Bryan Ferry shares a lot of intimate moments with us on his new album *Boys And Girls*. Directly the week after its release it is getting a lot of favourite reports. Joined by an impressive list of dignitaries like Mark Knopfler, Nile Rodgers and David Gilmour, the album contains classy and sensual rhythms, elegantly produced by Ferry and Rhett Davies. It's quite a hassle to point out real faves, as they're all equally strong. Cuts we especially liked include the reggae-ish *Valentine* and the smooth and funky *Sensation*.

For us Europeans it is quite hard to understand why Mr. Romantic himself, **Willie DeVille**, doesn't make the same impact in his home country (US), as in Europe. His first album for Polydor, *Sportin' Life* continues the line of his earlier works: an exciting mix of latin, blues and rock with that typical touch of his street-level based vocals. Most memorable tracks are *When You Walk My Way*, *There's No Living and In The*

Heart Of The City.



Check-out tunes like *Flip Ya Flip* and *Delivery Night*. **The Adventures** come up with their first solo album for Chrysalis entitled *Theodore & Friends*. Their first two singles, *Send My Heart* and *Another Silent Day* are included and other tracks demonstrating their fresh and vivid sound are *Feel The Raindrops* and *Lost In Hollywood*. Radio is still open for music from the Golden Era of the 6T's as proven earlier by the success that Van Morrison had some time ago. Therefore the new Bob Dylan album, *Empire Burlesque*, (Dylan's 27th album, we believe) will not have much trouble getting on the radio. And apart from that, it is a very commercial and consistent one too!





Directed by Arista's in-House creative manager DAVID SHORTT. It features Nick and friends having a fun-day at the beach, ending up with a Barbeque. Very light-hearted, also with that hint of romance. Just completed as well, the ADVENTURES clip to the single Feel The Raindrops. Nemesis is the title to the SHRIEKBACK new one, off their forthcoming Album. This has been directed by TONY VAN ENDE, and is a weird, decadent Fantasy. Featuring some amazing sets by AL MC DOWELL of Da Gama's creative team. Amongst an extraordinary cast of extras are a monkey, a goat and live eels. Apparently all was okay, until the monkey behaved a bit bad and bit poor BARRY ANDREWS, who is on leadvocals this time. 





Singles Guide

Nobody is too old to rock!.. Mr. B.B. King is almost 60 years of age, but still has not lost a bit of swing and vitality in the title track to the new John Landis movie *Into The Night*. His vocals are better than ever and his guitar (Lucille) sounds exactly the way it should: screaming and crying, definitely one of our favourites! The 3rd single from the successful *Agent Provocateur* album by **Foreigner** is just out on the market. *Reaction To Action* is a hot and steaming power cut, very commercial and chart bound. More rocky stuff comes from **Huey Lewis** (*Power Of Love*) and **Phil Collins** (*Don't Lose My Number*), the single on WEA for Continental Europe; Virgin comes out in July with *Take Me Home* for the UK only). While the Queen of sex-rap, **Millie Jackson**, joins up with **Elton John**, in their duet *Act Of War*, former Dollar singer, **Thereza Bazar** tries to make it on her own with the bright and catchy pop tune *The Big Kiss*, produced by the

legendary Arif Mardin. This single gets already great media reactions, especially in Germany.

ROMANTIC AND SULTRY

Strong Euro-crossover products continues to pour down on our desks. We were all charmed by the beautiful voice of the Italian singer **Fiorella Mannoia** with her romantic and sultry song *L'Aiuola* (Ariston). Highly recommended! Produced by Harold Faltermeyer (Beverly Hills Cop), the ex-Dynasty tv star **Al Corley** comes up with a new single *Cold Dresses*, commercial MOR disco with a driving beat. Swiss artist **Phil Carmen** has good chart positions at the moment in Germany, Austria and Switzerland with his single *On My Way In L.A.* (Metronome). We think he deserves more than that. The song is a very easy light-weighted R&B shuffle, that reminds a bit of the works of Dire Straits. Another potential crossover record is that by the Norwegian duo **Dollie De Luxe**. Regular watchers of Musicbox have undoubtedly seen their video *Queen Of The Night/Satisfaction*. Their mix of Mozart and the Stones classic is not

particularly our taste, but very commercial indeed.

AXEL F

After successes with *The Heat Is On* and *Neutron Dance* the **Beverly Hills Cop** Soundtrack yields its third successful single, the instrumental theme *Axel F* by the German **Harold Faltermeyer**. The single enters the European Top 100 Singles at no 16, making it (together with Frankie's *Welcome To The Pleasure Dome*) the highest entry a single made this year. Only one single ever came higher in its first week; **Bronski Beat**'s *Why* entered at no. 13 last year. Strong increase in sales for the singles of **Duran Duran** (2-5), the 2 singles by **Modern Talking** (You're My Heart 3-4; You Can Win 20-23), **Depeche Mode** (6-9), **Bryan Ferry** (19-29), **Billy Ocean** (25-34), **Rita Mitsouko** (31-40) and **Mai Tai** (35-63). The latter two belonged to our Euro Crossover tips during the last few weeks. The ubiquitous **Paul Hardcastle** hits the top of the European Airwaves this week (he just remixed some of **Ian Dury**'s old successes like *Hit Me*, *Reasons To Be Cheerful*, *Wake Up* etc.)

In our Spotlight we'll feature important radio or television personalities and their stations. One by one this will become a book of the top media people in Europe.



Juergen Juergens- SFB (self-portrait)

This weeks spotlight will be put on a man whose intention it always was to become a teacher, but eventually, at a very early age, came to work for the Berlin based station SFB. His name is Juergen Juergens and the regular readers of Eurotipsheet will certainly know his name, cause this versatile deejay/moderator was always one of the most loyal supporters of this magazine from the very beginnings.

Born in Berlin on the 22nd of September 1952, Juergens childhood isn't marked by any significant events. He was just a very quiet and good young man, never a problem to his parents. All this changed when he got his first record player. Very soon he became an absolute musicfreak, dealing with records and tapes, and even presenting a daily radio show - after school in his little room just as a hobby and only for himself.

Because his parents refused to buy a tv set, he concentrated on listening to the radio. The first show he was writing to was *Hey Music*, the international hitparade of Sender Freies Berlin (SFB). At the age of 17, he had an interview for his school magazine with a deejay of this show. After having made it, the producer asked him if he wasn't interested in radio programming and this was the beginning of a long career in radio. Juergen did his first official announcements in November '69. One year later he got the chance to take over the *Hey Music!* Hitparade, while simultaneously studying German literature and journalism. Since Juergen got a contract in 1973 as a producer at the SFB, he's responsible for about a dozen radio shows every week, mostly presented by himself (the most popular programs are a.o. *Soundcheck*, *Soeben Erschienen*, *Party-Music*, *Yesterday-Songs* and the *Hey Music!* Hitparade now for 15 years).

Is there any time left for other things, such as hobbies?

"The spare time I've got, I spend with my girlfriend, my cat and the rest is filled with drawing and painting (see the selfportrait above). Another hobby is super 8 filming which I picked up when I was about 16 years old. Apart from that, I am doing several jobs for the German tv; I am reporter for a daily local tv program called *Berliner Abend Schau* and I'm also producer/moderator of the *SFB Rocknights* in the Berlin Waldbuehne and lest I forget, I directed some video clips, a.o. for Heinz Rudolf Kunze, Ludwig Hirsch, Ian Andersson, etc."

Music is the connection to Juergen and everything he does, he does with conviction and enthusiasm.

Any regrets you have choosen for such a hectic life?

"No, each time I'm finding out that it is much better being a deejay than a teacher, because I get along much better with young people than teachers do. And music will keep you much longer in a young condition than anything else".

HOW CAN I BE SURE??

... INTO AN UNCERTAIN SUMMER 1985

Do you also feel so insecure? Do you share my feelings of uncertainty while presenting your program? Are you nervously trying to find the right choice for the next musical fashion? My life at the top of European radio presentation has never been more difficult than in 1985.

Long gone is the time that you could predict what will happen next. During my jet set trip last month to the most important media experts (are you still out there?), I found myself talking to many of you, my dear colleagues ... and there was one thing sure: *no-one feels secure anymore*. Okay, quite some of us have been yelled at as "old hippies!" and ... "go back to your psychedelic era". How the devil can they accuse us of such old fashioned things when you see that psychedelica is coming back in 1985? What to say about Prince who not only gives us a real psychedelic album sleeve but in fact already announced his attachment with The Superior Being on the B-side of Purple Rain; and the last track on the new album *Temptation* even contains a complete dialogue His Royal Purpleness is having with His Royal Highness! Talking about God and spiritual values, have you heard Steve Arrington's gospel-funk sounds in *Feel So Real*?

So don't tell me I am an old hippy and don't mind my long hair. Look at what long hair The Sisters Of Mercy are showing (and believe me they are in). They even take the unheard of decision to name themselves after a Leonard Cohen track! Cohen, I really thought that was out! Leonard Cohen, back to the days of joints and incense, love and peace and good old poetry? Is nothing sacred anymore?

You can't be sure of anything. Would you have had the nerve to pronounce that classical music would reign top of the charts in 1985. Look at what the BBC Welsh Choir is doing with their *Voices From The Holy Land* (reli again) and Leonard Bernstein's *Westside Story*. Even Austrian rapper Falco tributes the classical masters with his *Rock Me Amadeus* (or is it his way to cash in on the Mozart craze?).

You've got to change your approach in life. The normal values don't count anymore. Gone is the time when you could impress that beautiful girl at a party by saying: "Hey babe, come back to my flat, I've got this great record collection and I'll play you some wonderful music!" Chances are too big she'll open her handbag and show you her collection of CD's (and don't you try to drink her under the table either 'cause alcohol is really out these days).

And no-one could have told you in early 1984 that jazz could again increase its influence on today's popmusic. Ever since the beautiful tribute to Sonny Rollins by Joe Jackson, jazz music has impressed the pop/rock creators and with the present successes of Sade, Working Week, Everything But The Girl and even Style Council's Paul Weller on his album *Cafe Bleu*, cool jazz is in (and that's a real pleasure).

And what to say about the time when famous films delivered successful soundtracks? You see, I told you the world turns upside down. These days film themes often become major hits long before the movie even comes to town and record labels are no longer holding their releases until the film is distributed. Look at *The Dune* (with Sting) or *Stop Makin' Sense* or *1010*. They now even go as far as attracting film audiences through the enormous success of the single without even playing them in full length in the movie! That's exactly what happened with *Against All Odds* (although Phil Collins had a much bigger success with it than the film company), *The Woman In Red* where Stevie's *Call To Say I Love You* was equally successful as the funny film. And even more so with the new release *Falcon And The Snowman*, where they even have the nerve not to play Bowie's version until the film is over.

How can you be sure in a time when major record companies merge with others or are even rumoured to be bought by smaller ones (Motown buys Warner? RCA with Ariola; Polygram with ?) and don't you dare to think you are safe at your radio station! If US media entrepreneur Ted Turner tries to buy the CBS conglomerate than nothing can be sacred anymore?? Maybe you are looking for a new radio job? Don't just think of the normal territories! Who knows you might end up in Red China, where RTL starts to program and Wham! gives concerts. Who on earth would have predicted that in '83.

So you wanna be a good boy? And support the ailing record industry? These days it is not enough just to play the new releases. You've got to promote the new compact disc medium, really you should even fly Virgin Airways.

So don't you dare to ask me to be sure of myself. Or to tell you what will be in fashion tomorrow. Or to predict the state of the music industry next year.

You've got to stay on the ball. You will have to continue to listen to each and every sample and every new type of music. Don't let yourself be caught into one corner. Keep your mind and your mike open at all times. Don't try to be sure all the time. *Experient!* Here's only one thing for sure: Eurotipsheet will be back next week!


