involved as a success.

Prodi had to leave early to attend a ministerial meeting. That left the way for the Commission's vice president, Neil Kinnock, to step in. He told those assembled that "the truth is that pirates hit investment, variety, opportunity, and quality—and the music makers and the fans lose out."

The speech went down well with EMI Group chairman Eric Nicoli, who said it was good to see an eminent political figure demonstrate an "impressive grasp of the issues



facing our industry in an entertaining speech." Paul Russell, chairman of Sony Music Entertainment Europe said: "The fact that that two of the most important politicians in Europe, Prodi and Kinnock, both attended, shows how significant the Awards have become within the Brussels agenda." Chairman/CEO of Warner Music International Stephen Shrimpton described Kinnock's speech as a "positive statement for the European music industry."

Talking to M&M after the awards, Kinnock said he had enjoyed the event and that the message that the music industry was trying to pass on to European policy-makers has been "received and understood." He concluded that: "We need to look at the situa-

tion so that we can combine real protection without protectionism."

Looking back at the event, IFPI chairman/CEO Jay Berman said: "The feedback from politicians was very, very good. The EU people and the Commission people had a good time and thought it was just the right mix and low key. From our perspective, it went off perfectly."

One of the hottest tickets for Brussels bureaucrats, the Platinum Europe Awards could become an even bigger event. Berman says an expansion, taking it to different European capitals and even televising the show are all options, but adds, "The problem with bigger is that we would have to go to a bigger venue and it would lose some of the intimacy. We will have a review in September and begin to think about the next one."

Court ruling threatens future of Austrian commercial radio

VIENNA — More than 20 Austrian commercial radio stations face having their licences revoked, in a legal ruling which one leading radio executive says could "catapult Austria back into the Stone Age."

The country's constitutional court has ruled that the law which set up the country's Privatund Funkbehoerde (commercial broadcasting authority) in 1997 was unconstitutional, as it granted the organisation quasi-judicial powers, allowing it to operate independently from the constitutional court and parliament.

Media law expert Heinz Wittmann says that, in effect, the ruling means that the broadcasting authority can only operate with a very specific mandate dealing with a limited range of

areas. And because the very constitutionality of the authority had been called into question, so therefore has its licensing decisions.

The court's ruling has been greeted with horror by Austria's fledgling commercial sector, with the fate of major stations such as Radio Energy, 92.9 RTL, Antenne Wien and 88.6 hanging in the balance.

General manager at 88.6 Bernd Sebor says that "more than one billion schillings in investment by commercial broadcasters and many, many jobs," could be

affected by the ruling, which had been sought by more than 90 companies who were unsuccessful in their applications for commercial radio licences in 1997.

But some station executives believe the situation can be salvaged. Andrea Kozak-Kuszek, general manager of Radio Energy, which is partially owned by French group NRJ, says: "I'm fairly sure we will lose our licence, but even if we do we think we can get it back."

Wittmann, also a member of the Privatund

Funkbehoerde, agrees the stations are likely to regain their licenses even if they are initially withdrawn by the court. "The law hints at a slightly better position for broadcasting companies that have

conducted their operations in accordance with the law. I don't think the court will frustrate those broadcasters after all the money they have invested," he predicts.

MTV on top for first time in Germany

COLOGNE — MTV has taken over from its main competitor, VIVA, as the most popular music TV broadcaster in Germany for the first time since it launched its localised service three years ago.

According to a survey by market researchers IFD Allensbach, the two music TV channels both increased their ratings in their main target group of the 14-29 year-olds, with MTV's Central service reaching some 3.09 million viewers compared with VIVA's 2.99 million.



While managing director of MTV Central Christiane zu Salm welcomed the results as a "visible manifestation of MTV's market leadership," VIVA declared that their competitor's predominance was due to MTV upgrading to the Astra transponder (in January 1999), thus ensuring it an increase in reach of some seven million households.

Zu Salm admits that the satellite upgrade was a prerequisite for, but not a guarantee of, market leadership, explaining: "At the end of the day, it is content which decides leadership. For years we [MTV and

VIVA] have taken the Allensbach study as the common [ratings] currency and, as in previous years, the results are clear."

It is expected that VIVA's flotation in Frankfurt on July 19 will provide the funds to upgrade the broadcaster from the Eutelsat transponder to the Astra satellite, enabling the two music channels to compete on a level playing field.

The results will add fuel to the race between the two channels for Germany's youth audience, which has been hotting up recently. MTV has managed to poach Markus Kavka and Niels Ruf, two of VIVA 2's best-known VJs, while VIVA announced plans for the launch of a national radio brand.

Zomba seeking local talent in Italy

MILAN — UK-based Zomba Records is planning to develop Italian repertoire with the opening of its new office in Milan. The independent says it will be selective, intending to sign one or two young artists by the end of this year for launch early in 2001.

Five months after it was first announced, Zomba's Italian affiliate has opened up for business in the country's music capital, with Roberto Biglia, appointed back in

March, heading up operations as managing director.

"Initially we will be promoting Zomba's international artist roster," Biglia tells M&M. "But we already have contacts with Italian producers and we are keeping our antennae up for local acts."

Biglia, who was managing director of Universal Music Italy's Polydor division prior to the Universal merger will, for the time being, handle A&R activities. But he warns he will be prudent in his potential signings: "They will

be on the basis of the talent rather than looking for a specific genre. We will take our time to establish ourselves and find the right artist."

All promotional work will be handled by Zomba's new Italian team comprising former Polygram/Universal staffers Daniele Demartini, Giuseppina Bianchi and Simone Crescentini. Distribution will stay with Virgin/EMI, which previously licensed and handled Zomba's distribution and promotion in Italy.

ON THE BEAT

OMNITEL LAUNCHES MOBILE MUSIC

MILAN — Italian telecommunications company Omnitel is launching the country's first pay-to-play mobile phone music service, with users being charged around euro 0.26 to download a three-minute-long track. The service offers audio samples, previews of new records and a back catalogue juke-box. Dora Baiardo, MD of Omnitel 2000 says: "Record labels are showing a great interest in people paying for streaming, as most are sceptical about releasing their music for free." Music by unsigned acts will be made available to Omnitel under a deal with Italian Internet company Vitaminic.

DIGITAL ALLIANCE FORMED

LONDON — Three of the UK's largest radio groups have come together to form a consortium to bid for regional digital radio multiplexes as they are rolled out across the UK. The GWR Group, The Wireless Group and Scottish Radio Holdings have formed The Digital Radio Group Limited, which will bid for licences already advertised in the north east of England as well as forthcoming licences for the Severn Estuary, west, north west and Yorkshire regions of England. The alliance is backed by a multi-million pound investment and promises to expand radio listenership through DAB technology.

IRELAND BEEFS UP COPYRIGHT LAW

DUBLIN — A maximum five-year jail sentence and fines of up to IR £100,000 (euro 178,000) have been introduced in Ireland for those found guilty of copyright crimes, in the first major update to Irish piracy legislation since 1963. The law also affords protection for copyright owners on the Internet and makes the bootlegging of live concerts an offence for the first time. The IFPI says the bill will serve as "useful guidance" for the EU's forthcoming Green Paper on Counterfeiting and Piracy.

MUSIC TRIVIA ON THE WEB

LONDON — A useful resource for radio presenters has been launched on to the 'Net. Music trivia website www.thisdayinmusic.com provides a day-by-day rundown of the last 40 years of rock and pop music. The site claims to hold the largest database of music history on the web, listing artists' birthdays, revealing stars' real names and relating historic music events. The site has been set up by Seal's ex-manager John Wadlow and former Signal FM/Stoke-on-Trent presenter, Neil Cossar. The site also has an e-tailing facility through record store HMV.



MOVING CHAIRS



OSLO — Andreas Wille Paulsen has joined BMG Norway as promotion manager, radio/TV. Paulsen was formerly part of the editorial staff of public broadcaster NRK TV's chart show Top 20.

Meanwhile former head of promotion Jan Henrik Ohme is leaving the company to join Oslo-based Internet start-up WapBeats.com.

MILAN — Two former EMI Italy executives have been taken on by Columbia Italy. Leo Mansueto joins as promotions manager, reporting to local marketing director, Andrea Papalia. Roberto Grillo has been appointed to the newly-created post of A&R manager, working alongside Michele Barrile, Columbia artist director.

LUXEMBOURG — Markus Payer has joined Luxembourg-based pan-European media company, the RTL Group, as its new press officer. Payer joins from Bertelsmann AG and takes up his new role in September.

ON THE BEAT

SOUL SEARCHING FOR NEW STARS

LONDON — Soul music Internet radio station www.soul24-7.com is offering the chance of a recording deal to unsigned artists anywhere in the world. Star Search 2000 is open to any artist who has never had a label deal or been professionally recorded. The winner will get a week's studio time, with the master being sent to the major UK record labels supporting soul and R&B music. The initiative is in collaboration with UK music producer and soul 24-7 backer Ray Hayden.

ITALIAN POLICE RAID PIRATES

MILAN — Italian police have arrested four people after the discovery of 37 CD burners and over 23,000 pirate CDs during a raid in Naples on July 12. Inlay cards, computers and scanners were also seized. According to informants this may be the tip of the iceberg, with an estimated 400 more burners across the city all under the control of organised crime groups.

KISS PICKS DIGWEED

LONDON — Top club DJ John Digweed has been signed up by London dance station Kiss 100 to present a weekly show, starting in September. The two-hour show will include exclusive sets recorded especially for the station plus guest DJ sets from the progressive house scene. "John's profile in London is huge at the moment," confirms Andy Roberts (pictured), programme director at Kiss 100. "It'll be a great opportunity to break John as one of the major names in British dance radio."



FRENCH PUBLISHERS PAY TRIBUTE TO SEILLER

PARIS — The French music industry has been praising music publisher Philippe Seiller who died on June 30, aged 64, in a helicopter crash. Seiller was president/CEO of publishing company Editions Paul Beuscher. International vice-president, serious music at BMG Music Publishing Jean-Manuel de Scarano, described Seiller as "one of the best publishers in France."

LONGER SENTENCES FOR COUNTERFEITING

LONDON — The British government is proposing that prison sentences for those found guilty of counterfeiting and piracy should be increased from two to seven years. The announcement comes following figures showing such crimes have increase by 27%. The cost of copyright and trademark theft to the British music industry in 1999 increased to £8.19 billion (euros 13.34 billion) from £6.42 billion the previous year.

SGAE to provide 'artists' bridge'

MADRID — Sello Autor, the non-profit-making record label run by Spanish authors' society SGAE, is to function as a "talent-scout" for the major labels, by changing its emphasis from non-commercial product to seeking new talent from within the ranks of its 58,000 members.

The initiative has been taken by Sello Autor's newly-appointed director, Luis Francisco García, previously director general at the Arcade Music Company España. "This is open to any music genre," explains García. "The only condition is that

the material used must be registered with SGAE."

Sello Autor was set up three years ago, following the creation of Fundación Autor, the promotion and events arm of SGAE. Until now, it has concentrated mainly on classical music, Cuban music and singer/songwriters.

"We shall continue to publish this kind of material, which no commercial label would probably ever release," says García. "But the focus on new talent does not mean the creation of our own roster. Ideally, we would help good unsigned artists get a decent contract with one of the major labels. We hope new artists see us

as a bridge towards a useful music career."

Some 42,000 of SGAE's members are music-related, and more than 1,000 are non-Spanish, largely Cuban. "This is a great challenge, because there is no genre or language limit," says García. "I have an investment budget, but no sales budget, and so I feel my only real duty is to provide quality. Having said that, I shall of course try not to lose money."

García is currently looking for a distributor. Until now Sello Autor has relied on one-off distribution deals with various labels. "The important thing about this new enterprise is that Sello Autor does not want to compete with any other label—it is not about that," he says.



Mix Megapol signs up Rix's breakfast team

STOCKHOLM — Top Swedish radio breakfast team Jesse Wallin and Martin Loogna are to present on AC network Mix Megapol, after having been lured away from rival and main competitor, Rix FM (Hot AC).


Wallin and Loogna are veteran pioneers of Swedish commercial radio, with their respective careers going back to the 1980s. They began working together in the early '90s, first at Stockholm's Radio City and later on national network Rix FM. Their show, Rix Morronzoo, increased morning listening at the station, making it more popular in some regions among the target 25-44-year-old demo than market leader P4.

Mix Megapol programme director Ulf Tjerneld says: "I'm looking forward to working with such a well-esteemed team as Jesse and Loogna. They're already a working team, but we plan to do the programme in a Mix Megapol style." The duo will start their show, which will continue to feature Martina Thun of the current Mix Megapol morning show, in the second week of October.

The new breakfast show is part of a shake-up of station programming begun earlier this month with a "variety guarantee," which promises that the same song will not be

aired more than once between 09.00 and 17.00 each day. "This gives more room for new music, with a few extra new titles added in the daytime," explains Tjerneld. "But Mix Megapol will still be a 'conservative' radio station when it comes to music."

Rix FM managing and programme director Christer Modig says of his breakfast duo's surprise departure: "This is not at all the death knell for us. Rather the opposite, it has given our programming department a fresh impetus." At presstime, no permanent replacement at Rix had been confirmed for Wallin and Loogna.



Goodbye to 'The Commander'

LONDON — An emotional John Deacon bade farewell to his colleagues and friends at the British Phonographic Industry's (BPI) annual general meeting on July 12.

Deacon, who is retiring after 21 years in the role, received a standing ovation at the meeting, led by BPI chairman Rob Dickins, who praised Deacon's successor, Andrew Yeates, assuring members that he was the right man to take the organisation forward into

the digital age.


Deacon, known affectionately as "The Commander" by his staff after being made Commander of the (Order of the) British Empire last year, will continue working as a consultant at the BPI until the end of this year. Deacon

admitted he is finding it hard to end his love affair with the music industry: "After having gone through 21 years I suppose it really is the end of an era," he says. "To be honest I'm genuinely finding it quite hard to appreciate that I'm now in a different position—but everybody

has been wonderful about it. I found toward the end of my speech I was getting a bit croaky," he says. "I was deeply moved by the whole event and the nostalgia started to take over—but it was marvellous."

Paying tribute to Deacon's dedication, chairman Rob Dickins said: "He understands our business and he understands the people in our business better than anyone else. He also understands broadcasters and the government. The respect that people both outside and within the industry give John does not come any higher."

Something between a DIY radio station and a music library, MyPlay provides free, online space for storing music that users upload into their own private "locker." These tracks can then be played on any computer or downloaded onto a personal player. They can also be arranged into a radio-style programme. Any programme can be shared with other users via a public area, but it must conform to the Digital Millennium Copyright Act by being at least five hours long and containing no more than three tracks from the same album in a three-hour period. MyPlay also offers a selection of free legal downloads and programmes compiled by guest celebrities.

Opening up Europe's ratings books

M&M correspondents present a round-up and analysis of recently-released radio ratings figures in Germany, Italy and France.

GERMANY

This year's annual Media-Analyse (MA) ratings in Germany are, for the first time, based on Computer Assisted Telephone Interviews (CATI), replacing MA's 28 year-old system of personal interviews.

Some 57,273 Germans were interviewed about their radio listening habits between October 4 and December 1999 and between January 31 and April 9 2000. Germany is one of six European countries using CATI systems in their ratings—the others being Belgium, France, Luxembourg, Portugal and Sweden.

The MA 2000 figures reveal that German commercial stations have won another 2.43 million listeners aged 14-plus, and now reach 10.45 million listeners per average hour. The country's public broadcasters remain ahead, though, with 32.93 million listeners per day compared to commercial radio's 30.39 million.

The country's most competitive radio market of Berlin-Brandenburg, where 26 stations vie for listeners' attention, is led by commercial CHR station 94.3 r.s.2 with an average of 230,000 listeners per hour. The station enjoyed a major PR coup this year when it staged a wedding between

two listeners who had never previously met, a stunt previously undertaken in Australian radio and last year by Birmingham's BRMB in the UK. Following close behind with 210,000 listeners per hour is CHR station BB Radio, which is the market leader in the Brandenburg area.

Berlin urban outlet Jam FM saw its ratings increase substantially, from 19,000 per hour to 41,000. "It proves that a station like Jam FM, which has until now only been available via cable and satellite, can indeed compete with most of the terrestrial stations," says Jam FM managing director Frank Nordmann. "But we are still working very hard to secure a terrestrial frequency."

RTL's Hot AC station in Berlin, 104.6 RTL, saw an increase in its hourly audience from 110,00 to 186,000. "The figures confirm our strategy of concentrating our stations on specific target groups within the 14 to 49 demographic," says Jürgen Filla, managing director of RTL Radio in Germany. Filla adds that the new CATI methodology "gives a much more realistic and transparent overview of the radio market in all age groups."

There's little movement in the Hamburg and Schleswig-Holstein markets, with Hot AC station Radio Hamburg out in front in that city for

the ninth successive year with a marketshare of 23.6%. In Saxony and Sachsen-Anhalt, Radio PSR remains market-leader in Saxony. Its 363,000 listeners per hour make it the most successful commercial station in eastern Germany, while Radio SAW stays at number one in Sachsen-Anhalt. Baden Wuerttemberg, where SWR3 stays ahead of commercial CHR station Radio Regenbogen, is one of the few states where a public station is the market leader.

With 1.33 million listeners per average hour (compared to 790,000 in last year's MA) Radio NRW in North-Rhine Westfalia is the most-listened to individual radio station in Germany, beating off the challenge of stations from the state's public broadcaster WDR.

In Bavaria, AC powerhouse Antenne Bayern/Munich saw its audience increase by 86,000 to 791,000 per average hour, narrowly missing the top spot in Bavaria which remains the property of public station BR Bayern 1. Public rock station BR Bayern 3 almost doubled its hourly average, from 291,000 to 566,000 year-on-year.



ITALY

Radio Dimensione Suono (RDS) has overtaken RTL 102.5 Hit Radio in the head to head battle for the ears of Italy's twentysomethings, which saw the two networks in court earlier this year over programme rights.

Both stations operate an "adult" CHR music format skewed to the 25-34 demographic and are strong on news, information and personality presentation. RTL 102.5 overtook RDS 12 months ago, but in the latest Audiradio survey for the second quarter of 2000, the Rome based RDS has re-gained the lead over its Milan-based rival.

All networks lost audience compared to the



first quarter figures, due to seasonal listening habits. In comparison with the same period last year, RDS remained relatively stable with 4.6 million average daily listeners, whilst RTL 102.5 lost 150,000 listeners at 4.5 million.

"We've been working on refining our programming, and we feel that this work is now paying back in terms of listener loyalty," says RDS' head of external relations Danilo Ciotti. "But we are also looking towards the future and are increasing interaction with our listeners and the entertainment quota of our programming."

One factor in RDS' revival in fortunes is the success of its lunchtime comedy and phone-in show *Alto Gradimento*, presented by Charlie Gnocchi and Joe Violanti, which it poached lock, stock and barrel from RTL last year. RDS subsequently took RTL to court when the Milan network continued to broadcast the show with different presenters, Grant Benson and Gianni Riso.

The court ruled that the original presenters, Gnocchi and Violanti, created the format and therefore owned the rights to the programme and its title. As a result, RTL was forced to come up with a new name and format for its

lunchtime slot.

Despite a further quarter-on-quarter fall for overall listening to public broadcaster RAI's three radio networks, full-service RAI RadioUno—which recently increased its talk output—bucked the trend with an increase of over 100,000 listeners against the same period last year, with 7.7 million tuning in daily.

FRANCE

The good performance of most French national music networks contrasts with a downturn in listening to full-service and news stations in the latest Médiamétrie ratings for April-June.

This contrasts with the previous January-March sweep, during which most music networks lost audience share. Analysts consider that stations with a strong news content have been affected by a lack of major news event likely to boost their ratings.

Music stations Nostalgie, Fun Radio, Europe 2, Chérie FM, Rire et Chansons and RTL2 have all posted rises in audience, with gold network Nostalgie reaching an all-time high of 8.4%. The only music networks to lose audience were Skyrock (CHR/Urban) and RFM (Gold).

According to NRJ Group VP Alain Weill, Nostalgie's performance validates the program-

ming strategy implemented by NRJ when it bought the station two years ago, and took all the new music off the station (Nostalgie previously had an AC/Gold format). In just two years, the station's audience has increased by 90% to nearly four million daily listeners.

NRJ has seen all four of its national networks (CHR NRJ, AC Chérie FM, Gold Nostalgie and AC/comedy Rire et Chansons) reach new levels, with a cume of 13.8 daily listeners. "Four networks, four records," rejoices Weill.

The NRJ executive also notes that the company's flagship CHR network, which is up from 11.2% to 12% (with 5.7 million daily listeners), is back to the record figures it recorded in the same period of 1999. "And the gap [with market-leader RTL] is narrowing," notes Weill.

Another gainer this time around is Fun Radio, which has regained the audience levels it last enjoyed five years ago, thanks to the on-

going success of its rhythmic format introduced in 1998. Compared to January-March, the CLT-UFA-owned network has gained a further 260,000 listeners.

Dance grooves

GOD SAVE THE SOUL

The David Chong remix of Cyril K's *Soul Save The Queen* (Le Maquis/France), shows yet more evidence of a healthy diversification in French dance music. An undeniably soul influenced chorus and live instrumentation hint at the current garage movement but in reality have little real allegiance to it or any other movement. It is a strong song, well performed, and is already playlisted by Radio Nova. Although Nova's choices are often far from the mainstream, in this case *SSTQ* is a classy crossover contender.

TASTE OF THE TROPICS

Rightly hailed as being one of London's most creative crews, Da Lata have established a reputation as thoroughly worthy pan-cultural nu jazzers. Their latest effort, *Binti* (Palm Pictures/UK), shows a deft, neopopulist touch and wisely comes with a radio edit. The haunting vocal by Deirdre Dubois combines with a syncopated percussive backing that picks up momentum supported by guitar and keyboards. Amongst the many contemporary tracks influenced by tropical music, this is one of the freshest thanks to its originality and a warm production.

TAKA BOOM THE TRUSTIN' SORT

Following a top 10 with Joey Negro's *Must Be The Music* Taka Boom is back with *Trustin'* (Deepend/UK). With music by Articulate the track is already an early Ibiza-season hit and has enough pazazz to be a possible crossover tune. It is a given that Boom's vocals are characteristically powerful and rich but the song itself has a rounded production with plenty of classy, deep touches, and manages to be as floor-friendly as it is potentially programmable. With the track featuring regularly in sets by Lisa Loud, Jazzy M, Paul Stevens of El Divino and Jonathan Ulysses of The Space Bar "summer hit" momentum would seem to be building.

LATE DEBUT FROM TOMMY HOOLS

Ever since the track *Subjectif Warrior* appeared on 1998 compilation *French Fried Funk vol 2* Tommy Hools have been the next big French thing in-waiting. Over two and a half years later their self-titled debut album, on East West France licensed from indie label Recall, is finally ready.

The pop-lounge style will undoubtedly draw comparisons to Air as will the loose, melodic style and myriad '60s references. Kicking off with *The Return Of The Darkside* the band establish their hip hop roots only to flip into two tracks—*End Of The Day* and *Fire*—that owe much to psychedelic pop. *Love Is The Message* sees a return of a more electronic sound with dark, hovering textures and a lowkey rap—a moody opus.

I Don't Give A Damn is a funky workout that brings to mind Can's more approachable, song-based moments while the brass 'n' bass-heavy *Ness Uno Mai* is a heartfelt homage to the Paulo Conte school of growly dialogue underpinning a strong tune. *Le Maire de Venise* is a rousing Bacharach/Ennio Morricone-styled piece of film music and *Easy Way To Lose* is supremely wistful pop. *On My Mind* features top notch psychobabble and *Forward Not Backward* sounds like early Pink Floyd with tough love bass tones and scratching. A fabulous wake-up call.

Bomfunkers go mobile

When Music & Media reported in our February 12 issue on the two-pronged "Finnish invasion" of Europe by Bomfunk MC's and HIM, the *Freestyler* single by the Bomfunk duo of rapper Raymond Ebanks and DJ Gismo was in its fifth week on Eurochart Hot 100 Singles.

The infectious Epidrome/Sony club crossover had already been a number one in Sweden, but as *Freestyler* racks up its 29th week on the Eurochart this issue, Germany, France, Austria, Greece, Holland, Switzerland, Hungary and Belgium have all fallen to the single and its parent album *In Stereo*, and the UK will be next.

With a sound universal enough to be embraced by stations ranging from alternative rock outlet Xfm to dance mainstreamer Kiss 100 FM, both in London, and with further support from BBC Radio 1, local commercial radio and on the small screen at MTV and The Box, the track will finally be in British shops on July 24 on Sony's Dancepool label, followed by the album on August 7.

Early this month, *Freestyler* went to number one in Australia, the ninth country where it has hit the top, and perhaps frustratingly for UK programmers, the continuing international success, has led to no fewer than four postponements of its

British release date. But with Bomfunk MC's due in London for promotion on July 26, it's finally chocks away on one of the last key territories in the campaign: Sony has scheduled an in-house presentation to the act on that day for its achievements so far, for its own staff and selected media, and the group will also mount a regional radio tour.

"It's a little bit frustrating, because you just want it to come out, but it's a great record," says Kiss programme director Andy Roberts, who jumped on *Freestyler* very early. "I bought it when I was in Amsterdam, brought it back before it was

even serviced to us and started playing it in high rotation." It's currently receiving 25-30 plays a week on Kiss, and Roberts believes the song's breakbeat, "indie kid" feel is helping it cross the formats to a wide radio audience.

The Bomfunk pair are already charting in Scandinavia, Holland

and Belgium with another single, *B-Boys & Fly Girls*, and their dominance does not end there. The *Freestyler* theme can be downloaded onto mobile phones from various websites and is a European hit in that format too. An extraordinary 65,000 downloads are estimated to have been made from one site, yourmobile.com, so the melody can be heard blasting not just from radios but in bars, shops and trains all over the continent.



Spain's Carotone finds fame in Italy

Tonino Carotone rides a Vespa, dresses flash-cool in a white suit made by his mother, sports a pencil-line moustache, and has reached number three in the Italian singles charts with what is probably the song of the summer there. Nothing too unusual there perhaps except that his real name is Antonio de la Cuesta, he is from Pamplona of Hemingway bull-running fame in northern Spain, and his song—*Me Cago En El Amor* ("I Shit On Love")—is being ignored by Spain's main national music radio networks.

The problem could be the song's title, although at least one programmer privately argues that Carotone's humour is "too intelligent" for CHR audiences. Indeed, a mix of genuine fresh talent and slick humour is what Carotone and his new album, *Mondo Difficile*, is all about.

"The song title probably has not pleased this network's executives," agrees Toni Sanchez, programme director of CHR market-leader, Cadena SER's Los 40 Principales. "It is not a pop song, and if we put Carotone's song on our playlist we'd have to put Julio Iglesias, for example. It could even harm Los 40 as a pop network, and is more suitable for Radio 3." Indeed, in Spain, apart from the odd regional radio network such as the Basque Country's


Radio Euskadi, only alternative/indie public broadcaster Radio 3 does play the single.

In Italy, it is a different story, where alternative broadcaster Radio Popolare picked up on *Me Cago En El Amor* several months ago helping to make it a hit. But what really made it take off was its use as background music by

sportswear company Fila in a European TV advertising campaign, which has not yet reached Spain. Consequently when the album *Mondo Difficile* was released in mid-June it went straight in the Italian album charts at number 22.

Carotone is the first domestic artist to find international success on Virgin Records España imprint Chewaka, whose director Javier Linan describes him as a "genius". He is also what they call in Spain an

"insumiso," or someone who refuses to do compulsory military service—a decision which led to several months in prison where he learnt to play the guitar and wrote "insubordinate" songs. "Virgin France is now very interested in Tonino, so this summer we'll be launching him in a big way there," says Linan. "It's startling how big a summer phenomenon he quickly became in Italy, and we expect the same to happen in France with an album release in September." The album is also scheduled for release later this year in Germany, Greece, Mexico and Argentina.

Rapping in Spanish and English, DJ Mendez does not strike you as a typical Scandinavian act but

then he is originally from Chile. Full name Leopoldo Mendez peddles a blend of hip hop and latino music which has proved popular in the very north of Europe and is now spreading into southern territories, first stop Italy. His first single *Chiki-Chiki* was released in 1998, produced by Rob'n'Raz, and the follow-up, *Razor Tongue*, reached platinum status in Sweden as well as the airplay and sales charts in the rest of the Scandinavia. His debut album *Latino Life* came out in Sweden in March, and it is expected to receive a pan-European release shortly. New single *Fiesta* once again features a catchy mix of latino guitars and Spanish rap and is again going down well in Sweden. Head of music at Hot AC station Rix FM in Stockholm, Anders Svensson, says: "We don't normally play rap, but we playlisted *Fiesta* on our evening show. DJ Mendez broke with *Razor Tongue*, which we played a lot. It was more

melodic than *Fiesta* and it stayed for a long time on our A-list. *Fiesta* is less commercial, harder if you like. But if it becomes big we'll put it on our A-list."

In the years after his departure from *Take That*, Williams has established himself as a household radio name. Surprisingly given his mainstream appeal, the video for William's new single *Rock DJ* has managed to court controversy and has been banned from many children's TV shows as well as the BBC's *Top Of The Tops* programme. This has not stopped *Rock DJ* from being picked up across Europe. "My first impression was that it was a bit old fashioned," says Ville Vilén head of music at Finnish CHR station YLE Radiomafia. "And when I listened to it again, I realised that the piano and drums section was taken from an old Barry White tune. It sounded interesting. I also think Robbie sounds a little different on this one. We have played all of his songs so it was an easy choice. Our listeners like him and he is a profile artist for our station." Vilén adds: "I think that if we didn't programme it, there would immediately be questions why from our listeners. It's not a classic, but it's a good song for radio."

Dance Beat

The weekly dance chart comment by Harald Roth

There is still a lack of movement at the top of the chart, with Black Legend's *You See The Trouble With Me* (Rise/Time) remaining at number one for the eighth consecutive week, making it the longest running Italian-signed chart topper ever. The track has now overtaken Eiffel 65's seven week stay with *Move Your Body* (Skooby/Bliss Co.). Number two also remains the same, as Bob Sinclar holds fort with *I Feel For You* (Yellow Productions/East West), whose increase in sales is compensating for a decline in club play.

Two tracks enter the top 10 this week. Firstly, Finnish DaRude's *Sandstorm* (16 Inch/Stargate) rises from 11 to three and is now the highest ever charting dance track from this territory. While Armand van Helden's *Koochy* (Armed/ffrr) still ranks in the top 30, the artist's new track *Full Moon* (also Armed/ffrr) goes up from 13 to seven, giving van Helden the honour of being the best performing US act in the chart this week.

Italian Afro Medusa's *Pasilda* (D:Vision/Energy), already big at home and in the UK, has now entered the German dance chart. It climbs from 38 to 13 in our chart and becomes the third highest-ranked Italian-signed track this week, below Black Legend and Love Connection.

Matt Darey presents Mash Up's *Beautiful* (Incentive/Ministry Of Sound) rockets from 93 to 28 thanks to increased sales. However, as yet it only features in the UK and Spanish club charts. Also impressive is Moloko's *Pure Pleasure Seeker*'s (Echo) jump from 37 to 24 in its second chart week. If the UK act follow their usual pattern, the rest of Europe will open their ears to the track shortly and lift it to the top end of the chart in no time.

This week's top 100 sees no less than 14 new entries, some of them likely to enter the top 40 next week. One of the hopefuls is Wink featuring Lil' Louis' *How's Your Evening So Far* (French Kiss/Ovum/ffrr). The track is only charting in the UK at the moment, but word is expected to spread quickly and cross-over the track to other major European dance markets.



On the air

M&M's weekly airplay analysis column

We have a new number one! Whitney and George have been pushed down to third place as The Corrs' *Breathless* (143/Lava/Atlantic) shoots up from six to the top spot this week. Deservedly so, some might say, as the group have followed in Jean Michel Jarre's footsteps and became artist spokespeople for IFPI. No less than 13 stations have picked up the track in its sixth week on the chart, including Radio DeeJay in Italy and Belgian Radio Contact.

The highest new entry is Melanie C's *I Turn To You* (Virgin) at 38. Many CHR stations in the UK are picking up the track, but also new rock/dance station Beat 106 in central Scotland has added it to its playlist.

Beat's head of music Richard Wilkinson says that it's not a track he would normally play on the ten-month old station: "We took a stand from the beginning not to play the Spice Girls, boybands, Britneys or Whitneys. But Hex Hector's version is a good trancy mix. It's good for our Scottish audience who are into harder dance stuff.

Mel C had a battle getting credibility but she still had fantastic success with *Never Be The Same Again*. She does the vocal anthem thing and it doesn't sound cheesy. She has a strong and powerful voice and it's well produced."

Beat 106, which has just been bought by UK-based Capital Radio Group, is taking part in the festival scene in Scotland this summer. Apart from being involved with T In The Park earlier this month, the station is also going to broadcast shows from the Edinburgh Festival. "The festival gets the rap for being just about classical music," says Wilkinson. "But this year names like Boy George, Metalheads and Dave Simmonds are on the list. There will also be a live ISDN-link to [dance event] Creamfields."

Robbie Williams' *Rock DJ* (Chrysalis) (see *Airbornes*, page 10), continues its progress up the chart, moving from 14 to six this week. Ronan Keating's *Life Is A Rollercoaster* (Polydor) is also enjoying solid airplay in Europe—the record shoots up from 17 to 11 thanks to support from Spanish SER's Los 40 Principales and Cadena Dial, and German Bayern 3.

New this week are ATC's *Around The World* (Hansa) at 40, Macy Gray's *Why Didn't You Call Me* (Epic) at 43 and Samantha Mumba's *Gotta Tell You* (Wild Card/Polydor) at 47. The theme for the Tom Cruise movie *Mission Impossible 2*, Limp Bizkit's *Take A Look Around* (Interscope), enters at 48. Its supporters include Germany's Eins Live and Radio 538 in Holland. David Gray's *Babylon* (IHT/East West) enters at 50.

Britney Spears' new single *Lucky* (Jive) seems destined for a high position in next week's chart. Another possible new entry is A-ha's second single from their comeback album, the title track *Minor Earth Major Sky* (WEA).

ous alternative revenue source.

EMI's announcement confirms the UK-based multinational record company as one of the first majors, along with Sony, to transport large chunks of their extensive catalogues into the digital age.

Although starting in the US, Simon Dyson, music market analyst at London-based Market Tracking International says: "If it takes off fairly quickly, they'll distribute in Europe very soon after."

EMI is offering the works of 80-plus different artists—ranging from the likes of Frank Sinatra, Pat Benatar, Pink Floyd and Joe Cocker to contemporary material by NWA, Spice Girls and Janet Jackson—for downloading via the new version of Microsoft's online digital audio software, Windows Media Player 7.

"Windows Media is a great format for releasing music today and one that allows us to embrace digital music sales over the Internet," says Jay Samit, senior VP, new media, EMI Recorded Music.

The new Windows Media player, available for downloading on to PCs through its web site, enables music fans to play EMI tracks downloaded via US online music stores such as US-based Virgin Jamcast, Best Buy, CDnow, Trans World Entertainment, Musicland and HMV Canada.

One of the issues raised by digital delivery, and the one dearest to consumers, is how record companies plan to price downloadable tracks compared to music sold on physical formats such as CDs. According to New York-based EMI spokeswoman Dawn Bridges: "Wholesale price, which is all we set, is the same as that in the physical world." In the US, that means a downloaded album could cost between \$7.99 and \$15.99 at US retail.

As part of an initial 60-day promotional campaign, visitors to the WindowsMedia.com site can use Windows Media Player 7 to access

30-second song samples from EMI tracks before choosing to click and buy the relevant digitised tracks on the retail sites. On the Virgin Jamcast site consumers will, for example, be charged between \$7 and \$11 to download EMI albums, including the Pink Floyd classic *Dark Side of the Moon*. Internet users with Liquid Audio's multi-format music delivery software on their PC will also be able to listen to downloaded EMI repertoire.

However, Jupiter Communications analyst Aram Sinnreich in New York is not over-impressed with EMI's foray into commercial downloads. "This is a just baby step in the right direction," he tells M&M. "There's no question that the major labels will sell digitised versions of their entire catalogue in the near future. But we should not be excited by this, which is just a quaint gesture." He argues that in an age when consumers can simultaneously exchange 500,000 music files every night via Napster, the file-swapping website, EMI's 100-plus albums and singles are a mere drop in the ocean.

Sinnreich believes all the majors need to digitise their entire catalogues soon or "they'll be forced to by law. They are good at announcing things, but the follow-through is always a hit-and-miss affair."

MTI's Dyson agrees. "[Digital delivery] is still a very unformed way of selling music. Like all the other record companies, EMI's hand has been forced because of piracy and file-swapping activities such as Napster and soon by Freenet. This is more like a tester to see how the market develops."

In May, Sony Music Entertainment started selling a handful of secure digitised tracks from about 30 artists to US online consumers via thestore.com. Additionally, Sony and Universal Music Group have also announced plans to sell digital music on a subscription basis.

been published.

Germany could be a key territory for cutbacks, but sources there say this may be more to do with the reluctance of Sony Music staff to relocate from the company's traditional base in Frankfurt to a new state-of-the-art complex in Berlin. A restructuring of the Frankfurt distribution centre may also be on the cards. More than 20 jobs could be affected there.

Sony has already been restructuring some parts of its operations in Europe. Sony Music Holland recently re-merged its Epic and Columbia labels. At the time managing director Patrick Decam com-

mented: "The whole move is based on the mere fact that we have to do something to counter the decreasing market."

No large-scale losses are evident in the UK, although there have been departures this year. Mick Clark, managing director of Sony's Higher Ground label, was one, while more recent exits include Cynthia Leu and Jon Fowler, international marketing directors for Columbia and Epic respectively, and strategic marketing VP Tony Clark. Some of the departees have been replaced or had their responsibilities added to the workload of others.

charts in March 1996.

Breathless also made a top 10 sales debut in Sweden and opened strongly in Holland, with other European territories also helping to form an extremely healthy set-up for *In Blue*.

If ever there was a creative marriage tailor-made for instant radio and retail acceptance, it is the combined pop sensibilities on *Breathless* of the Corrs family and producer "Mutt" Lange, the long-time esteemed rock sideman (Def Leppard, Bryan Adams) who turned white-hot with his writing and production for Mrs. Lange, better known as Shania Twain.

"*Breathless* sounded so much like the first single," says lead singer and lyricist Andrea Corr. "It was like 'there you go, I just punched you again.'" She recalls how the group met up with Lange at London CHR giant 95.8 Capital FM's summer concert last year. "We were doing Party In The Park and Shania was doing it too, so we met Mutt and he really was gushing about our music, he really liked our work, which was amazing to us."

"We got on very well and decided to try and write together, so we wrote *Breathless* and two other songs on the album (*All The Love In The World* and *Irresistible*) and it's lent it a very dramatic sound, I think. Mutt always does that, it's a great flavour for the album."

Andy Murray, VP marketing for Warner Music International, reports spectacular early numbers for both single and album. At presstime, midweek sales figures suggested a number one debut for *In Blue* in the UK, Ireland and Germany. "Their key markets in Europe, who got behind them from the beginning, are Denmark, France and Spain," says Murray, "but now having caught up, also Sweden, Italy and Germany. All the things we hoped would happen are happening."

Eik Frederiksen, programme director of CHR station The Voice in Copenhagen and its AC sister Pop FM, describes *Breathless* as "a superb pop number. We play it on both Pop FM and The Voice."

While many stations were cautious about playing the early

Corrs' releases, Frederiksen is a longtime fan. "We've been there since *Forgiven, Not Forgotten* and started playing their stuff very early," he says. "It was well produced and well performed, and we had no doubts about them. Warner Denmark sent the first singles out to radio four or five times before they got any play, but now they have a huge audience."

Steve Bulley, programme controller at Orchard FM in Taunton, Somerset, in the UK, admits that the Hot AC did not play the group until "they were an established act. We've had most of their hits on our playlist in one form or another," he says, singing the praises of *Breathless* and the *In Blue* set. "It's not all pure pop, there are some deep and meaningful tracks."

In Blue also includes new studio recordings of *Radio*, a hit from last year's MTV *Unplugged* set, and another song from that album, *At Your Side*. The *Unplugged* set received its second Platinum Europe Award certification in the IFPI's June awards for European sales of two million copies, just before the Corrs took over as the organisation's artist spokespeople at the July 13 ceremony in Brussels (see story, page 2).

In Blue has polarised opinion in the British media, with some reviewers seeing it as a natural progression of the Corrs' sound and others accusing them of burying their Irish roots. "We're very well prepared for people to say 'this isn't what you've done before,'" says Caroline Corr. "It's not supposed to be what we've done before, we said to ourselves 'we want to progress'."

"There's one totally instrumental track [*Rebel Heart*] which is very traditional, and *Give Me A Reason* has a very big section of Irish in it." *Rebel Heart*, written chiefly by Sharon Corr, is to feature as the theme of a BBC TV series this autumn about the Irish uprising of 1916. But Jim Corr says they refuse to be traditional for the sake of it. "We're certainly not going to try and put in a traditional Irish line into a song if it doesn't work," he says.

German media giant **Bertelsmann** has announced plans to take over US online retailer **CDnow**, via a cash offer of \$117 million. After completion of the transaction, CDnow will operate under the umbrella of Bertelsmann's e-commerce group **BeCG** but will still use its own brand name, according to a July 20 statement from Bertelsmann. CDnow has been plagued with financial difficulties and rumours of a takeover had been persistent in recent months.

In the UK, big changes are afoot in the programming department at public AC/MOR station **BBC Radio 2**, following the BBC's recent restructuring which saw **Trevor Dann's** Music Entertainment department disappear. **Geoff Mullin's** position as Radio 2's head of music policy has been abolished, to be replaced by two less senior posts of executive producer, music and executive producer, live music. These posts will report to Radio 2's head of programmes **Lesley Douglas** (formerly managing editor, Radio 2), who in turn reports to Radio 2 controller **Jim Moir**. It was unclear at presstime whether Mullin, formerly head of music at the now-defunct London MOR station **Melody FM**, would be remaining with the BBC.

Italian music industry federation **FIMI** has named Milan-based online music company **Vitaminic** among its 105 member labels. Vitaminic becomes the first Internet company to join the IFPI-supported body; it is recognised in the independent label category. The decision was made during FIMI's steering committee meeting on July 11. General manager **Andrea Rosi** will represent Vitaminic at FIMI, but will not be on the association's board.

NRJ Group's multimedia affiliate **e-NRJ** has acquired a 50% stake in **Declics Multimédia**, a company specialising in interactive marketing and communication which was responsible for the creation of NRJ's web site **nrj.fr**. The move will allow NRJ to "boost its development in the multimedia world," according to the company.

EMI Europe has named **Colin Daniels** to the newly created position of senior director of A&R, effective August 1. In his London-based role, Daniels—formerly A&R director at **Mushroom Records** in Australia—will report to **Charlie Dimont**, president of EMI Europe. He will be responsible for developing an A&R strategy for EMI Europe, and is expected to help identify artists with potential for international success.

Beat 106/Glasgow programme controller **John Collins** has departed the central Scotland Alt.Rock and Dance station following its acquisition by the **Capital Radio** group (M&M, July 22). He is replaced by **Andrew Jeffries**, who moves north from Capital's Brighton-based CHR station **Southern FM**. **Bobby Hain**, Beat's managing director, is understood to be staying with the station.

And, talking of Capital Radio, that company's chief executive **David Mansfield** has been confirmed as a keynote speaker at the **NAB European Radio Conference 2000**, which will be held in Berlin on November 5-7. Also taking to the lectern will be **Norm Pattiz**, chairman of US radio syndication company **Westwood One**.

Finally, happy birthday to leading UK music executive **Rob Dickins**, founder of the new **Sony Music**-bankrolled label **Instant Karma** and chairman of UK's trade federation **BPI**, who was set to celebrate his half-century on July 22 with 250 invited guests at a London hotel.




