

## BPI URGES BAN ON FREE VIDEOS UK Likely To Accept Pay-For-Play policy

The British Phonographic Industry (BPI) is advising all its member record companies to stop supplying free music videos to UK television networks as from May 31.

The dramatic new policy sets a firm deadline because, says BPI, the national IFPI group, it aims to underline the urgency of the situation. Music videos will in future be supplied only on a pay-for-play basis. And the payment principle from that date will also apply to videos already supplied.

Says Terri Anderson, BPI press and public relations chief: "There have been discussions going on for over a year between the record industry and the television companies, but little progress has been made. Our council reviewed the situation and decided that free videos just could not continue. "Now a negotiating committee has been set up to look at the whole question of rates and payments of

dues." The BPI's tough line is based on four declared points. First, the value of music videos, basically financed by record companies, as programming fodder has grown steadily, in line with the growth of the retail market for this product. BPI notes that the promotional (continued on page 3)

## UK TV BOOSTS POP COVERAGE Specialist Charts Aired On Channel IV

Pop coverage on British television is about to get a massive boost with the arrival of several new weekly shows. They include Chan-

nel Four's "The Chart Show" and "Solid Soul", both airing for the first time April 11, plus a proposed ITV rival to "Top of the Pops" based on the independent local radio stations' network chart, and still under consideration a BBC TV showcase for new rock videos provisionally dubbed "The First Sight Show".

"The Chart Show" will be produced for Channel Four by Jill Sinclair and Keith Macmillan of Video Visuals. Macmillan is an experienced video director best-known as the founder of leading promo company Keefco. Running 45 minutes from 5.30 Friday evenings, the show will have no presenters or studio audience. "What we are trying to do is an all-video, all-chart show," says Sinclair. "We wanted to (continued on page 3)

## CLT Stake Bought By Moet-Hennessy

Moet-Hennessy has bought an 8.2% stake in CLT (Compagnie Luxembourgeoise de Telediffusion), the Luxembourg-based broadcaster group, for some 230 million French Francs (around £ 22 million). It bought its interest from French publishing group Hachette, which had indicated it would be selling because it had acquired control of the Europe 1 broadcast group from the French


government. CLT, with its Radio Television Luxembourg subsidiary, is a direct rival of Europe 1. Moet-Hennessy, the champagne and brandy giant, says its stake in CLT gave it a "first look" in the new field of communications. And it comes at a time of great change in the French broadcasting sector because of deregulation, political change and the launch of new television channels.

# - Highlights -

## UNITED KINGDOM

For the 3rd week at no. 1, *Living Doll*. This week the charity single is followed by the poignant *A Different Corner*. Apart from dominating the charts, the two singles have one other thing in common; both singles had new entries in the English chart at 4, making them the highest entries of this year. While **George Michael** is followed by **Sam Cooke** and **Samantha Fox**, **Falco** raps to no. 5 with the American edit of *Rock Me Amadeus* (from 10). In two weeks, the Norwegians **A-Ha** have conquered the English top 10 again with their latest single *Train Of Thought* (9-23). Other good moves for **Atlantic Star** (10-14), **Big Audio Dynamite** (11-20), **Style Council** (14-27) **S.O.S. Band** (23-35) and **Bryan Ferry** (29-36), **Simple Minds** have highest entry with *All The Things She Said* (15) followed by **Big Country** at 18 with *Look Away* and **Five Star** with yet another charting single entitled *Can't Wait Another Minute* (new at 36). After seven singles released from their ten track LP *Luxury Of Life* (yielding one top 10 hit with *System Addict* and two top 20 singles with *All Fall Down* and *Let Me Be The One*) this one is not from this LP but a brand new track. Other major entries for **Whitney Houston** (*The Greatest Love Of All*) and **Billy Ocean** (*There'll Be Sad Songs*).

## GERMANY

While the nonsense rap *Geil* sticks at 1, American soda quartet **Bangles** move up to 2 (coming from 5). **Billy Ocean** has been put back to 3 and **Sheila E.** remains at 4. **Prince** hits the top 10 (7-21) and also new is **David Bowie** (8-12). **Marietta** moves up with *Fire And Ice* (16-20) and this is from the soundtrack of the same name based on a film by **Willy Bogner**. **Pet Shop Boys** move up (17-27) as well as **Juliane Werding** (18-24) and **Jennifer Rush** (24-33). **Queen** have brought their latest single *A Kind Of Magic* in two weeks to number 29 and the melodic MOR pop of **Muenchener Freiheit** is currently at 30 (from 58). New entries for EMI Electrola artist **Herbert Groenemeyer** (who also has one of the best played singles in Germany at the moment),

the Monacan Princess **Stephanie** with *Irresistible* and a new entry for **The Blow Monkeys** at 50.

## FRANCE

**Gold's Capitaine Abandonne** remains at no. 1 followed by *Burning Heart* and *Russians*, which is climbing fast to the top (3-7). The most notable jump however goes to the Monacan princess, **Stephanie**, with her *Ouagan*, up to 13 from 45. Her English sung version, *Irresistible*, entered both the English and German charts this week. Only two new entries this week: **Sabine Patarel** with *Les Belises* and **Simple Minds' Alive and Kicking**.

## HOLLAND

For the 2nd week at no. 1, *Jeanny* and again followed by **Cock Robin** and **Miami Sound Machine**. Two newcomers in the top 10, **Prince** and **Whistle** and good moves for **George Michael**, **Paul Hardcastle** and (the surprise of the week) **Cliff Richard & The Young Ones** straight in at 16. Other entries for **Time Bandits** (with their **Dan Hartman** produced *I Won't Steel Away*), the lovely **Dolly Dots** with *Dreaming Of You*, **Portrait/CBS** singer **Nicole** with *Don't You Want My Love*, local acts **Frank Alfoller**, **Het Goede Doel** and the German no. 1 *Geil* by **Bruce & Bongio**.

## BELGIUM

After 2 weeks at no. 1, **Modern Talking's Brother Louie** is removed this week by **Cock Robin's The Promise You Made**. It is the 6th different no. 1 of this year after **Lionel Richie** (1 week), **Elton John** (2), **Sandra** (4), **Survivor** (4) and **Modern Talking** (2). **Sandra** continues her popularity with her latest single *Little Girl* entering the top 10 (8-14 in its 2nd week). Good moves for **Miami Sound Machine** (11-17), **Falco** (16-21) and new at 23 is **Sigue Sigue Sputnik**. Of the first 20 records, only 3 are French language material, being **Stephanie**, **Bill Baxter** with *Embrasse-Moi Idiot* and the French group **Gold** with *Capitaine Abandonne*. All other records have English lyrics and most of them are of Anglo-American origin.

## SPAIN

A very static top 10 this week with an up-changed top 3. **Jennifer Rush's** Spanish version of *The Power Of Love* remains at no. 1 while her English version of the same song stands at 8. Best moves for *Brother Louie* (16-25), *Harlem Shuffle* (17-27) and *Absolute Beginners* (21-30). The highest new entry goes to **Sigue Sigue** ('Follow Follow' in Spanish) **Sputnik** and others include **Mr. Mister's Broken Wings**, **Luz's Rufino** and **Nacho Cano & German Coppini's Dame Un Chupito De Amor** (Give Me A Little Bit Of Love).

## SWITZERLAND

The best played single on the national pop channel (and on 5 private stations) is **David Bowie's Absolute Beginners**. Local musician **Phil Carmen** gets lots of airplay as well with his *Moonshine Still* and the current Swiss no. 1 (**Muenchener Freiheit**) still receive masses of plays. On chart level there is, hardly any change and **Matt Bianco** and **Starship** have highest entries. Bubbling under are **5 Star (System Addict)**, **S.S. Sputnik**, **Joe Cocker (Don't You Love Me Anymore)**, **Prince** and **Cock Robin**.

## ITALY

A new no. 1 as **Sting's Russians** puts **San Remo** winner **Eros Ramazzotti** back to no. 2. **Double stick** at no. 3 and with the immense popularity of the **Adrian Lyne** directed 9 1/2 Weeks, **Joe Cocker's You Can Leave Your Hat On** shoots up to no. 4 (from 16). It is on this track that **Kim Basinger** does her sensuous striptease. Italy is the first country where 9 1/2 Weeks has been released and the theme for this movie, *I Do What I Do* by **John Taylor** is also shooting up the charts (17-28). More good moves for **Bowie** (18-26), **Prince**, **Cock Robin (The Promise)**, **Kissing The Pink** and 'Rolling Stones



## PRINCE PARADES AT 11

Rocky IV sticks at 1 and Rolling Stones enter Top 10 in their second week (5-11). Talk Talk make a slight move to 7 and Prince has highest entry at 14 this week (after the Stones' entry of last week at 11, the best album entry of this year).

The *Parade* album gathers the best reports and plays from our European correspondents this week. Just like his last one, *Around The World In A Day*, Prince refuses to stick to the obvious hit formula and again comes up with a quite unpredictable set of tracks. Most of the tracks are supported by heavy orchestration and sparse funk arrangements. Tracks that yielded the most airplay include *Anotherloverwholenyohead*, *Mountains* and *Girls & Boys*.

The first musical piece played and recorded in space...an instrumental piece that the astronaut Ron McNair had to play on his saxophone in the Challenger Shuttle that fatally exploded after its launch. *Last Rendez-Vous* ('Ron's Piece') is the grande finale of Jean-Michel Jarre's latest album, *Rendez-Vous*, that is dedicated to Ron McNair and the other six astronauts. The LP is the 4th best entry this week and enters at 61. Jarre recorded the album for the 150th birthday of the city Houston, where he performed a multi-media spectacle last week. It is Jarre's 6th album and again contains an amazing and impressive tapestry of cosmic synthesizer sounds.

One of our Albums of the Week is *Animal Magic* by the Blow Monkeys, one of the brightest and obsessed English bands at the

moment. Fronted by Dr. Robert (Howard) the band is destined to make it. And we love them with their glam-cocktail of white Philly soul, pumping dance stuff and exalted pop. This record should be played loud! Apart from the two hit singles (*Forbidden Fruit* and *Digging Your Scene*) there are further stand outs like *Wicked Ways* (really soulful and a definite single contender), the bluesy *Burn The Rich*, the doo-woop *I Backed A Winner* and the hectic funk in *Sweet Murder* (featuring Eek-a-Mouse on vocals). After a wait of three years European Radio will surely welcome the new album of Bob Seger & The Silver Bullet Band. The Detroit rocker broke in Europe and the US with his 10th album 'Night Moves' (from 1976) and delivered hits like 'Against The Wind', 'Night Moves' and 'Firelake'. With this 15th album he continues the line of Night Moves and as always he finds the perfect balance between ballads and rockers. Apart from the new single *American Storm* we are pretty sure the title track will pick up the most airplay; strong lyrics, a chilling slide solo and Seger in his role as a great story teller. Other airplay candidates are *The Ring* and the rockers *Tight Rope* and *The Aftermath*.

Watch out for American roots band The Swimming Pool Q's from Athens, GA. A pop-group with a capital P who write bright and folk-tinged pop songs on their A&M debut album *Blue Tomorrow*. Although the group lacks a truly consistent sound, they are definite talents to look out for.

## EURORADIO ALBUM SMASHES







## British Gov'n. Fights Video Piracy

The British government is to set up a special unit under the authority of the Customs & Excise department, to fight video piracy, especially where British television programmes or films are concerned.

The Video Copyright Protection Society estimates there's a loss of at least £50 million annually from this area of piracy-export dealing. It is urging the government to make it an offence to export illegally obtained video or television programmes. It believes that tapes are taken, or air-freighted out, by

travellers who pretend they are for their own use, and then copied for illicit sales abroad.

The society also wants firm action taken against overseas governments said to "turn a blind eye" to this trade. Involvement of the Customs & Excise people would make easier the seizure of illegal cassettes.

The Video Copyright Protection Society was set up by the Independent Television Companies Association, the Society of Film Distributors and BBC Enterprises.

## SKY/TROS To Co-produce Pop Show

TROS, the Dutch National Broadcaster, and Sky Channel have reached a 15-month co-production agreement. As from October they will co-produce two 45 minute pop music shows every week in Amsterdam. 'Pop Formule' will be screened every Friday on TROS and will be produced in Dutch and

its equivalent will be screened on Wednesdays in English on Sky. TROS star, Erik De Zwart, and Linda De Mol, Sky presenter, are to co-host the programmes which will feature two acts recorded live every week. These are expected to provide a platform enabling Dutch artists to gain European exposure

music video has become a valuable in-home entertainment in its own right, and that the number of television shows relying on music videos is much larger than when music vids were first made available.

Further new programmes are in the pipeline, including on Channel 4 which is to rely almost entirely on music videos.

Countries in Europe which have already established the pay-for-play principle in relation to broadcast of music videos are: Austria, Belgium, Luxembourg, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Italy, Netherlands, Norway,

Sweden and Switzerland. Payments and per-play basis tariffs vary between them. The situation leaves just the UK, Spain and Portugal on the "free" list.

But in the UK payment for the use of music videos is already being made by video jukebox and disco operators, and Music Box and Sky Channel pay fees for licences for pan-European cable/satellite operations using music videos.

Patrick Isherwood, BPI legal adviser, says: "We're not seeking confrontation with television companies. The deadline is not meant as a threat. We just want to create the right environment in which real negotiations can take place.

## TUNING IN

Tom Huybrechts is producer of the bi-weekly pop tv programme Villa Tempo.

"The name 'Villa Tempo' reflects a bit of the style we are trying to maintain in our programme. The subtitle of the programme is 'Gejaagd door de rock cultuur' (an apt translation could be: Haunted by the rock culture - editor) and this also gives an indication of

the way we work; we try to keep updated with the latest trends and to react as accurately as possible in the fast changing world of pop music. Obviously we don't have the budgets to visit groups abroad and that is why we are dependent on those acts which come to Belgium. Apart from the usual clips we keep a close eye on the local culture and feature upcoming young Belgian bands as much as possible. It is a magazine-type of programme with short spots, specials and news items.

I started as a director and for the last 5 years I have been working for the Youth Service Department of BRT ("Dienst Jeugd"). Villa Tempo evolved out of 'Pop Elektron' which was a very popular programme 2 years ago. Through its unusual combination of science and pop music, and the unique presentation of Bart Peeters, we attracted lots of attention. This was actually a brand new way of presenting pop music.

There are plans to start a weekly pop programme on the BRT channel, a programme that is far more youth orientated (and should therefore attract more viewers) than Villa Tempo which is sometimes a bit too complex and intellectual for the big masses.

## 6 HOUR RADIO SHOW ON BOWIE

London's Odyssey Group, a multi-faceted music complex headed by former hit songwriter Wayne Bickerton, has completed a six-hour radio series titled "In Other Words - David Bowie," to be made available in six sections for use worldwide.

It is narrated by Angie Bowie, the singer's ex-wife, and is to be the first in a series profiling British music makers. Kate Bush is lined up for

the second.

The producers interviewed more than 30 people closely associated with Bowie's private and professional lives, including his producers Gus Dudgeon and Tony Visconti and from Ken Pitt, his one-time manager who shaped the Bowie career. Musicians involved include Brian Eno, Mick Ronson and Carlos Alomar.

get away from 25-year-old habits."

It will feature two or three specialist charts each week - heavy metal, dance, reggae, country and so on - all compiled by MRIB which produces the ILR network placings. These charts include an air-play element, and there has been some question whether tv companies might be reluctant to use them for that reason. But according to Sinclair, "The airplay factor does not bother us."

The timing of the show could hardly be bettered, from the record industry's point of view. Up to 60% of weekly record sales are made Friday afternoons and Saturdays, and when "The Chart Show" goes out the charts it uses will be barely five hours old. "We are going to stimulate sales," says Sinclair, "and we will also be interested to see whether more indie product and

heavy metal gets into the main chart because of what we are doing. I am sure we will be helping crossover"

However, Channel Four denies it is competing with BBC's "Top of the Pops", long seen as the key promotional outlet for UK sales. Says youth commissioning editor John Cummins, "The record and pop promo industries have made a very coherent and forceful case that they need different outlets, and I'm convinced we should give them an opportunity."

Fifteen minutes after the programme ends, "Solid Soul" will take over, beginning a 26-week run in a half-hour slot. A successor to last year's "Soul Train", itself derived from the American show of the same name, "Solid Soul" will be made by the same team led by producer Gordon Elsbury, and aims to highlight developments in the black/dance music scene with a mix of live music and news.



## Hit Singles: The Formula For Success

The history of the original soundtrack is a long and successful one. Way back in 1924 when the first electric recordings were being made, and the first talking film (Jazz Singer of 1928) was launched in Hollywood, it became abundantly clear that the histories of the record industry and the movies would parallel each other. Songs featured in successful new movies and screen plays were later to become top hit records in their own right. One way or another, songs and movies have always influenced each other in a mutual and rewarding way.

The relation between soundtracks and films is manifold. First of all original instrumental themes were composed as music to go with a particular film, as in the popular *Star Wars* and *Chariots Of Fire*. Conversely films like *Sound Of Music* and *Grease* were adapted from another medium; stage and comedy settings were the basic source of inspiration for this type of film.

Rock and roll and disco scores, like *Saturday Night Fever*, *American Hot Wax*, *Miami Vice*, *Breakfast Club*, etc. all used previously recorded material as the material for the specific soundtrack. This currently seems to be the most popular means of making soundtracks; various well-known artists give permission to use their material and this often results


in soundtracks being top 40 hit parade compilations. As is frequently the case, most of the songs featured on the soundtrack are not even played in the corresponding movie.

More and more films that are not directly related to music, carry additional musical footage to make commercial success more viable. Soundtracks thereby become a souvenir, keeping the memory of the film alive (though strong hit compilations or highly representative musical scores do not necessarily follow). Some films however, can revive

the interest in musical genres that are hardly touched upon by some age brackets; the enormous success that the OST of *Amadeus* yielded was a surprise to many.

The '80s are an era in which record companies, movie companies and distributors are becoming closely involved in joint marketing campaigns. The situation whereby film music becomes successful without any major investment of record companies is hardly conceivable.

Full length albums however are not always the promotional tools to support a movie. WEA International launched a campaign in close co-operation with Orion Pictures to promote Madonna and the feature film, *Desperately Seeking Susan*. Three of the artist's clips were put on 35 mm and these were inserted at the beginning of the film, 'Into The Groove' which




### Out Of Africa- MCA

The marketing campaign surrounding *Out Of Africa* began in full force at Christmas. Executives from UIP International and MCA came to the agreement that since the film promised to be such a strong one, its release with the album should be more or less simultaneous. MCA's policy is to break the record first if it appears to be a strong one and the picture is considered weak. MCA and UIP worked closely together on a joint marketing campaign; all advertising from WEA incorporating a credit for the movie and vice versa. Posters highlighting Oscar awards were printed for instore use and albums were overstickered likewise. Stuart Watson, international director MCA, says that "it was a conscious decision to put the main theme on the B-side and the decision has paid off admirably." He continues: "In Germany this is the track that is receiving maximum promotion and in the UK it is the B-side which resulted in our early chart position of 75." Although it is very early days, European sales are already promising. The single, *Music Of Goodbye*, performed by Melissa Manchester and Al Jarreau coupled with the main theme has been released and in order to promote this prints of the video were supplied to various cinemas prior to the movie release.


### Rocky IV- Scotti Brothers/CBS

*Rocky IV* is undoubtedly the success story of 1986 so far. *Rocky* exploded as soon as it was released on a retail level: the LP is currently no. 1 in the European Hot 100, *Survivor* dominates the singles charts and James Brown reached the no. 2 spot in the Hot 100. Indeed throughout most countries in Europe both songs went top 10, achieving a good share of golds. This unprecedented success inevitably pre-sold the movie especially in view of the fact that the videos to the singles all show extracts from the film, thereby acting as ideal advertising material for the film.

CBS worked closely with UIP in marketing jointly the music and film. In order to ascertain that the videos would receive maximum rotation a competition was arranged between Sky Channel, CBS and UIP with a first prize of a round trip to LA and a visit to Disneyland. The necessity of answering questions relating to the movie and the videos capitalised on peak viewing on the cable programme. Instore decoration in fashion shops was set up throughout Europe. Holland embarked on a



3-month TV ad campaign, selling 50,000 LPs before the film opened. Belgium, benefiting from both the French and Dutch promotion sold more copies relative to the size of the country than any other territory. The only Euro country to react slowly was Norway where boxing is forbidden on the screen. Clips have had to be shown very restrictively. Sweden presented no problem thanks to *Rocky's* blond rival, the Swede Dolf Lundgren.




### Absolute Beginners- Virgin

The release of David Bowie's single *Absolute Beginners* was an instant assurance of success, boding very well for the film. Its release last month was the beginning of a concerted campaign from the Virgin group

and the single rapidly shot up to the 2nd position in the UK charts. Both the LP and the single have already gone silver in the UK selling over 60,000 copies. There are two LPs from the film: a single album entitled *Songs From The Motion Picture*, and a double LP out this week, called *The Original Motion Picture Soundtrack*, the latter containing all the incidental jazz from the movie.

Since the movie was made by Virgin Films (jointly financed by Goldcrest) the Virgin Group obviously worked closely together in the marketing campaign. A large format cardboard display in 3D was placed in stores, 400 being produced for the UK and 1,500 distributed throughout Europe. Norman Dinesen, marketing director Virgin Records, says: "We were determined to get a hit in first to co-market the film. A hit single is obviously the most successful formula to do so."

appears in the film was included on Madonna's LP, Like A Virgin, and all film posters were stickered with 'Into The Groove' announcements. Both film and record company thus mutually aided each other.



**9 1/2 Weeks- Capitol**

9 1/2 Weeks, a film starring Kim Basinger and Mickey Rourke as the partners in a torrid, obsessive romance that lasts 9 1/2 weeks, is Capitol's latest OST. It has so far only been released in Italy and The States but is due out sporadically over the year throughout Europe. 9 1/2 Weeks has received a lot of acclaim in both countries and it is seemingly the biggest movie in the last 10 years in Italy. The lp entered the top 10 and sold 60,000 copies in 2 weeks, making it one of the fastest selling albums ever. The first single to be released was John Taylor's I Do What I Do out worldwide and the second single Joe Cocker's You Can Leave Your Hat On was the highest new entry in the Italian charts, is now at 4, and is a likely contender for the no. 1 spot. Luba's The Best Is Yet To Come is the 3rd single which will be released from the album. When asked about any specific marketing campaigns related to the lp Heinz Henn, director European operations Capitol/EMI America/Manhattan, said, "It is difficult to generate a close campaign between the film company and the record company as the film is being released so sporadically throughout Europe. We have therefore concentrated on local campaigns in each country"

A promising OST due out on Capitol in July is Labyrinth, a film starring David Bowie directed by George Lucas of Starwars in conjunction with Jim Henson (creator of the Muppets). The OST is basically a Bowie lp and should therefore be expected to do very well.

**Jewel Of The Nile- Jive**

Jive's first ever OST venture, the highly successful Jewel Of The Nile, has given the company a taste for continuing with the production of further soundtracks. Both the film and the LP had staggered releases, but are now out all over Europe with the exception of the UK and Holland which are releasing this week. The LP has so far charted in Sweden, Germany, Switzerland and Austria with over 100,000 albums sold throughout Europe. Four singles have all been successfully released performed by Billy Ocean, Ruby Turner, Precious Wilson and Whodini. Billy Ocean's success is unprecedented, it reached top 10 in every country in which it was released, going to no 1 in the UK, Holland, Belgium, Denmark and Finland and no. 2 in Germany, Norway, Sweden and Switzerland. Around 2 million copies have been sold in Europe with almost one million in The UK alone.

Jive co-ordinated with 20th Century



Fox and ensured that the Billy Ocean video was screened as a trailer to the movie generally two months before the arrival of the film. The film is becoming a box office hit: as John Briley, md Zomba Holland, aptly remarked: "It is proof indeed that a catchy song is the best possible promotion for a film."




**Miami Vice- MCA**

MCA's most successful OST to date is Miami Vice which has so far released 3 hit singles. Stuart Watson, international director MCA, comments: "The phenomenal US success (4 million units) which resulted in MCA's first ever quadruple platinum lp meant that release in many territories had to be prior to the series." MCA TV own the series and MCA Records work closely with the affiliate in feeding out information of new sales of the series to the record people. A heavy marketing campaign was placed around the launch of the LP with press ads and window displays

**Pretty In Pink- A&M**

A&M released Pretty In Pink in mid-February, the soundtrack to a film done by Paramount Pictures directed by Tom Hughes (of Breakfast Club fame). The LP contains an impressive line-up of 80's talent including OMD, Suzanne Vega, INXS, New Order, Belouis Some and Echo And The Bunnymen. Two singles are to be released from the LP: New Order's Shell Shock imminently and towards the end of April Left Of Center performed by Suzanne Vega backed by Joe Jackson on the piano. Bert Ruiter, product manager A&M, says that they are currently working on a marketing campaign, but he points out that it is significant that the album was released 3

or 4 months before the film.






## Centerfold - Dictator Injection/CNR





## Singles Guide

Bowie holds his reigning position in the European Airplay charts for already 3 weeks, although the difference with Stones and Queen isn't that big anymore. Queen's single *A Kind Of Magic* moves in it's 3rd week from 17 to 3 and many of our correspondents think this is their best single for a long time.

George Michael's 'dedication to a memory' gets enormous airplay in Europe and it is together with Queen the top new add in Europe (5-18). Who would ever have thought that the Continental Europeans would appreciate the (typical?) English humour of the Young Ones? Not only in England is the charity single *Living Doll* receiving masses of airplay, but in all the major European markets the single is shooting up in the radio airplay charts and in some countries the single ever entered (new in Holland at 16). In the Airplay Top 50 the single is already number 8 and in the European Hot 100 it rose with a bullet to 25. Another odd combination: Art Of Noise featuring Duane Eddy, doing very well with their re-make of *Peter Gunn*. 12-24 in the Airplay Top 50. Recently Island artist Ruddy Thomas recorded a version of *Peter Gunn* as well (as the B-side to his new single *Long Lost Lover*), seemingly unaware of the Art Of Noise release.

Falco is already for three week at no. 1 in the Billboard Hot 100 and both in the Airplay Top 50 (24-49) as well as in the European Hot 100 (38-44), the single is doing extremely well. Last week the Dutch producers of the song, Bolland & Bolland, were awarded with the Dutch Export Prize

New airplay entries for Big Country (28), the English Siren act it's *Immaterial* with their glorious and sparkling country-tinged pop single *Driving Away From Home* (one of our Sure Hits of three weeks ago) and the East-Londoners The Outfield with their Police-like *Your Love*.

A new no. 1 in the European Hot 100 as *Survivor* (after topping the charts for 7 weeks) is replaced by Billy Ocean's *When The Going*. It is Ocean's first European no. 1 hit and it took him 12 weeks to accomplish this.

One of the biggest Euro-Crossover movers this week comes from a real Princess! Stephanie, the Monacan princess already had a very good selling single in France with *Ouragan* ('Hurricane'). The English translation of this song, *Irresistible*, enters both the German and English hit parades this week and in the Hot 100 it makes a surprise jump from 95 to 11! The 20 year old Stephanie was very successful as a model with her swim wear collection 'Pool Position'. This is her first hit single and a pretty successful one too.

ZZ Top release a new single, *Rough Boy*. A beautiful and slow ballad, with fine guitar works. Chrysalis released the new single of

**Icehouse**. *No Promises*. Floating rhythms, a wonderful melody and the identifiable Ferry/Bowie-like vocals. Former Split Enz front-man Tim Finn releases his new solo single entitled *No Thunder, No Fire, No Rain*, taking a couple of plays to fully appreciate its impact. RCA UK released the single by an unknown band entitled *The Man* and their single *It's All In The Game* is overstickered with 'this record is a hit'. And yes, we like this sort of catchy pop, a Sure Hit this week. Another Sure Hit by the Island act, *Baby Go Boom!* who release a funky dance pop single entitled *Life (Can Be A Hurtful Thing)*. Hook heavy pop with a sense of urgency that really works.
