## 6TH FRENCH CHANNEL DOMINATED BY MUSIC CONCESSION GRANTED TO ALL FRENCH CONSORTIUM

France is to have a new private television channel, set to start operations before the end of February, and with at least half its programme schedules devoted to music. There will be a minimum quota of French-produced shows.

The announcement by Georges Fillioud, French secretary of state for communications, emphasized that the concession had been given to an "all-French" group of companies, comprising Gaumont Films, private radio station NRJ and the advertising agencies Publicis and Agence Gilbert Gros.

Following French President Mitterrand's decision to deregulate television and radio broadcasting in the territory, a great political

storm grew up when the new Fifth Channel, first private network, was handed to a Franco-Italian partnership which linked the Chargeurs transport company (headed by Jerome Seydoux) with the group headed by controversial Italian entrepreneur Silvio Berlusconi.

That political upheaval led the opposition in France's National Assembly to threaten to disband the new Fifth Channel if it gains a majority in the upcoming general elections.

In the event the group taking on the new Sixth Channel has apparently been warmly welcomed. The network goes into competition against the three existing state-owned television channels (TF1, Antenne 2 and FR3), the Canal (continued on page 3)

## UK SUPERCHANNEL LAUNCH

BRIT'S BEST ON EURO-CABLES

Britain's independent television companies finally decided, January 31, to go ahead with Super Channel, the satellite operation which is planned to break into the pan-European cable networks offering the "best" of British television.

The basic strategy is to put together a selection of ITV, Channel 4 and BBC programmes to include live news segments for an 18 hours-a-day output schedule. The investment will be certainly 20 million pounds and could be as high as 40 million.

At the decisive meeting in London only 13 of the 15 ITV companies backed the venture, Thames Television and Yorkshire Television taking the line that they could not go ahead at least for the present.

The BBC, having previously agreed to make its programmes available for Super Channel, wants a 20% share of the eventual profits even though it will not be putting up any of the equity finance. The corporation will also seek fees from individual programmes so its negotiations with the commercial networks could well be prolonged.

## MTV STARTS INTERNATIONAL HOUR MAJOR EXPOSURE FOR EURO-PRODUCTIONS

North America's MTV video music network is to introduce a monthly showcase for international video-clips from June this year. Titled "MTV International Hour", the 60-minute programme will be hosted by Alan Hunter, and should provide an important U.S. marketing window for European and other foreign acts.

Announcing the launch at Midem in Cannes, MTV's senior vice-president of music programming Les Garland said: "This is a wonderful opportunity to expose new music to Stateside audiences, as well as yet another example of MTV's determination to bring innovative programming to its nearly

30 million viewers."

Content of the "MTV International Hour" has not yet been finalised, and may vary from programme to programme, but Garland says the initial plan is to include ten videos from around the world," Garland adds, "the first thing record companies do when I go into their offices is show me their videos, and some of them are really extremely impressive. We aim to showcase some of the finest contemporary clips."

Clips submitted for inclusion on the programme have to be in three-quarter inch NTSC format and should be sent to MTV Networks' Sherill Smith in New York.

# - Highlights -

## UNITED KINGDOM

In only three weeks Billy Ocean achieved silver status for sales over a quarter of a million. *When The Going Climbs* to the top of the charts putting A-Ha back to no. 2. Madonna rises 1 place to no. 3 and apart from Ireland, the UK are so far the only country where this single, *Borderline*, is doing well. Three new Top 10 singles including Five Star with *System Addict*, *Phantom Of The Opera* by Sara Brightman & Steve Harley, *Simple Minds* from 17 to 10 and James Brown knocks in at 8 (from 19) with his biggest hit for 20 years. Lower down there are good moves for Swiss duo *Double* (14-34; they will perform in TOTP this week, making them the only the Swiss act so far to do the English countdown show), *Talk Talk* (16-22), *Whitney Houston* (19-23) and PL's commercial single *Rise*. The other Rocky IV contribution *Survivor, Burning Heart*, have biggest jump this week. Their punchy ballad moves up from 70 to 30. The enigmatic *The Damned* have highest entry at 18 this week with their cover of the Paul and Barry Ryan classic *Eloise*. Other entries for *Shakin' Stevens* with his new Epic single *Turning Away* (39) and *Talking Heads* (*And She Was*), new at 45.

## GERMANY

A very static top 10 this week with only one new addition, *Survivor's Burning Heart* moving to 10 from 17. Falco's controversial *Jeanny* remains at no. 1 despite no longer featuring in the playlists since the ban. Lower down the charts there are several dramatic moves, the fastest being C.C.Catch's *'Cause You Are Young* (16-52), *Billy Ocean* (21-54) and *Silent*

*Circle's Touch In The Night* (22-39). The *Eurythmics* latest release is highest new entry (29), followed by Austrian *Joy's Touch By Touch*.

Both of *Mr. Mister's* releases are receiving good airplay at the moment with a considerable increase in particular for their latest *Kyrie*. *Feargal Sharkey's You Little Thief* is currently bubbling under the German playlists as are *Elton John's Wrap Her Up* and *Peter Maffay's Ein Wort Bricht Das Schweigen*.

## FRANCE

It is a perhaps a fitting homage to Daniel Balavoine, following his death a couple of weeks ago, that he has now risen to no. 1 having shot up the charts from the 10th position. *L'Aziza* replaces *Jean-Luc Lahaye's Papa Chanteur* which is in turn followed by *Jean-Jacques Goldman's Je Te Donne*. Apart from A-Ha, Sting, Andrea and Stevie Wonder the top 10 are entirely taken up with local products and several of the fast movers this week are similarly local artists. *Telephone's Le Jour S'est Leve* has risen from 9 to 5, *Indochine's 3e sexe* from 20 to 14 and the duet between *Serge Gainsbourg* and his daughter *Charlotte, Lemon Incest*, has reached 21 from 27. The fastest climb though this week definitely goes to *Lionel Richie* whose *Say You, Say Me* has shot up to 15 from 44.

## ITALY

A-Ha continue to top the Italian charts with *Via Verdi's Diamond* in 2nd place and followed by a new no.3 from *Lionel Richie*. His *Say You, Say Me* is currently gaining in popularity in most European countries. Good moves this

week for *Raffaella Carrà's Fidati* (16-23) and *Talk Talk's Life's What You Make It* (17-25).


## BELGIUM

*Sandra* remains on top followed by *Lionel Richie* and *Andrea* who have both risen one place each. Two of the new additions to the top 10 this week come from the seemingly very popular Rocky IV film: *Survivor's Burning Heart* has climbed to 7 from 18 and *James Brown's Living In America* is also rising steadily (9-17). The other new track in the top 10 is *Broken Wings* by *Mr. Mister* who are currently busy on a promo tour throughout Europe. The highest new entry this week is *Daniel Balavoine's L'Aziza* (18) while other additions to the top 50 include *Simple Minds*, duet of *Will Tura & Bonnie St. Claire*, *Chantal Goya*, *Mai Tai*, *Sophia George* and *Starship*.


## AUSTRIA

Local product continues to dominate the charts with *Jeanny* still at no. 1 and the football star *Hans Krankl* at no. 2 with his *Lonely Boy*. After *Elton John* comes another local artist, *Erste Allgemeine Verunsicherung* with their potential European cross-over record *Ba-Ba-Bankueberfall*. *Jennifer Rush* consolidates her popularity with *Destiny* and *The Power Of Love* following each other at 5 and 6. Apart from *Lionel Richie* and *Talking Heads* the Top 10 is taken by local productions (*Sandra*, *S.T.S.*).


## EURO-TALENT TO WATCH

*Peter Frampton* comes alive again with his new Virgin album *Premonition*, his first LP in nearly 4 years. ## RED HOT

The **Simply Red** album turns out to be a premiere hit collection. After their appearance at the Midem Gala last week and several other promotional visits in Europe, they are, together with Matt Bianco and Fine Young Cannibals, the best new young act that Britain currently has to offer. *Picture Book* is currently the album in Europe that most programmers use for their shows and apart from the three hit singles that have already proven their impact on radio, *Jericho* is getting substantial backing. It will be the band's forthcoming new single and it will only enhance the sales potential of the album. In the European Hot 100 things are on the bright side as well with the LP moving up.

Many European programmers jumped upon the new **Electric Light Orchestra** album *Balance Of Power* (CBS). It is ELO's 12th studio album and considering the lengthy period that it took them to return to the scene, this eagerness isn't hard to understand. Obviously their new single *Calling America* gets most of the attention and it is a typical ELO production with the distinctive voice of Jeff Lynne leading the way. Other airplay candidates include *Heaven Only Knows* and *Sorrow About To Fall*. No doubt this will bring ELO completely back on the map.

Whereas 1985 was a rather quiet year with regards to soundtracks, it seems that this year we might get the same OST dominance in the charts as in 1984. **Rocky IV** is exploding at retail level and the album streaks right into Top 10 this week (9-18). With both the **James Brown** and **Survivor** contributions making incredibly good moves in the Hot 100 Singles



(resp. 12-14 and 4-19) together with other performing artists like John Cafferty and Go West, it is abundantly clear that the LP is a Euro-Radio Album Smash. The **Rocky IV** Soundtrack is already on its way to surpass the successes of last year's OSTs **Chess** and **Mad Max**.

What started as a new thing in '84 has now become common practice as every American movie nowadays seems to have an accompanying soundtrack. Lots of the released OSTs are however hardly worth the attention since they sometimes only contain one or two really good hit singles. The US Atlantic Soundtrack **Quicksilver** nevertheless is a favourable exception. The musical score was written by Genesis member Tony Banks and the album features a host of good and solid AOR killers. **Roger Daltrey's Quicksilver Lightning** could especially please programmers in Europe with its accessible production of Giorgio Moroder. Other strong rockers by **Peter Frampton** and **Fiona**. Also watch the love song from the movie performed by **John Parr & Marilyn Martin**: very strong vocals, good powerbreaks and a lovely melody!

Talking about Marilyn Martin, this strong new talented lady could break into the album market in Europe in a few weeks to come. Her Atlantic debut album contains some real rocky material that could appeal to a mass audience. Produced by a.o. Phil Ramone, Arif Mardin and John Parr, Martin immediately convinces in tracks like *Body And The Beat*, *Beauty Or The Beast* and the Dave Stewart/Feargal Sharkey written *Thank You*. On your desk very soon!



## MUSIC BOX TO GO 24 HRS

Music Box, Europe's only all-music satellite television channel, has announced its plans, six months ahead of schedule, to transmit its programmes 24 hours a day, seven days a week. This makes Music Box Europe's first 24 hour satellite TV channel. The station now reaches nearly 4 million homes connected to cable in 11 countries. Transmission hours were increased to 18 hours a day a year ago and it is audience demand which has precipitated this decision for continuous transmission.

Music Box, has also finished shooting four pop promo clips of German bands, Shark Vegas, Black Carnations, Mike Vamp and Soif De La Vie. All were taped during a one-week film shot in Berlin. So far this year Music Box has made more than 20 similar promos for new and emerging bands all over Europe. Peter Walker heads the Music Box team in this sector and Jane Kelly, the channel's head of production, says: "We find this new addition to our work is really challenging and exciting. Our policy has always been to cover European bands but the shortage of available visual material has lead us to turn our words into actions. We could have sat back and watched things happen, but we wanted to get involved in what is basically a service to the record companies, the groups and the audiences who otherwise would be deprived of visual back-up for some of their favourite local bands."





## RADIO BREMEN REFORMS







## WDR SHOW USING PHONE-IN SYSTEM INCREASE IN AUDIENCE PARTICIPATION

The weekly German WDR programme, 'Schlagerrally', this week introduced into its show a telephone dialogue system, as developed by the PTT. It enables the public to call in directly after the show to give their votes for the 18 records as appearing in the Schlagerrally. Formerly people sent letters to choose their favourite records but with this new system it is expected that the audience commitment will speed up drastically. "I think the system is ideal for our purpose," says Bud-dah Kraemer, DJ and producer behind the programme. "Whereas people were always obliged to

write in the past we found new ways of increasing audience participation. The system is very simple: At the end of the programme we present each record very briefly with its corresponding code number. People dial a local Dusseldorf number and just add the song code. Each vote is registered and updated results are continuously shown on a screen."

Following similar projects by BR (Munich) and SWF (Baden Baden), it looks likely to become very successful and, adds Kraemer, "I'm hoping at least 20,000 people will call every week".

Plus pay-television operation and the Fifth Channel, the latter going on stream from February 20.

Max Guazzini, 'Secrétaire General' of the Paris based NRJ, says "the new sixth channel is aiming for an audience of under 35's. I think that NRJ is therefore the ideal station to supply the musical programming since we are so popular amongst the young."

A disappointed contender for the new commercial concession was the big Luxembourg-based broadcaster Compagnie Luxembourgeoise de Télédiffusion (CLT) which had earlier been seen as in with strong chances of winning the battle to run the Fifth Channel.

Details as to precisely how much French music product has to be incorporated in the new channel's programmes have not yet been made known.

## VOGUE SUBSIDIARIES RESTRUCTURED

### BENELUX CO ESTABLISHED

Vogue France has announced the merger of its Dutch and Belgian operations into a single entity to be known as Vogue Benelux. The move is the latest phase in the rescue of the company by former Carrere Video head Jean-Louis Detry, who acquired the troubled Vogue PIP early last year shortly before it filed for bankruptcy.

Detry subsequently re-started the business under the name Vogue France, reducing its payroll, re-structuring sales and promotion departments and re-negotiating contracts with international labels including Chess, Solar, Sugarhill,

## BELGIAN TOP 50 GETS WEEKLY RUN OFFICIAL HITPARADE AIRED ON RADIO 21

Radio 21, the daily 24 hour pop channel on the French language network RTBF, has started a weekly show based on the official national hitparade, the Sabam/Sibesa. Every Friday from five till six pm, the show goes on the air and is alternatively presented by Radio 21 deejays Marc Ysaye and Pierre Guyaut, and produced by Rudy Leonet. The programme spotlights the major moves and new entries in the Top 30 with a small section at the end presenting the new records currently bubbling under.

The National Top 50 is compiled by the Sibesa, the Belgian industry organisation and controlled by the copyright organisation, Sabam.

While the BRT, the Dutch public broadcasting service, is still programming its own compiled

'BRT Top 30', hopes are set that they will eventually go along with the Sabam/Sibesa hitparade. According to Rudy Leonet, the producer, the great breakthrough is the fact that the national Top 50 is at last broadcast on radio although the chart was established January 1985. Its acceptance both on industry and radio level is a good step towards lessening the rigid borders between the two linguistic areas, the French and Dutch speaking communities Ted Sikkink, managing director WEA Belgium, says of the new move: "Obviously we are very happy with this development. We finally have an official and national hitparade. So no talk anymore of a Flemish or French compiled hitparade, we just have the official chart on the RTBF."

## NEEDLETIME DISPUTE CONTINUES

### AIRPLAY PAYMENTS CONTESTED

The long-running legal battle between Britain's commercial radio stations (through the Association of Independent Radio Contractors, AIRC) and Phonographic Performance Ltd (PPL) over payments for airplay of records is still far from being settled.

After the latest High Court hearing in London, both sides seemed reasonably happy when the judge referred the dispute back to the Performing Right Tribunal for reconsideration of some "key points in law" on which the tribunal could have gone wrong.

But the judge rejected several submissions by AIRC that the tribunal was wrong in setting the rate for needletime payments back in 1980 because in fact the value of airplay promotion to record com-

panies is so great that radio stations should pay only "a nominal sum."

Says John Love of PPL: "Now that theory has been thrown out, we should have finally ended all the arguments on the value of airplay."

However the judge did accept that there should be a comparison of commercial radio station payments with those paid by the BBC. He also ruled that PPL's payments to the Musicians' Union shouldn't form part of PPL's "bargaining stance" with the AIRC stations.

Now it's back to the Performing Right Tribunal, with AIRC still looking for "substantial" reductions in the money they have to pay out for music use.

spent in financing local acts who had little or no international interest even for France.

"So I decided to liquidate Vogue Belgium, while the Dutch subsidiary has now become Vogue Benelux, with its own sales/promotion team and offices in both Hilversum and Brussels. The new streamlined operation should have better profitability and work international artists more effectively."

Vogue's main objective now, Detry adds, is to develop international acts from the labels it represent and rebuild its strength in local French product. "We will be interested in Benelux acts," he notes, "only if they have sales potential in Europe, and especially in France."

The event, attended by many top-level music industry executives, was co-hosted by Billboard and its associated publication Eurotipsheet.

Mike Hennessey, editorial director Eurotipsheet and managing director Billboard Ltd, told guests that the event was being inaugurated in order to forge an important link between the disseminators of radio and television programmes and the music industry.

## TUNING IN



**Rafael Revert - SER Madrid**  
*Rafael Revert is head of all the music programmes of the SER network.*

"There are 130 SER stations throughout Spain, shared between AM and FM. The AM stations are more orientated towards providing first class news, sport and entertainment information. Pop music is reserved to night-time listening, usually between 10.00pm and 7.00 in the morning. Generally the AM stations are most popular with the over 30's age bracket. The FM stations on the other hand play music 24 hours a day, concentrating on the top 40 whilst also including 24 of the latest new releases. Every Tuesday about 10 or 20 of the SER programmers from different regions in Spain gather together and we listen to the new sounds and decide how much airplay to devote to these records. We are always working towards the success of new records.

At SER Madrid we have a repertoire of about 60% international records and 40% local but we generally play these on a 50/50 ratio. However we hardly ever play non-English continental records here in Spain unless as with groups like Baltimora or Modern Talking they sing in English.

A particularly successful group in Spain at the moment is Alaska Y Dineram whose single Como Pudiste Hacerme Esto A Mi was a tremendous hit. They are popular in Mexico and I think they have a good chance of crossing over to Europe. Another local group also doing very well are Hombres G. The other day they were performing at a disco in Madrid for the 'El Gran Musical' show which is broadcast live every Sunday and they had to have 50 police to protect them! Three singles, all of which have achieved considerable success, have been released from their LP which has sold over 140,000 copies. The group is less likely to cross-over than Alaska as they play with clever and amusing words and are therefore harder to understand.

Another local up-and-coming group is Radio Futura and promising soloists include Miguel Bose and Rosendo."





The European Airplay chart shows a lot of action this week with a new no. 1, lots of fast movers and new entries.

The Norwegians have done it again, their second single is this week best played in Europe and they pushed Broken Wings back to no. 4. But Mr. Mister shouldn't feel too broken as their follow up *Kyrie* is about to conquer Europe again. Only in its second week it moves up to 13 (from 28). The band was very honoured recently when they heard that Miles Davis had recorded a cover version of Broken Wings.

The Pet Shop Boys have second best played single and Billy Ocean follows at 3. On their way to being Europe's best crossover after A-Ha, Kurt Maloo and Felix Haug a.k.a Double, have finally achieved the success they deserve. The single moves into Airplay Top 10 this week in a good jump from 12 to 6.

EMI released the new Talking Heads single *And She Was* last week. It is quite a change after the poppy impact of their last one *Road To Nowhere*. This is more of a return to the days of 1977. European radio does not seem to be bothered by such reflections, it is an obvious add-on for many and it is now up to no. 14 (from 36).

Highest debuting single in the Airplay Top 50 for PIL: *Rise* enters at 23. Completely in line with PIL's policy of minimum information whereby music is more important than the people behind it, all titles of the released products are simplified. The new album is called *Album*, the cassette is called *Cassette*, their record company is called *Label* and even the publicity shots of Johnny Lydon are credited as 'Photo Of Artist!'

The supremacy of Sting lasted exactly one week as he is this week put back to no. 2 by the sudden strong upward movement of Lionel Richie's *Say You Say Me*. The single followed a rather erratic course and no one really expected it to hit the Hot 100. Two weeks ago it reached a position of 3 and then fell back to no. 9 likely to leave Top 10 the week after. But now with very strong sales in France and Spain, a re-entry in the UK and consol-

dated positions in 12 other markets (!), Richie is The King of Europe this week.

The prize for the most obvious hit of 1986 so far definitely goes to *Survivor*. Their *Burning Heart* is in two weeks time up to no. 4, nearly surpassing the success of Phil Collins' *One More Night* last year. The latter entered at 12 in its first week (making it the highest entry of that year) and went up in its second week to no. 6. And it looks very likely that *Burning Heart* will even go up next week.

Another newcomer in the Top 10 is *Billy Ocean* whose new single definitely is not going tough: from 13 to 9 in its third week. Other movers in the Hot 100 for *James Brown* (12-14), *Eurythmics* (14-27), *Simple Minds* (18-42) and *Feargal Sharkey's A Good Heart*

(24-31).

Following her marriage with the Norwegian shipsmagnate Arne Naess, Diana Ross should also be pleased to see her cheerful Motown-esque *Chain Reaction* finally making inroads in Europe. Although the single went up in the UK last week it dropped out of Germany and Belgium and it could therefore not improve on its new entry of 79 two weeks ago. Capitol however started a new campaign on the single which turned out to be very successful in Germany. This week the single re-enters at 48 in the Hot 100.

Trendsetting Award winners of 1985 *Modern Talking* and *Opus* both have new singles out this week which are expected to become hot radio adds next week.
