



BLANKET BAN

In 1979 Island also hit number one in Britain for the first time. The tune was *Video Killed The Radio Star*. It was by a duo called *Buggles*, one half of whom is currently figuring very heavily in the Island story.

Last year *Trevor Horn* - the former Buggie-formed his own label, called *Zang Tumb Tuum*. The label was signed to Island and the first ZTT record was a single called *Relax* by a new Liverpool band, *Frankie Goes To Hollywood*. By the end of January this year the record had reached number one in the UK charts. It had also started to hit the European charts with vengeance. *Relax* then gathered a certain notoriety, thanks to a blanket ban on BBC Radio One and Britain's top pop TV show, *Top Of The Pops*. Indeed, the single is still in the British chart, 42 weeks after release and 1.6 millions UK sales later.

The follow-up *Two Tribes*, was released the first week of June. It entered the British chart the following week - at number one. *Relax* then followed it up the chart until, by the end of June, *Frankie Goes To Hollywood* held the top two places. It was an achievement rivalled only by *Evis Presley*, *The Beatles* and *John Lennon*. *Two Tribes* has now sold over 1.3 million in Britain, confirming *Frankie Goes To Hollywood* as the hottest new band in years. While *Frankie* were dominating the singles chart, *Bob Marley* was a permanent fixture at number one in the albums listings. At the beginning of May, commemorating the third anniversary of *Marley's* death, Island released the *Legend* album. The following week the LP hit number one in the UK chart: a position it held for 12 consecutive weeks. It has now sold some 750,000 copies in Britain.

The company's roster now includes *Tom Waits*, *Aswad*, *Linton Kwesi Johnson*, *King Sunny Ade* and, via its associated labels, *The Waterboys*, *Phil Fearon & Galaxy*, *Propaganda*, *John Cale* and *The Breakfast Band*. Island has also signed *Animal Nightlife*, *White China*, *Pearl Harbor*, *In Tua Nua* and *Blue in Heaven*, new bands and artists for the Eighties.

The most important deal of the year, however, has been the re-signing of *U2*, a band that has been with Island since 1980. The new contract means that *U2* will be with Island until the end of the Eighties. Says *Chris Blackwell*: "I consider this a very important deal for Island; it shows an independent company can successfully compete against the majors. I'm delighted we are to continue our relationship with *U2*. The band, for me, is the essence of rock music and I know my opinion is shared by everyone at Island. We have one of the world's great rock bands."

At the end of 1983 Island bought 50 per cent of *Stiff Records*, another legendary independent label. *Dave Robinson*, founder of *Stiff*, became Island UK's Managing Director and the two companies now work in tandem from the same offices in Hammersmith. Island also has offices in London, New York, Paris, Los Angeles (headquarters of its publishing company) and Jamaica. There is also *Compass Point*, the recording studio in

Nassau. In four years it has become one of the world's best-known studios, the centre not only for Island's own productions but also for such stars as *The Rolling Stones*, *The Police*, *Eric Clapton*, *AC/DC* and *Talking Heads*. Most of all, however, Island remains an independent company jealous of its own roots and sense of style. "The sharpest company has to be *Island Records*, in their ability to preempt trends and broader tendencies while holding onto a core of long-term quality acts and, not least, in their generally unfailing good taste," says Britain's influential *Face* magazine. Check out the roster for confirmation.




Original Soundtrack Metropolis- CBS



Rubber Rodeo - Scenic Views- Mercury
 Their name seems to refer to the new wave in the country rock which is flourishing lately (Rank & File, Violent Femmes, Jason & The Scorchers etc.). Although the influences are certainly there, the end result is different. Especially through the voice of **Thrish Milleken** they do sound more like a revised version of the N.Y. band **The Shirts** (remember their '78 hit *Tell Me Your Plans?*). They have a special way of arranging songs which gives the album a very pure transparent atmosphere. Side 2 is strong with songs like *The Hardest Thing*, *Mess O' Me* and *House Of Pain*.



Romeo Void - Instincts- 415/CBS
 In the US this third album from San Francisco's **Romeo Void** is already big on college radio and it seems likely that they will go mainstream very soon. Though it seems initially quite a clean safe album with pop songs, behind the songs lies a threatening and very self-assured feel. **Deborah** sings involved but remains at a certain distance, **Benjamin Bossi** shines on sax and the rhythm section plays vibrant and sharp. An intriguing album with songs like *A Girl In Trouble* (hit single), *Instincts*, *Just Too Easy* and *Say No*.



Y & T - Meanstreak- A&M
 This time, **Y & T** goes for it and mind you, it leaves little doubt that they would not achieve it with their 3rd album. All instruments are taken to the top. The songs bare spontaneity and feelings, as a result of **Dave Minketti's** vocals and firework guitar stand aside by his companions. Needless to mention that once again **Chris Tsangarides** proved his ability to be one of the best producers. The tracks on this new album reveals **Y & T's** increased emphasis on vocal harmonies and fuller, more detailed orchestrations.

ABOUT THE CHARTS....
THE EUROPEAN TOP 100 (SINGLES/ALBUMS):
In many European countries one chart is recognised by the
music industry as the "OFFICIAL" hit parade and is therefore
used for the compilation of the EUROPEAN TOP100. However
there are other countries where various charts are in existence
and often equally important. For these countries we have
compiled a number of these charts into one representing the
sales in that market.
Each chart position for every country then receives, relevant to
that position, an equal points rating which is in turn multiplied
by a factor determined through the latest known sales
percentage of total singles (or album) sales which that country
holds in relation to the rest of Europe. There are different
percentages for singles and albums. These figures are kindly
provided on a regular basis by the industry organisations such
as IFPI-BPI-Gallup- Deutsche Phonoverband etc. A European
Chart-Committee, with experts from a number of these
industry organisations will overlook the calculation system and
will decide on improvements, changes and updates.
For the EUROPEAN TOP 100 SINGLES 25 charts are used
from 16 countries, for the EUROPEAN TOP 100 ALBUMS 20
charts are used from 15 countries. Since the sales
percentages of a few countries are too small to get their hits
into the EUROPEAN TOP 100 (provided these records are not
charted in any other territory), we are also printing a TOP 3 IN
EUROPE list each week.
The EUROPEAN AIRPLAY TOP 50 is compiled through all our
correspondents tips received this week. (Records of the week
receive extra points. The airplay lists of the airplay report
organisations within some of the European countries are also
used in the calculations, as well as playlists of major radio
stations. (Please note that not all received tips appear in
Eurotipsheet but they are all used for the calculation of the
Airplay Top 50.
THE EUROCLIPS LIST shows the music-videos most aired on
television throughout Europe in the week prior to publication. It
includes video-tv programs and other t.v. shows partly using
video's from 14 European countries.
For more detailed information on any of the chart-systems
please contact our chart department.

ISLAND RECORDS

The prestigious American magazine *Rolling Stone* once commented: "There are a lot of imitators but very few originals. In quality music Island is one of the two or three games in town." Such reputations are not easily won.

Island Records was founded in 1962, initially as a specialist label dealing with *Jamaican* music. Over the past 22 years, however, Island has played a significant role in transforming the face of Britain's music industry while, in the process, establishing an artists' roster the envy of most major companies. From *Jamaican* pop to global company: no other label can boast such an idiosyncratic history. Island today is one of the world's leading independents, with separate companies in London and New York. It also has, from the start of this year, a new company called *Island International*, headed by *Phil Cooper*.

It was formed in recognition of the international market's crucial importance: record companies can prosper only if they make an impact around the world.

Island International controls the destiny of Island's worldwide operations outside the UK and America. In the last nine months, Managing Director Cooper and his team have hit the world's charts with *Frankie Goes To Hollywood*, *U2*, *Phil Fearon & Galaxy*, *Mel Brooks*, *Charliefie Couture*, *Propaganda*, *Grace Jones* and *Bob Marley & The Wailers*. Much of the work on the road has been done by *Martin Satterthwaite* in a newly-created position as International Manager; his role is another example of Island's determination to compete in the world's markets.

SHARPEST DANCE RECORDS IN TOWN

The roots of Island Records are steeped in *Jamaican* music. *Chris Blackwell*, founder of the company, started in Jamaica during the late-fifties, cutting rhythm and blues tunes with local singers. Realising the limited potential of the *Jamaican* market, Blackwell transferred operations to Britain in 1962. He had noted the increasing sales of his records among the *West Indian* community and, accordingly, made deals with other small *Jamaican* labels to handle their records in Britain.

The company was, at the start, a one-man operation. Blackwell himself distributed the records to the shops. None of the tunes, of course, were pop hits although Blackwell's company quickly established a reputation for releasing the *sharpest* *Jamaican* dance records in town: it was at the time, remember, when Britain's *Mods* were arguably the most significant youth cult in the world.

On one of his trips back to Jamaica, in 1964, Blackwell found a young singer called *Millie Small*. He brought her back to England and produced *My Boy Lollipop* which, although it appeared on the *Fontana* label, was the first Island production to make the charts. A breakthrough had been achieved.

That same year Blackwell saw a young rock band in a Birmingham club. He was immediately impressed. "I just couldn't believe it. Couldn't believe it," he was later to tell *Rolling Stone*. "My roots had always been in black music and there was a kid sounding exactly like what I'd dug. There was *Steve Winwood*."

The band was the *Spencer Davies Group*. Blackwell, realising the limitations of Island Records at that stage in its development, put the band with *Fontana*. The *Spencer Davies Group* was in the vanguard of the British invasion, one of the bands that dominated the world's pop charts during the mid-Sixties. By 1967 Blackwell was ready to expand Island *BA* Records. The company had become a major force in a minor market - *Jamaican Ska Music* - but it was now ready to move into the challenging new rock business. It was the year when popular music's focal point changed from pop to rock, with musicianship and life-style becoming the paramount considerations. It was also the year *Steve Winwood* quit the *Spencer Davies Group* to form *Traffic*, one of Island's first rock groups.

Traffic, featuring *Jim Capaldi*, *Chris Wood*, *Dave Mason* and *Winwood*, was an immediate

success; the band's first two singles, *Paper Sun* and *Hole In My Shoe*, were both massive hits in Britain. That success opened the way for the next phase in Island's development. Island, more than any other independent company, changed the face of British rock music during the late-Sixties. The company was sympathetic to the new rock audience, gave vast opportunities to its bands and promoted the album virtually as life-style. The major companies suddenly found themselves outflanked by a skinny little label operating out of cramped offices in London's Oxford Street.

FRESH AND INNOVATIVE

Island, by common consensus, was now the best and most interesting indie company in Britain. It was fresh and innovative, a major contributor to a completely new sound and attitude, known at that time as *progressive* rock.

Frankie Goes To Hollywood



Crucial to that extraordinary growth was *Jethro Tull* - the first band with outside management to be signed by Island Records - and a production deal with *Joe Boyd*, who brought with him *Fairport Convention* and the beginnings of folk-rock. *Tull*, of course, were managed by *Chris Wright* and *Terri Ellis* who were later to form *Chrysalis Records* (which was distributed by Island until the mid-Seventies).

The roster grew, with such bands as *Spooky Tooth*, *Mott the Hoople*, *Quintessence*, *Free*, *Renaissance* and *King Crimson* all signed to Island Records by the end of the Sixties. *Mott the Hoople*, incidentally, were discovered and named by *Guy Stevens*, one of the greatest names in the British record business.

Blackwell linked up with *Guy* in the early-Sixties and, throughout that decade, he ran Island's *Sue* label - a pioneering outlet for hot R&B records in Britain.

By the end of the Sixties, Island had become a rock label. The company's *Jamaican* material - by now dominated by a new dance rhythm called reggae - appeared on a label called *Trojan*, a 50/50 company formed in partnership with *B&C Records*.

Island moved into the Seventies with super-confidence. The company's studio in London's *Notting Hill* quickly established itself as one of the world's prime recording centres while Island Records moved to new offices in *Hammersmith*, a few minutes' walking distance from the *River Thames*.

Free hit the British charts with *All Right Now* in the summer of 1970. It was a classic rock song which proved Island was alert to the possibilities offered by the pop charts: until *All Right Now* hit number two the company's reputation had been almost confined to the album chart. Exiting new signings, such as *Cat Stevens*, *Roxy Music* and *Sparks*, made immense contributions to Island's fortunes during the Seventies. For the first time Island was creating an international name for itself.

In 1972 Island signed *Bob Marley & The Wailers*, Jamaica's premier reggae group. Although a star in the Caribbean, Marley was almost completely unknown as an international artist. Blackwell, true to the innovative nature of Island, adopted a completely new strategy with Marley. Simply, it was decided to treat the band in much the same way as, say, a rock group. Such a move, at that time, was considered revolutionary. Jamaican music was considered virtually a *joke*, with little credibility outside the West Indian population. It was a music that sold only through singles and cheap price compilations. The first Wailers album, *Catch A Fire*, therefore broke all the rules. It was beautifully packaged and produced - and it sold at full price. By the end of the decade, of course, the Wailers were established as one of the world's most

important bands. And Bob Marley was, without doubt, a seminal figure in popular music. Following in Marley's slipstream came a whole roster of Jamaican acts, such as *Third World*, *Burning Spear*, *Inner Circle*, *Toots and The Maytals*, *Bunny Wailer*, *Sly Dunbar & Robbie Shakespeare* and *Black Uhuru*. By the end of the Seventies reggae had entered the mainstream. No longer was it a joke music best left to Jamaicans: it was a music that carried an extraordinary impact and influence (Bob Marley & the Wailers, remember, was the only international act invited to perform at

Zimbabwe's Independence Ceremony. Marley was the Third World's first superstar). The late-Seventies brought with it a changing artists' roster and fresh challenges. It signalled, for instance, the emergence of Steve Winwood as a solo artist, a new career that led to well over a million American sales for his *Arc Of A Diver* album in 1981. *Grace Jones*, *Mananne Faithful*, *U2* and *The B-52's* also came to the label, joining such artists as *Robert Palmer* whose associations with Island stretch back a decade. Robert hit most of the European charts in the early-Eighties with *Johnny & Mary*, a pop song of classic dimensions.


