Jagger's first solo single (apart from his Memo From Turner single years ago) is Europe's hottest record this week, closely followed by Commodores and David Bowie. While Don Henley is new in the Airplay Top 10, his partner in The Eagles Glenn Frey is picking up a lot of major tips in Europe this week with The Heat Is On from the MCA Soundtrack The Beverly Hills Cop. We expect that this soundtrack will score high in Europe as it contains other chart contenders like The Pointer Sisters (Neutron Dance), New Edition (Mr. Telephone Man), Junior (Do You Really) and Patti Labelle (New Attitude). Another soundtrack Paris, Texas (the Wim Wenders film) for which Ry Cooder wrote the music is receiving a lot of tips as well this week.

Suggs and Carl from Madness are the two people behind the act the Fink Brothers with the single Mutants In Mega-City One. It is a heavy weight electro dance track featuring Judge Dredd who is defending Mega-City-One from invading Mutants. All done very witty and a nice novelty track. Former teeny-bop star David Cassidy is back after so many years with a new single entitled The Last Kiss. And although the song builds up very slow, it grows on you after a few plays. New Chrysalis signing Go West (described by Arif Mardin as 'Modern Motown') have a track out called We Close Our Eyes, a good energetic dance track which could do very well in the clubs. Second Image is a group on MCA who have a song out

called Starting Again and it all sounds very Solar-like (Shalamar, Whispers, etc.). A lot of new danceable products we like: Cashmere's Can I, Dark City's False Alarm and Loose Ends' Hangin' On A String. All very sophisticated and also appropriate for club play. Eric Carmen, ex-Raspberries, is back with his fifth solo album being a delicate balance between uptempo and romantic popsongs, all carefully arranged and styled. Best cuts: I Wanna Hear It From Your Lips (single), I'm Through With Love and our favourite Come Back To My Love, which sounds very close to Michael McDonald.

### ALL OVER THE PLACE

As already mentioned in our last issue we absolutely love the Bangles' album All Over The Place. Although all of the compositions on the album sound somewhat primitive, these 4 girls from the US combine the influences of the Mama's & The Papa's, Tom Verlaine and the Mersey sound of the Sixties into quite an exciting sound. We recommend you to check out songs like James (on which Susanna has a voice very close to that of Sally Carr- of Middle Of The Road fame), Dover Beach, Going Down To Liverpool (very 6 T's) and More Than Meets The Eye (in which their raunchier side suddenly is replaced by a ballad, full with strings and a cappella vocal work). Products expected to enter the airplay chart soon, include Santana's Say It Again, Madonna's Material Girl, Peter Wolf's tribute to Motown Baby Please Don't Let Me Go, Little River Band who are now abbreviated to LRB (Is that a sound marketing decision we wonder?) with Playing To Win and Cyndi Lauper with the live version of Money

Changes Everything. Much is expected from the Swiss group Yello with their new album Stella. It's in this weeks fastest mover in the Top 100 Albums. Another Swiss artist, Andreas Vollenweider is enjoying lots of success lately in the US; he is the first CBS artist who is charted with two albums (Behind The Gardens/Caverna Magica) in 3 different categories (jazz, classical and pop).

### ERRATIC PATH

The success of the Euro-Crossover hit Fotonovela (tipped by us weeks and weeks ago) has followed a rather erratic path. Coming from Spain it first charted in the Benelux, then slowly hit France and is now entering high in Germany and therefore a big mover this week in the European Top 100 (from 39 to 15). While Sade is about to break in the US and is getting lots and lots of media coverage, it is nice to see her album at the top of the European Top 100. And from Sade's unique vocals it is not a big step to Joan Armatrading, her new album Secret Secrets is 2nd best new entry this week. And although for us she has lost a bit of her initial charm moving more and more into a broader (American) sound, we still love her best in tracks like One Night and Friends Not Lovers. One group that might break big outside of the UK the coming months is King. Although we are not too sure Europe will go for the trend of the painted boots (have you seen the video?), all signs are clear that his current UK hitsuccess Love And Pride (no 2) will spread around. The single was produced by Richard James Burgess who has worked in the past with acts like Adam Ant and Spandau Ballet.



**ABOUT THE CHARTS...**  
**THE EUROPEAN TOP 100 (SINGLES/ALBUMS):**  
 In many European countries one chart is recognised by the  
 music industry as the "OFFICIAL" hit parade and is therefore  
 used for the compilation of the EUROPEAN TOP100. However  
 there are other countries where various charts are in existence  
 and often equally important. For these countries we have  
 compiled a number of these charts into one representing the  
 sales in that market.  
 Each chart position for every country then receives, relevant to  
 that position, an equal points rating which is in turn multiplied  
 by a factor determined through the latest known sales  
 percentage of total singles (or album) sales which that country  
 holds in relation to the rest of Europe. There are different  
 percentages for singles and albums. These figures are kindly  
 provided on a regular basis by the industry-organisations such  
 as IFPI-BP-Gallup-Deutsche Phonoverband etc. For the  
 EUROPEAN TOP 100 SINGLES 25 charts are used from 16  
 countries, for the EUROPEAN TOP 100 ALBUMS 20 charts  
 are used from 15 countries. Since the sales percentages of a  
 few countries are too small to get their hits into the  
 EUROPEAN TOP 100 (provided these records are not charted  
 in any other territory), we are also printing a TOP 3 IN EUROPE  
 list each week.  
 The EUROPEAN AIRPLAY TOP 50 is compiled through all our  
 correspondents tips received this week.(\*)Records of the week  
 receive extra points. The airplay lists of the airplay report  
 organizations within some of the European countries are also  
 used in the calculations, as well as playlists of major radio  
 stations. (\*Please note that not all received tips appear in  
 Eurotipsheet but they are all used for the calculation of the  
 Airplay Top 50.  
 THE EUROCLIPS LIST shows the music-videos most aired on  
 television throughout Europe in the week prior to publication. It  
 includes video-t.v.programs and other t.v.shows partly using  
 video's from 14 European countries.




