Sky Considers 24-Hour Pop

Sky Channel is looking "very seriously" at the feasibility of launching a 24-hour pop music service to take advantage of the gap which will be left when Music Box transmissions become part of overall Superchannel output at the end of this year.

The idea reportedly grew out of representations made to Sky by UK cable operators worried about losing the pop-around-the-clock service they can presently offer, and anxious that the free availability of Music Box programming through the night on Yorkshire TV and potentially on all UK commercial tv stations could start to hit their subscriptions. Some operators in continental Europe have expressed similar concerns.

Sky says it has made no decision as yet, but is examining questions of cost and logistics. But it stresses that it has both the resources and the expertise necessary, and points out that it was the first in Europe to savor daily pop music, back in 1983. With UK produc-

tion now centred at the Carlton facility in North London the company has the capacity to undertake something more ambitious than merely downloading ■ continued on page 3

London Weekend TV To Transmit Night Programming

London Weekend TV could become the second UK commercial broadcaster to experiment with night-time transmissions, following the lead set by Yorkshire TV with its three-month trial for all-night Music Box pro-

gramming. Suggestions that regulatory body the IBA might decide to award separate franchises for night-time broadcasts have alarmed the independent companies. The best way to head off such a plan, they believe, is to get in first, but most are only in the early stages of planning. LWT however has already spent two years researching the market, and had it not been for the dispute with the BPT over video clip payments might already have started night transmissions.

Pop videos would clearly form a major part of the LWT service, provisionally dubbed "Night Owls", but the company stresses it is not planning a diet of wall-to-wall clips. Says a spokesman: "Although music will be a large part of it we don't just want to string a load of pop videos together. We are looking at creating a broadcasting equivalent of some of the more upmarket style magazines.

Europe 1 Prepares New FM Programming More Music For Younger Audiences

If Frank Tenot, managing director of Europe 1, has his way, about 40 French towns will be receiving 'Europe 2' by the end of the year on FM.

Europe 2 will consist of music programmes, supplemented with some news bulletins, which local stations will be able to relay in part or in full as and when they wish. "The only obligation," stipulates Tenot, "is that these stations should re-transmit the programme at peak period, in particular in the mornings when publicity

(the only financial resources) will be reinforced."

Several dozen local radio stations have already been approached, in particular those belonging to regional daily papers. Thanks to this new project, Europe 1 hopes to reach a younger audience and financially speaking, branching out onto FM is indispensable for the network. "To be a success," says Tenot, "Europe 2 must reach one million listeners."

IFMTC Unites Cable & Sat Programmers

The formation has been announced of the International Federation of Music Television Channels (IFMTC) of which founder members are Sky Channel, Italy's Video Music, Music Box in Germany and MuchMusic of Canada. Together these reach nearly 19 million homes with daily pop music programming.

President of the new federation is David Ciclitira, assistant md Sky Channel, with Music Box's Wolfgang

Fisher, Video Music's Pier Luigi Stefan and Moses Znamier of MuchMusic as vice presidents.

IFMTC says its main aims are to explore the possibilities of co-production and programme exchanges, to serve as a forum for the exchange of views on common problems, and to examine national and international copyright provision. The federation also pledges to fight piracy of members' programmes.

BBC Attacks Peacock's "Phoney Bill Of Goods"

The BBC will fight any attempt to sell off Radio One and Radio Two, as proposed in the Peacock Committee's report on the future of UK broadcasting.

In his first public comments on the report BBC Radio managing director Brian Wenham told the Radio Academy Festival in Glasgow that the disposal of the two stations would be a "fraud." "The promise that the dropped-off bits would re-emerge as something as well established as Radio One and Two cannot be delivered," he claimed, adding that the Peacock proposal was "a phoney bill of goods."

If the two services were to be inevitable, Wenham said, then the programme mix of the remaining Radio Three and Radio Four stations

would have to be modified to accommodate pop music and sport. The BBC would look at the government's eventual Green Paper on radio with an open mind, but this should not be interpreted as lack of resolve.

On the future of radio in general, Wenham said the BBC would welcome an expansion of services, but was very unlikely to undertake such expansion itself. "We want a more lively and varied radio pattern, and we expect most of the new radio to be non-BBC and either community or commercially led. When we say we welcome an extension of radio outlets we mean it, and we accept that it is inevitable that BBC's share of radio listening will fall a little as a consequence."

The Boss Releases 10 Yrs Live Action 5-LP Set Spans Recording Career

Bruce Springsteen is in the middle of finishing a live album, entitled "Bruce Springsteen And The E Street Band Live 1975 - 1985". Released late fall, the 5-lp set contains some 40 songs recorded in concert during the US tours of 1975, 1978, 1980-81, and 1984-85. It will be Springsteen's eighth album, spanning his entire recording career and a follow-up to the "Born In The USA" album which has become one of the best-selling albums in the history of recorded music with total world-wide sales in excess of 17

million copies. In addition to the set, a 36-page booklet with lyrics and photographs has been prepared. All recordings were produced by Springsteen, Jon Landau and Chuck Plotkin and recorded by Toby Scott (with some cuts recorded by Jimmy Iovine). Digitally mixed by Bob Clearmountain and digitally mastered by Bob Ludwig. multi-cassette and multi-compact disc formats will be simultaneously issued.

Jarre To Perform For The Pope

Jean Michel Jarre has been invited by his home city of Lyon in France to perform a concert in honour of the pope's visit to the town. A spectacular extravaganza in line with his previous show at Houston, Texas, will take place on Sunday October 5th.

Jean Michel Jarre's show will celebrate the visit of John Paul II to the area and will take place after the pope's blessing of the city. Lyon was the birthplace of the first christian church in France and the last papal visit to the town was in 1808. Jarre's senator and mayor Franiscoe Collobin has said that the city will be welcoming not only its own inhabitants but

also pilgrims from abroad. He added: "The people of Lyon will express their immense joy in greeting the pope through the music of Jean Michel Jarre, one of the most illustrious contemporary musicians."

As in Houston, the latest techniques will be used to accompany Jarre's music which he will perform on a stage placed at the bottom of the hill Fourviere. The event will be backed by millions of lights, graphic projections, illuminations and fire works. Comments Jean Michel Jarre: "I'm extremely honoured and proud to have been asked."

the existing "Sky Trax" strand. If a decision is made to go ahead, the start-up could come as early as the end of the year, assuming the agreement of Video Performance Limited. Music Box head Charles Levison, now joint managing director of Superchannel, concedes there is demand for 24-hour pop, but says: "If they have to make a choice between Music Box and Superchannel the overwhelming majority of operators say they will go

for Superchannel." No operator has yet cancelled its contract with the Music Channel, he adds.

Even after Superchannel gets underway, operators will still have the option of rolling out Music Box's six hours of programming into a separate 24-hour service. Delays in securing union agreement have led to Superchannel missing its scheduled October 1st launch date, but the service expects to be on air within two months of concluding those agreements.







Paul Young's 3rd LP Shifts To Self-Penned Material

Padgham Acts As Invisible Catalyst

The latter half of October will see the release of Paul Young's third album, tentatively titled "War And Passion" or "Between Two Fires". The three months of recording at the Piazza Castello studios on the outskirts of Milan have just concluded and the first single, "Wonderland", will be released September 22nd, with the LP out October 13th.

Paul Young's album differs from his previous two, "No Parlez" and "The Secret Of Association", in several respects. This is the first album to be co-produced by Young, co-writer Ian Kewley, and Hugh Padgham of Phil Collins, Genesis, Police and Paul McCartney fame. It is the first of Young's albums not to be recorded in the Workhouse Studios in London, and it is his first album with considerably more original material than the cover versions the artist formerly relied on. Young's previous two backing singers, the two sisters calling themselves the Fabulous Wealthy Tarts who

were then replaced by three black male singers are now reduced to one black vocalist so that the vocals are far purer and higher in pitch.

Much of the material on the new album was written by Paul Young himself (and partly co-written with Ian Kewley), as he explains: "I decided to get away from the crowds and go to France for a few weeks to write my own songs. I ploughed through around 200 cassettes, sent from all sorts of people including Bryan Adams, but

none were too stimulating; the result being that only 2 of the 11 tracks on the album are covers. I have adopted my own musical direction because now is the time to take the chance of moving on."

This new policy of writing more of his own material is in line with his

strongly felt opinions on the importance of lyrics. Young adds: "The songs themselves are more important than the way they are presented and lyrics have a suggestive, probing quality which is all too frequently destroyed by videos." He has always avoided videos, confiding those he has


made to fairly straight performance pieces, as he says: "Unless you're very clever, videos take all the mystique out of the lyrics."

When recording new songs, Paul Young is very much aware of the importance of live shows since he feels that an artist's duty lies in a good deal of touring for the fans. Although it has been two years since "The Secret Of Association", Young has in that time embarked on a year long worldwide tour. Young is very much in favour of touring in the States (where he last year had a no. 1 single and conquest breakthrough with "Every Time You Go Away") because as he says: "There is no need to comply with trends in the States. In the UK fashion is 50% of

success and the video business in the UK signs up any old artist who looks half decent but who half of the time can't sing."

Padgham was able to record the majority of the tracks on the new album live as he explains: "The band members are all very high class players, thanks to which we managed to record all instruments basically at the same time. Young and his band are very much a collective effort. This made my work much easier and I was essentially an invisible catalyst." Paul Young's shift from Laurie Latham to Padgham after having worked with Laurie for the first two years was because, says Young, "it's really quite exciting to have a change from one producer to another, otherwise there's always the danger of getting stale."

In the U.S. the band got overwhelming response with their album *Look What The Cat Dragged In* and many consider the act to have the same potential as Motley Crue. The company has also great confidence of the hardrock band Stryper, who sold over a million copies in the US of their new album *Hell With The Devil*. An interesting angle for media people could be the unusual combination of hardrock and inspirational leanings. As the band has not been able to tour Europe due to





It'll head off for Israel, America, Japan and Australia during their spring.

And Nik's also been busy lending his voice to the anti-heroin record

Nik arrived home from his holiday in Barbados on Sunday morning only to be driven straight to the Abbey Road Studios to join a host of stars including Cliff Richard, the Thompson Twins, Frankie's Holly Johnson, Fish from Marillion and many more - but not Boy George as hoped. The songs they recorded will be released as a single in a month's time and will also appear on the double Anti-Snack album which comes out in November. The LP features tracks either especially written or donated by top name artists like Paul McCartney, Eurythmics, Bananarama and Ringo Star. Profits from the records will go to The Phoenix House Charity's drug rehabilitation programme in the UK and Europe.

And these days, rock stars don't just sing for charity. Last week Amies International benefited from a cricket match in Bristol where Mike Oldfield and John Illsey took their turn at the crease and Feargal Sharkey provided entertainment of a more musical variety. Meanwhile in Germany, De' Lappard's one-armed drummer, Rick Allen, led a rock soccer team which included artists from Iron Maiden to victory against an all-star West German side. However Rick Wakeman's charity soccer match on home soil didn't go quite so well when he fractured his arm and had to cancel an Italian concert and maybe Elton John should stick to what he does best too, shooting of the video for "Heartache All Over The World" had to be postponed when he dislocated his shoulder playing tennis.

What is the typical 'Cars sound'? It is hard to pin point but it has definitely got something to do with Rick Ocasek's distinctive voice and knack of writing songs that combine strong hooks with persuasive leads. Ocasek's first solo single for Geffen, *Emotion In Motion* is a slow, moody mainstream pop single that hardly differs from the usual Cars releases. Nevertheless, an interesting song that is sure to get attention on the European radio.

Glades Knight & Bill Medley deliver the love theme for the Sylvester Stallone movie 'Cobra'. *Loving On Borrowed Time* is a beautiful romantic ballad with a good build up and modeled along the lines of Cocker & Warner's 'Up Where We Belong', the love theme to 'An Officer And A Gentleman'. Borrowed Time is already getting good reports from our correspondents and if this trend continues it has a fair chance of entering the European Airplay Top 50 next week.

First tips are beginning to pour in for the new Billy Idol single *To Be A Lover*. The single comes from his new album *Whiplash* which will be released on October 15. 'To Be A Lover' is full of driving energy and power and will soon enter the Airplay Top 50.

More recommended singles for your rock radio shows include Rod Stewart's *Another Heartache*, an Adams/Vallance co-written single, convincingly sung and with lots of appeal. Chicago have re-issued their 1970 hit *25 Or 6 To 4* in a 1986 remix. Produced by David Foster, the single features the new singer Jason Scheff (Peter Cetera has concentrated completely on his solo career) and it is from their forthcoming album '18'.

Madonna releases her new single *True Blue* this week with the second-time round hit 'Holiday' on the B-side.

More new singles for Queen. *We Can't Live Forever* a plaintive and dramatic slow song, featuring a 74-piece national philharmonic orchestra conducted by Michael Kame, to be found on their latest 'A Kind Of Magic' album and also featured in the film 'Highlander'. Ultravox release a new single *Same Old Story*, from their forthcoming album *U+Ux*. No doubt the single with its sense of immediacy and the urging female backing choir will deliver the band a big hit.

White Hollywood Beyond's 'What's The

Colour Of Money' is still a hit in some countries, in the UK there is a follow-up entitled *No More Tears*. Super 'Pet Shop Boys' Hogue's produced single features a swinging and accessible beat.

A new number one in the European Hot 100 Singles as the unusual fact happens that a pop act is being put back by its own clones. Madonna's 'Papa Don't Preach' is after an 8-week domination replaced by Dutch duo M.C. Mikker "G" & Dreijay Sven who took exactly 7 weeks to reach this feat. As stated before it doesn't happen often that a Dutch production is that successful abroad and this marks the first time in the history of M&M that a Dutch record reaches the Top of the Hot 100. Further to that it makes *Holiday Rap* also the most successful continental European production of this year (although Norwegian A-Ha' also

reached the top with 'Take On Me', this was basically an English production).

Dieter Bohlen must undoubtedly be one of Germany's most successful writers and producers and he has again triumphed, this time with C.C. Catch's *Heartbreak Hotel*. This week's highest debuting single due to a gigantic jump in the German charts (15-7) and an entry in Belgium.

The top of the European Airplay Top 50 is taken by acts of American origin as Huey Lewis stick for the second week at no. 1, followed by Bruce Hornsby and Madonna. Highest Airplay entry for Dead Or Alive's *Brand New Lover* and other Airplay entries include Julian Cope, Hollywood Beyond and Big Country's latest *One Great Thing*.






AUTUMN BOOST

The traditional autumn release schedule has definitely set in with lots and lots of important releases to serve the European media. This week we welcome new albums by **Human League**, **John Fogerty**, **Bon Jovi** and **Talking Heads** and forthcoming new albums are expected from **Ultravox**, **U2**, **Alison Moyet**, **Eric Clapton**, **Frankie Goes To Hollywood** (*Liverpool*), **Billy Idol** (*Whiplash*), **Howard Jones** (*One To One*), **Paul Young** (see for all information page 8), **Pretenders** (*Get Close*), **OMD** (*Pacific Age*), **Iron Maiden** (*Somewhere In Time*) and **Miles Davis** (*Tutu*). The autumn boom follows a rather busy summer schedule that reversed the usual summer trend of a slowdown in releases.

The major 1p to arrive this week is **Talking Heads' True Stories**, another David Byrne project that whittles off many interesting side activities. As stated in last week's issue 'True Stories' is not the soundtrack to the movie, as the OST contains versions of songs from the movie, sung by the actors, available on separate recordings. Every Talking Heads album is something to look out for; Byrne is a gifted songwriter and knows how to capture the attention. Although this album does not signal any drastic changes in musical style and as such is a direct continuation of the 'Little Creatures' album, it is however a very solid collection of interesting pop songs. Byrne is able to reach a maximum of effects with very simple knocks. Perfect examples are *Dream Operator*, *Hey Now*, and *City Of Dreams*. A simple, almost naive view, making them the David Newman of today's pop music.

The new **Human League** album, *Crash*, is closing a gap of two years since the last last

released 'Hysteria' and it is this week's highest entry in the European Hot 100 Albums, due to high positions in the UK, Germany and Belgium. Producers Jimmy Jam and Terry Lewis have helped acts like S.O.S. Band, Janet Jackson, Alexander O'Neal and in a similar way the magic touch of the duo should help the Sheffield sextet as well. Jam and Lewis have added a sparse and cool edge to H.L.'s techno-pop. The result is a truly soulful album of at least several strong contenders for radio play including *Are You Ever Coming Back*, *I Need Your Loving* and *Love Is All That Matters*.



With all the Abba members delving into solo projects a new album from the ultimate renegades of pop is always welcome. *Abba Live* features songs from their Australian tour in 1977, the Wembley Arena in 1979 and the Dick Cavett Meets Abba TV-show 1981. Not only a live album, but also a strong 'Best Of' compilation. Including hits like *Dancing Queen*, *Gimme Gimme Gimme*, *Super Trouper* and *I Have A Dream*.

David Sylvian's 1994 solo debut 'Brilliant Trees' was the favourite album of the year for many European media people. The follow up, *Gone To Earth*, will probably not evoke the same strong reactions. The double set contains two more superfluous tracks to be able to fascinate from beginning to end. The best tracks are on the last 1p (*Flow Man*, *Silver Moon*, *Taking The Hell*); if Sylvian had released a single set the outcome would have been of a greater overall quality.

The extensive European marketing campaign orchestrated by Capitol/EMI to promote Tina Turner's new album (see last week's M&M) is certainly paying off. In only her second week of being charted, she shoots up to 12 from 93!

Some records have more than the usual six-week shelf life, as is clearly demonstrated by the Swedish trio **Fake** with their song *Brick*, originally signed through D.I.D. Records in Italy and as such a hit in Italy as well as in the Scandinavian market. M&M's New Talent tip dated last December, the single now suddenly crops up in the French hit parade. This excellently polished disco production with its glorified vocals is currently Top 50 in France.

Good to see M&M New Talent tip *Ronette* having a Top 3 position in the Swedish chart with *Never Ending Love*. We're still waiting for the other European EMI companies to release this contagious pop single. Metronome act *Trio Rio* are still going strong in the German charts with their single *New York-Rio-Tokyo* still at the third position and the album *Trio Rio* at 35. In the meantime the master is placed in no less than 14 European countries (including the UK) as well as South Africa and Brazil.

Say tuned for the new *Tracee Daniels* single *Hoodoo Wanna Woodoo*, which should bring the Swedish act, reviewed in next week's New Talent!
