EMR & BILLBOARD JOINT VENTURE !

Billboard publications and EMR are announcing a joint venture under the name **European Music Report**. Under this new structure Eurotipsheet will develop into a Pan-European weekly music trade, adding more editorial newspapers to its existing format.

EMR will also expand into other areas in the music media field, including the syndication of radio and television programs. Theo Roos, founder and publisher of Eurotipsheet will be president of EMR and will also become publisher of Billboard in Europe.

The new joint venture was announced at the **New Music Seminar** in New York this week by Billboard publisher and editor-in-chief **Sam Holdsworth** and Theo Roos.

Billboard is the world's leading and international newsweekly of music and home entertainment. Eurotipsheet was launched 15 months ago as a Pan-European weekly, basically aimed at the European radio and television programmers. It also compiles and publishes the European Top 100 charts as well as the European Airplay Top 50. These charts are used by a number of important European radio and television stations.

AMSTERDAM & LONDEN

The joint venture will be based at Eurotipsheet's new offices in the centre of Amsterdam. Billboard Europe and EMR will also share new office space in London. Eurotipsheet will continue to spotlight the playlists of the 300 most important radio stations as well as the various charts and will follow the development of the European talent with cross-over potential on a weekly basis. *More editorial pages*

will be added with industry news of the major countries in Europe. Reportings from the key program directors in Europe will be increased and speeded up, giving record labels and music publishers and radio & tv producers a complete and advanced Pan-European picture on the progress of national and international pop/rock product.

PROGRAMSYNDICATION IN EUROPE ON ITS WAY!

From the various phonecalls and letters we receive it becomes clear that more and more European programdirectors are interested in the syndication possibilities both on the buying as well as the selling side. There are a great number of Eurostations producing very interesting programs for both pop and rock music and they are just preparing these shows for their own (often local) market. They are only just starting to discover the potential of selling these shows in other countries. When you have a good show, especially when it is a regular one, why not translate it for other markets? You only need to make sample cassettes to test the interest from other European countries and/or even the United States.

Especially in the U.K. there are already a number of stations quite active in this field (Capital Radio!) but in the most other countries this is still just a very small issue. This is partly due to the fact that most stations with enough money to produce quality programming are government-owned and do not often have the commercial departments aggressive enough to sell their programming. You can use Eurotipsheet to present these shows to your colleagues. Please inform us about them.

ROUNDS RADIO EXPRESS

Tom Rounds has left behind his position as President and CEO of ABC Watermark, the syndicated radio production and distribution company he co-founded in 1970, to create Radio Express, a new company which will be the exclusive international distributor of all ABC Watermark product.

While he continues to serve as Executive Producer of his phenomenally successful "American Top 40 with Casey Kasem," as well as "American Country Countdown with Bob Kingsley," the move marks a career triumph for Rounds - who takes a big step closer to realizing a dream.

"Radio is slowly reaching people in parts of the world that were previously considered to be inaccessible to American-style radio," notes the pioneer whose programs already reach an estimated 40 million listeners in the USA alone. "The potential worldwide communication that can result from the exchange of popular culture and popular music is profound. With Radio Express, we'll make it as easy as possible for broadcasters around the world to get this information."

With a diverse catalogue that also includes "The King Biscuit Flower Hour," "Silver Eagle," "Supergroups In Concert," "GoldPicks," "Spotlight Specials," "Musical!" and "Ringo's Yellow Submarine," Radio Express has already begun distribution in over 40 countries spread over five continents, including such markets as Japan, France, Germany, Mexico, Peru, Costa Rica, Australia, New Zealand, Malaysia and Thailand and to countless listeners via the Armed Forces Radio Network.

Rounds is particularly excited about the not-too-distant possibility that Radio Express product will be on the air in The People's Republic of China, India, Burma, Pakistan and throughout the Middle East and South America - areas that have

heretofore been virtually isolated from commercial radio programming.

Also playing an important part in the Radio Express game plan will be the importation of top quality foreign music programming. While the ABC Watermark library available for export is quite extensive, Rounds is actively seeking other syndicated program acquisitions and new production opportunities.


AVAILABLE PROGRAMS

There are some good new shows from the U.S. The radio networks Westwood One still have The Isle of Dreams Festival available, a 12-hour concert extravaganza with 24 of the top recording artists, Huey Lewis, Foreigner, Bryan Adams, Elton John, The Cars, David Bowie and many more. And there are new programs as well! Concerts from Midnight Oil, China Crisis, Dan Hartman, Luther Vandross and coming soon- Paul Young, Don Henley, Tom Petty, Roger Waters, Cock Robin and Joe Walsh. Westwood also has some exceptional interviews ready to air in Europe: Dire Straits, Billy Joel, Ray Parker, Phil Collins, Huey Lewis, The Firm and Jeff Beck.

NSBA presents Huey Lewis, an one hour show. Barnett & Robbins have a Superstars Of Rock special on Sting, which aired on September 20th. They also present a Bob Dylan superstar portrait as well as a Doors rock reunion. For the Metal lovers MJI has a Scorpions special. Most major companies attended the NAB/NRBA programming conference. And the major syndication companies like NBC, ABC and Westwood presented their new shows. An extensive interview with Eric Clapton is the base of a "best of everything" focus on Clapton's 20 year career and is presented by NBC.

MEDIA NEWS

The ARD channel in Germany will have from January '86 on a new structure of their nighttime programming; pop and AOR will be programmed all night, classical music will get its share at 3am and an experimental rock program will run from 12 till 2 am ... some changes at BR (Bayerischen Rundfunk) in Munchen; Fritz Egner's popular program "Fritz And Hits" will continue, though under another name: "Hithouse" and the "Rockit" program from Juergen Hermann is cancelled as of the 1st of October (although Hermann will go on with his nightshow "Song Books"). And the big news on BR is that popular moderator Thomas Gottschalk



will be back on the air! ...

Riveira 104 is a new station based in Ventimiglia, Italy, close to San Remo. Although the station is based in Italy it mainly airs its programs on the French Cote d'Azur. Our former correspondent for BFBS, Richard Astbury, is general manager at 104 (his successor at BFBS is Patrick Eade) and Paul James is the musical director ... congratulations go out to the British and American military broadcasters AFN and the afore mentioned BFBS who celebrated their 40th year of broadcasting ... welcome to the new regional UK stations, Devon Air in Exeter and Swansea Sound in Wales ... a fairly new station corresponding to Eurotipsheet is Radio Gong in Munchen who since May have a transmitter to air a full day program ... Apologies to Thomas Conrad of Radio C, last weeks issue stated Willy Zwingman as 'musikredacteur' of Radio C. Willy Zwingman belongs to Radio M1 and Conrad obviously to Radio C ...

And a couple of FM stations in France are new reporters to Eurotipsheet as well: La Voix Du Lezard (Paris), RMP (Aix-en-Provence), Radio Angora (Bordeaux), Radio Arc-en-Ciel (Lille) and Radio Scoop (Lyon). From Switzerland comes the new station KTFM in Gex with former RSI dj Jean Luc Zwickert as our new correspondent ...



Now they've released their latest one and with their video for *Tonight It's You* added on several music channels in Europe they could easily strike again. The music of C.T. hasn't changed much over the past years and is guaranteed for a portion of solid rock (*Little Sister, She's Got Motion*) and an occasional ballad (*Love Comes*).

Best tracks include *Something To Fall Back On, Blue Orpheus* and *Johneee Jinga*.

An excellent and exciting live- performance which only confirms Hall & Oates' status as contemporary soul-influenced artists.


Looking at all the new albums entering the Album Top 100 this week, it is

Singles Guide



With the amount of disco/dance records making it to the charts, this weeks Singles Guide will be reserved for new and exciting dancerecords, all worth checking and suitable for your soul radioshow.

The successes of e.g. Five Star, Princess, Lisa Lisa & Cult Jam, Coolnotes and Mai Tai clearly show a new trend tending towards pop-polished disco products in favour of the more funky and rough disco approach of a few years back. The most recent proof of those successful polished soul products is Princess with *Say I'm Your No. 1* (Supreme 105 bpm) and after conquering the UK, it is now a smash in Holland and Germany and a lot other territories are going to follow.

The swinging tropic surprise from Holland, Mai Tai have seen a fast upward movement in their career after the success in the UK with *History* and *Body & Soul*. *Body & Soul (Injection 113 bpm)* is at the moment 40 in the European Top

100 singles and charted in the UK and Ireland.

While on the subject of history, the nowadays fashion is a renewed interest for old records enwrapped in a modern '85 sounding dance-remix. With the obvious example of Paul Hardcastle as the leading innovator, the excellent '85 remix of Ben Liebrand of Tavares' *Heaven Must Be Missing An Angel* (EMI 119 bpm) should be a hot item for you to check out. Be sure not to miss it!

ADDITIONAL IMPACT

Another powerful re-release is Class Actions's *Weekend* on Jive. And yet other re-releases already a success in the UK include Dan Hartman's *I Can Dream About You*, the double A-sided single of Amii Stewart *Knock On Wood/Light My Fire*, Jaki Graham with *Heaven Knows*, Maria Vidal's *Body Rock* and D-Train's *You're The One For Me*. All those records have, apart from their proven quality on the dancefloor, additional impact on the radio due to their commercial and smooth pop/disco sounds.

Magazine 60 come from Spain where Hi-NRG is the current trend. They

have made a fresh interpretation of the traditional 'Don Quichotte' theme. *Don Quichotte* (Polydor 122 bpm) is already charted in Spain and France and indeed a good production with undoubtedly good chances for the rest of Europe (starting with the Benelux countries).

IMPORT CHANNELS

Talking about Benelux, the Benelux countries are always very keen in picking up hot disco records from the US and the UK through import channels. Both Lisa Lisa & Cult Jam's *I Wonder If I Take You Home* (CBS 118 bpm), Colonel Abrams' *Trapped* (MCA 116 bpm) and Rene & Angela's *I'll Be Good* (Mercury 118 bpm) were already hot import items before the companies officially gave the sign to re-release.

Some more releases this month that deserve your attention are the Shannon '84 sound-a-like *Stop Playing On Me* done by Vikki Love (4th & Broadway/Island 118 bpm) and the new Mercy Mercy- *What Are We Gonna Do About It*, one that makes you definitely longing for the summer holidays again (Ensign 106 bpm).

The English Top 3 remains the same with **Bowie & Jagger** on top followed by **Bonnie Tyler** and **Stevie Wonder**. Not everybody is so keen on **Midge Ure's** *If I Was*, but in the UK the single is already up to no. 4 (from 8). Following right after is **Madonna's** *Angel* (from 10) and the other Sire act **Red Box** is new in the Top 10 at position no. 6 (from 18). Other movers for **Billy Idol** (*Rebel Yell*; 13- 25), **Colonel Abrams** (*Trapped*; 16-28) and the German production *Power Of Love* by **Jennifer Rush** jumping from 36 to 15, making it together with **Battimora** and **Mai Tai** the 3rd Euro-production in the English Top 50. But the Norwegian band **A-Ha** is on it's way to become the 4th! Their *Take On Me* is new at 55 this week.

Other entries for **Style Council** (*The Lodgers*, smooth and soft swinging sounds with vocal assistance of D.C. Lee, new at 17), **Depeche Mode** (*It's Called A Heart*, new at 21) and **The Alarm** at 48 with *Strength*.

GERMANY

After **Tarzan Boy** it looks like **Maria Magdalena** by the 22 year old German singer **Sandra** will be the next big European cross-over hit; it has this typical Euro-feel which helped **Laura Branigan's** *Self-Control* to chart that easily in Europe last year. The single is currently Germany's best played single.

Two other German productions are major additions on nearly all the German stations; **Modern Talking's** *Cheri Cheri Lady* currently 5th best played single and **Falco's** *Vienna Calling* at no. 13 in the German Airplay Hitparade. Norwegian band **A-Ha** are suddenly picking up a lot of airplay in Europe with their smooth and sophisticated track *Take On Me*, at the moment bubbling under the German Airplay charts. Other bubblebers include German rockband **Rodgau Monotones** (*Hallo Ich Bin Hermann*), **Diana Ross** and **Martinelli's** *Cenerentola*.

Saleswise, *Cheri* by **Modern Talking** is biggest runner up: 2-12. Other moves for **Princess** (16-52) and **C.C. Catch's** *I Can Lose My Heart Tonight* (20-37). Entries for **Depeche's** *It's Called A Heart* (25), **Stevie** (36) and **Peter Maffay** (*Sonne In Der Nacht*, new at 40; his album his currently at 1 in the German Album charts).

FRANCE

Baltimora, **Gold** (*Plus Des Etoiles*) and **Jean-Jacques Goldman** remain France

best selling singles and the fast movers in the French combined charts (as compiled by Eurotipsheet) are **Modern Talking's** *You Can Win*, **Century's** *Lover Why*, **Ken Laszlo's** *Hey Hey Guy*, **Patrick Bruel's** *Comment Ca Va Pour Vous*, **Pierre Bachelet's** *Marionnettiste*, **Sting's** *If You Love Somebody* and finally **Bryan Ferry's** *Slave To Love*.

Madonna's *Groove* is still favourite record on the FM channels followed by WEA artist **Jean-Pierre Mader** with *Un Pied Devant L'Autre*, **Laurent Voulzy** with *Les Nuits Sans Kim Wilde* and **Tina's** *Hero*.

HOLLAND

Kate Bush has the highest album entry this week in the Dutch charts. The splendid album *Hounds Of Love* jumps in at 32. As predicted last week, **Diana Ross** enters the Top 75 as 2nd best entry at 41 and surprisingly enough **Stevie Wonder** comes in at 51, we expected a somewhat higher entry. The 2 fastest movers come from local productions, the Dutch singer **Koos Alberts** moves from 26 to 15 and **George Baker Selection** from 35 to 20.

Dutch singer **Gerard Joling** picks up airplay with his single *Love Is In Your Eyes* on a lot of English stations. In Holland however his follow-up single *Ticket To The Tropics* is best played single and shooting up the Dutch charts (10-19). Dutch production **Boom Boom Mancini** is the other Dutch product gaining a lot of airplay this week on the Dutch channels. Their single *Red Skies* is the first release from **Ring Records** (distr. Ariola), the label founded and owned by the two Golden Earring members **Berry Hay** and **George Kooymans**. *Red Skies* is an excellent funky dancetrack, our tip for Eurocross-over this week. With **Joling** on top **Sting's** *Seventh Wave*, **Bowie & Jagger**, **Cars** (*Drive*) and **Five Star's** *Let Me Be The One* follow close by.

BELGIUM

Only one real notable change in the Top 10: **Bowie & Jagger** from 12 to 6. The longest charting singles in the Belgian Hitparade include **Opus**, 24 weeks followed by **Duran Duran**, 18 weeks and 2 local productions (**Nacht Und Nebel** with *Ready To Dance* and **Twee Belgen** with *Lena*) and 1 Euro-Crossover production (**Rita Mitsouko** with *Marcia Baila*, why oh why is no one outside France and Belgium playing this wonderful record?).

Highest entries from **Modern Talking** (28), **Bryan Ferry** (38), **Sting** (34) and **Cliff Richard** (35).

SPAIN

With most of the Southern European countries programming *Into The Groove*, Spain however is in favour of *Angel*, the single currently getting a re-campaign from Warner. *Angel* is best played single followed by local band **Hombres-G** (*Venezia*). A lot of holiday makers in Spain will return with *Baila Para Mi*, the light-weighted poppy dance song from **Objetivo Birmania** currently very popular on Spanish radio and in the discotecues.

Popular Euro-product represented by **Opus**, **Modern Talking**, and **Dan Harrow**.

SWITZERLAND

Although **Sandra** will never be *Maria Magdalena* she still tops the Swiss Top 30 followed by her producer **Michael Cretu** with *Samurai* moving from 5 to no. 2. As stated earlier, the beautiful love ballad *Cherish* is now on its way in Continental Europe to make full impact; Swiss fastest mover this week making a strong move from 22 to 6. It took some time for the Swiss band **Double** to chart in their own country, but our definite favourite Euro-Crossover song *The Captain Of Her Heart* is highest new entry at 24. Other new entries for **Thompson Twins** and **Modern Talking** (*Cheri Cheri Lady*).

The records by **Baltimora**, **Stevie Wonder**, **Cliff Richard**, **Frank Tovey** (*Luxury*) and **UB 40** stand a good chance to enter the Swiss Top 30 next week.

FINLAND

The number 1 in the Finnish **Suosikki** chart is still taken by the popular Finnish band **Eppu Normaali** with their *Kitara, Taivas Ja Tahdet* which stands for 'The Guitar, The Sky And The Stars'. EMI artist **Pirkka-Pekka Petelius** has the biggest mover in the Finnish charts with his *Lellette-Tra-La-La* (meaning just La-La-La etc.) moving from 14 to 2. Another local Finnish product is straight in at no. 3: **Neuman** with *Mennaan Hiljaa Markkinoilille* which means something like 'Let's Go Quietly To The Market Place' (in order to do what?).

Best moving international products include **Bad Boys Blue** (5- 18), **Springsteen** (*I'm On Fire*, 9-13) and **Tina Turner** (*Hero*, new at 12).


