# spotlight on



## THE VERSATILE VISSER

There aren't many dj's and radio personalities in Europe who can boast such a broad array of interests as Ad Visser, together with Jan Steeman (program director) our correspondent for the Dutch radio and TV channel AVRO.

The impassionate lyrics of John Miles, 'Music Was My First Love And It Will Be My Last', partially hold for Visser as music is only one of his passions. Visser was born in 1947 in Amsterdam and at an early age his fascination for music, literature and film started to develop. After finishing highschool, he is uncertain about his future studies and spends some time at Dutch record company Barclay. It is in this same period that he starts to work for the AVRO, where he contributes to a cultural youth magazine with interviews and short items.

His ability to recognize talent has not remained unnoticed as Phonogram Holland asks him in 1966 for the job of product manager, a quite unique request considering his age. Visser is mainly concerned with the selection and marketing of national and international repertoire and sees a chance to learn the business-like aspects of the music field. At the same time he remains involved with the AVRO where he makes the legendary program "Superclean Dreammachine", a program completely in the spirit of the late Sixties, where his 'arty' presentation combined with a remarkable musical choice attracts many listeners. His popularity only increases after being selected to do the presentation of the weekly AVRO TV program 'Toppop'; it is the first weekly pop program in Holland and develops into the most watched and best judged youth (and family!) program. In the years to come Visser will be chosen no less than 9 times by the Dutch audiences as most popular TV presenter of the year. Although Visser decides to leave Phonogram to concentrate fully on his radio and TV career, he suddenly realises the most appropriate study for him to choose: marketing and its applications on mass-communication. In the period after finishing his studies for marketing manager, his versatility is most striking; he starts his own production company, his own drive-in show and makes radio- and TV commercials.

In 1980 Visser again is in the centre of the attention by starting an electronic 'Space Opera' entitled *Sobrietas*, a multi-media project containing a science-fiction novel, an album (charted in Holland and Italy- where Visser appears in no less than 10 TV shows) and a theatre version. Apart from all this Visser even finds time to investigate the possibilities of using the computer in new forms of entertainment to create, as he calls it, 'Computer Theatre'.

Experiments with new forms of entertainment for Radio and TV are Visser's main interest at the moment and Ad is looking for cooperation with colleagues in other countries sharing the same interests. ## CULT STATUS

Following the success of the single *In Between Days*, **The Cure's** new album *The Head On The Door* (Fiction/Polydor) is this week's highest entry at 24. Looking at the good sales this album gets in the UK, Germany and Holland it is clear that The Cure has grown out of its cult-status and could follow the same path like U2 and Simple Minds.

The English formation Theatre Of Hate used to be an indie-topper as well. Fronted by vocalist Kirk Brandon the band's name was changed into **Spear Of Destiny** in 1982 and the band's 3rd album *World Service* (Epic) is this week's second best entry at 51 and so far charted in the UK and Holland. Brandon's powerful and deliberately indifferent vocals give an exciting dimension to all the songs (best tracks: *Come Back* and *Mickey*).

And yet another English band as new entry, Squeeze is 3rd best entry at 82 with their excellent pop album *Cosi Fan*


*Tutti Frutti* (A&M). Sofar charted in the UK only, but chartpositions expected in the Benelux next week.





### CENSOR THE CLIPS?

With the Video programming idea now well established, it is not surprising that this phenomena comes under criticism from various sides. During the first part of 1985 it was the Pay For Play issue that attracted the industry media, but the second part of this year is likely to be the Censor The Clips perio. Especially in the USA, but also starting around the European continent, TV producers come under increasing pressure to select videos more carefully as many clips are deemed to be "harmful" to the young audiences generally watching the clip-parades. In Germany even the politicians are screaming about the 'Video Corruption' of young people and are urging the official responsible to check feature films on video to also take action and ban clips with an overdose of violence and/or sex. This could effect popular weekly videoshows such as Formel Eins. In the U.K. the BBC has always been prudent in its programming decisions and various clips have been banned from showing on the popshows like Top Of The Pops. In The USA the issue is becoming the most talked about topic on all the Video Industry Conferences and is attracting wide-spread attention. There is even a major problem for clips showing romantic situations between black and white people. This incidently was one of the major discussions during the Rockamerica Video Seminar recently held in New York. One of the victims of lyrical boycott was Dire Straits Money For Nothing which contained the word 'faggot'. There are different views from the various record labels how this should be handled. Many believe it to be bad policy to interfere too much as they see video production as an 'artform', but with production budget at a present record height the labels have to think twice, if they want their expensive clips to be broadcast. They also make a number of clips available in two versions, one conservative enough not to risk being banned. The whole issue is particularly damaging to the harder rock artists who often have quite a bit of sex showing in their videos. These acts (especially the Heavy Metal ones) depend strongly on their 'hard' image and bands like Helix and Lee Aaron are amongst many others victims.

The outcry over 'video sexism' is often hypocrite with boycotts to clips from David Lee Roth (California Girls) as well as Moonmoon Suite's Wave Babies. We are just waiting for the first country to ban Madonna's 'sexist' videos from the screens. Or are videos becoming more conservative (and unfortunately more alike or dull)? Whatdaya want? Dee "Twisted Sister" Snider, sittin' on the sofa while visiting his poor old lovely granny while being properly and suitable dressed, behaving absolutely charming? In any case the record companies should be careful in future and be aware of these problems, mainly for the dose of 'Violence and Sex'. We urge our European TV friends to let us know their feelings on this issue and explain their decision policy in this increasingly important matter. WRITE US!! No doubt this will also be a source for discussions on the seventh annual Billboard Video Conference slated for November 21-24 in Los Angeles. Attendees will have a wide spectrum of issues to talk about and get a worldpremiere to a long-form Julian Lennon release from MCA Home Video.

Another major video event coming soon is MTV's 2nd annual VIDEO MUSIC AWARDS on September 13. Amidst the sale of MTV to a major investment group (it's no longer a Warner company) this event will feature a great number of top stars such as Bryan Adams, Tina Turner, Grace Jones, Sting, Tears For Fears and the Eurythmics and is presented by host Eddie Murphy. Many famous clips are nominated, but with an almost non-presence for Euro artists. And that, while back here in Europe, more and more space is given to clips of the increasingly popular European Crossover acts such as Baltimora, Opus, Rita Mitsouko, Yello, Star Sisters, Curtie And The Boombbox all showing on heavy rotation lists from SKY TRAX and MUSIC BOX.

### NEW CLIPS

Many new clips are arriving backing the major fall releases of the labels. King's Alone Without You is a rather sad song in a way, but the clip was shot during their holidays in Greece and has that typical summer holiday feeling. The new Bryan Adams clip has already been shown on the box, for his (yet another) hit Summer Of 69, starting off in black and white with back flashes and turns into today perfectly fitting with the lyrics. Good Video! Billy Idol's White Wedding still is one of our faves.. have you shown it yet? When deciding your selection this week, don't overlook new clips by Bryan Ferry (Don't Stop The Dance), Meatloaf (Surf's Up), Lee Aaron (Barely Holdin' On), the 2 charming ten-tonners The Weather Girls (Weel-A-Wiggy) an uptempo light hearted lovesong and Jimmy Cliff with his new single Hot Shot. Furthermore there are Sting (Love Is The 7th Wave) and Princess (Say I'm Your Number 1). Finally the clip Brave The Storm by new band Shy directed by Marcello Anciano.







## Singles Guide

So many new lovely records we hardly know where to begin! Ultravox frontman **Midge Ure** surprises us with a solo single entitled *If I Was* on Chrysalis. One of Frits Spits' (NOS) personal faves and indeed a good one. Not very different from the usual Ultravox releases though very catchy and bound for popformats. While **Marillion's** *Kayleigh* still gets heavy radiobacking in some European countries the heirs to the throne of Genesis come up with a new one, the beautiful *Lavender*. The Glaswegians **Lloyd Cole & The Commotions** had one of the most interesting debut albums of last year. Their new single *Brand New Friend* (Polydor) tries for a more commercial vein compared to their earlier material; while their unmistakable own sound has remained, the chorus gets extra female vocal backing making it more commercial and attractive. Speaking about commerciality, **John Cale** will probably

never make the charts although his latest Beggars Banquet single *Dying On The Vine* certainly deserves to do so; his profound vocals against the sober but effective backing make this our favourite indie-record this week. For the Southern European countries the summer season has not yet ended and we are anxiously awaiting their new product. Meanwhile the successful German formation **Modern Talking** came up with a new single entitled *Cheri Cheri*, possibly their next Eurohit.

### DUET STRAIGHT IN

Although the two Dutch hard rock bands **Vandenberg** and **Highway Chile** are in fact Europroductions, both bands are signed to an American label (Atco) and are therefore regarded by us as international releases. Vandenberg's *Once In A Lifetime* is a beautiful slow song with a rough edge just like Highway Chile's *Christine*. For those of you in favour of bands like Foreigner, you will surely like these two as well. No doubt this was going to happen, the **Bowie & Jagger** duet is this weeks best played single in Europe and following the

no. 1 in England (straight in!) and high positions in all the major European markets it jumps directly to 9 in the European Top 100 Singles. This makes it the highest entry a single ever made in the Top 100, following the entries earlier this year of Collins' *One More Night* (12) and Faltermeyer's *Axel F* together with Frankie's *Pleasure Dome* (both new at 16).

### POWER OF THE FUTURE

Anticipating Steven Spielberg's movie *Back To The Future* **Huey Lewis'** *Power Of Love* jumps from 9 to 5 in the Airplay Top 50. Due to continued play in France **Sting** re-enters the Top 10 with *If You Love Somebody* and **Two Of Us** moves up again due to sudden airplay in the Benelux. The highest new entry and a definite favourite for nearly all European stations, is **Stevie Wonder's** swinging and jazzy *Part-Time Lover*. **Madness'** latest single *Yesterday's Men* is second best entry (at 32). Other new entries in the Airplay Top 50 for **Dan Hartman** (the re-released *I Can Dream About You*), **Bananarama** (*Do Not Disturb*) and the new **Cliff Richard** (*She's So Beautiful*).

# - Highlights -

## UNITED KINGDOM

Bowie & Jagger are shooting up all over of Europe with their interpretation of the Martha Reeves & The Vendellas' hit. *Dancing In The Street* is currently England's best played single (and also no. 1 in Europe) and are following Frankie's Two Tribes by coming in straight at no. 1. Other chart entries for Stevie Wonder (20), Marillion (23; *Lavender*) and Blancmange (51; *What's Your Problem*). The second time around hit for Dan Hartman's *I Can Dream About You* is the hottest addition to the English Airplay charts this week; last week in the lower regions, this week already up to no. 5. As expected Stevie Wonder's long awaited single *Part-Time Lover* is climbing up the English airwaves as does Huey Lewis, Bananarama and Princess. New in the lower regions of the airplay is the Lloyd Cole single *Brand New Friend*, a fave for many UK correspondents.

## GERMANY

While Tina had best played single in Germany for many weeks, she is suddenly dethroned by Kool & The Gang with their ballad *Cherish*. More fast movers in the Airplay charts: UB 40, Jagger & Bowie and The Cars. Bubbling under the Top 20 are German singer Cosa Rosa with *Millionenmal* (see issue 34 for album review), Thompson Twins and Pointer Sisters. Strong contenders for airplay entries next week: Sting (*Love*), Mary Roos (*Keine Traene Tut Mir Leid*), Madness and the Italian formation Toto Cotugno. The German Top 10 remains unchanged, apart from some small changes; Eurythmics up to 4 (from 6) and Lee Marrow's *Shanghai* (*Discomagic*) moving to 8 (from 12). Further notable changes include Martinelli's *Cenerentola* ('Cinderella') on EMI (12-25) and Leinemann's version of *Toot Toot* (17-29). International productions doing well include Kate Bush (22-63), Bowie & Jagger (29-66), Jaki Graham (*Round And Around* new at 37; in the UK the re-released *Heaven Knows* is having considerable succes) and finally... Chris Rea's *Josephine* new at 40.

## FRANCE

The French stations can't get enough of Jean-Jacques Goldman, both AM and FM have *Je Marche Seul* as their favourite record for airplay. Some increase in airplay for French rockband

Indochine (*Canary Bay*) and the new Jean-Jacques Lavont single (*Le Giant De Papier*). The AM stations are rather quick in adding the Bowie & Jagger duet, normally it takes at least one-and-a-half month before a new international product even gets a chance to enter the AM playlists. New French products added to the AM lists are Julien Clerc's single *Bamboo Bar* and the new Michel Sardou, entitled *Rouge*. On FM level the hottest additions are Madonna's *Groove* followed by, believe it or not, Tears For Fears' *Everybody Wants To Rule The World*; while the success of the third single of the Big Chair album, *Head Over Heels* has just faded out, France is suddenly catching up on this one. Other new additions to the playlist are Modern Talking's *You Can Win* and Tina's *Hero*. While *Life Is Live* continues to be best sold single in France, *Plus Pres Des Etoiles* from Gold is a serious competitor. Also moving steady to the top is Goldman's *Je Marche Seul* (still a good candidate to chart outside of France!). Popstar Jean-Pierre Mader (WEA) shows strong sales increase this week with his single *Un Pied Devant L'Autre*. Further sales moves for Ivan, Hardcastle, Italian artist Eros Ramazzotti with his 'Important Story' and Jeanne Mas with her follow up to *Toute Premiere Fois*, *Coeur En Stereo*.

## ITALY

The Top 10 of Italy contains 4 records not appearing in the European Top 100 Singles; these are Dead Or Alive (*Spin*), Belouis Some (*Imagination*), Michael Cretu (*Samurai*) and local artist Den Harrow with *Future Brain* (one of our Crossover tips some weeks ago). The rest are international productions with the most popular one for Duran Duran followed by Hardcastle and Simple Minds.

## HOLLAND

The excellent Ben Liebrand mix of Tavares *Heave Must Be Missing An Angel* is the biggest mover in the Dutch charts (16-27; on EMI). EMI also does well with the Bowie & Jagger duet (13-20) and the Belgian production *What's Your Name* by Zinno (a hip hop Bond tribute). Local comedian Andre van Duin puts his single *Een Boutje* ('a bolt') up to no. 20 (from 38; on CNR). Other movers for Dutch farmers band Normaal (the Dutch answer to ZZ T'), Sting (*Love*

and Rick James (*Glow*).

Sting pushes Springsteen back to no. 2 and the *Turtle* album is now best sold in Holland. Also strong sales for Eurythmics, Madonna, Chris Rea and local artist Benny Neyman (*Het Zwarte Goud*). The Cure album *The Head On The Door* is new at 30 and Dio, Saga and Neil Young's latest album for Geffen *Old Ways* are the 3 best moving albums.

Dutch hard rockband Vandenberg have a new album out entitled *Alibi* (Atco) and this one will undoubtedly get a strong push on Dutch radios in the coming weeks.

## SWITZERLAND

The *Toot Toot* battle is won by Denise LaSalle, her version shoots up to no. 6 (from 16) this week while the original version by Rockin' Sidney drops 3 places (12-9). Also new in the Top 5 and a bubbler last week is Sandra's Euro-crossover hit *Maria Magdalena*, a new entry at no. 5. Other entries for yet another of our crossover tips, Righeira, their *L'Estate Sta Finendo* (Strum Italy) is new at 23 and Europroduct continues with Mai Tai's *History* new at 27. While Tina, Madonna and Bad Boys Blue still take the first 3 positions, Michael Cretu, Laura Branigan, Two Of Us, Bowie & Jagger and Thompson Twins are dying to come in and have good chances to do so. Albumwise Bruce still tops the chart followed by Straits and Saga (the latter making a gigantic move from 23 to 3). New album entries for OST's Mad Max and A View To A Kill.

## SPAIN

Europroduct dominates the Top 3 of Spain with Opus at 1 followed by Baltimora and Modern Talking (*You Can Win*). Other popular singles include Duran, Ivan, USA For Africa, Paul Hardcastle, Ashford & Simpson (*Solich*), Gary Low (*How Much*) and Freddy Mercury (*Born To Love You*). Dire Straits have two singles charted in the Spanish Superventas chart, *Walk Of Life* at 13 and *So Far Away* at 15. The same applies for Madonna, *Angel* (16) and *Material Girl* (23). Albumwise Straits are no. 1 with two local artists on their heels, Julio Iglesias (Spanish language album-Libra) at 2 and Luis Cobos (*Mas Zarzuela*) at 3. The USA charity album still sells vast amounts as does Sting, Radio Futura and Spandau Ballet.



**Highway Chile - Rockarama** - 21 Records/Atco  
 This is their 2nd fulllength album, starting off with the powerful titletrack. A wide range of powerrock songs (produced by Shell Schellekens), very suitable for airplay. *Christine*, the current single, has got a great hookline. All tracks are well played, sung & arranged. That band's got a lot going for them. All they need from the outside is back-up. Faves: *You Took My Heart, On The Rocks, California On Fire* and *Broken Promises*.



**Double - Blue** - Metronome  
 Our best bet for Euro-crossover at the moment. With their single *The Captain Of Her Heart* this Swiss based band have good chances to attack Europe. Their music is a pleasant mix of soft intelligent pop and easy-listening, much in the same vein of Michael Franks and Ben Sidran (who remembers him?). Eight moody and jazzy tracks of which *Captain, Woman Of The World* and *Rangoon Moon* are stand-out tracks.



**Sheila E. - Romance 1600** - Paisley Park/Warner  
 From *The Glamorous Life* to *Romance 1600*, Sheila Escovedo stars as Sister Fate on this percussion based second album, yet another sign of life from the Paisley Park. Mr. Paisley himself appears as one of the guitarplayers in the rhythmic patterns of *A Love Bizarre* (it Gets Kinda Rough In The Back Of Our Limousine) and our favourite *Toy Box*.
