## French Fall For Oldland's Fair Musical Charms

Largely neglected at home, Columbia Records' UK artist Misty Oldland has been one of the past year's most notable channel crossovers.

She has struck a strong chord with French audiences in particular thanks to extensive TV appearances and the support of the country's radio industry.

Following an introductory showcase at Midem 1994, the Columbia label division of Sony Music Entertainment France put together a game plan for Oldland involving performances on most of the nation's prime TV shows.

Radio promotion kicked in at a later stage, and now, 10 months later, the singer's *Supernatural* album has sold 50,000 copies in France.

## Cecchetto Leaves Radio DeeJay, Launches Syndication Service

Italian record producer and media entrepreneur Claudio Cecchetto has resigned as artistic director of Radio DeeJay, the country's leading private radio network, which he founded in 1982.

Cecchetto says he plans to create a new national syndicated network using his own Milan/Lombardy regional station Radio Capital as a base, and that he will be taking personalities from Radio DeeJay with him to launch the new project.

Cecchetto sold a majority stake in Radio DeeJay to the Espresso Publishing Group in 1989. According to Radio Capital MD Luigi Latini, Cecchetto had been disillusioned with his role at Radio DeeJay for some time.

"He resigned as artistic director following disagreements with the owners over the direction of the station," says Latini.

Radio Capital is reported to have signed a contract with Tele-

com Italia for digital distribution via satellite.

The new syndication project is being called "Media Network" and Latini explains that while other syndicators exploit a loophole in the law to transmit nationally 24 hours a day, Media Net-

work will respect the law and supply the maximum allowed six hours a day of live programming in a complete block every afternoon, with the local affiliates maintaining their own live output for the rest of the time.

## Cabrel, Solaar Top Of Victoires Nominees List

MC Solaar, Alain Bashung and Francis Cabrel head the list of nominees for the Victoires de la Musique, the French music awards.

Columbia-signed Cabrel—whose album *Samedi Soir Sur La Terre* has already sold over 1.5 million copies in France alone—has been nominated twice, as Best Male Act and Best Album, but falls short of his five nominations in 1990.

Alain Bashung scores four times for Best Song and Best Video (*Ma Petite Entreprise*), Best Album (*Chatterton* on Barclay), and Best Concert.

Polydor rap artist Solaar, who earned the Victoires for upcoming act in 1991, now has three nominations: Best Male Act, Best Album (*Prose Combat*) and Best Video (*Nouveau Western*).

## Mercury Recruits Arrive For Island Label

Mercury outlets across Europe—as Phonogram companies are now known—are appointing managers to handle the newly-arrived Island label, which has switched from BMG to PolyGram in accordance with a £320 million worldwide deal (app. US\$508 million) signed in 1989.

The transfer marks the end of a 24-year relationship between Island and Ariola, Europe's longest ever licensing deal. It does not effect the UK and France, however, where Island has operated stand-alone companies.

Since the new arrangement came into effect on January 1, Mercury is responsible for marketing and promotion of Island repertoire in Europe, and new

recruits are taking their places to handle the job.

In Holland, Mercury senior marketing manager Dries van der Schuyt has reorganised along label lines. Connie Kemp has arrived as Island product manager, moving from EMI. "We feel that Holland is too small of a market to go by repertoire," says Van Der Schuyt. "Apart from dance, which has its own infra-structure and

needs specialised marketing, we like to put professional people at specific labels." Newcomer senior product manager Chris Havinga will handle Mercury UK/USA.

The recently-restructured PolyGram Germany (M&M, December 3) will be one of the few outlets not to appoint an Island representative, as product is divided into repertoire categories.





# Ministry Shakes Up Radioscape; Extra 500 FM Stations Planned

Spain is planning to grant licences for 500 new FM stations in what will be the country's third major radiofusion plan since democracy

was restored after general Franco's 1975 death.

The news was announced at a two-day Madrid conference entitled "Public and Private Radio: The Rules of The Games," at the end of last year by Isaac Moreno,

deputy director general of radio affairs at the public works ministry, which covers telecommunications.

Moreno indicated that the licences would be granted in the spring, once the country's 17 regions have informed the public works ministry of their needs. He declined to estimate the number of new licences, but the International Telecommunications Union has granted Spain a maximum of 2,000 FM stations, and around 1,500 legal FM stations currently exist.

The two previous post-Franco radio reorganisations, in 1978 and 1989, both drastically reshaped and enlarged the country's radio scene. But these projects were carried out almost entirely by the central government, whereas the new plan will see the country's 17 regional governments granting the licences, pending the approval of the public works ministry.

The Madrid conference, organised by Radio Nacional de Espana (RNE) and the Spanish Association of Commercial Radio (AERC), was opened by public works minister Jose Borrell. He suggested that as part of a revision of the country's radio structure, it may be convenient to set up a national agency to administer the radio spectrum, whereby licences would be put up for tender. The idea is similar to one planned in France (M&M, December 24).

## Conference Highlights Key Programming Issues

**EUROPE**

Programming problems affecting radio stations across the Continent will come under the spotlight later this year at a seminar aimed at European programme directors.

By limiting the seminar to just 100 places, the organisers—radio consultancy firm Ad Roland Media Services and Music & Media—hope to create an intimate atmosphere to promote open discussions on vital programming issues.

Topics scheduled for discussion at the conference, to be held in Hilversum in the Netherlands on May 6-7, include the role of computers in programming, team building, time management, research and radio after the year 2000.

Explains Ad Roland's gener-

al manager Peter Nelissen, "Through the contacts with our clients—both public and commercial—and especially during sessions in our offices with Swedish programme directors, we realised there was demand for a seminar that wasn't based on the usual panels, but instead concentrates on European speakers, topics and round-table discussions.

"We also think it is vital for people to be able to talk freely about their experiences and share them with colleagues from all over Europe."

# Privates Protest Against 'Unfair Competition' From Local Radio

Representatives from private Spanish radio called for an end to the double financing of the country's 680 municipal stations through advertising and local government subsidies, alleging that it amounts to unfair competition.

Sixty experts at a two-day conference on "Public and Private Radio: The Rules Of The Game," organised by Radio Nacional de Espana (RNE) and the Spain's Association of Commercial Radio (AERC), were trying to discover the reasons behind Spanish radio's financial crisis.

The industry continues to register good listening levels with around 22 million daily listeners out of a population of 39 million. However, private radio alone lost about Pta6 billion (app. US\$46 million) in 1993, with Cadena SER being the only major net to make a profit. While all speakers agreed that the public/private mix must be maintained, the majority called for an end to the privileges they allege are enjoyed by radio stations funded by both advertising and local and regional governments.

AERC figures show that the municipal stations had a 1993 advertising turnover of around Pta7 billion, more than the total of private radio losses.

AERC chairman Alfonso Cavalle called the double financing "the key to all perversion," warning that many stations are being distracted from their public service

aims and are "being handed over to private individuals."

Onda Cero Radio managing director Santiago Galvan said local administrations had multiplied the number of public stations without justification, adding that the money invested could have been spent on other needs. HL

## EUROPE AT A GLANCE

### ITALY: Michael Jackson Found Guilty Of Plagiarism

Rome's Civil Tribunal has ruled in favour of Italian singer/songwriter Al Banao Carrisi, who claimed that mega-star Michael Jackson had copied one of his songs. Carrisi had said that Jackson's song *Will You Be There*, written in 1991, is identical to his own *I Cigni Di Balaka*, which he composed in 1981 and recorded in 1986. Judge Domenico Bonaccorsi has issued a temporary 120-day injunction against the use and distribution of Jackson's song, pending a definitive sentence including a decision on the extent of damages to be awarded. Italian lawyers representing Jackson say they hope to get the sentence annulled, claiming the judge was "incompetent in musical matters."

### SWEDEN: Sveriges Chart Show Inspires Music Book

The popular Swedish radio programme "Trackslistan," hosted for 10 years by Kaj Kindvall, has become the subject of a book. Premium Publishing in Stockholm has produced a 128-page publication detailing all songs ever featured on the Sveriges Radio chart show. The book lists hit singles by 800 acts and gives additional information on chart entry date, peak position, the number of weeks charted and label.

### HOLLAND: Jannah Offered Contract By Blue Note

US record company Blue Note has offered Dutch jazz singer Denise Jannah a contract, which the singer was scheduled to sign at the beginning of January. Under the terms of the deal, Jannah will record at least three CDs for the company, which will then be promoted worldwide. Jannah, who won a Dutch Edison Award last year, is the first Dutch artist to be signed to Blue Note.

### UNITED KINGDOM: BMG, Imago Part Company

BMG has brought its four-year relationship with Imago Records to an end, announcing the cessation of the joint venture deal between the two companies. Imago's biggest success to date is Henry Rollins' album *Weight*, which reached gold status in the US. Terry Ellis, the driving force behind Imago, has vowed to continue with the label and will retain all artists. In a recent move, some 20 staff members have been laid off by the label, leaving a core of 10 staff.

### UNITED KINGDOM: Mercia Sound's Linnell Receives MBE

Stuart Linnell, station director of GWR-owned Mercia Sound was made an MBE in the New Year Honours in recognition of his services to radio broadcasting. Linnell, 47, has been in radio for 25 years, including positions as sports editor at Radio Hallam in Sheffield, MD and programme controller at Leicester Sound from 1991-1994, and sports editor, DJ, programme controller and MD and GWR station director at Mercia Sound. Linnell has served on the AIRC Labour Relations and Programming Committees, and from 1988 to 1994 was the AIRC representative on the Sony Radio Awards Committee.

### EUROPE: Ledent-Vilain Leaves Warner Music Europe

After over 20 years with the company, Jaquelyne Ledent-Vilain is stepping down as Warner Music Europe (WME) director artist promotion to establish herself as an independent promotion consultant. She will continue to work with WME in this new capacity. Sue Wildish, currently promotion manager, will take over Ledent-Vilain's responsibilities. Wildish joined WME in 1988 from PolyGram International.

### SPAIN: Barcelona Gets New Onda Cero Station

Spain's most popular radio programme, Onda Cero's "Protagonistas," was broadcast last month by presenter Luis del Olmo from Barcelona's Palau de la Musica concert hall. The transmission on December 12 marked the inauguration of a new Onda Cero station in the city, Onda Rambla 89.8FM. The morning magazine show's guests included singers Lluís Llach and Carlos Cano, and it was followed by a reception in a luxury hotel attended by 1,000 people, including Onda Cero MD Santiago Galvan and Barcelona football club's Dutch trainer Johan Cruyff.

● BELGIUM: EMI Belgium appointed Erwin Listhaeghe as sales promotion officer with responsibilities for in-store promotion, special campaigns and trade relations. ● INTERNATIONAL: Jay Boberg is to join the MCA Music Entertainment Group as president of MCA Music Publishing worldwide, based in Los Angeles. Boberg was previously president of I.R.S. Records. ● GERMANY: Jörg Böhm has joined MCA Music's publishing arm in Hamburg as A&R manager. Böhm previously worked for WEA Music and is specialised in dance music. He replaces Armand Hacaturyan, who moved to Polydor as product manager for national signings. # German-Speaking Belgium Awaits New Frequency Plan

Public broadcaster Belgischer Rundfunk and the eight private stations in German-speaking Belgium are expected to be allocated fresh

licences valid for two years in mid-January.

The new licences are part of a new frequency plan hoped to open up extra transmission power and increase reach. The move follows a new frequency plan in French-

speaking Belgium at the end of 1994 (M&M, December 24).

All stations in the country have submitted applications for new licences to the regional audiovisual ministry, and the new frequencies are expected to be allocated before the end of the month. The country's eight private, Radio Aktivaet, Radio Rewi, Radio International Elsenborn, Radio X, Okay, Metropole, Fantasie and Studio Kelmis will all stay on air.

Three of them, meanwhile, have grouped together to form a trial network in anticipation of the new frequency plan. Radio Aktivaet, Radio Fantasie and Radio International are now broadcasting simultaneous programming under the name Pro FM, and are expected to increase their transmission power from 100 W to 1 kW by the end of the month. Negotiations are also reportedly under way with Radio Okay.

The new frequency plan is hoped to allow each station to cover at least 50% of either the North or South of the German speaking community, according to a spokesperson at the ministry for audiovisual affairs.

The new licences are also expected to take more account of the mountainous geography of the country, which has caused transmission problems for many private stations. Plans exist to boost maximum antenna power from 100W to 1 W.

All frequency plans in the territory must be negotiated with broadcasting ministries in the surrounding countries, and the current plan has been given the go-ahead by France, Luxembourg, Flanders and the French Community. Problems with Germany and Holland are still being looked at, however, as the proposed frequencies would cause interference with their radio signals.

# FNAC Fills Temporary Absence Of Chart

Retail music store FNAC is maximising on a two-month absence of official national chart data in Belgium to increase exposure of its Top FNAC 50 chart, based on sales information from its four stores in Belgium.

The hiatus comes as the last chart produced jointly by IFPI Belgium and Belgian authors rights association SABAM was published on December 31. SABAM did not renew its deal with IFPI, which expired on January 1 after 10 years.

FNAC is conducting negotiations with leading radio and TV stations and printed media to provide chart information until a revamped IFPI chart launches in March. RTBF Rock/EHR Radio 21 has confirmed that it will start using the FNAC album chart as from January 7.

Meanwhile, IFPI is now working on a new "regional" chart system, which is expected to be up and running in March based on research supplied by research company Nielsen. Information will be updated daily via barcode scanners installed at retail outlets, and will be divided to show figures for both

the French and the Flemish communities. Nielsen also operates chart research in Denmark and Italy.

Other additions will include a classical and a dance chart—for both singles and albums. The data will be published in a weekly 8-page booklet distributed to the record stores and public.

Meanwhile, record companies and societies will be able to access Nielsen's daily-updated files on chart information, via a system of membership. Companies can join a chart "foundation," which has at yet been given no name, allowing them to update their chart information from the Nielsen database, which will initially contain 80,000 titles. New members will be invited to submit their repertoire and to add barcodes to new releases.

Talks with the Flemish BRTN Radio and the French language Bel-RTL are reported to be in a final stage.

Meanwhile, it is uncertain whether FNAC will fully support join the new system. According to a spokesperson for the retail group, the Brussels and Antwerp outlets will be prepared for the Nielsen-based chart, while the other outlets are supplying only information for the Top FNAC chart.

# AKN Collaboration Dissolves

Dutch public broadcasting organisations the AVRO, KRO and NCRV have relaxed their collaboration arrangement set up three years ago, in a decision to "protect the identities" of the groups.

The three broadcasters joined forces in 1992, combining administrative facilities under the name AKN and sharing programming time on national EHR outlet Radio 3 as "Het Station." The arrangement marked the beginning of true "horizontal programming," where each day was divided up between two or more of the seven broadcasting groups, and a move towards increasing collaboration between the broadcasters.

A dissolution of the names "Het Station" and AKN is now part of a move to restore the individual on-air identities of the three broadcasters. For the listener the recent

changes will mean a return to the original station IDs and jingles. Programme slots and presenters will remain unchanged, however.

Behind the scenes, the changes will mean a dissolution of the combined management structure under Jan Steeman, returning decision-making to each of the three groups. Administrative duties will continue to be shared, in a new joint organisation SUS.

Radio 3 coordinator Paul Van Der Lugt stresses that the changes are "cosmetic." "The three broadcasters involved are reorganising their way of collaborating in order to maintain their individual stamp."

Steeman will now head the AVRO, while Jelleke Jongewaard and Ceciel Ten Tusscher will top the NCRV and KRO respectively.

Meanwhile, the structure of umbrella broadcasting organisation the NOS has also been modified. The organisation's two functions as broadcasting umbrella group and

producer of programmes have been split, with the establishment of a separate "programme foundation" the NPS.

According to the Dutch media law passed in 1992, broadcasters are required to collaborate in order to qualify for five-year licences. The need for the NOS to work closer with other broadcasters in programming required it to separate its two functions.

The NPS—which is without members, unlike the other broadcasters—will handle cultural shows, general interest- and programmes for ethnic minority groups.

The NOS, meanwhile, will continue its operations as a coordinating body, overseeing the operations of the whole public broadcasting system, and grouping together representatives from each of the broadcasting groups. Sports, news and major events such as the Eurovision Song Contest will continue to be handled by the NOS.

# EUROPE AT A GLANCE

## HOLLAND: Operette Gold Goes Gold

BMG Classics has confirmed that the compilation CD *Operette Gold* reached gold status at the end of December. More than 15,000 copies of the album have been sold in the Netherlands. The CD includes 22 of the best tracks from the Eurodisc label, including tracks sung by Rudolf Schock, Peter Alexander and Margit Schramm.

## GERMANY: Radio Hamburg Applies For Second FM Frequency

Private ACE station Radio Hamburg is applying for the FM frequency 104.0 to improve reception of its programme in the inner city area. The additional frequency would bring a step-up in broadcasting power of 160 wats.

## GERMANY: Radio RPR Achieves World Record

Tillmann Uhrmacher, presenter at private ACE station Radio RPR, holds the world record in non-stop radio presentation. Between December 27 and December 30, Uhrmacher stayed on air for 80 hours. The old record set up by German private broadcaster Delta Radio in Kiel amounted to 76 hours non-stop.

## FINLAND: Anssi Voted Radio Personality Of The Year

Listeners to YLE Radiomafia (the youth channel) have voted Ari Peltonen, alias Anssi as the Radio Personality of The Year in Finland. Anssi, known for his controversial language and topics, was "shelved" by YLE Radiomafia PD Leena Pakkanen late last year for going "too far". Following his award he is expected back on air soon. Anssi's style has made him something of a local youth hero. He recently recorded his first single "Soteem Pornolaulu" (Audiovox), in which he is backed by Radiomafia Chorus. Runners up included Alex Niemine, presenter of weekly "Lista" chart show and Friday's dance/disco marathon on YLE Radiomafia.

## FINLAND: Baba Lybeck Returns To Radio City

One of Radio City/Helsinki's original personality DJs, Baba Lybeck, has returned to Radio City, having worked at various stations including YLE TV 1. She will have City's Monday afternoon slot from 12:00-16:00 as a presenter of "A Blond In the Afternoon."

## GERMANY: New Age Act Cusco Nominated For Grammy In USA

Cusco's latest album *Apurimac II* has been nominated in the USA for a Grammy as Best New Age album 1994. The song *Montezuma* has been nominated as Best Instrumental of the year. Founded in 1979, the act has released 14 albums to date with a total of 1.6 million records sold worldwide.

## GERMANY: Music Magazine Asks Readers To Pick Top Radio DJs

Monthly music magazine *Musikexpress* has launched a reader survey of Germany's favourite radio DJs in its January 1995 issue. The deadline for the poll is January 11. *Musikexpress* staffers have already selected their Top 10 Radio DJs—only two of these work for private broadcasters, while public stations provide three: Alan Bangs (WDR1, Cologne), Mathias Holtmann (SDR3, Stuttgart) and Volker Wieprecht (Fritz, Potsdam).

## UNITED KINGDOM: Official R&B Chart Planned For January 14

Following a successful three-month trial period, the first official R&B chart will be published in the UK on January 14. The chart will be based on CIN data and compiled by Millward Brown, based on information submitted by 1,800 shops. CIN chart development manager Reuben Pearson says, "The test chart has gone very well. It has been accepted by the Chart Supervisory Committee and CIN as representative of UK R&B."

## UNITED KINGDOM: Licences Awarded For Birmingham

Birmingham Broadcasting, parent company of EHR station BRMB FM and gold broadcaster Xtra-AM, has been reawarded the FM and AM franchises for the Birmingham area. The licences will run for eight years from February 1996. Birmingham Broadcasting was the only applicant for the franchise.

## INTERNATIONAL: First Awards For Multimedia Products




## SPAIN: SER's La Rebotica Receives Science Prize



A single, low-cost MiniDisc gives you room for up to 255 idents or jingles. 148 30-second commercials. Or a total of 74 minutes of pure digital sound.



And since a MiniDisc measures 71 mm x 68 mm, it slips into a shirt pocket. (Try that with a few dozen carts.)

MiniDisc means instantaneous track access, with instant start and cue standby. It plays single tracks or continuously, and even pauses at the start of a track.

And with MiniDisc, you can re-record an unlimited number of times, then play back with sound quality that makes a cart sound like, well ... a tissue dispenser.

The only drawback? It'll never match carts for the uses shown above. But then, it's got more important things to do.

And haven't you?

# The Glove Puppet Invasion From Ireland Has Begun

Suspend disbelief for a moment and consider a singing glove puppet turkey (who thinks he's a vulture) who's as big as the Beatles. In Ireland **Dustin Hoffman Jr.**, the glove puppet in question, is the best-known turkey on the airwaves. His debut single, a traditional arrangement of the folk song *Spanish Lady* and sung as a duet with the **Dubliners' Ronnie Drew**, has dominated the Irish Christmas singles chart.

Artists like **Joe Dolan** and the **Saw Doctors** have lent a hand. **U2's** the Edge approved a flutulent parody of his own *Numb* from *Zooropa* while U2 manager **Paul McGuinness** even agreed to take part in the video, whispering advice in a glove puppet's ear just as in the original U2 video.

"Round Christmas we sold at least 20,000 copies of the single," says **EMI Ireland's Darren Smith**, "and we've deleted it to improve the album sales." The accompanying debut 14-track CD, complete with guest appearances and Dustin-style parodies of **Van Morrison's Coney Island** and

*U2's Numb*, has become a runaway best seller in Ireland for EMI. It has even matched sales of EMI's other big seller, **The Beatles, Live At The BBC**.

The glove puppet "invasion" has spread further than Ireland. **Zig 'N' Zag**, two furry aliens from the planet Zog landed on daytime Irish children's TV four years ago. Since then the two puppets with the stinging line in irreverent and iconoclastic patter have become star attractions on British TV **Channel Four's** daily "Big Breakfast Show." More recently the two wicked "Zogabons" have been recruited by **MTV Europe**.

"They said 'here's half an hour, do what you want with it,'" Zig, one half of the deadly duo said last week. The programme, which went on air in September captured the highest ratings on MTV in November and was run daily on Christmas week in MTV's "Best Of" series.

Meanwhile, the furry pair has taken the UK singles chart by storm and was predicted by many to topple **East 17** from the coveted Christmas number one spot—although this turned out to be a mission impossible. The Zig 'N' Zag single

though is no Christmas novelty single like 1993's *Mr. Blobby* phenomenon.

"We didn't want to make a novelty single but of course, with us on it, it is a novelty. If you take Zig 'N' Zag away it would stand up as a great dance single," says Zig.

They achieved this by recruiting top dance producer **Eric Morillo** of **Reel 2 Real** to do the production duties. "He's been a Zig 'N' Zag fan since he heard us do a country version of *I Like To Move It* on the Big Breakfast," says Zig. (Throughout this interview Zig's partner, Zag was constantly interrupting by submerging the telephone in their jacuzzi).

But there's more to their patter than meets the eye. The Zig 'N' Zag phenomenon may be big business right now, but by this time next year their fame is likely to have become global. Beneath those furry alien exteriors lurk two astute business brains.

Before Zig 'N' Zag left Ireland they had already scored a number one hit in the Irish singles chart with their debut double A-sided single, *ZigZaggin' Around* and *Tijuana Gypsy*, while their debut album, *Never Mind The Zogabons* was a runaway best

seller and sold 70,000 units in music cassette format only.

Merchandise deals abound and negotiations have already begun to export the MTV Europe show to MTV Asia and MTV USA. Meanwhile, Zig reveals, the single could be released throughout Europe in the new year because of the growing popularity of the MTV show. "It's not a Christmas single," says Zag, "so we can release it anywhere, anytime."

With Dustin ruling the roost in the Irish charts and Zig 'N' Zag plotting global domination, the glove puppet invasion from Ireland has begun in earnest.

In Germany, Island titles will fall under Mercury repertoire managers **Birgit Hönsch (ACE)**, **Thorsten Reuber (alternative)**, **Clemens Fachinger (black music/dance)**, **Ines Weidemann (pop/artist development)** and **Gianna Possehl (rock)**.

Elsewhere around Europe, new Island managers to join Mercury outlets include **Karin Leinwather** in Austria, **Stephen Pressinger** in Switzerland, **Derdrie Keustermans** in Belgium, **Michele Olcese** in Italy, **Pedro de la Espalera** in Spain, **Cle Dahlen** in Sweden, **Ingwe Ness** in Norway, and **Nat Beskos** in Denmark.

The first six months of 1995 will bring a flurry of new product, according to Island international product manager **Paul Zijlstra**, in London.

This will include new albums by **Marianne Faithfull** (produced by **Angelo Badalamenti**); **PJ Harvey** (*To Bring You My Love*); **Stereo MCs**; **Apache Indian**; **Bomb The Bass**; the **Orb**; a new **Bob Marley The Legend** sampler and new product from development acts **Don E., Salad** and **Spell**.

"The change to Mercury is very positive," he says. "You start working with new people and that always brings fresh ideas. Now we can really work on artist development."

Compliments to **BMG** for their handling of Island have been widespread, however, with particular credit for their job with the **Cranberries**.

The **Cranberries** come to Mercury as an established act, only two years after its debut album *Everybody Else Is Doing It, So Why Can't We?*, which sold close to one million copies in Europe.

## Oldland's Charms

With a new single on the market, the record company is hoping to strike gold (100,000 unit sales) before the summer, when Oldland's new album is likely to be released.

Part of her success to date is attributable to the local connotations of Oldland's first single *A Fair Affair* which sampled the basic rhythm of (and was lyrically inspired by) **Serge Gainsbourg & Jane Birkin's** 1969 hit *Je t'Aime Moi Non Plus*.

**Doe Phillips**, international marketing manager at **Columbia Records UK**, says, "We were helped by the 'Je t'Aime' part, although it could have worked against us. But the French were charmed by it and also fell for Oldland's personality. She's a natural on camera and what you see is what you get. The way she dresses—that masculine look—is also the way she is at home."

Tying in with the French release of the single, Oldland crossed the channel on March 7 for a showcase at a Parisian club, **The Hot Brass**.

To attract an audience, Columbia decided to play on Oldland's image: any girl wearing her hair in plaits could enter the show for free. Some 700 people showed up, including a large male contingent, and Oldland's first base was established.

Label product manager **Valerie Michelin** says this was followed by four other Oldland visits to Paris including performances for prime TV shows such as **Antenne 2's "Taratata"** (in which she appeared twice, once duetting with French

superstar **Patricia Kaas**), **A2's "Le Monde Est Fou"** and **Canal Plus' "Nulle Part Ailleurs"**. Also, the singer was on the mid-November "Mega Dance" spectacular organised by MTV Europe and radio network **NRJ**, which was broadcast on national TV channel **M6**. In June, **Columbia TV**-advertised *Supernatural* with 100 20-second spots on **M6, Canal Plus** and **MCM**.

Nevertheless, France is recognized as being a slow market, especially when it comes to introducing new talent.

*A Fair Affair* was serviced to radio at the beginning of April, but it was not until June that the single started showing up on radio playlists

(**NRJ** was as late as September).

Once under way, however, the French momentum can last longer than in a market like the UK. Almost 10 months after release, *A Fair Affair* was still receiving national airplay. The follow-up single, *Got Me A Feeling*, was serviced to radio last month.

According to **Columbia's Michelin**, **Radio Nova/Paris** was the first station to support Oldland. "They really developed her in France," she says, "and they were the official sponsors of her March 7 concert."

Programming the gamut of dance styles, from acid jazz to jungle and ragga, **Radio Nova DJ** and music programmer **Ariel Wicman** says Oldland's music fitted right in. So did her personality.

"We had great fun with her," he explains. "Only after we had met her, did

we play the album and we liked that too. **Misty** is a very relaxed and cool human being with an open mind. The whole persona appealed to us."

Oldland's cross-channel commitment was extended by a support slot for the **Brand New Heavies** in June when they toured Germany, Holland, Austria, Italy, Spain and France. She was also chosen for a **Levi's** jeans ad campaign, which saw her, together with **Ice T, Iggy Pop** and **Verve**, featured on in-store material and in a video screened in **Levi's** retail outlets. In Norway, the result was a top 10 slot for *A Fair Affair*.

Oldland's European profile was further raised when she hosted **Lisa L'Anson's "The Soul Of MTV"** show during October.

Now Oldland has turned her attention to 1995. According to manager **Rodney Borde-Kuofie** of London-based **Rubikon**, she is laying the groundwork for a new album and has demoed 17 songs for the project.

Moreover, the international emphasis remains: for Japan, where her profile is building, the singer will be making a new version of *What A Wonderful World* for **Sony**, with a local ska-reggae act, the **Tokio Scar Paradise Orchestra**.







But here you get it served with '80s hardcore, pure metal and a bulldog of a singer. All songs have a similar build-up, a raw rock part and a milder "Jamaican touch." The horn section is as basic as the one in Dexys *Midnight Runners* used to be. *Pictures To Prove It* might confuse your Selector-computerised playlist system, but not programers with a heart.

Accordion, fiddles and brushed drums create an atmosphere in which non-connoisseurs suddenly speak of "chansons" instead of songs. The HI-NRG factor is the connection with our time. For adventurous ears only.

Singing and chatting away, *Kick Your Game* with its lovely blubbery bass synth line is their entry into the pop league in which Salt-N-Pepa play. The **Prince** cover *If I Was Your Girlfriend* is the key to open radio's gates.



and **Mariah Carey's** Christmas smash *All I Want For Christmas Is You*. As usual this period of the year is rather flat as far as records are concerned, but I'm not overly worried. Among the tracks to look out for are **Jimmy Somerville's** new one *Heartbeat (London)*, which could become a major smash, while **Sounds Of Blackness' I'm Going All The Way (Perspective/A&M)** and **Barry White's Practice What You Preach (A&M)** are also serious contenders, especially now that there's a certain buzz around them."

Despite the usual end-of-year turbulence and irregularities influencing the national European charts, **Rednex' Cotton Eye Joe** remains leader of the Hot 100 pack, bullet 'n all. With the act's follow-up *Old Pop In An Oak* still in the top 10, **Zomba** is enjoying a great start to the new year.

Meanwhile, UK act **East 17** sees another European hit coming its way as *Stay Another Day (London)* consolidates its mainland success, climbing one place to number 2 and leaving the way free for a former chart-topper, **Bon Jovi's Always**, to descend another step from Eurochart heaven.

East 17, however, should look over their shoulder as the Irish answer to the heartthrob sensation of British Boy-bands, **Boyzonè**, climbs four places to number 6 with *Love Me For A Reason (Polydor)*.

This week's singles Sales Breaker award goes to **Guns N' Roses'** cover of the **Stones** classic *Sympathy For The Devil*. Recorded for the OST *Interview With The Vampire (Geffen)* it promises to become a hit and continue last year's trend of successful covers. A trend which also holds true for the band itself as *Sympathy For The Devil* is its 15th Eurochart entry and fifth successful cover to-date. Check out the hits:

The albums Sales Breaker award is for **Eternal's Always & Forever (EMI)** which jumps 15 places to number 19 this week. Enjoying huge UK Christmas sales it will soon ship its millionth copy after the band enjoyed no less than five British top 40 singles hits in 1994.



## OFF THE RECORD

**DUTCH KEY PLAYERS MAY COMPETE WITH MTV IN HOLLAND:** M&M hears that media joint venture Veronica/Endemol and record company Arcade have separate plans to set up music TV stations in Holland. Industry insiders assume that Veronica/Endemol is thinking of a 24-hour music channel targeting a strictly teenage group. Arcade is widely believed to be contemplating a part-time music station with a 25+ target demo. According to advertising industry sources, both channels stand a fair chance of competing with MTV Europe in Holland, where the key success factor could prove to be Dutch language presentation.

**NEWS WAR DEVELOPS IN UK:** M&M hears that the news service war in the UK has taken another turn, following the break of a contract between a major national private and National Network News in favour of Reuters Radio News.

**NOWOTNY RESIGNS AS DIRECTOR OF WDR:** After 10 years as director general of Germany's biggest public broadcaster WDR, Friedrich Nowotny has revealed his intention to leave the company on June 30. Nowotny's period of office was scheduled to end one year later. He cites "personal reasons" as the motivating force behind his decision.

**GOVERNMENT BACKS DOWN ON FREQUENCY FEE THREAT:** The French government is expected to shortly drop its proposal to create a new frequency agency to rent frequencies out to broadcasters. The proposal, made in December by a high-ranked civil servant (M&M, December 24), was met with such opposition by TV and radio broadcasters that the government is said to have realised that this wasn't a wise move just before crucial elections.

**BMG FINDS A PRESIDENT:** M&M hears that BMG has found a president for its French affiliate. Although no name has as yet been announced, sources says the successful candidate is "not from the music industry." The seat has been empty since Bernard Carbonez resigned in September.

**RESTYLED M40 WAITS IN THE WINGS FOR AIR TIME:** The new-look M40 station is standing in the wings and awaiting CSA's approval. The station's team has moved from their previous location in the centre of Paris to RTL's building close to the Champs Elysées. If approved by CSA, the new station will be called RTL 2 and will present a mix of music and news. Until now, CSA has been reluctant to let CLT have a radio station which uses the RTL name.

The neutral name Media Network was chosen to allow established stations to retain their identity, tagging the name onto the end of their existing title.

Media Network will target the 15-35 demographic with a hit radio format, according to Latini. "We will be playing less hard techno music [than Radio DeeJay] and concentrating on a mainstream variety," he explains. "The afternoon slot has been selected for the nationally syndicated live output, as it is peak time for Italy's youth

audience who finish school at 13.00."

Milan-based EHR/gold Radio Capital will modify its current format to fit with the new syndication plans, adjusting the balance towards more current hits.

Radio Capital, which will become the base for syndicated Media Network programmes, is also moving location for the anticipated April start-up. Currently housed one floor below Radio DeeJay in central Milan, they will be moving to the Assago Forum, an open-air arena for live concerts in the city.

# PolyGram Most-Nominated Record Company In Victoires

PolyGram heads the list of record companies in France's music awards, the Victoires de la Musique, with a total of 13 nominations.

Four of these 13 come under the Polydor flag, two are for Phonogram, while Barclay scores five nominations with four different acts, reflecting the diversity of

the label's roster.

The list of nominations includes 11 Sony Music artists with the majority of these (9) going to the Columbia label.

Virgin and its sub-imprint Delabel each score three nominations, while EMI earns two for its sub-labels Chrysalis (De Palmas) and CH2 (Vallée), and BMG has three (two for RCA's act Enzo Enzo and one for Ariola). At Warner, Carrère Music and WEA

Music each have one nomination.

The 10th edition of the Victoires will take place on February 13 and will be broadcast live on public channel-France 2.

The awards cover a total of 18 categories, with an additional two Victoires which are not subject to vote—Best Exported French Album (which will probably go to Patricia Kaas) and another for the Largest Concert Attendance.

projects are DJ's Amadeus and Luca Laurenti, as well as recording artists on Cecchetto's own record label, and those he produces for other labels including Jovanotti, Fiorello, 883 and Nikki.

Cecchetto is also expected to announce plans for a new syndicated music TV show along the lines of his DeeJay Television programme—made popular in the '80s on private network Italia 1—as well as a new music magazine and an internet on-line computer service to complement his record label and media interests.

Meanwhile, at EHR network Radio DeeJay, which leads the private ratings battle with a daily reach of over four million listeners, brothers Albertino and Linus have been appointed artistic directors.

Linus told M&M that he was sorry to see Cecchetto leave and wished him luck with his new project. "Claudio has been trying to buy back the station for some time, but when he realised it was not possible he decided to leave and start up something new."

Linus added that no major changes were planned in the immediate future. "What we will be doing is to give the station more of a communal direction, which was lacking while the disagreement between Cecchetto and the owners continued."

## NRJ, RMC Switch Ad Sales House Managers

### FRANCE

The managers of two leading French sales houses have traded places, with consequences for the country's leading network NRJ.

The changes see RMC's Elisabeth Descombes move to NRJ as general manager of the network's advertising sales house 15-34. She replaces one of NRJ's leading figures, Bernard Malvezin, who is moving to RMC's ad sales house GEM, which sells for RMC, Nostalgie and Radio Montmartre FM.

Descombes has been general manager of GEM since August 1992 and will now be responsible for selling NRJ, Cherie FM and Rires et Chansons. She reports to NRJ MD Alain Weill, who is president of NRJ's affiliate sales house 15-34.

Weill hails the departure of Malvezin, known for his straightforward selling methods, as "the end of an era," while some industry insiders suggest the split was not an amicable one.

The arrival of Descombes, Weill says, marks "a new step in

the development of the station. We want to strengthen the activities of our sales house at a moment when the business requires more and more attention and new methods.

"We are planning to increase the scope of our activities with the launch of our new national network [thought to be based on the Paris station Rires et Chansons] during the first semester of 1995. This change shows our will to take a new step and become the most efficient sales house on the market."

The name of the sales house will be changed, Weill comments, as 15-34 no longer reflects the NRJ philosophy. No name has yet been decided upon.

Some sources suggest that GEM and 15-34 may offer joint tie-in commercial proposals in order to compete better with the country's two other leading sales houses, Europe 1's Régie No1 (Europe 1 and 2, Skyrock, RFM and Les Independants), and IP (RTL, Fun, M40, Sud Radio and Wit FM).

The EHR Top 40 chart is based on a weighted-scoring system. Songs score points by achieving airplay at M&M's EHR reporting stations, that target 12-34 year-old listeners with contemporary music fulltime or during specific dayparts. Songs in "A" rotation airplay receive more points than those in "B" rotation or more limited airplay exposure. Stations are weighted by market size and by the number of hours per week committed to the format. indicates Europe's most Radio Active record, registering the biggest increase in chart points.

### East 17 At The Top

After eight weeks at the chart's top spot, six of which were consecutive, **Bon Jovi's** *Always* has made way for *Stay Another Day* by **East 17**. The British foursome take home their first EHR number 1 with this ballad, the third single from their second album *Steam* and their sixth hit on EHR. Boosted by 17 adds (the second best of the week) and six upward rotation conversions (from medium to heavy), *Stay Another Day* additionally earns the **Radio Active** designation—for the third time, as M&M's award for the week's biggest chart-point gain went to the same song three and four weeks ago.

*Stay Another Day* gains particular ground in France, Italy and Poland this week. The song is reported from no fewer than 26 European countries, most significantly the Czech Republic (100% penetration), the UK (84%), Holland (83%) and Norway (78%). Italy, Finland, Denmark, Russia and Switzerland form the second league, with figures ranging from 60 to 67%. It's interesting to notice that, on a regional level, East 17's current single appears in the top 3's of five out of the eight regional listings, but doesn't currently occupy any regional number 1 spot. In fact, eight different chart-toppers can be spotted—**M People**, **Bon Jovi**, **Sting**, **Madonna**, **Elton John**, **Mariah Carey**, **Aerosmith** and **Simple Minds** (see **Regional Airplay**, page 19).

The highest new entry in this week's **EHR Top 40** is *She's A River* by the Simple Minds, the appetiser for *Good News From The Next World*, the 12th album by the British band which has been slimmed down to a duo made up of **Jim Kerr** and **Charlie Burchill**. The album, their first original set in four years, is due out on February 6.

With 28 first-time reports at its side, *She's A River* also qualifies as **Most Added** leader. Appearing on playlists from 13 territories in total, the song is being picked up most fervently by our Czech reporters, with all four of them having it on rotation. Poland is next in line with 43% airplay penetration at this early stage. Key stations in Italy, Denmark and Spain have also added the song. On a regional scale, the Simple Minds' new material has conquered the East Central music radio by storm, as shown by their entrance straight at number 1 in that region (see **Regional Airplay**). The Simple Minds enjoyed three EHR hits before—*Let There Be Love* went highest, peaking at number 8 in 1991. The chart, however, wasn't launched until December 1990.

The other new chart entry is grabbed by the Senegalese, US-signed **Youssou N'Dour**, whose *Undecided*, the second single from *The Guide (Wommat)* and the follow-up to the immensely successful *7 Seconds* (seven weeks at number 1), enters at number 39, marking the artist's second EHR hit. *Undecided* is backed by a 28-station roster, recruited from nine countries—notably Italy, Belgium, the UK, Norway and Denmark. *Pieter Kops*

## Midem Stages Border Breakers Concerts

On January 30-31, international music industry market **Midem** stages two nights of "Border Breakers" concerts at the Studio Circus venue in Cannes to showcase new talent from the mainland expected to cross borders. Presented by Midem in collaboration with M&M, the series of concerts is inspired by M&M's own **Border Breakers** airplay charts, as featured on this page.

The concerts are organised to emphasise this year's main theme, christened the Midem 1995 A&R Spotlight, with panels, workshops and conferences concentrating on the vital role European A&R people play in the discovery of new artists, the recognition of their potential and the job of guiding them to the magical milestone of the pan-European hit. Since its inception in October 1993, the unique **Border Breakers** chart has become a crucial reference point for European A&R executives, signalling the border-crossing airplay achievements at an early stage.

Artists scheduled to perform during the **Border Breakers** concerts include **Inside The Whale** (Denmark), **Philippe Pascale** (France), **Nordman** (Sweden), **The Choice** (Belgium), **Mau Mau** (Italy) and **Celtas Cortos** (Spain). Be there! *Pieter Kops*

The *Regional Crossover* charts track the cross-regional movement of product. The *Border Breakers* chart ranks the 25 most successful Continental European records making airplay impact outside their region of signing (airplay achieved in the original region is excluded from the calculations).

The second chart, *Channel Crossovers*, registers the airplay penetration of UK-signed artists in mainland Europe, while the third Top 25, the *Atlantic Crossover* chart, ranks the most successful North American artists according to regional airplay impact in Europe.

All three charts are non-format specific. "Region Of Origin" is not necessarily an indication of where the artist comes from but, more significantly, where he/she is signed. An increasing number of national artists are signed to "foreign" labels and M&M wants to acknowledge the crossover impact of such deals.

For each record, "Crossover Regions" are listed in order of first-time airplay appearance.


