## Midem Lines Up Star Studded Galas

In its first year since being acquired by the UK commercial TV company TVS, the Midem organisation hopes to set new attendance records for the annual five-day music industry event, scheduled to take place January 26-30 in the Nouveau Palais, Cannes.

The 21st Midem will gather more than 7000 people from the international record, music publishing and video music markets from all over the world. 1.550 companies will be participating in the event, 800 of which will have a stand. As well as the usual conferences and symposiums, Midem will be host-

ing several galas, the most prestigious of which is the Opening Gala on Sunday 25th. Called the Midem Trophy Gala, it will be a truly international event with artists from nine countries appearing: Stephanie, Images, Desireless (France), Level 42, Carmel, Basia (UK), M.C. Miker "G" & DeeJay Sven (Holland), Hong Kong Syndikat (Germany), Spagna, Gianni Nannini (Italy), Carl Lewis, Berlin (US), Claude Maurane (Belgium), Fake (Sweden) and Stephan Eichler (Switzerland).

## Ariston Pulls Out Of The Record Business

Milan—It has just been announced that Ariston ceased all its disc activity as from the end of 1986. While the publishing business remains at Ariston Music, all record masters, except for the Matia Bazar recordings which belong to the group itself, were bought by the Trident Company and then immediately resold to Durium.

Says Trident President Maurizio Salvadori: "We are a management agency and we did not mean to go into the record business. The only reason we went into the whole thing

was because we wanted to get the best possible buy out for Matia Bazar whom we manage. The hardest problem was to settle the contracts for the recording artists' roster. As it was not advisable for us to buy the Ariston company, and as those contracts could not be sold, we only could try to settle artists' problems one by one.

As far as Matia Bazar are concerned, we are looking around for a recording contract suitable to the international status of these artists."

## UK Pirates Under Attack

The number of pirate radio stations regularly broadcasting in the UK has been cut from 27 to just seven in the year ending April 1986, according to the first annual report of the radio regulatory division of the Department of Trade & Industry in London.

Members of the division's Radio Investigation Service (RIS) raided 69 unlicensed radio stations a total 217 times. As a result 124 people were convicted by the courts and

fines of more than £ 35,000 imposed.

The successful crackdown, following a "sustained and concentrated campaign", reflects RIS action since it started seriously monitoring and tracking down pirates and unlicensed radio users in 1985. The campaign followed many complaints from people about radio and television interference in their home.

The move follows the recent

## UK Publishers & Songwriters To Be Protected?

Britain's Mechanical Copyright Protection Society (MCPS) and the British Phonographic Industry (BPI) are considering whether record companies should be required to lodge bonds when concession agreements are granted, so that publishers and songwriters do not end up out of pocket in the event of any label collapsing.

The move follows the recent failure of two UK companies, Towerbell and Stuff, leaving

500,000 pounds in unpaid royalties owed to MCPS members. At Commercial Operations Controller Graham Churchill says: "The record industry has an obligation on behalf of its membership in total. While companies are granted concessions at variance with the strict conditions of the Copyright Act they should move hell and high water to make sure they keep to their side of the agreement."

## New German CD Factory Totally Computerised

Interpress, the manufacturing subsidiary of West German record company Bellaphon, has set up its own compact disc plant and set a 1.2 million unit output schedule for 1987.

Branko Zivanovic, Bellaphon

President, says the new plant represents a "major breakthrough" in CD manufacturing technology, incorporating new handling systems and complete computerisation of all production processes.

Last year's IMMC resulted in more than a thousand extensive interviews with artists for radio and television stations all over the world. BBC Television's Michael Hurlst is presently preparing the Golden Rose Rock TV Show which once again will be attended by a line of commentators. ## TUBE PLANS FOR '87

1987 Tees' The Tube is kicking off Tube year with a first ever 90-minute Tube special starring such artists as Kate Bush, Patsy Kensit, Siouxsie & The Banshees, Steven Fry and XTC amongst others.

Other Tube plans for the coming year include Spandau Ballet at the NEC in Birmingham, England. This 45-minute special captures the band's sell out concert in late 1986 which will be screened on Valentine's Day (February 14). The Tube is also breaking new ground with a 3-D video project to be filmed by award winning director Kevin Bayle for a screening with the aid of 3-D glasses in March.

Negotiations for two major international projects, profiles of David Bowie and Tina Turner, are also under way. And making their first ever appearance on British television in the weeks ahead are Psychedelic Furs, The Smithereens, and ex-Bowie guitarist Steve Nicks. Executive producer Malcolm Gerric comments: "The Tube enjoys a rare reputation for discovering new bands like Frankie Goes To Hollywood, Paul Young, Housemartins, Fine Young Cannibals and Hollywood Beyond. And during the rest of the current series I plan to double the amount of new talent on screen."

## Madonna Wins World Video Awards

Madonna's 'Papa Don't Preach' has taken the top place in the World Music Video Awards 1987, broadcast live worldwide on January 10 as the first project of the recently formed International Federation of Music Television Channels.

The organisation claimed that some 225 million viewers in 35 countries across four continents watched the three-hour programme, which included live segments from London, Los Angeles, Paris, Toronto, Sydney, Tokyo, Florence and Munich, coordinated via a five-satellite link-up.

Despite the multi-national flavour of the event, British and American acts dominated the Top 20 awards, voted by viewers worldwide. Second place went to Peter Gabriel ('Sledgehammer'), followed by Wham ('Edge Of Heaven'). Duran Duran ('Notorious') and Cyndi Lauper ('True Colors'). Only the Scandinavian act Europe, in seventh place with 'The Final Countdown', and A-Ha, fifth with 'Hunting High And Low', interrupted the Anglo-Saxon dominance.

Madonna took an additional national award for the leading US clip, and Peter Gabriel a second award for innovation in video presented by Coca Cola, sponsors of the event. Other national award winners included David Bowie, Eurythmics, Queen and Genesis.

## Independent TV In UK To Back Film Industry

Britain's independent television companies seem set to provide substantial backing for the British film industry. One proposal suggests ITV companies putting up some £5 million a year for three years to help finance 20 British movies which would be shown on commercial television.

This would be via an investment in British Screen Finance (BSF), the private enterprise spin-off of the National Film Finance Corporation. The plan, virtually certain to be approved, is seen as a major boost for BSF, which currently has around £10 million a year to invest in film production.

BSF gets £1.5 million in government grants annually, this set through to 1991, and the rest of

its revenue comes from shareholders, Channel 4, Rank and the Cannon Film Group, and from income from the old NFFC catalogue of film rights.

The scheme ties up with the controversial issue of access by independent producers to the broadcasting system. Douglas Hurd, the Home Secretary, has said that he wants to see independent producers gain access to 25% of Britain's television channels over the next four years.

But it seems certain that there would help to be agreement the rest of a screening with BSF would have to go to "real" independent producers, and not be returned to the film-making subsidiaries of ITV companies.






## Corey Hart - Commitment To Success

The new single, "Can't Help Falling In Love", similarly entered the American CHR radio charts at 47 last week with a bullet. It has already been released in Scandinavia and Holland and other countries are to follow soon.

With "Fields of Fire", the Canadian artist who writes all his own material has brought an emotional

commitment not just to personal relationships but to international issues as well. Songs like "An Angry Young Man" and "Political Cry" explore the disillusionment of contemporary youth. Capitol/EMI are confident that "Can't Help Falling In Love" will repeat the success Corey had with "Sunglasses At Night". The video has already been added to the MTV rotation lists.

Corey Hart is currently interviewing for new band members and is about to embark on a world tour which will follow on from his appearance at the prestigious San Remo Festival in Italy.



## EMI Releases Beatles CDs

Following mounting public demand, EMI Music Worldwide will release the first four Beatles albums on CD. Released in their original UK format on the Parlophone label, "Please Please Me", "With The Beatles", "A Hard Days Night" and "Beatles For Sale" will be released on February 26 and further Beatles CDs will be issued chronologically during 1987.

Bhaskar Menon, Chairman and Chief Executive EMI Music Worldwide comments: "I am absolutely delighted to announce the release of the first Beatles CDs, it is another significant chapter in the historic

relationship between EMI and the Beatles."

These historic CD releases coincide with EMI Music's recent release of its catalogue on CD, following the opening of its CD manufacturing plants in Jacksonville, Illinois, the UK plant in Swindon and Toshiba-EMI's joint venture in Tokyo, Japan. Other titles in the new schedule include the Beach Boys, Kate Bush, ELO, J. Geils Band, Steve Miller, Pink Floyd, Bob Seger, Frank Sinatra and Cliff Richard. Also set for release as CDs are titles from the legendary Blue Note Jazz Catalogue.

## Major European Tour For Berlin

Berlin kicked off their intensive two month European promo and concert tour on January 10 with a gig in Manchester, England. They are performing as special guests to Frankie Goes To Hollywood. Following a couple of gigs at Wembley in London, the successful US group will tour in Northern Ireland, Scotland, France, Italy, Holland, Belgium, Switzerland and Germany.

In addition to the concerts, they are appearing at the Midem Opening Gala as well as in several television shows including two French shows, Champs-Élysées on Antenne 2 and A La Folie Pas Du Tout on TF1, a performance on Dutch pop programme Countdown and on Belgian Bingo. Interviews have been carried out for Belgian Rox Box, an Irish TV show and German and Italian interviews are undergoing negotiations.

Berlin's former single, "Take My Breath Away", reached no. 1 in almost every European country, hitting the no. 1 of the European Hot 100. The second single to be issued from their current album, "Like Flames", is already charted in Holland, Germany and Belgium. The UK has released a single entitled "You Don't Know It" which will be the next single to be released in continental Europe. The song is already charted in England and following last week's appearance on the UK's The Tube, the single is expected to zoom up the charts. Berlin also shared the dubious honour of appearing in ITV's Saturday Superstore, sharing the limelight with British prime minister Maggie Thatcher.

Midem is well known for its quality Galas. As well as the Trophy Gala, the 21 Midem will include the Gala Prestige (Thursday 29th), during which James Brown, Al Jarreau and Kim Wilde will perform, and the Stars Of Tomorrow Gala organised by the International Federation Of Music Channels (Sky Channel, Music Box, Much Music, Video Music, TV6 and Channel 10 from Australia). A possible jazz Gala still has to be confirmed.

Although Midem is traditionally a meeting place for publishers, record companies are also well represented. RCA/Ariola will have A&R and publishing representatives from virtually all territories. Says Rick Blaskey, Vice President of European Marketing for RCA/Ariola Int.: "Over the last year or so we have been undergoing major changes structurally and otherwise, so now, as a major, fully integrated international company, Midem is of substantial value to us. It brings together our own people to kick off the new year and if used properly by individuals one can

pick up what the rest of the industry is up to as well. It also gives us the opportunity to present new acts and albums to our own people."

The only major RCA act appearing at Midem during the Prestige Gala is the American mother and daughter country act, The Judds.

PolyGram Int. are bringing Berlin, Level 42, Stephan Eicher (from Barclay France) and Gianna Nannini with them for the Opening Gala. They will be both re-signing and signing new acts to their labels; the Cure will be re-signed to PolyGram Int. for the Polydor group, Victor Lazlo, who was previously with Polygram France and Germany, will also be re-signed to the overall group and Joan Jett, formerly with CBS, will be signed to PolyGram Int.

WEA will be represented by ar-

tists Al Jarreau and Kim Wilde. To celebrate the 15th anniversary of the founding of WEA last year as well as the 20th anniversary of Midem, WEA had a large delegation in 1986, but will this year be going back to their former participation. Says Juergen Otterstein, Marketing Director WEA Europe, "We have decided to adopt a low key approach this year."

Most of the European publishers from EMI will be represented at Midem together with publishers from Japan and the US. Brian Hopkins, Creative Director EMI Music Publishing comments: "We intend to be as aggressive and high profiled as ever. Last year we signed Duran Duran, Status Quo and Black Britain, a new British band we believe have a significant future, and we hope to keep up these activities in 1987. We are always interested in major new European talent because we feel Europe is a significant source of repertoire. Our great find in 1986 was obviously the band Europe who have enjoyed such tremendous international success. I still believe that Midem is a good market both to make new friends and to discover new talent.

CBS will only have three members representing the company, but their female Polish singer Basta will perform at the Opening Gala.

Last year Britain was the most strongly represented territory followed by France and the US. This year the British presence is expected to be even stronger, while West German and Scandinavian participation is also likely to be well up. More national stands than ever before will be taken with Australia, Holland, Belgium, Austria, Sweden, Finland, Norway and Canada

sector European satellite service based in Luxembourg, in 1988.

Astra plans a 16-channel operation covering most of Western Europe starting in the spring of next year. Thames is paying £3.7 million for an initial 5% stake but has an option open until June to take a further 5%.

The investment is seen as a major move for Thames, which is the largest of the 15 TV companies but which did not join Super Channel on January 30.

Thames is the only British company to invest so far in SES, a private company which was founded in March 1985 and has 12 investors headed by the Luxembourg and Belgium banks. Astra is a medium-powered satellite so its channels can be received by domestic dish receivers of around 85 centimetres as well as by cable television networks.

The Royal Albert Hall rocked to the guitars of Eric Clapton and Mark Knopfler last week when Eric played his sellout Longon gigs. Mark joined the three-piece backing band of Greg Philingtons, Nathan East and Steve (Duran Duran/Average White Band) Ferrone and kept a low profile until the encore when they did a version of "Money For Nothing." Among the favourites performed was "White Room" which is also one of the live tracks on the limited edition gatefold of Eric's new UK single "Behind the Mask" - the other is "Crossroads." Both were recorded at Eric's Birmingham concert last July when Phil Collins helped out on drums and backing vocals; it was only a matter of days after they had emerged from the studio where Collins had been producing "August."

Simply Red have announced their UK tour dates to coincide with the release of their second album 'Men And Women'. It begins in

Dublin on February 24 and winds up at the Hammersmith Odeon a month later.

A long-awaited Go West LP has been put back yet again. After the delays caused by computer problems in the Denmark studio at the end of last year, the latest setback is Peter Cox's illness which has held up the final re-mixing. Now he's on the mend so should see it emerging at the end of February.

Hugh Cornwell's current release "Facts And Figures" is just one of a number of tracks he has been working on without the Stranglers and there will be a solo album in the spring. However, Hugh stresses that he has no intention of leaving the band and says, "I just have too many songs and many of them are not Stranglers material."

UB40 get a lot of what we Brits call 'suits' over the discrepancy between their name (the UB40 is our unemployment ID form) and their ever-increasing fortune. They are also criticised for the alleged lack of political commitment in their songs which seems a bit unfair when they released the anti-apartheid track "Fight For Ourselves" and played a benefit gig for the Movement in December. It has now come to light that they are not one of the many British rock groups who have forbidden the sale of their records in South Africa. Singer Ali Campbell defends their decision by saying the country should be listening to their songs and some of the

money made on sales there goes to worthwhile causes. They also make sure that no potentially sensitive tracks are omitted from the South African album releases.

We hear that Boy George has been banned by Malaysian radio as the government try to eradicate all traces of the drug culture from music and entertainment broadcasts.

The Smiths' new single "Shoplifters Of The World Unite" will be followed by another album by the band on Rough Trade, their last before switching to EMI. The band enter the studio soon to start work on it, but even before that, Rough Trade will be releasing a compilation of Smiths' tracks selected by lead singer Morrissey, called "The World Won't Listen."

The Human League will soon be releasing another single from the "Crash" album. Crash is exactly what the last follow-up to "Human", namely, "I Need Your Loving" did in the UK. They're off to the States in February, then the Far East and Europe, and there's the possibility of more British dates in May or June.

Deep Purple's first UK single from 'The House Of Blue Light' is 'Call Of The Wild', out at the beginning of February and, as mentioned earlier, Eric Clapton's first UK single from 'August' is 'Behind The Mask', his best shot at a British hit in years.







## Highlights

### UNITED KINGDOM

After a very quiet period the English charts are now full of interesting changes. Jackie Wilson stays on top but is followed by a disco-instrumental piece called *Jack Your Body* by Steve Silk Hurley which of course makes him a very good contender for next week's no. 1. Steve Silk Hurley is a member of the band J.M. Silk, but this track dates from the time he was still on his own. At three is Alison Moyet with *Is This Love*. But Steve Silk Hurley is not the only contender; Robbie Nevil's *C'est La Vie* jumps from 32 to 6 and *Swing Out Sister's Surrender* climbs from 38 to 10. The latter is receiving very good station reports. Other good moves are for Lionel Richie (17-24), Iggy Pop (8-36), Paul Simon (26-31) and Bangles' newest *Walking Down Your Street*. There are 24 new entries this week, we can't mention them all but here are the most important ones - *Style Council's It Didn't Matter* (in at 15), *Mission with Hasselblad* (24), *Sionis & The Banishes' This Wheel's On Fire* (30), *UB40* (31) and *Julian Cope with Trampoline* (33).

### GERMANY

**BANGLES** have changed places with **Mel & Kim** who are now on top. In third position is **Stephan Remmle**. At 7, 8 and 9 are three new additions to the top 10. The first is for **Genesis** (7-13), the second for **Kim Wilde** (who is slowly but certainly conquering the whole of Europe with this single) and the last is off with **Electric Salsa**. The biggest jump this week is for **Robbie Nevil** (16-521). Other jumps worth mentioning are for **16 Bit with Where Are You** (11-21), **Sandra's Lovest** (26-32) and **Alison Moyet** (37-49). **Fancy with Lady Of Ice** is highest new entry at 47. **Nick Kamen, Gregory Abbott, Housemartins and Eddie Meyer** (*Take Me Home Tonight*) are new at 66, 72, 74 and 75 respectively.

### FRANCE

The French hit parade is usually very stable but just as in the UK, there are quite a few changes this week. **Ella** remains strongest for the second consecutive week followed by **Europe** and **Desireless** (*Hoyage Hoyage*). Good moves for **Caroline Loeb** with *C'est La Quête* (19-15),

**Jean-Luc Lahaye** with *Il Faudrait Que Te Reviennes* (9-26), **Lana Parker** with *Les Eaux D'Amé... Eric* (*Your State Of Mind*... Eric) (35-32), the incredibly popular **Niagara** with their latest *Je Dois M'En Aller* (24-38) and **Depeche Mode** (29-42). New entries for **Francis Lalanne** with *On Se Re-Trouvera* the soundtrack to the very popular French movie *Le Passage*, **Bernard Lavilliers** with *Noir Et Blanc*, **Lio** with *Fallait Pas Commencer*, **Stacey Q** and **Carmel's Sully**.

### HOLLAND

**Mel & Kim** have finally replaced the six week contenders **The Bangles** who are now in second position. **Spandau Ballet** follow at 3. Three new additions to the top three are **Box Jovi** (6-11), **Nick Kamen** (9-14) and **Red Box** (10-16). **Erasure** are storming up the charts with their *Sometimes* (12-24), and, after a slow start, so are **Kim Wilde** (21-32) and Dutch singer **Richened** with *Dance Around The World*. More good jumps for **Alison Moyet** (17-21), **Gregory Abbott** (18-27) and **Debbie Harry** (25-29). New entries for **A-Ha** (highest entry, in at 26), **Berlin's Like Flames**, **Housemartins**, **Micela's** version of the Madonna song *La Isla Bonita* and **Paul Simon**.

### IRELAND

**Jackie Wilson** has reached the top followed by **Housemartins** and **Europe**. **Genesis** entered the top 10 just like **Gap Band** who entered straight in at 10. Another high entry is **Lionel Richie's Ballerina Girl**. Good moves for **Genesis** (9-13), **Pretenders** (12-16) and **Gina with Run Like The Wind** (19-27). Other new entries are **Bangles**, **Jim Lockhart** (*Theme From Glennie*) and **Debbie Harry**.

### SPAIN

There are not many changes in the Spanish charts this week. The top three are the same as last week with **Modern Talking**, **M.C. Miker "G"** and **Deejay Sven's Holiday Rap** in second position and **Level 42** in third. There are no new entries this week, only a few re-entries; **Mecano** (*Cruz De Novias*), **David Bowie** (*Underground*) and **Modern Talking** (*Brother Louie*). **Jumps for Wax's Right Between The**

**Eyes** (13-22), **Bruce Springsteen** (17-30) and **Depeche Mode** (32-46).

### SWITZERLAND

**Mel & Kim** have also conquered the top slot in Switzerland, and are followed by **Status Quo** and **Kim Wilde**. No shocking moves this week; the best move is for **Drea Harrow's Catch The Fox** (8-15). The Rio singer **Stephan Remmle's Keine Sterne In Athen**, **Madonna** and **Fancy's Lady Of Ice** which is very appropriate considering the weather at the moment in Europe.

### AUSTRIA

**Status Quo** have made it to the top. **Mixed Emotions** follow at 3 and **Contact with Schourze Madonna** (which is a ballad and has nothing to do with the "blond" Madonna). Highest new entry is for **Elkin & Nelson** with a Spanish song called *Jibaro*. This song was released in 1974 on an album and on a 12" in 1980. Since then there have been offers of up to £800 for this record, according to CBS who have now released it as a single. Other entries are **Duran Duran**, **Madonna** and **Europe** with *Rock The Night*.


### SWEDEN


### DENMARK



## THE GAUDI PROJECT

More albums are now beginning to trickle in after the Christmas lull. Arista has released a beautiful sounding digitally recorded album by Alan Parsons Project, entitled *Gaudi*. Working alongside executive producer Eric Woolfson, the team (who have worked together for 12 years) label their albums 'projects' since their music follows a specific concept and is made up with the cooperation of different musicians, rather than a steady band. Parsons' earlier experience as a technician for the Beatles, Paul McCartney and Pink Floyd (for which he was nominated for a Grammy for 'Dark Side Of The Moon') and as producer for Steve Harley and Al Stewart, stood him in good stead for his debut as a musician. Now nine albums later with around 25 million albums sold in total, the latest Alan Parsons Project is inspired by the life and works of the Spanish architect Antonio Gaudi, famous for La Sagrada Familia Cathedral, Barcelona. The opening track uses vocals from John Miles but each track is strongly recommended for its soothing atmospheric harmonies.

In line with the recent stream of compilation albums (Springsteen, Kate Bush, Pet Shop Boys), Soft Cell (who have now split up of course) have released an album entitled *The Singles*. The legendary duo, one of the best exponents of the 'British Invasion', were responsible, according to many, for a new musical sound: techno-pop combined with Marc Almond's soulful voice. 'The Singles' shows the musical variety of the duo in such songs as the danceable up-tempo *Down In The Subway*

and Torch, their mega worldwide hit *Tainted Love* and the beautiful *Say Hello, Wave Goodbye*.

Freddie Jackson's latest album, 'Just Like The First Time', has already been a huge hit in the US where it went to no. 1 in the Black Billboard Charts. The soulful ballad singer is renowned in Europe for his 'Rock Me Tonight' and 'You Are My Lady'. The production of the album continues in the same vein as his former ones: the majority of the tracks are romantic love songs, kicking off with the first two hit singles of the album *Tasty Love* and *Have You Ever Loved Somebody*. Other recommended tracks are the up-tempo *Jam Tonight, I Can't Let You Go* and the ballad *You Are My Love* (sounding like a mix between Lionel's 'Lady' and Diana's 'Missing You').

After a long absence, Microdisney have released their third lp on Virgin entitled *Crooked Mile*. Produced by Lemmy Kaye, of Patii Smith and Suzanne Vega fame, the album includes 12 new Cathal Coughlan/Sean O'Hagan compositions. The overall feel of 'Crooked Mile' is an American style r&b sound mingled with synthesizers, accompanying some fairly outspoken lyrics. Faves are the accessible *Town To Town* and the country & western style *Our Children* with backing vocals by June Miles-Kingston.

George Clinton has come up with yet another compilation album, *The Best Of George Clinton*. An ideal album for new fans to become acquainted with Mr. P. Funk with his amusing and funky classic such as the '83 US hit *Atomic Dog* and *Quicke* and the more recent single *Do Fries Go With That Shake*.

BOB GELDOF is all set to start his tour at the end of February. His latest single Love Like A Rocket has just been put onto the market. Last week he could be seen on at Sky Channel's World Music Awards where he was the first artist to perform live with his new 45er called Stay Out Of My Life \*. The Cost Of Loving is the title of the latest Michael Jackson album, slated for a February release and produced by THE VALENTINE BROTHERS. The new SIMPLY RED single is out by the beginning of February, entitled Red Thing. Backed by the track, 'There's A Light, the single takes from the forthcoming album 'Men And Women', out March 2nd.

It seems certain that MICHAEL JACKSON's long awaited lp will be available in March, produced by QUINCY JONES, but as yet, it is still unannounced. Produce Monsters, to be released in February, on which he had help from ex-JAPAN drummer STEVE JANSSEN as co-producer and on that just-issued single Buy, from DAVID SYLVIAN as vocalist and co-writer \*. BAD COMRANLY is special guest on DEEP PURPLE's European tour \*. Also touring Europe starting at the end of February is DAVID THOMAS & THE WOODEN BRIDGES to promote their album Blame The Messenger \*. SUDDEN SWAY have signed to Rough Trade and will release a new single this week \*
